- Check all bolts and screws every 90 days. Tighten as necessary if any are lose.


Please read through this instruction booklet before beginning assembly of this item.

Two adults are recommended for assembly.


- Clear space for assembly and lay out all parts on Parts List. Extra room will allow you to easily determine if all the pieces are present.
- Save all packing materials until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding smaller parts or hardware.
- Keep small parts and pieces away from children and pets until fully assembled.
- Please check for any loose screws and tighten them before use.

WARNING: DO NOT LET CHILDREN PLAY IN OR AROUND THE UNIT DURING ASSEMBLY DUE TO THE POSSIBLE RISK OF INJURY.




Step 1-- 1. Ensure all parts have been removed from the carton and place on a protected surface or carpet.

2. Check all parts and hardware are the same as the "Parts List".


3. Attach Headboard Leg (2) to Headboard (1), secure using bolt (H) then tighten with Allen Key (E).




Step 2-- Attach side rails (4) to Headboard (1) and Footboard (3). Place Plastic Washer (C) between rail and Headboard (1)/ Footboard (3). Put together with Metal Washer (D) and Bolt (A) then tighten with Allen key (E) as shown below.




Step 3-- Attach Cross Bar (5) onto Side Rails (4) as shown below. Using Bolt (A) and Metal Washer (D), tighten with Allen Key (E).



Step 4-- Attach Center Rail (6) to Cross Bar (5) and using Bolt (A), Metal Washer (D) and tighten with Allen key (E).




Step 5-- Attach support leg (7) x2 to central rail (6), secure using bolt (B), Metal washer (D) then tighten with Allen Key (E)




Step 6-- 1. Attach Plastic Cap (G) on Center Rail (6).


2. Lay all the slats (8) across the base of the bed, making sure they are the right way up (convex face upside with ribbon on the underside). With the assembly hole on the outside position; insert the end of slat into Plastic Cap (G).

3. Insert the Plastic Pins (F) into the holes at the end of the Slats (8) to secure to the Side Rails (4).





Periodically (every 90 days) make sure that the screws are still fully tightened. ATTENTION: Be certain that all screws are fully tightened before using bed.



Product Dimension

Limited Warranty

The product you have purchased is warrantied against defects in material and workmanship while owned by the "Original Purchaser". The term "Original Purchaser" is defined as that party or entity which purchases these products from an authorized dealer or retailer as shown by the original sales receipt. This warranty does not apply to "as is" or previously owned products.

The manufacturer warrants its products to be free from defects in materials and workmanship (normal wear and tear, fading and stretching excepted), for one year from the date of purchase, except as provided below under the limited warranty.

This warranty gives you specific rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state (or country to country). All warranties are limited to the Original Purchaser for normal use.

The exceptions or exclusions to this warranty are:

• Upholstery material and foam cushion material is warranted against defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year, beginning on the date of purchase as shown on the original sales receipt.

• Any warranty claim that is submitted after the limited warranty period, or without proper proof of purchase will not include the cost of parts, labor, or delivery on the warranted parts within a reasonable amount of time. We reserve the right to require damaged parts to be returned to us upon request. Natural markings such as scars, brands, grain variations, wrinkles, color variations, etc. will be considered normal characteristics and not construed as defects.
