



### CAUTION



### **STEP 1**

Place the **canopy** over the **mounting unit** and secure the **fixture** with the **cap nuts**.




# STEP 2


Make the electrical connection from the junction box to the **fixture**. Connect the ground wire to the **mounting unit** using the preinstalled green ground screw. Then, connect the positive, negative and ground wires with the supplied **wire nuts**. Secure with electrical tape

Connect Clear, Brown, Gold or Black Parallel Wire without tracer (round & smooth) or Black Fixture Wire to:

Black or Red Supply Wire or Insulated Wire (other than green) with copper conductor. Connect Clear, Brown, Gold or Black \*Parallel Wire with tracer (square & ridged) or White Fixture Wire to:

White Supply Wire or Insulated Wire (other than green) with silver conductor





# STEP 3

Place the **fixture** over the **mounting unit** and secure with the **lock nut**.



STEP 4

Install a bulb (not included).
