Prior to Installation:

Inspect the sink prior to installation to make sure the sink has not been damaged during shipping.

- Observe all plumbing and building codes according to your state requirements.
- Additional floor and wall preparation may be required to avoid damaging the sink.
- Make sure to purchase the correct cabinet for your farmhouse sink. Farmhouse base cabinets should be 3" larger than the actual size of the sink.
- Not recommended to be installed with laminate countertop.

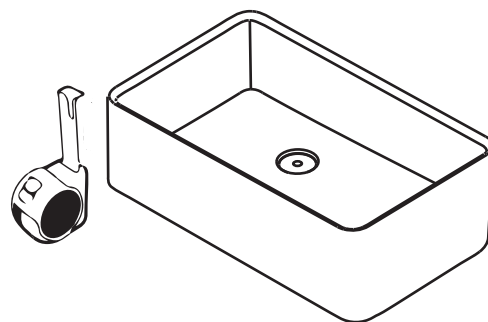
Apron-front Style

APRON-FRONT INSTALLATION

Following these steps will help you install a apron-front fireclay kitchen sink effectively. Remember to refer to the BESTGO's specific installation instructions for your sink model to ensure you handle the installation correctly. If you encounter any challenges during the installation process, consider consulting a professional plumber for assistance.

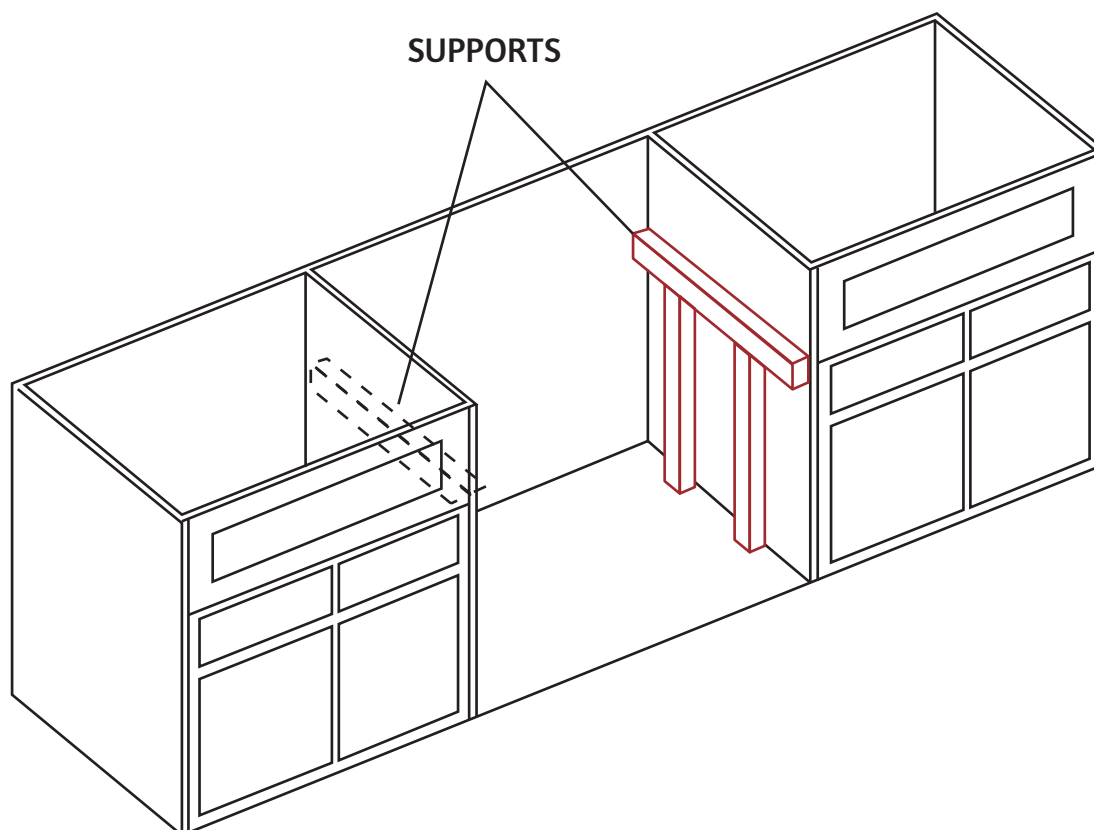
1.MEASURE AND PLAN

Measure the cabinet opening where the sink will be installed to ensure the apron-front sink fits properly. Plan for any modifications needed to accommodate the larger size of the sink.



