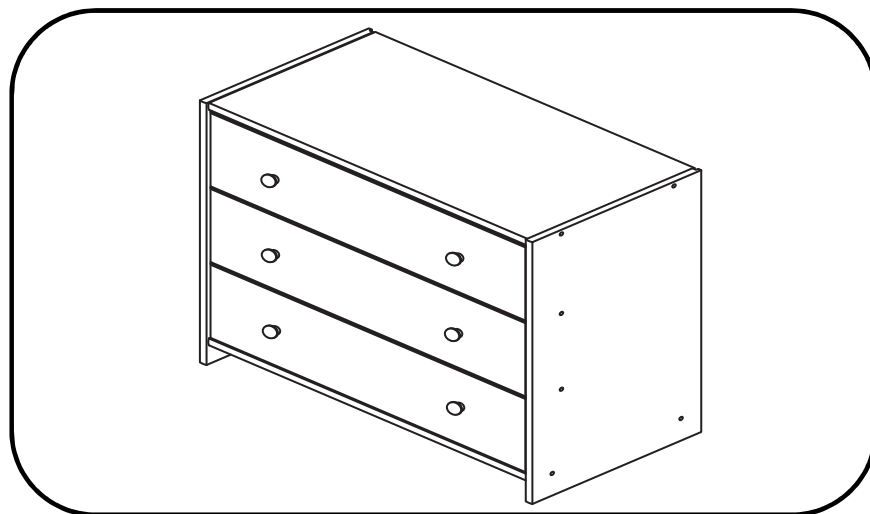


Low Loft Bed - 3 Drawer Chest

WARNING CAUTION

ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED CHOKING HAZARD

- This product includes small parts, sharp points and sharp edges in its unassembled state. Keep unassembled parts away from children under 3 years of age, and animals.

STRANGULATION HAZARD

- Never attach or hang items to any part of the chest that is not designed for use with the chest; for example, but not limited to hooks, belts, and jump ropes.

SAFETY WARNINGS

- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the loft bed end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.
- Do not allow children under 3 years of age to use the 3 Drawer Chest.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.

FURNITURE TIP-OVER HAZARD

Children have died from furniture tip-over.

To reduce the risk of furniture tip-over:

- ALWAYS install tip-over restraint especially if used by a wall or in the open.
- NEVER put a TV on this product
- NEVER allow children to stand, climb or hang on drawers, doors, or shelves.
- NEVER open more than one drawer at a time.
- ALWAYS place heaviest items in lowest drawers.



PARENTAL SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED

- This product is intended for child use age 3+.
- Parents or Guardians should supervise use under the intended age specifically regarding children that may have access to it and climb on the unit.
- Do not allow horseplay on, under, or behind the unit and prohibit jumping on the chest.
- If used improperly, your 3 drawer chest may be pulled over or fall, creating risk of injury or damage. Children should not be permitted to climb or pull on the 3 drawer chest.

USE, MAINTENANCE & ASSEMBLY

- Periodically check and ensure that the components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Use on level surfaces only. Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damage to unit or floor.
- Do not use this item if any components are missing or damaged.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Only clean using damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- Check you have all components and tools listed on page 4
- Do not stand or put weight on this product during assembly, this could cause damage.
- Remove all hardware from the plastic bags and separate them into groups.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Certain assembly steps may be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- We do not recommend power screwdrivers. Only use hand screwdrivers to prevent damage to unit.

