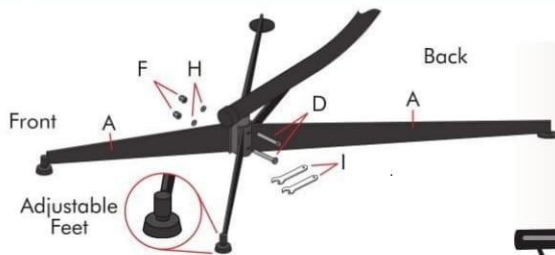

Assembly Guide

PARTS LIST

- A - Two (2) Base items
- B - One (1) Center Piece Item
- C - One (1) Top Piece Item
- D - Two (2) Long Bolts
- E - Two (2) Short Bolts
- F - Four (4) Nuts
- G - Two (2) Flat Washers
- H - Four (4) Split Washers
- I - Two (2) Wrench Tools

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Secure base items (A) together by inserting one bolt and nut provided through the bottom hole and place on the ground making sure it is stable and flat to the surface. (See diagram above)
Note: do not tighten bottom bolt securely at this time.
2. Place the center piece (B) into the base making sure that the notched base piece fits around the bottom bolt. The longer ends of the base will face towards the back of the stand. Secure the 2 sections tightly with the two bolts provided.
3. Connect the top piece (C) to the top of the center piece (B) with the bolts included. (See diagram below)
4. Ensure the stand is stable and go find your Hammock Chair to hang and enjoy!

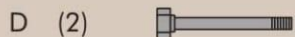
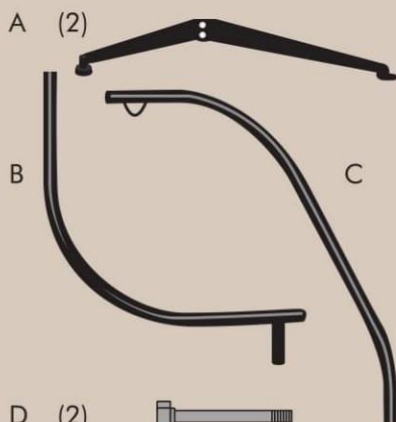

CAUTION! DO NOT JUMP OR BOUNCE IN THE STAND; DOING SO MAY CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH!

The Stand's maximum weight capacity is 300 lbs. Do not exceed maximum weight capacity. Inspect hooks, and hardware before each use for rust or loosening that makes this product unsafe to use. If the functionality of the hardware has been compromised in any way do not use this product as doing so may cause serious injury or death. It may be necessary to tighten the hardware each time before using the product due to hot or cold weather conditions. Inspect the overall condition of this product before each use. Children should not use the Stand without adult supervision.

WARRANTY AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS.

For maximum life of this product we recommends putting the item indoors when you are located in extreme weather conditions. Check all connections to make sure they are secure each time before and periodically while using the product. Check that the hardware has not rusted. We recommend using a rust inhibitor available at your local hardware store to prolong the life of the hardware when leaving it outdoors.

Clean with mild soap and warm water, scrubbing when necessary.
