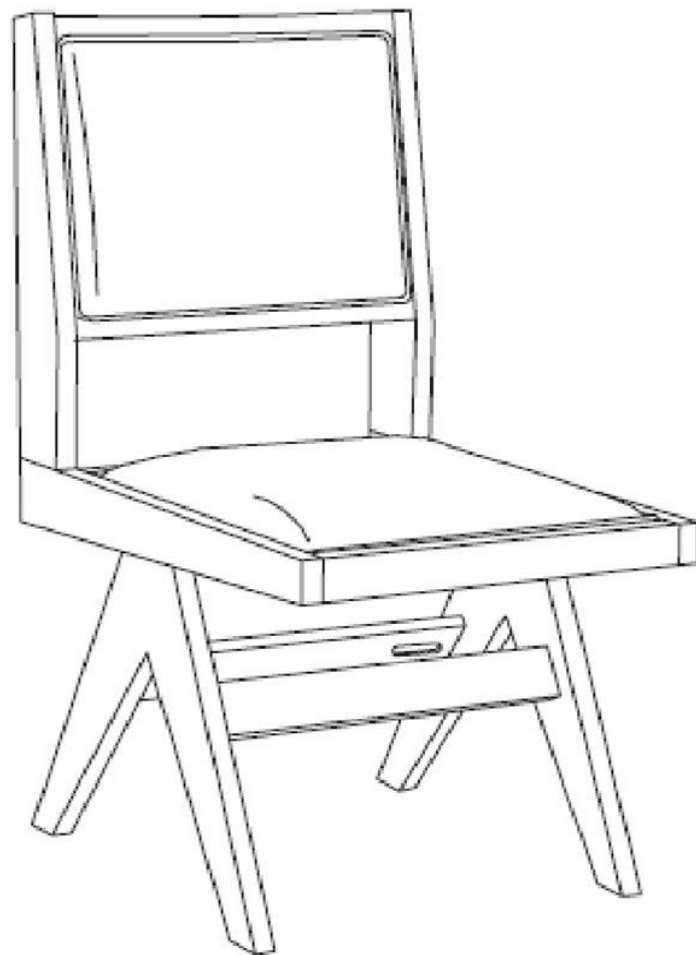

Prep Time!
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We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



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ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

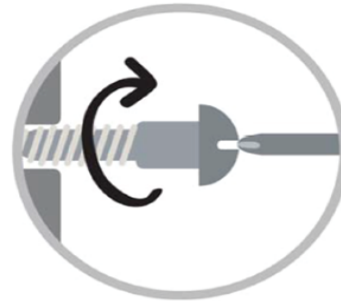
ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE



FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW MAY RESULT IN INJURY AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.



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Turn clockwise to tighten and only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



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Save the instructions and store any supplied tools for later maintenance.



After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

IT IS THE USER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO MAINTAIN THE FURNITURE. THE HARDWARE MAY LOOSEN OVER TIME AND MAY CAUSE THE FURNITURE TO BE WOBBLY AND UNABLE TO SUPPORT ITS INTENDED WEIGHT CAPACITY. THIS MAY LEAD TO COLLAPSE AND MAY CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY.

Please read instructions carefully

Remove all wrapping materials, staples and packing straps from the carton. Refer to Parts List and Hardware List and ensure they are complete before you start assembling. Place all wooden parts on a clean, flat and soft surface (e.g carpet or rug) to prevent parts from being scratched.

- CAUTIONS: 1) DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS AND NUTS UNTIL ALL PARTS HAVE BEEN ASSEMBLED.
 2) DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN BOLTS AND NUTS .
 3) KEEP ALL HARDWARE PARTS OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

STEP 1




Prepare the Seat (P4) by inserting the Wooden dowel (H6) into the desired holes. Then, place the Leg frame-Left (P1) on a clean, soft surface. Attach the Seat (P4) by locating the dowel the Seat into the desired holes in the Leg frame. Align Bolt (H1) together with Spring washer (H3) & Flat washer Big (H4). Tighten the bolts using Allen key (H8).