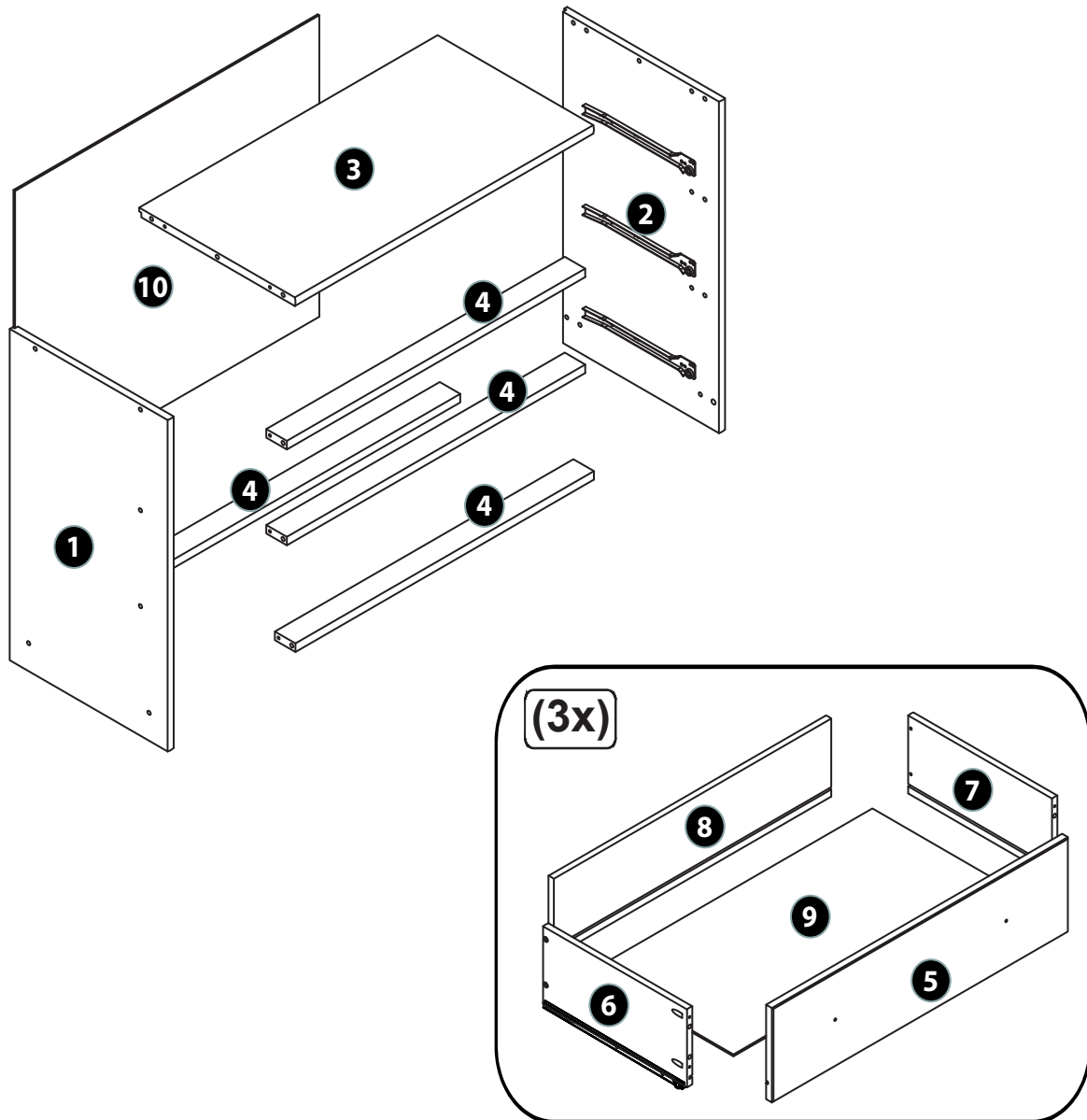
Para limitar el riesgo de vuelco de los muebles:

Due to the number of parts involved assembly can take a few hours so set aside between 1 and 1.5 hours to assemble this without rushing.

