

BEFORE ASSEMBLY

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- Place all wooden parts on a clean and smooth surface such as a rug or carpet to avoid the parts from being scratched.
- Remove all wrapping material, including staples & packing straps before you start to assemble. DO NOT tighten all screws and bolts until completely assembled.
- Keep all hardware parts out of reach of children.



STEP 1


Attach frame (B) to the back (A) by using bolts (3) and (1) and washers (4) and (5). Tighten slightly with Allen Key (6).

Note: DO NOT fully tighten any bolt until the all chair components are put together.



STEP 2

Attach front legs (C) to the seat frame using bolts (2), washers (4) and (5). Tighten slightly with Allen Key (6).



Place the chair on a flat level surface to make sure the chair is levelled and then tighten fully the all bolts.
