

NOTE

Place the **Middle Pole (2)** onto the **Bottom Pole with Ground Stake (3)**.

Note: If using cement to secure ground stake, make sure that it's completely hardened.

YOU ARE NOW READY TO PLAY!

Tetherball Court Setup:

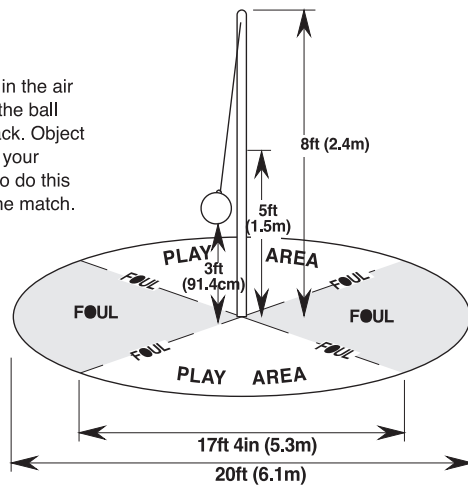
Make a circle 20ft (6.1m) in diameter. Cross the circle with two lines that meet at the pole (see diagram below). Mark a line on the pole at a level of 5ft (1.5m) above the ground. This is the foul line.

Tetherball Rules:

To start the game, one player tosses the ball in the air and hits with hand or fist. Opponent must let the ball pass once around the pole before hitting it back. Object of the game is to completely wind the rope in your direction above the foul line. The first player to do this wins the game. Best 4 games out of 7 wins the match.

Fouls:

- Players must stay in play area
- Ball can only be hit with hand or forearm.
- Ball cannot be held or caught.
- Players may not touch the pole.
- Ball cannot be hit outside play area.
- Any foul constitutes a loss of the game for the player committing the foul.

GENERAL NOTE







Find a flat open playing area at least 20ft (6.1m) square. For best results many people prefer to anchor the tetherball pole and stake to the ground with cement. We encourage you to consider the same.

Dig a hole in the center of the area approximately 12in (30.5cm) deep and 12in (30.5cm) wide.

Place the ground stake in the center of the hole assuring the ground stake is straight and vertical.

Fill the hole with cement. Make sure the ground stake stays straight and vertical. Let cement harden.

SETUP

<p>STEP 1</p> 	<p>PARTS</p> 	<p>NOTE</p> <p>Insert Eyebolt (7) into the top hole of the Top Pole (1).</p>
<p>STEP 2</p> 	<p>PARTS</p> 	<p>NOTE</p> <p>Tie one end of the Tetherball Cord (4) to the Eyebolt (7).</p>
<p>STEP 3</p> 	<p>PARTS</p> 	<p>NOTE</p> <p>Place the Top Pole (1) onto the Middle Pole (2).</p>