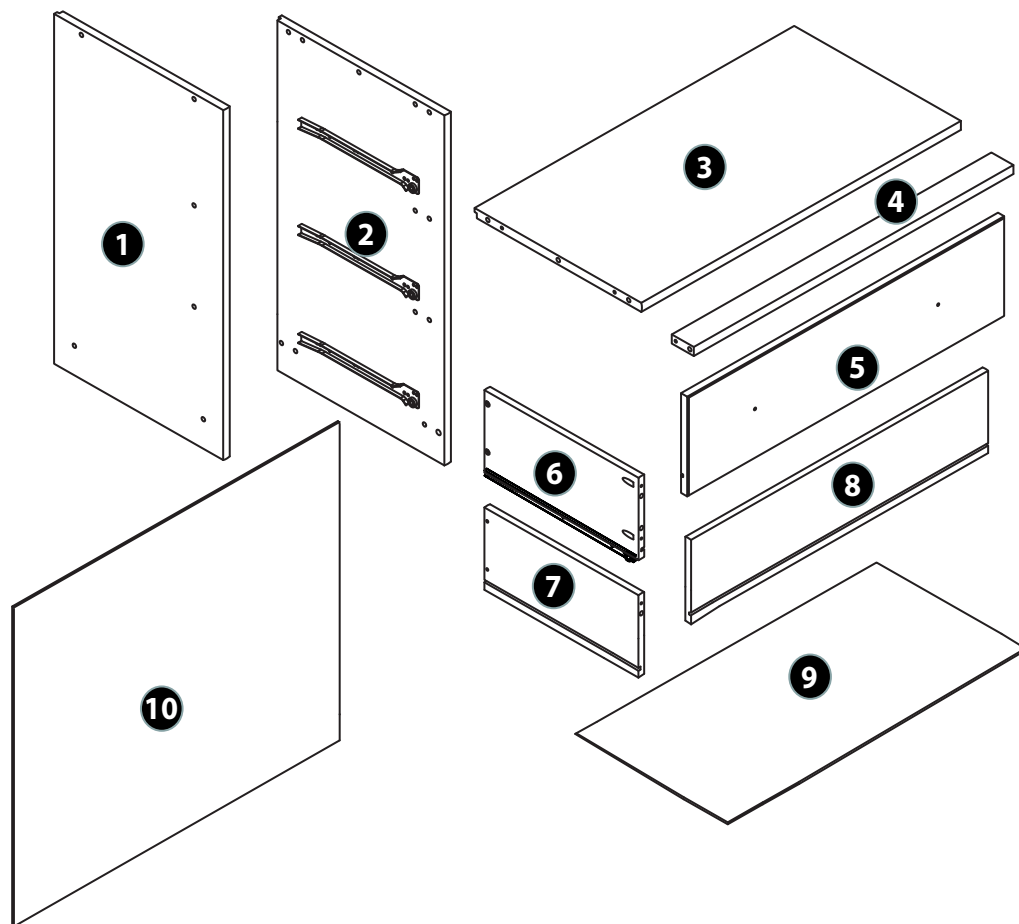

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

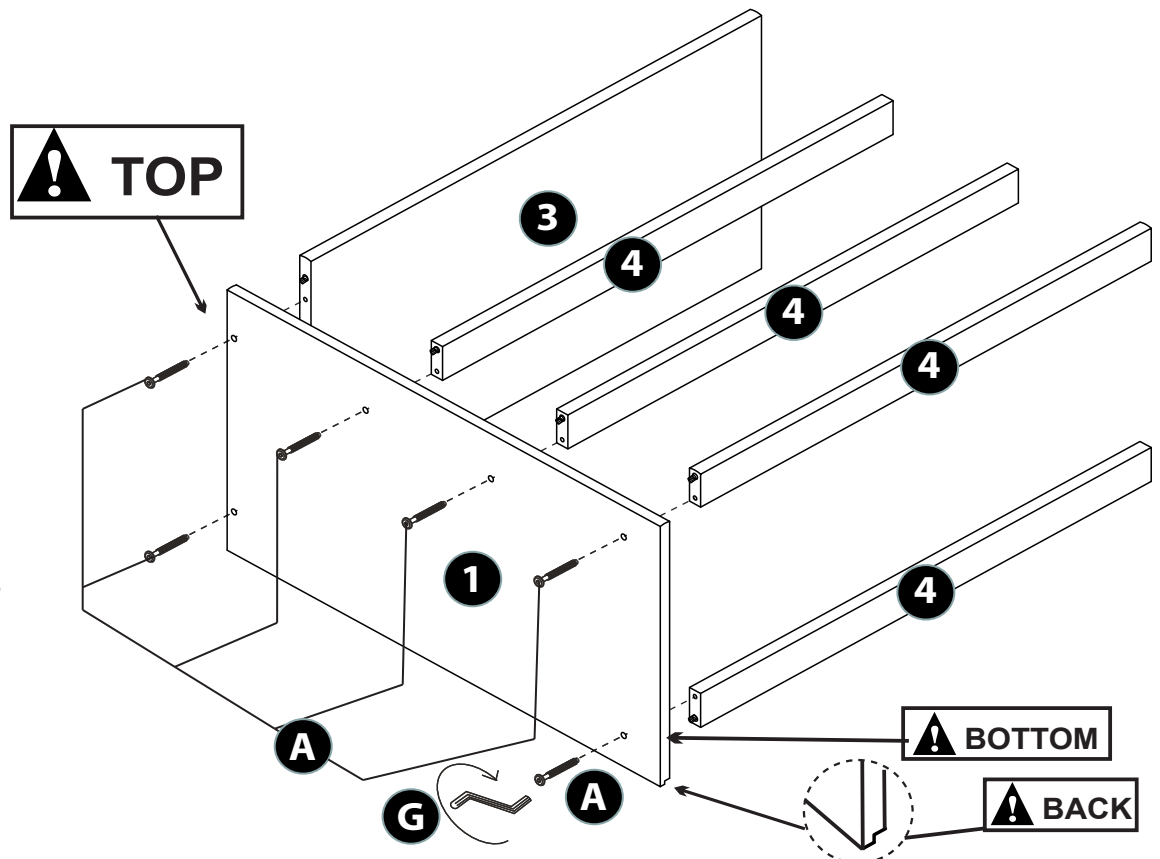

Select 3, 4 x4, 6 x3, 7 x3, B x26. Insert Bx3 into large holes on end of 3. Repeat other end of 3. Insert B into large holes at ends of 4, and repeat x3 other 4s. Insert 2 Bs at one end of 6. Repeat x2 for 6. Insert 2 Bs at one end of 7. Repeat x2 for 7.

