



ASSEMBLING WATER SPRAYERS:

- 1. Attach the Hose Assembly to the Water Slide. Connect the Tubing to the hook and loop closures down the side of the inflatable.
- 2. Mount the Sprayers to the Top of the slide, the Arch above the Straight Slide and the Cannon. Matching the numbers on the tube and on the product for installing the Sprayers in right positions.
- 3. Attach the garden house to the end of the Tubing Assembly.
- 4. Turn on the garden hose and adjust the pressure as desired. Make sure that a steady spray of water comes out of the sprayer and keep the slides wet.

PLAYING IN THE WATER SLIDE:

- Children can drown in a very small amount of water. Empty the pool when not in use.
- To avoid the risk of injury, ALWAYS slide down the slide with feet first. NEVER slide down on your stomach or head first.
- Only one child should be on the slide at one time.
- NEVER slide down the slide until the splashdown area is clear.
- NEVER slide or jump down the climbing wall.
- WEIGHT LIMIT: Platform and slide overall maximum total weight: 160lbs/72kg Individual user maximum weight 80lbs/36kg. Maximum 2 children on sildes, platform or climbing wall at a time

NOTE: It is normal to see air bubbles rising from the pool floor and other wet areas of the Water Slide.

TO DEFLATE:

- 1. All children must leave the Water Slide before switching off the Blower.
- 2. Turn off the Blower and unplug it from the outlet.
- 3. Disconnect the long intake tube from the Blower and open the short release tube. Move the Blower to dry ground if it appears that it will get wet
- 4. Turn off the garden hose and disconnect it from the clear plastic tubing.
- 5. As the Water Slide deflates, water will find the lowest point and drain from the collapsing pool walls. Lift the bottom of pool from one side to the another to let the remaining water drain
- 6. Remove stakes and drag the Water Slide away from the drained water to a dry area.
- 7. Re-stake the Water Slide and Blower, tie the long intake tube and the short release tube to the Blower again, then reconnect and power up the
- 8. Leave the Water Slide inflated until all remaining water has evaporated and the Water Slide is dry. This may take 2 hours or more depending on weather conditions
- 9. Once Water Slide is completely dry, turn off the Blower and unplug it from the outlet.
- 10. Remove and drain the Hose Assembly from the Water Slide. Untie the drawstring from the short release tube and allow the Water Slide to fully deflate. Remove the Hose Assembly and wrap it up with no kinks.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Inflatable Water Slide MUST be drained of all water and be completely dry before storage in order to avoid mold and mildew.
- DO NOT fold and store Water Slide if any moisture remains.

ELECTRIC BLOWER OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The Continuous Air Inflatable shall only be inflated with the provided electrical blower or with manufacturer specified replacement blower.Do not use extension cord and keep the blower and power cord away from water.
- 2. Place the blower of soft, level ground and then fixed in place by inserting the provided ground stakes through the fixing holes and firmly into the ground.
- 3. Blower should be installed in a well-ventilated location and on level surface.
- 4. Blower must be fixed reliably when being used outdoors.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Place the blower on the ground and then secure it by inserting the ground stakes into the holes in the base.
- 2. The blower should be installed in a well-ventilated location and on a level surface.
- 3. The air input of the Sidewinder Falls[™] (the long yellow intake tube) is to be attached to the air output of the blower and secured in place with a cord.

USING THE BLOWER

- 1. Plug the Blower into a power supply.
- 2. To avoid electric shock, never plug in or unplug the appliance when hands are wet.
- 3. The power supply should be disconnected if the Blower or Continuous Air Inflatable Product needs to be transported or moved.
- 4. There is an ON/OFF switch on the body of the Blower. Press "I" to switch the Blower on and press "O" to switch Blower off.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL GROUNDED, CORD-CONNECTED PRODUCTS:





INFLATING & STAKING THE WATER SLIDE:

- 1. Remove Continuous Air Inflatable Device from storage bag or package. Place the product on a soft level ground surface at least 2 m (6 ft) away from any structure or obstruction such as fence, garage, house, overhanging braches, laundry lines, or electrical wires.
- 2. Check the ground where the product is to be inflated for any sharp objects or unusual by products. Do not install Continuous Air Inflatable Devices over concrete, asphalt, packed earth, carpet or any other hard surface. A fall onto hard surface can result in serious injury to the user. Do not set up the product on a slope or incline.
- 3. Unfold and place the Continuous Air Inflatable Device on level ground, not less than 1.8 m (6 ft) in any direction from any structure or obstruction such as a fence, garage, house, overhanging branches, laundry lines, or electrical wires. Do not install Continuous Air Inflatable Devices over concrete, asphalt, packed earth, carpet or any other hard surface. A fall onto hard surface can result in serious injury to the user.
- 4. The Continuous Air Inflatable shall only be inflated with the provided electrical blower or with manufacturer specified replacement blower. Do not use extension cord and keep the blower and power cord away from water. Place blower on level ground and insert the ground stakes through the holes at the base of the blower firmly into the lawn.
- 5. Fully stretch out the air fill tube and position the blower at the end of the tube. Slide the end of the tube around the mouth of the blower and secure air tube to blower with the string that is provided. The air tube should be straight and untwisted.
- 6. Plug blower into an approved grounded outlet. Ensure that the blower is free from debris and securely sited to avoid tripping.
- 7. To inflate Continuous Air Inflatable, turn the switch on the blower to ON. The continuous air blower must be left on at all times while the Continuous Air Inflatable item is in use.
- 8. Bouncerinflates in less than 2 minutes.
- 9. The ground stakes provided are used for lawn surfaces. Hook the ground stakes over and into the safety loops and secure firmly into ground, below ground level, to prevent overturn or lift during play. The stakes should be placed level with or under the ground to reduce tripping hazard. Diagram A show how the ground stakes are to be attached to the loop of the bouncer and the locations of the loops for the ground stakes.
- 10. Ensure that the Continuous Air Inflatable item is fully inflated and securely anchored before allowing child to enter to play. Failure to do so will result in the product being unstable and can cause serious injuries.
