Overhead Storage Rack
Installation Instructions**

Included:

4 – 53" length bars (2 pieces per length bar for adjustable sizing)

2 – 48" width bars

12 – 20" leg pieces (2 pieces per leg = 6 legs total)

6 – 12" ceiling bars

4 – 48" middle crossbars

Step 1: Use a stud detector to find the studs, or wooden beams behind your ceiling. These are the strongest points of the ceiling and will be able to best hold up your rack. Drill into where



you marked the studs.

Step 2: Attach the ceiling bars and measure how long you want the rack legs to be (how low you want your rack to hang). You can slide these bars and insert two of the included screws to secure your desired length. Use a drill to tighten and secure.

Step 3: Attach the 6 legs to the ceiling bars with diagonally placed screws. Two are on either end and one is in the middle of the rack.



Step 4: Adjust and secure the length of your rack with 2 screws. Two length pieces can combine and slide to your desired length.



Step 5: Slide in the singular width bars between the length bars with the shorter edge facing inward. Remember to tighten **all** screws with



the drill to ensure structural stability.

Step 6: Add in the 4 middle crossbars with equal distance between them, and they should be



positioned parallel to the width bars.

Step 7: Finally, slide the wooden boards over your rack to complete assembly. Enjoy your product and thank you for your business!