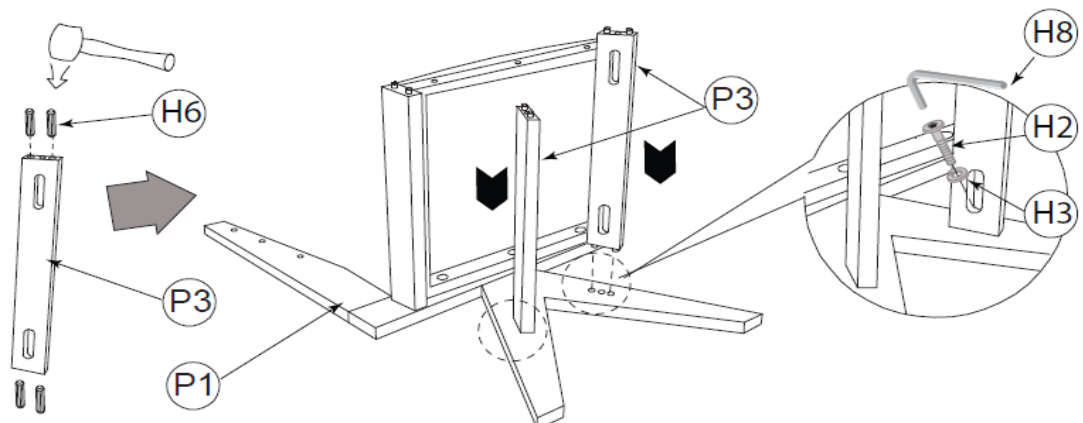

STEP 2

Prepare the Stretchers (P3) by inserting the Wooden dowel (H6) into the desired holes. Attach both Stretchers (P3) into the desired holes in the Leg frame-Left (P1). Align Bolt (H2) with Spring Washer (H3) & tighten it using Allen key (H8).