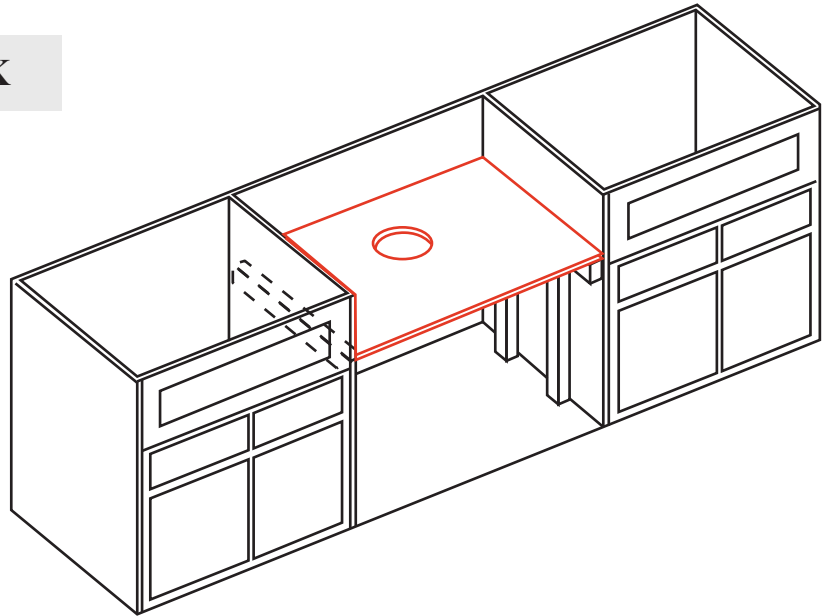
2.SUPPORT STRUCTURE

Reinforce the cabinet base to support the weight of the sink. Use support beams or brackets if necessary to provide adequate support.



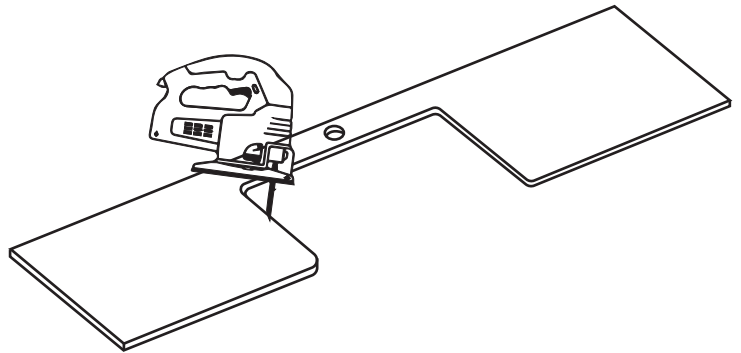
3.CREATE SUPPORT FOR SINK

Build a support frame or use adjustable supports to hold the weight of the sink. Make sure the sink will sit securely and level in the cabinet opening.