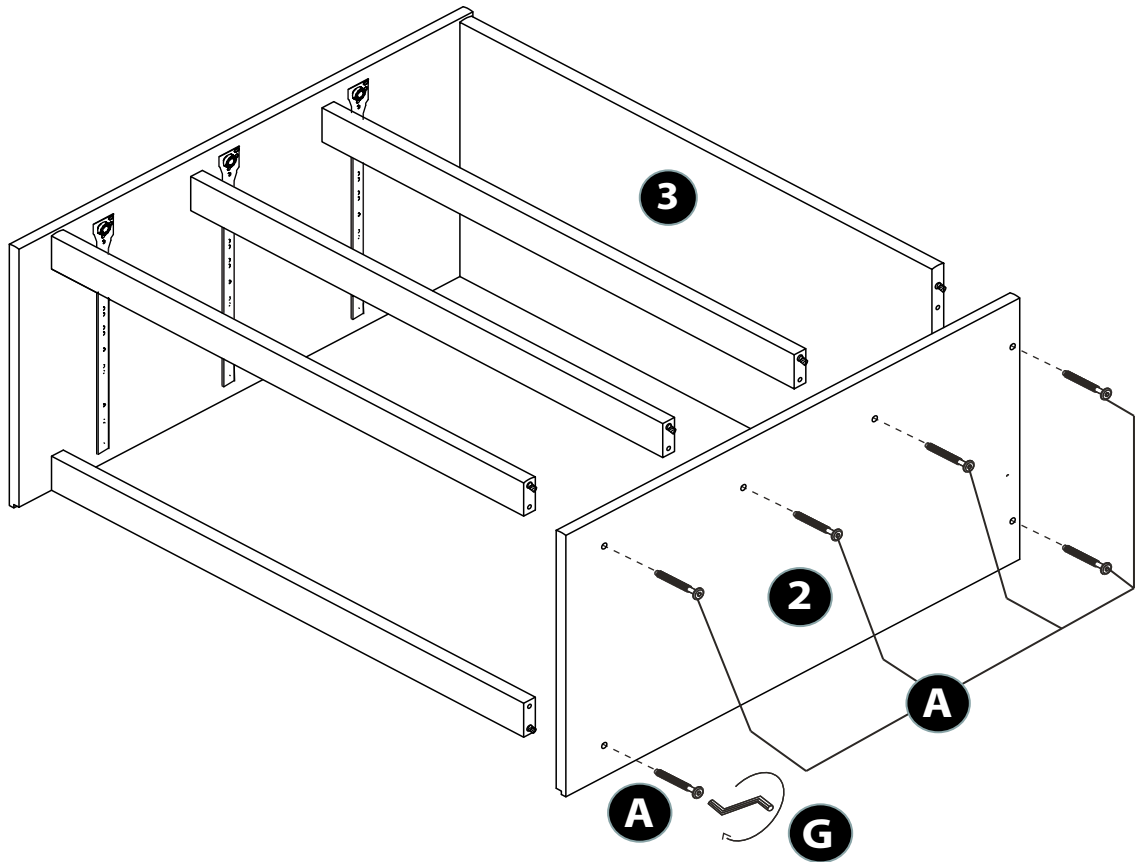
Select 1, 3, 4 x4, A x6. Position 1 left. **Note, the top of 1 the holes are close to the end and the bottom holes are further away from the end.** Position 3 at the top and align Bs into 1. Insert A into top hole on 1 and into 3. Finger tighten, repeat A for other top hole into 3. Align 4 B to 1, and insert A through 1. Repeat other 4s x3. Tighten all A screws x6.