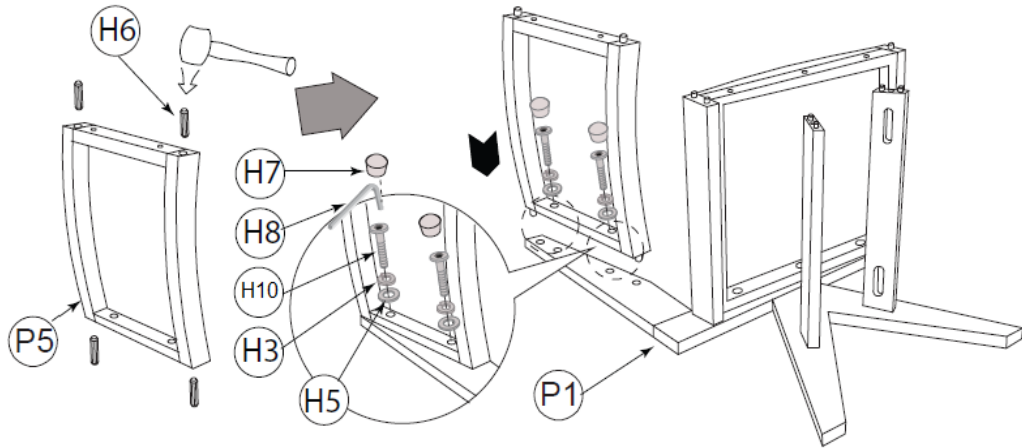

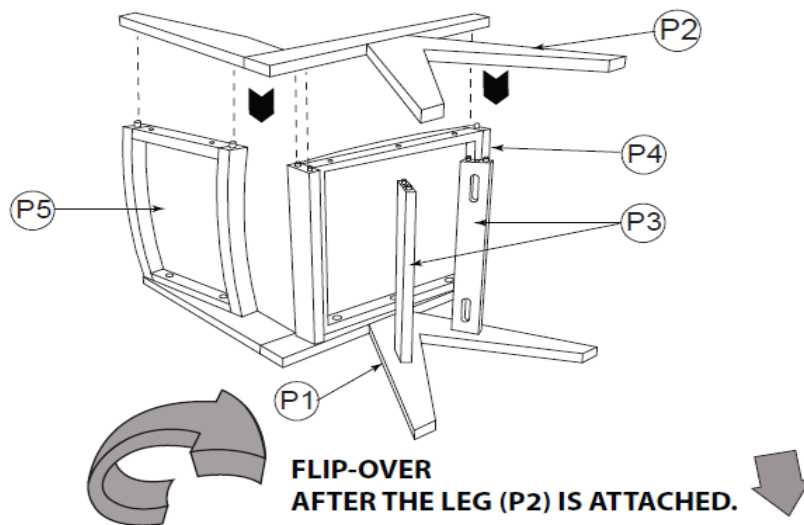

Prepare the Backrest (P5) by inserting the Wooden dowel (H6) into the desired holes. Then Attach the Backrest (P5) into the Leg frame. Align Bolt (H10) together with the Spring washer (H3) & the Flat washer Small (H5)
Tighten it using Allen key (H8). Tap the Wood button (H7) to cover the holes.






STEP 4

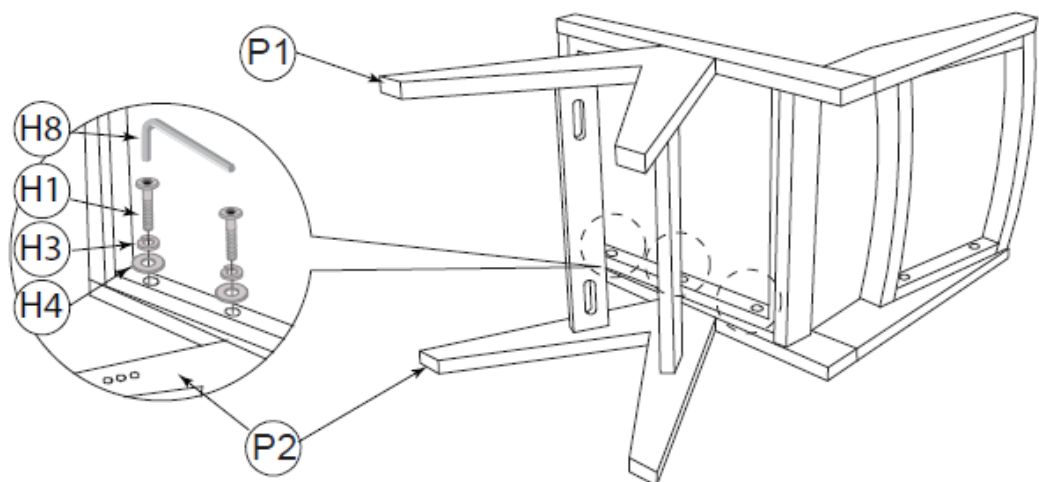
Prepare the other side of the leg: the Leg frame-Right (P2). Attach it to the parts of (Seat P4), Stretchers (P3) & Backrest (P5), by locating the wood dowel at those parts to the desired holes in the Leg (P2).
Use a rubber mallet to tap the leg frame until all the parts are snug to the leg frame.
Then, carefully flip the chair to the other side as a preparation to align the bolts into the respective holes.



Start with tting the leg to the seat by aligning Screw (H1) with Spring washer (H3) & Flat washer Big (H4).
Tighten it using Allen key (H8).

