
step4 Tear off the tape, cut the ribbon, and take out the key. Make sure that all four corners are in correct place as shown.




Insert the key removed from Step 4 into the lock hole and turn it clockwise 180°. The lock is now open.












The cabinet can be fixed to the wall as needed.




































Install the other four drawers in the same way.


Possible problem: The drawer is too high to close.
