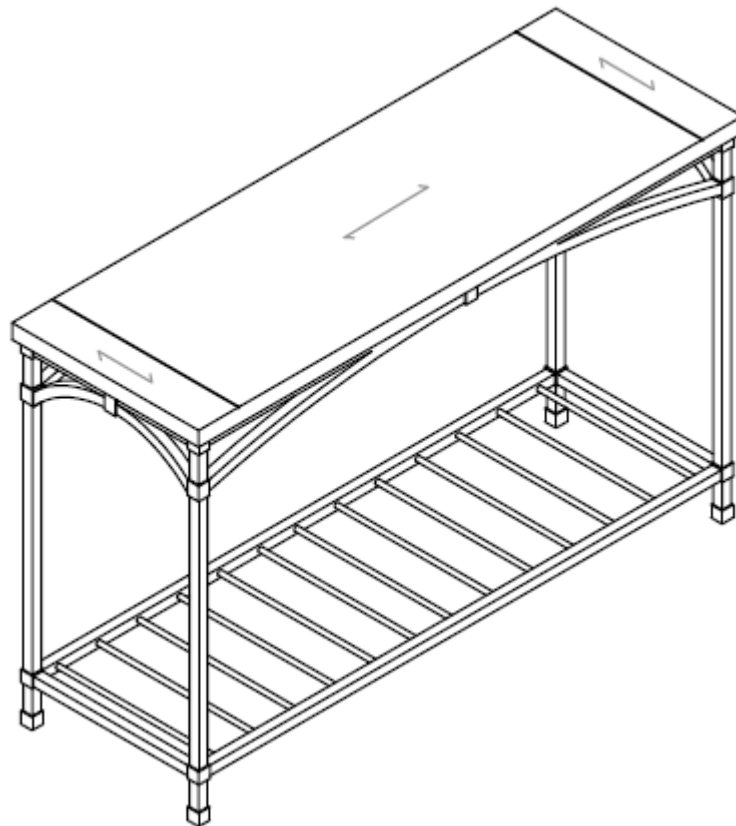




Assembly Instructions

ASSEMBLY RATING

The Assembly Rating is a 5-point system that shows the degree of effort needed in assembling a specific product (with 1 being easy and 5 being difficult). For some products, two persons are recommended.

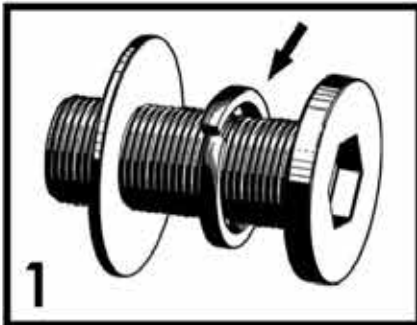

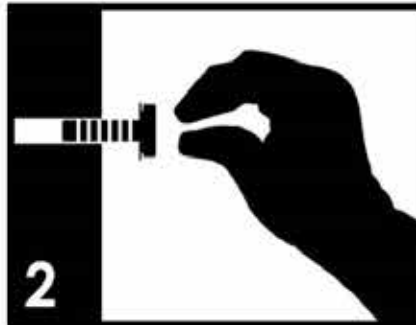

BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



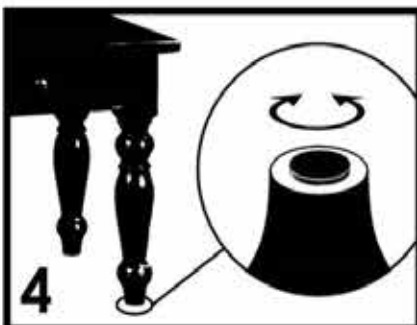
When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



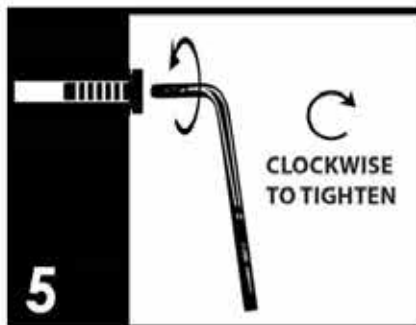
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



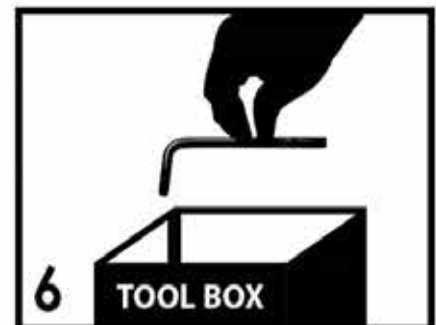
Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.



Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

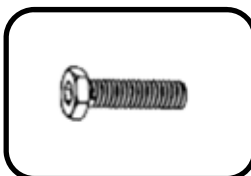

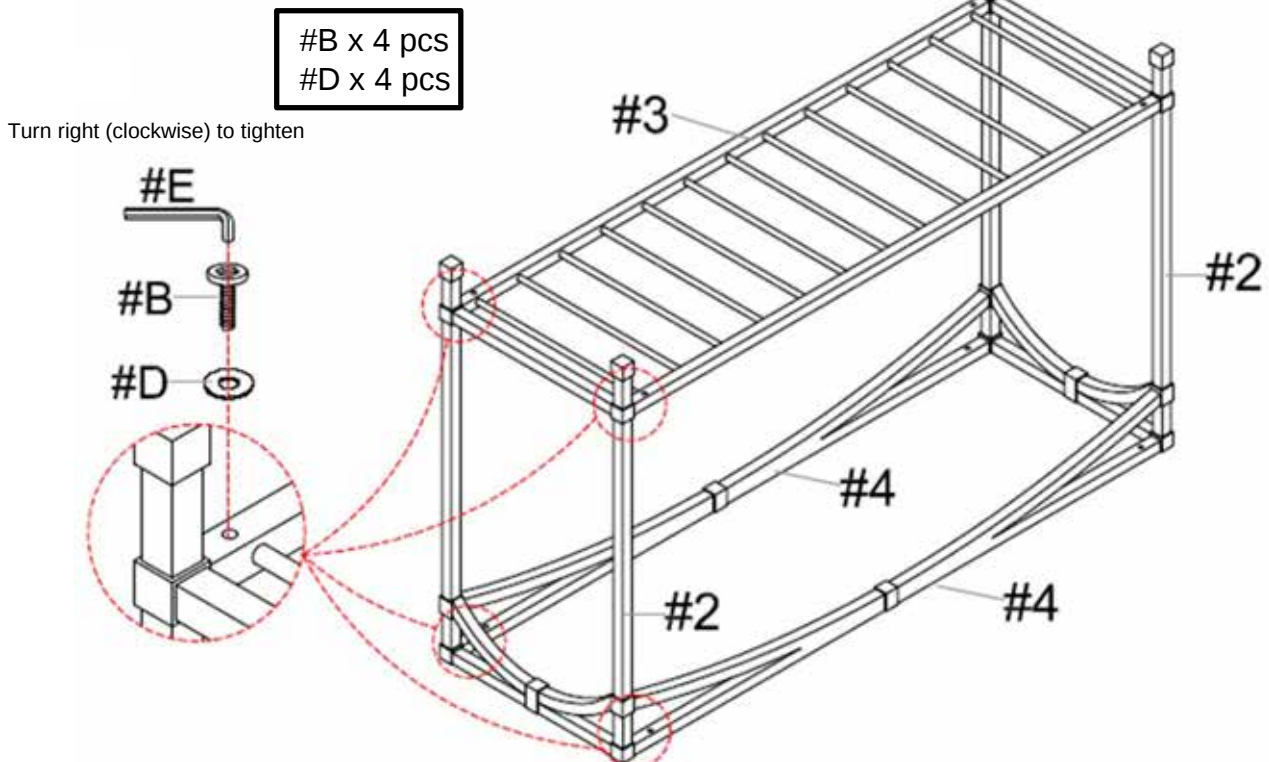
Due to the size and/or weight of this product, it is highly recommended that the assembly should be done near the area of its intended location. Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly. ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid any potential injury and/or damage.