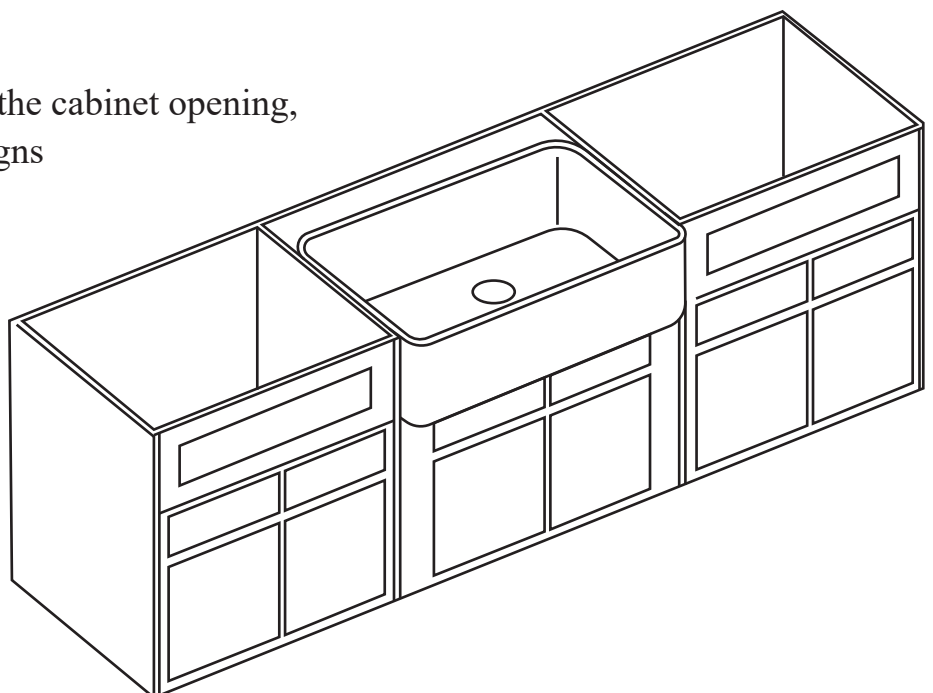
4.CUT COUNTERTOP

If the countertop needs to be modified to accommodate the sink, carefully measure and cut out the opening for the sink according to the actual sink specifications.



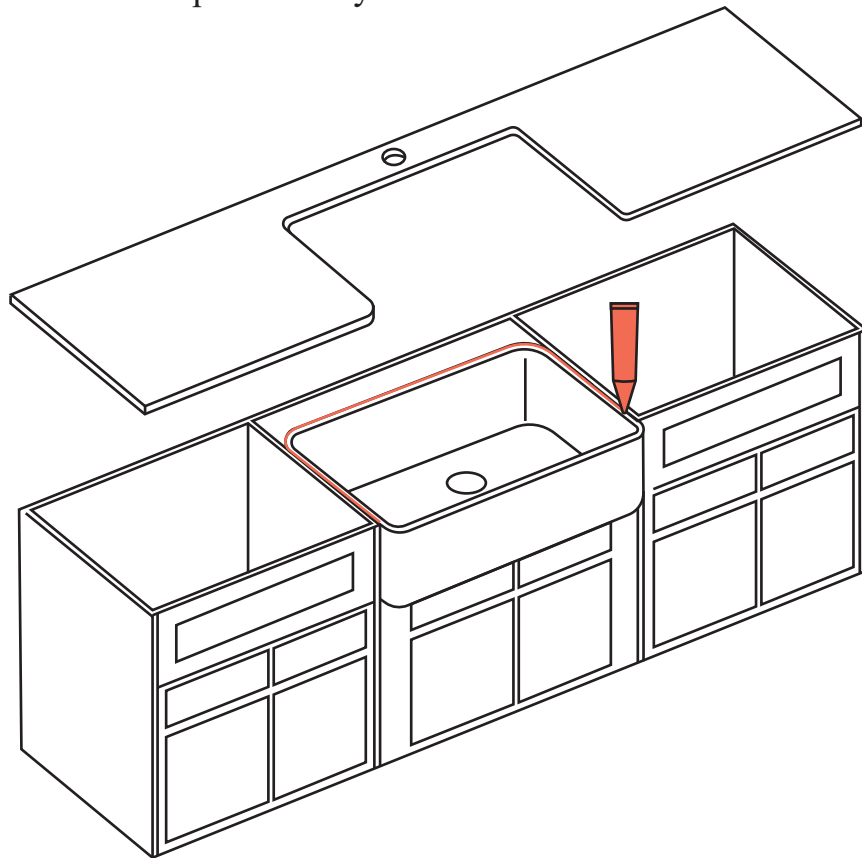
5.SINK PLACEMENT

Carefully lower the sink into the cabinet opening, ensuring it fits snugly and aligns correctly with the countertop.



