Read First Before Assembling Table Base

Before Assembly

Read First:

Thoroughly review the assembly manual for an overview of the process and parts list.

Prepare the Area:

Choose a clean, well-lit space with enough room. Protect parts from damage by using a soft surface.

Inspect Components:

Make sure you have all necessary pieces. Contact customer service for any missing or damaged parts before starting.

Assembly Process

Highlight:

You must place the base on a flat surface before tightening the screws. This ensures stability and alignment during and after assembly.

Use Correct Tools:

Have the specified tools ready. Proper tools ensure efficient assembly.

Alignment First:

Initially, fit screws and bolts loosely to correctly align all parts, then securely tighten them to avoid misalignment and damage.

Force Avoidance:

Recheck the instructions if parts don't fit easily; forcing can cause damage.

Safety Gear:

Utilize protective gear if needed, especially when handling heavy parts or tools.

After Assembly

Stability Check:

Verify the table base is stable and level. Make necessary adjustments.

Regular Maintenance:

Inspect for loose components and signs of wear. Tighten or replace as needed.

Usage Guidelines:

Follow the recommended weight limits and intended use to prevent damage.

Care and Cleaning:

Adhere to the manufacturer's maintenance and cleaning recommendations.