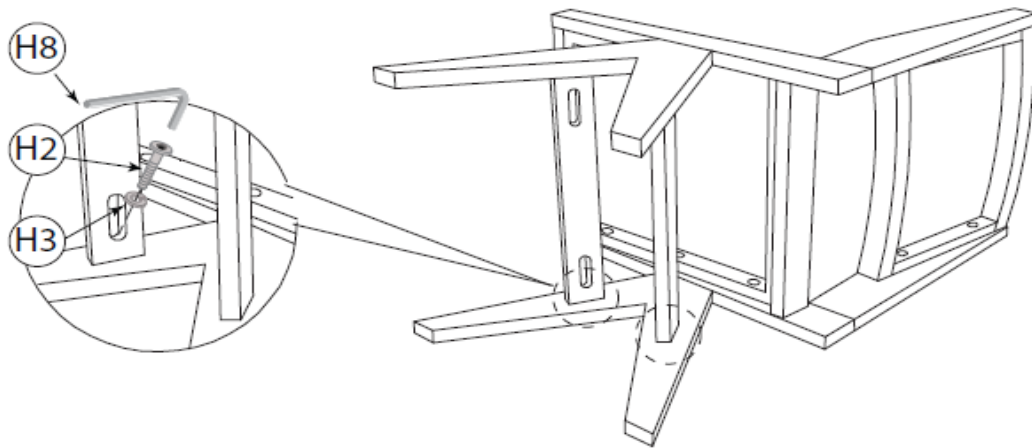


STEP 6

FITTING TO THE STRETCHERS

Align Bolt (H2) with Spring Washer (H3) & tighten it using Allen key (H8).

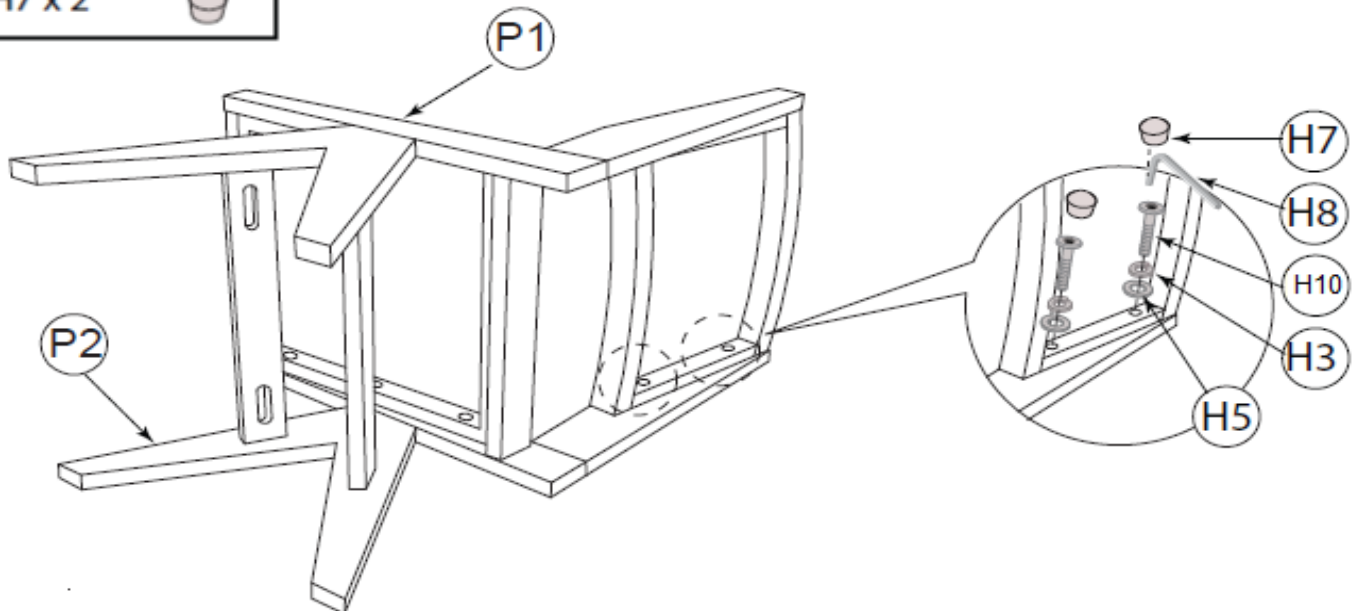


STEP 7

FITTING TO THE BACKREST

Align Bolt (H10) together with the Spring washer (H3) & the Flat washer Small (H5). Tighten it using Allen key (H8). Tap the Wood button (H7) to cover the holes