6.SECURE THE SINK

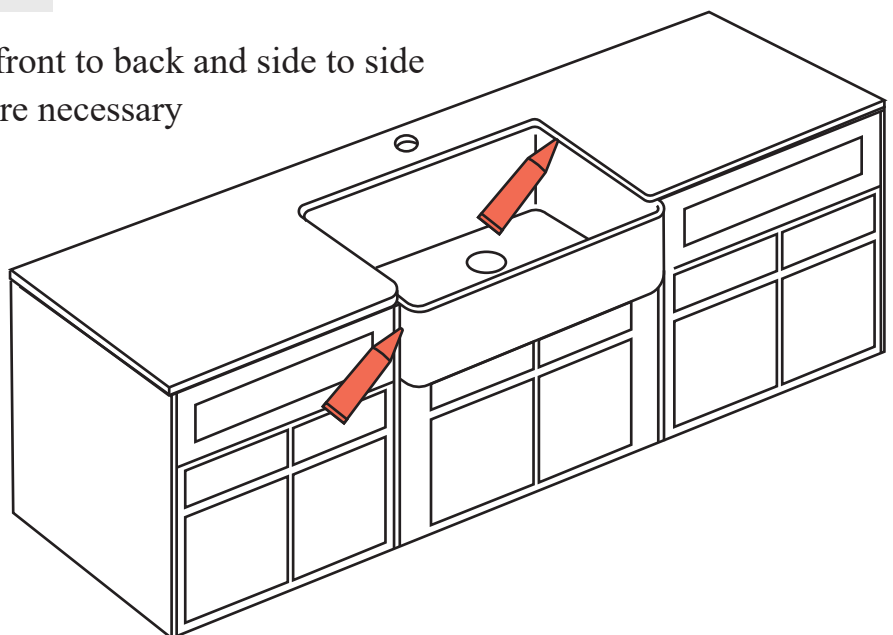
Use a bead of silicone (or preferred adhesive) around the rim of the sink. Check the alignment of the sink to the cutout in the countertop. Place countertop cutout hole over sink and press firmly.



7.FINISH INSTALLATION

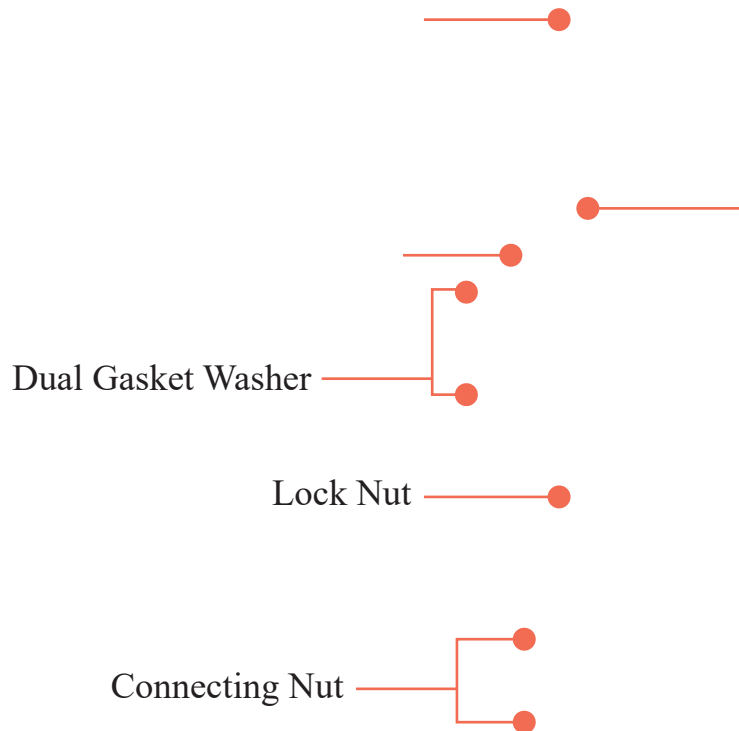
- Make sure sink is leveled from front to back and side to side
- Uses silicone to fill in gaps where necessary

Installer Tip: Use acetone or denatured alcohol to remove any excess sealant.