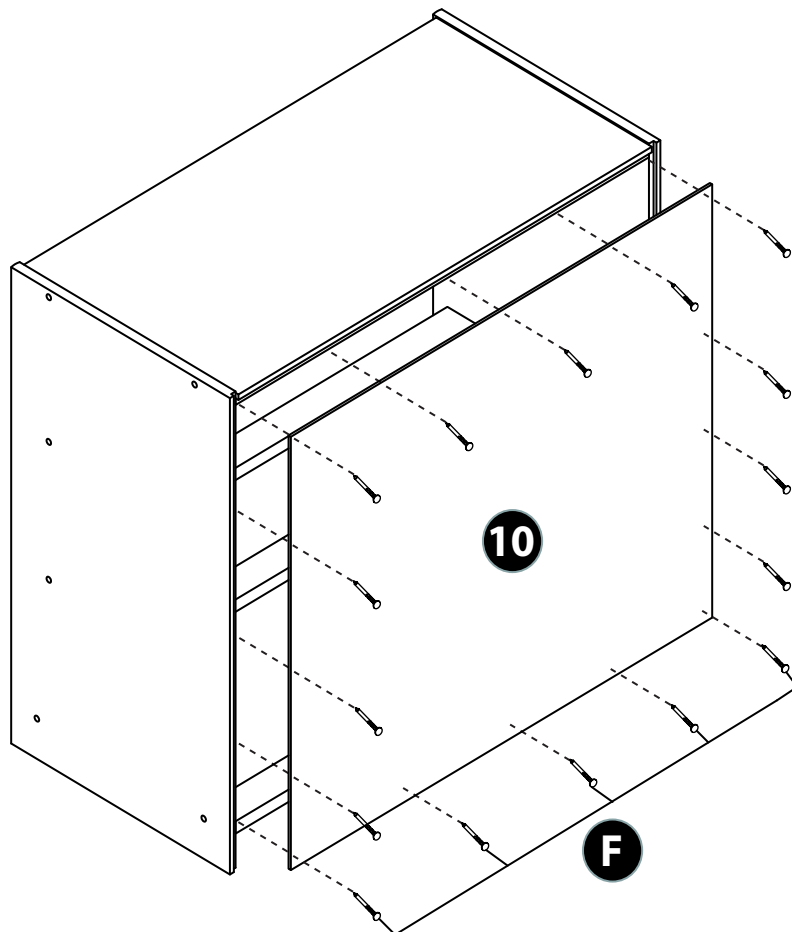

Select 2, A x6. Align Bs in 3 with holes in top of 2. Insert A into top hole in 2 and into 3. Repeat A into other top hole in 2 and into 3. Align Bs in 4s to holes in 2. Insert A through 2 into 4 and finger tighten. Repeat insert As through 2 x3 for other 4s. Tighten all A screws with G.

