#### CARE. USE AND SAFETY ADVICE

Designed with a thick Thermic base for use on Aga, Rayburn and similar stoves, Stellar Traditional Stove Top Kettles are also efficient on Gas, Electric Solid Plate, Halogen and Ceramic hobs, and Induction Hobs.

Premium grade materials and manufacture assure extended service: there is a Lifetime Guarantee.

Please read through this Care, Use and Safety Advice however, as hot water and steam can be dangerous and you should be aware of the safety guidelines following.

Before first use, boil some water and wash out the inside a couple of times to remove any manufacturing taint.

The Maximum Fill Level has been marked on the outside of the body at the side of the spout. This is also visible inside the kettle body. Never fill beyond this mark, and ensure the lid is firmly in position before water is heated.

Always use Oven Gloves or similar when handling the kettle on the hob.

Do not leave the kettle simmering for long periods as it may boil dry, permanently damaging the base.

## Should boiling-dry occur -

# ON GAS/ELECTRIC HOBS

Do not remove from hob but switch off and allow the base to cool naturally.

## ON AGA TYPE HOBS

Gently remove from heat, keeping the base level.

Always use the fast plate on Aga type hobs. On Gas/Electric hobs match the hotplate size to the base size of the kettle. Keep Gas flames directly under the base.

Lime scale build-up may occur in areas with 'hard' water. You can minimise this by -

- Emptying the kettle at the end of the day.
- Filling with fresh water, not topping up, before every use.

Boiling a water/vinegar solution (1 teaspoon vinegar/1 cup water) will remove some of the deposits, and various commercial kettle descaling agents are available.

Clean the outside with warm, soapy water and polish dry. The exterior polished finish will benefit occasionally from the use of a specialist preparation such as Stellar Stainless Steel Cleaner, available from your Stellar stockist.