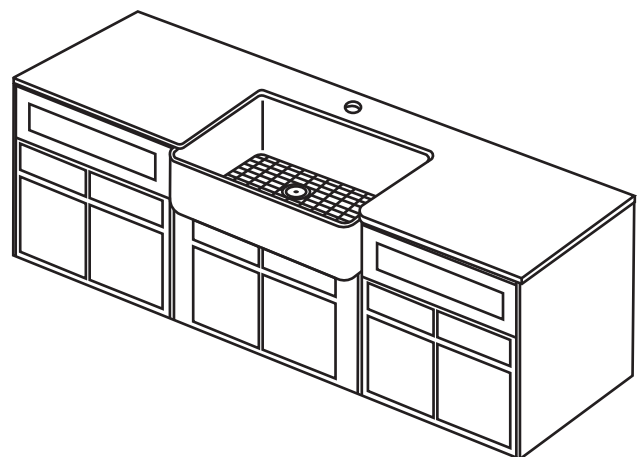
8.CONNECT PLUMBING

Connect the sink's drain pipes and any other plumbing components, ensuring a watertight seal. Check for leaks and make adjustments as needed.



9. TEST THE SINK

Run water in the sink and check for any leaks or drainage issues. Make adjustments as necessary to ensure everything is working properly.



By following these steps you can successfully install a farmhouse sink in your kitchen. If you're unsure about any step, consider consulting a professional plumber for assistance.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

To maintain a fireclay kitchen sink and keep it looking its best, follow these tips

1.REGULAR CLEANING

Clean your fireclay sink regularly with a mild soap or a non-abrasive cleaner and a soft cloth or sponge. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that can damage the sink's finish.

2.AVOID STAINING

Immediately rinse or wipe away any spills or stains to prevent them from setting onto the sink's surface. Avoid leaving coffee grounds, tea bags, or acidic foods in the sink for an extended period. For tough stains, you can use a paste of baking soda and water.

3.PREVENT SCRATCHES

Use a plastic or rubber mat at the bottom of the sink to prevent scratches from pots, pans, or utensils. Avoid using steel wool or abrasive pads to clean the sink.

4.AVOID EXTREME TEMPERATURES

While fireclay sinks are heat-resistant, avoid exposing them to extreme temperature changes. Do not pour boiling water directly into the sink or place hot cookware directly in the sink.

5.REMOVE METAL MARKS

If you notice metal marks left by pots or pans, gently scrub the sink with a mild abrasive cleaner or a mixture of baking soda and water to remove them.

6.MAINTAIN THE FINISH

Periodically apply a sink conditioner or polish specifically designed for fireclay sinks to maintain the finish and protect the surface.

7.PREVENT HARD WATER BUILDUP

To prevent hard water deposits, dry the sink after each use and consider using a mixture of water and vinegar to remove any buildup.

8.AVOID HEAVY IMPACT

Fireclay sinks are durable but can chip if hit with a heavy object. Be careful when placing pots and pans in the sink.

9.USE SINK GRIDS

To protect the sink bottom from scratches and dents, please use BESTGO sink grids which accompany the sink or other brand mats.

10.MAINTAIN THE DRAIN

Regularly clean the drain to prevent clogs and ensure proper drainage.

LIMITED WARRANTY COVERAGE

1 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

GETPRO products are made with quality materials and excellent craftsmanship to provide the customers a long-lasting product. In the case of any defects in materials or craftsmanship under regular use were inspected in the first one year of delivery, GETPRO will provide replacement parts at no charge, or at its option, replace any product or part of the product that is deemed defective, under normal installation, use, service and maintenance. This warranty applies only to the original purchaser. Proof of purchase will be required in the case of a claim.