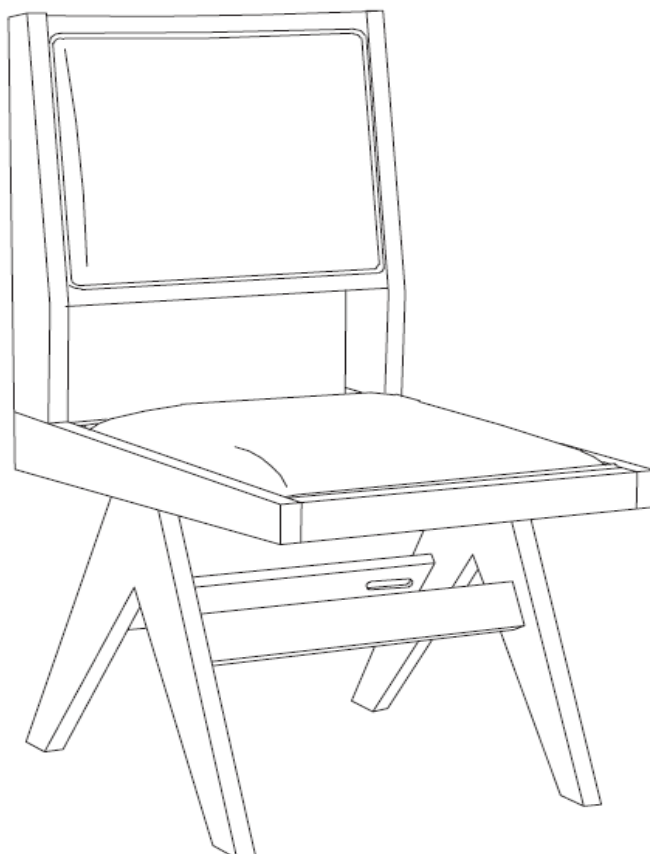
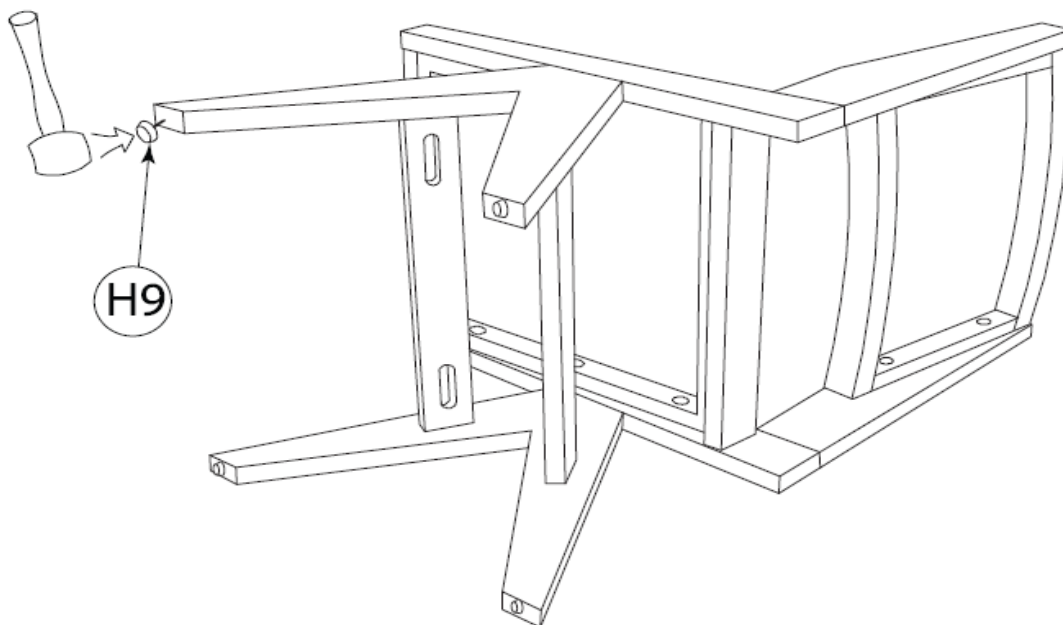


PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL THE BOLTS ARE FULLY TIGHTEN BEFORE USING THE CHAIR

Before putting the chair upright, tap the nail leg (H9) into the under edge of all the legs .

