Crib Warning



CAUTION: Any mattress used in this crib s hould be at least 27-1/4 by 51-5/8 in. with a thickness not exceeding 6 in.

△WARNING:

- Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, loose bolts or other fasteners, missing parts, or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. Securely tighten loose bolts and other fasteners. DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact us for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.

Storage: The crib must be kept in a dry and clean area. Solid wood tends to exchange moisture with the surrounding air and reacts to major changes in temperature and humidity. The ideal environment for the crib is at a temperature between 65 and 75 degrees and a relative humidity between 35 and 40 percent. If the room is too humid, the crib willabsorb moisture and expand; in verse, the crib will lose moisure and shrink in a dry environment. It is best to place your furniture away from heating or air-conditioning vents. Also, direct exposure to sunlight can discolor the wood, sodo not place your product where it will receive prolonged sunlight exposure.

Care and Cleaning: Do not scratch or chip the finish. Do not use abrasive chemicals for cleaning. Clean with mild soap on a soft rag. Rinse and dry thoroughly. If you choose to refinish this furniture, be sure to use only a non-toxic finish specified for childrens products.



To avoid dangerous gaps, any mattress used in the bed shall be a full-size crib mattress at least 51-5/8 in. (1310 mm) in length, 27-1/4 in. (690 mm) in width., and a max thickness of 5 in. (130 mm).

- The maximum weight shall not be greater than 50 lbs (22.7kg).
- Do not use with less than 12 inches of space between toddler bed and solid objects such as a wall or dresser. Child could slide into smaller spaces and suffocate.
- DO NOT use a water mattress.
- DO NOT use casters on toddler bed.
- Guardrails if provided must be used to avoid the formation of a gap between the mattress and the bed that c
 ould cause an entrapment. If mattress retention clips are provided they must be used to restrict mattress
 movement.







STEP 1:

- a. Insert one Dowel (#2) into top rail of Left Side Panel(A)
- b. Attach Front Left Leg(C) to the Left Side Panel (A) by using Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner before inserting Bolts (#4) into top and bottom holes.
- c. Insert one Dowel (#2) into top rail of Right Side Panel (D)
- d. Attach Front Right Leg (F) to the Right Side Panel (D) by using Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner before inserting Bolts (#4) into top and bottom holes..





STEP 2:

- a. Insert four Dowels (#2) into the both side of Cross Bar (I)
- b. Attach Rear Left Leg (B) to the Headboard(G) and Cross Bar(I)


By using two Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner before inserting two Bolts (#1) into top and bottom holes for the Headboard (G).

By using one Bolt (#3) inserting into top holes for the Cross Bar (I).

c. Attach Rear Right Leg(E) to the Headboard(G) and Cross Bar(I)


By using two Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner before inserting two Bolts (#1) into top and bottom holes for the Headboard (G).

By using one Bolt (#3) inserting into top holes for the Cross Bar (I).



STEP 3:

- a. Insert two Dowels (#2) into the top of Rear Left Leg (B) and Rear Right Leg (E).
- b. Attach the Left Side Panel (A) to Rear Left Leg (B) by using two Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner before inserting two Bolts (#4) into top and bottom holes.
- c. Attach the Right Side Panel (D) to the Rear Right Leg (E) by using two Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner before inserting two Bolts (#4) into top and bottom holes.



STEP 4:


Attach Mattress Support (L) flat side up by swinging out the four hangers at the corners of the mattress support and use 4 Bolts (#7) to attach hangers to the brackets on the legs at an even level on all sides.






STEP 5:

- a. Insert four Dowels (#2) into Cross Bar (I) and two Dowels (#2) into bottom rail of Footboard (H).
- b. Attach the Footboard (H), Cross Bar (I) between the Front Left Leg(C) and Front Right Leg (F)

By using four Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner before inserting two Bolts (#3) into top and bottom holes.

By using two Bolts (#3) inserting into top holes for the Cross Bar (I).







- a. Loosen the bolts from the Side Panels to the Footboard (H), Cross Bar (I) bolts to detach the Footboard (H) and Cross Bar (I).
- b. Attach the Stabilizer Bar (J) to the Front Left Leg(C) and Front Right Leg (F) by inserting two Dowels(#2) and 2 Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner of the Stabilizer Bar before screwing 2 Bolts (#1) to secure the legs. Tighten firmly.







- a. Loosen the bolts from the Side Panels to the Footboard (H), Cross Bar (I) bolts to detach the Footboard (H) and Cross Bar (I).
- b. Attach the Stabilizer Bar (J) to the Front Left Leg(C) and Front Right Leg (F) by inserting two Dowels(#2) and 2 Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner of the Stabilizer Bar before screwing 2 Bolts (#1) to secure the legs. Tighten firmly.
- c. Attach Guardrail (K) to Stabilizer Bar (J) by using 2 Bolts (#1), and Left Side Panel (A) by using 2 Bolts (#6).





For cribs, the identification sticker is generally located near the bottom of the crib's side rails, the toddler guardrail, or the stabilizer bar.

For changers, the identification sticker is located on the top panel of the changing unit.

Under no circumstances should you remove any warning labels from the product. These labels are meant to be permanent and removing them may damage the wood and void your warranty.

Safety Tips for Assembling and Re-assembling Cribs

- Parents should not use any crib with missing, broken or loose hardware parts. Crib slats or spindles should be spaced no more than 2-3/8" apart, and none should be loose or missing. NEVER use a crib with corner posts over 1/16" of an inch above the end panels (unless they are over 16" high for a canopy).
- Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, and loose bolts or other fasteners, missing parts, or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. Securely tighten loose bolts and other fasteners. DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact us for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.
- Never place infants to sleep on pillows, sofa cushions, adult beds, waterbeds, beanbags, or any other surface not specifically designed for infant sleep.
- Always check all sides and corners of the crib to assure proper assembly with no openings that may entrap a child. The crib mattress should fit snugly with no more than two fingers width, one-inch, between the edge of the mattress and the crib side. Otherwise, the baby can get trapped between the mattress and the side of the crib.
- Do not try to repair any side of the crib without manufacturer-approved hardware.
- Putting a broken side up against the wall is not a solution and can often make the situation worse.
- When re-assembling the crib for your second child, please keep in mind that the screw holes will need to be filled in order for the screws to grip to the wood. Talk to your local hardware store or lumberyard about how to do it properly.

One year limited warranty

We will provide promptly, at the request of the retailer, and without charge, any missing parts that have been reported, with proper description, within 7 days of the purchase of the products.