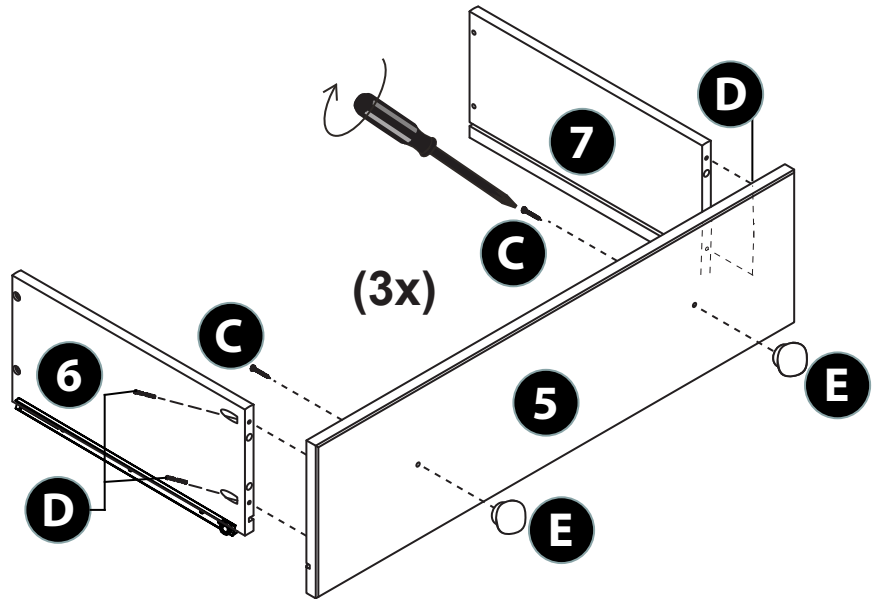
Select 10, F x16. In the back of the assembly note the groove in 1 and 2. Insert 10 into the grooves of 1 and 2. Use a hammer and carefully nail through 10 straight into the back of 1, 2, 3, and 4 at the bottom. Repeat for all 16 nails.

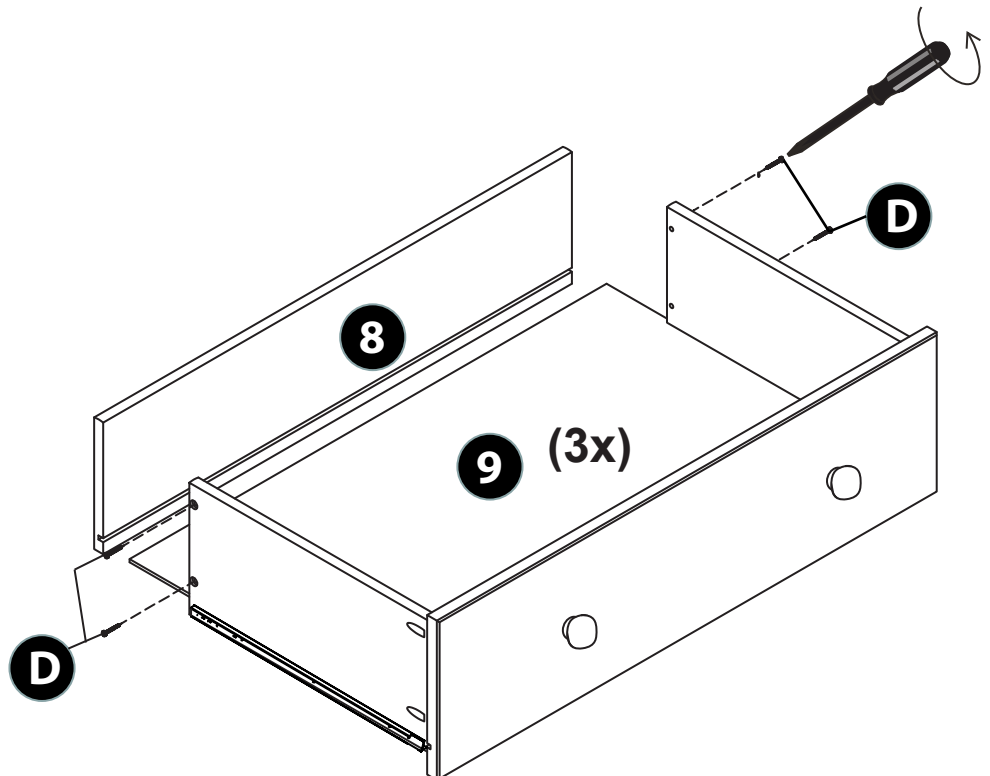

Select 5, 6, 7, E x2, C x2, D x4. Place 5 with inner groove down and toward center. Facing 5, place 6 on the left with glider facing outward and down. Insert D into top hole of 6 and using a screwdriver affix to top hole in 5. Repeat D in bottom hole of 6. Position 7 on the right with the glide out and down. Insert D through 7 and screw to 5. Insert C through center hole in 5 and affix E knob to 5. Repeat C to E for other knob in 5. Repeat step x2 for other 2 drawers.