- I. Insert the two aprons (#4) into the leg stand (#2).
- II. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by inserting the flat washer (#D) onto the bolt (#B).
- III. Insert two bolt assemblies through the two aprons (#4) using the Allen wrench (#E) to lock them with the leg stand (#2).
- IV. Insert the shelf (#3) into the same leg stand (#2).
- V. Insert the remaining two bolt assemblies through the shelf (#3) using the Allen wrench (#E) to lock them with the leg stand (#2).



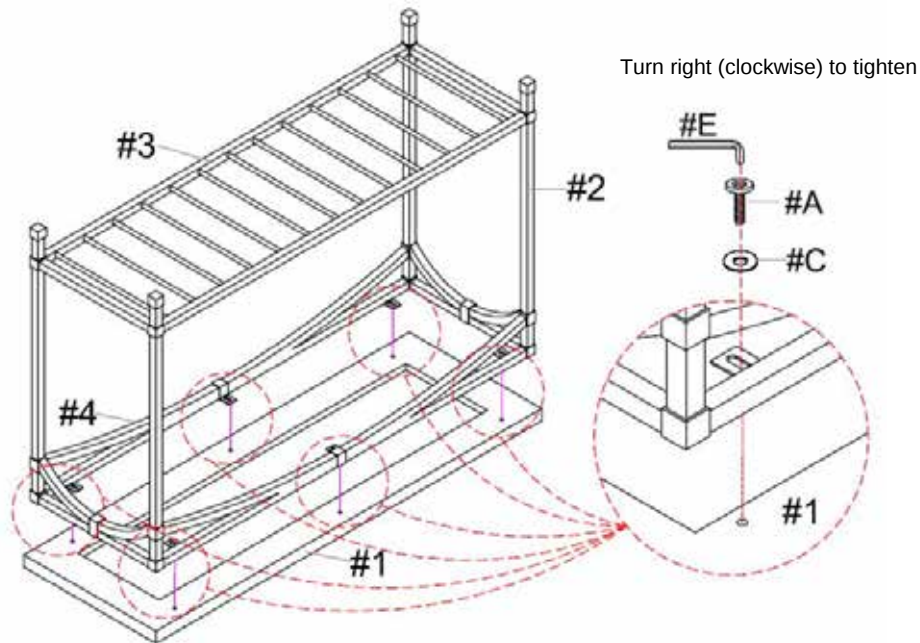
Repeat the process above to assemble the other leg stand (#2) onto the other ends of the shelf (#3) and the two aprons (#4).



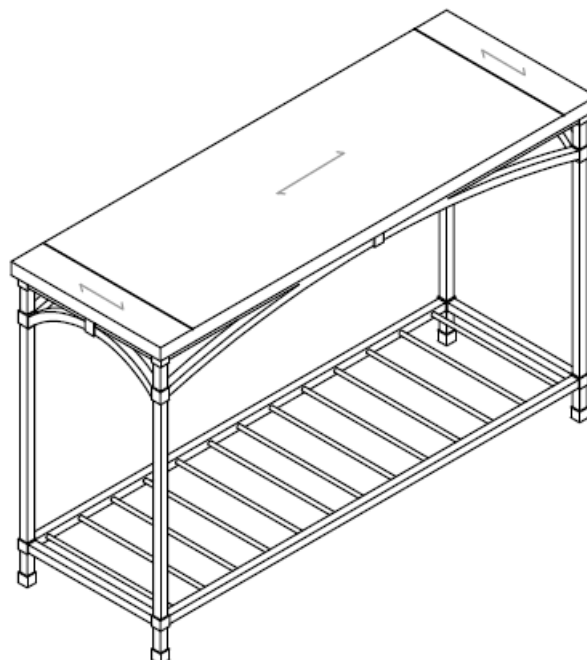


- I. Carefully place the table top (#1) facing down on a protected surface.
- II. Align the assembled aprons (#4) with the pre-drilled holes of the table top (#1).
- III. Prepare 6 bolt assemblies by inserting the flat washer (#C) onto the bolt (#A).
- IV. Insert the bolt assemblies through the two aprons (#4) using the Allen wrench (#E) to lock them with the table top (#1).

#C x 6 pcs



Carefully turn the completed table upright. Make sure the table is rested on a flat surface and does not feel loose or wobbly. If it does, double check that the bolts/screws are secured and properly tightened.
