

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Fixture wire markings:

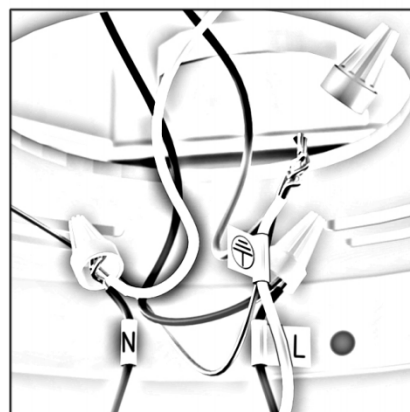
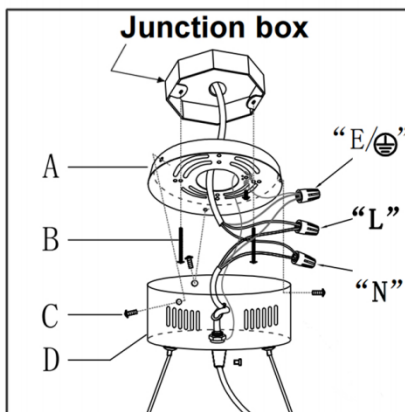
“L” Live wire (Black or Brown)
“N” Neutral wire (White or Blue)
“⊥” Ground wire (Green or Bare)

AC power equivalent:

“L” Live wire (Black)
“N” Neutral wire (White)
“⊥” Ground wire (Green or Bare)

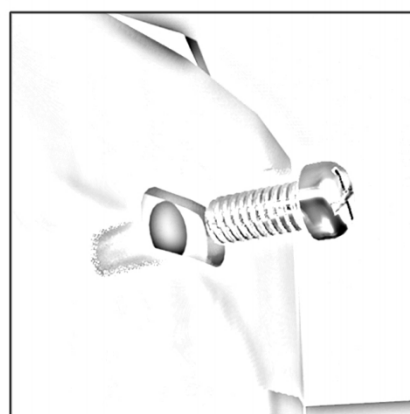
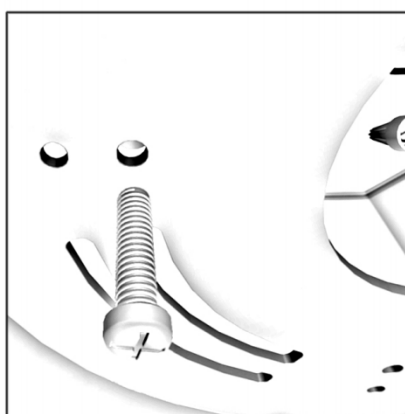
Installation instructions:

1) Connect wires according to the connection table on the other side of this page.



2) Use the provided screws (B) to secure the mounting bracket (A) to the junction box.

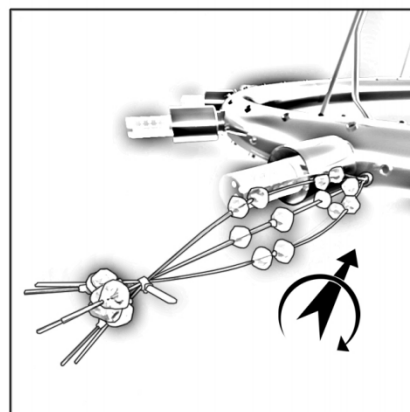
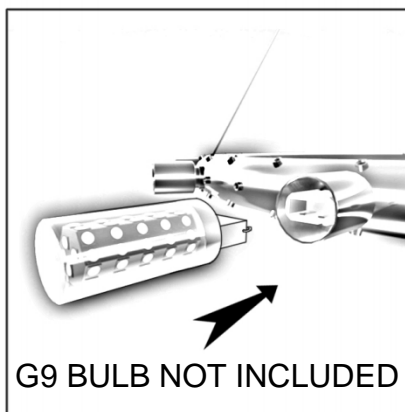
Then secure the canopy (D) to the mounting bracket (A) using the second set of screws (C).



3) Install the bulbs and crystal clusters to the fixture. (**G9 Bulbs not included**)

Question: What kind of bulbs should I use?

Answer: You can use **12pcs G9** bulbs, and choose either standard or dimmable versions depending on your needs. For dimming functionality, please select dimmable G9 bulbs. Most customers prefer **4W 3000K warm white** bulbs.



4) Use scissors to cut the zip ties keeping the clusters shut.

Optional: Adjust the wire and cord to set the fixture at the desired height.