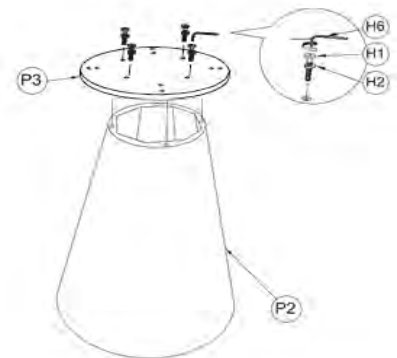


Important: Detach Mounting Panel (P3) from Table Top (P1) before assembly.

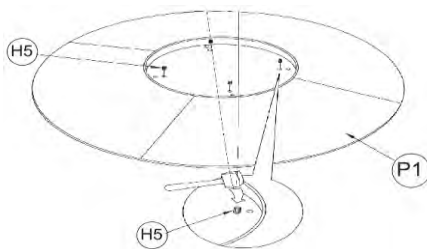
Attach mounting plate (P3) to the smaller end of the pedestal leg (P2) by using Bolt (H1) with spring washer (H2).

Install the wooden dowels (H5) to the table top (P1) as shown in the diagram.

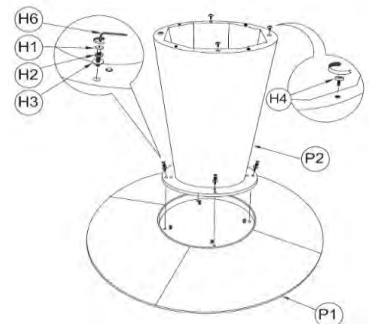

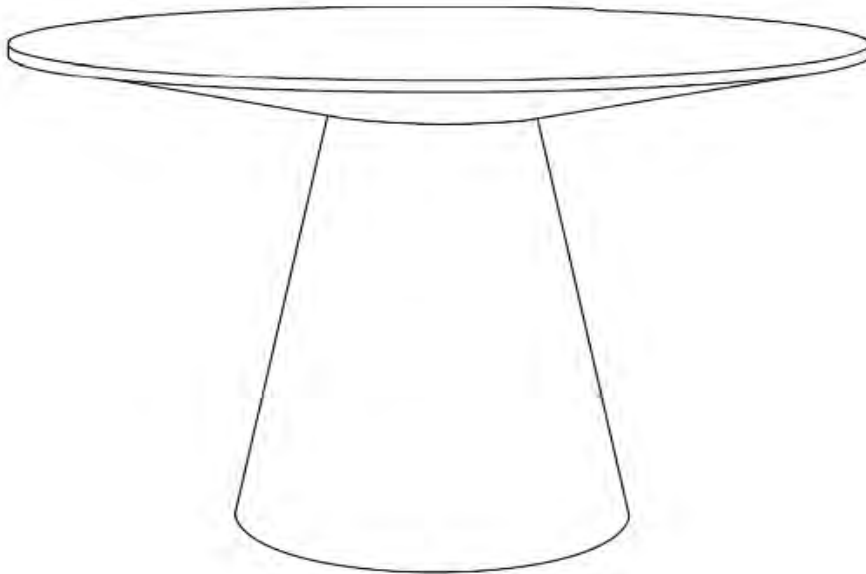
Flip the pedestal over and align to the table using the dowels as a guidance. Secure by using Bolt (H6) with spring washer (H2) and lock washer (H3). Attach the adjustable leg stud to the pedestal.



CAUTION ! REQUIRES TWO ADULTS TO TURN THE TABLE UPRIGHT AFTER FINISHED ASSEMBLY.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

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- CLEANING** - Clean with damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not use bleach or abrasive products.
- FITTINGS** - Tighten bolts and nuts from time to time to ensure all parts of product are securely fitted.