Select 8, 9, D x4. Align 9 to groove in 6 and 7 at back. Insert 9 into groove and slide forward and then into groove in 5. Place 8 at back and insert 9 into groove in 8. Insert D in top hole of 6 and into 8. Finger tighten. Insert D in top hole of 7 and into 8 and finger tighten. Repeat D in 6 and 7 at bottom holes. Tighten all screws with screwdriver. Repeat step 6 x2 for other 2 drawers.

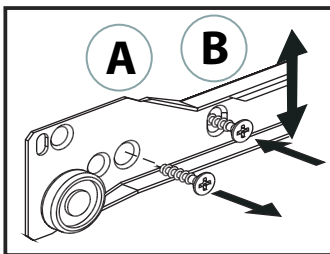
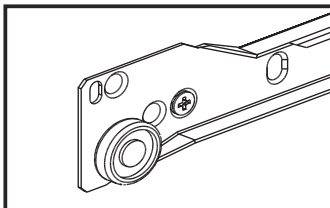
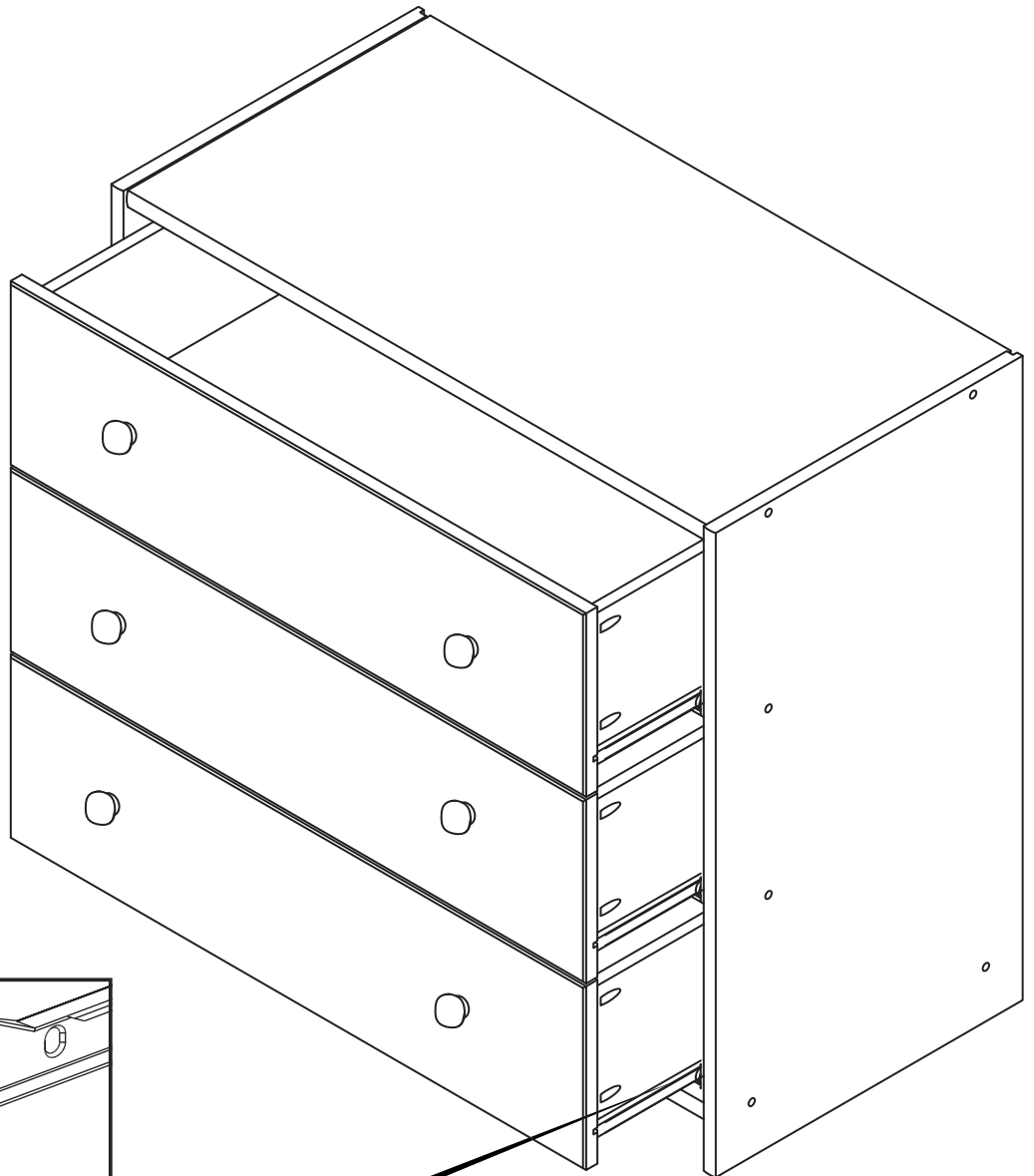

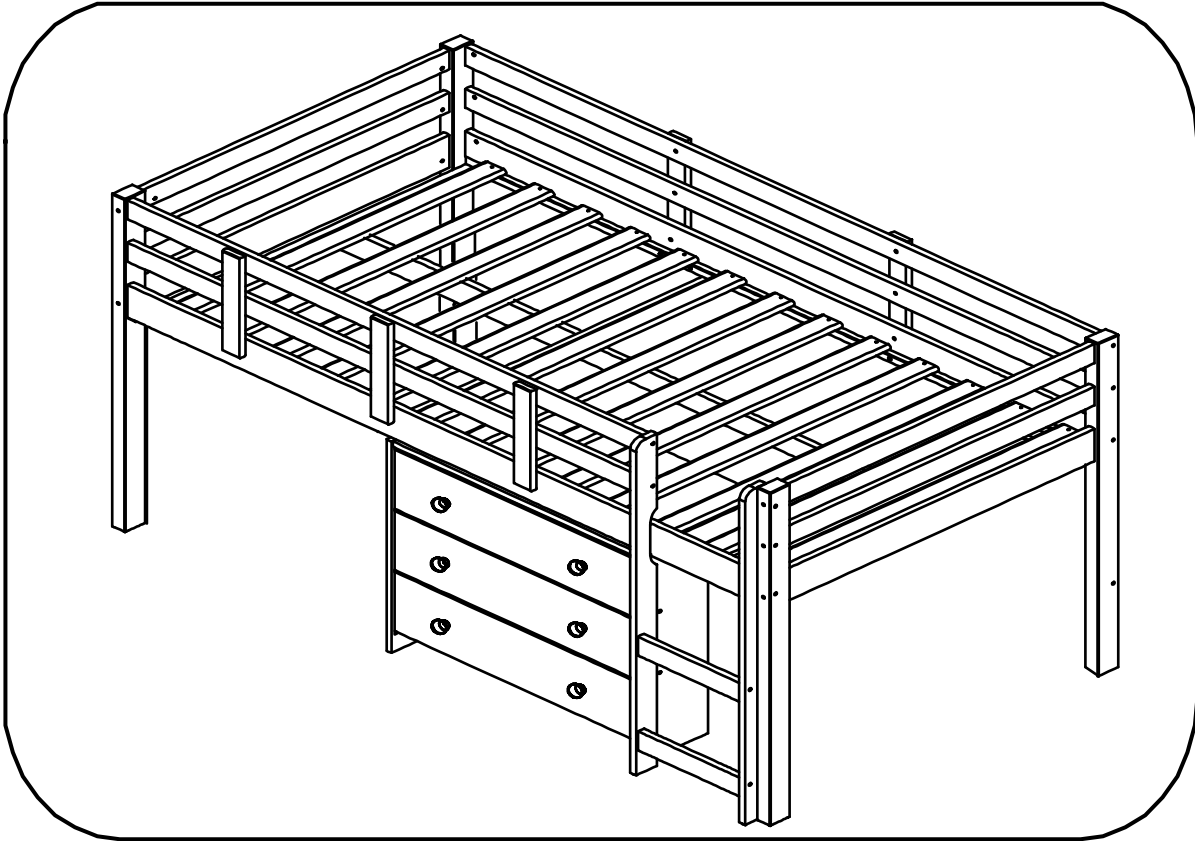
Align Drawer glides on left and right to glides in chest assembly. Insert drawer in bottom position. Repeat for other 2 drawers.

See inset for more information to adjust gliders if necessary.



Please remove screw "A" and affix on "B" if necessary to adjust the slide, moving up or down.
