Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

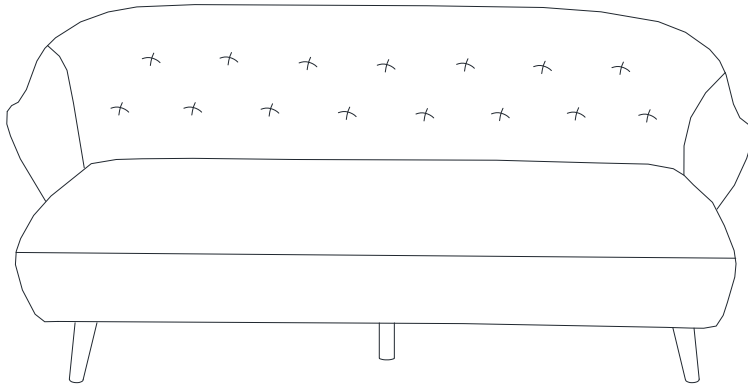


- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.

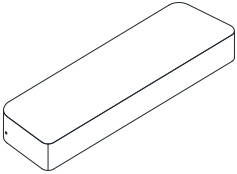
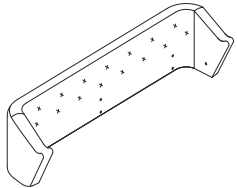


- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

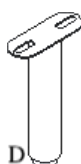
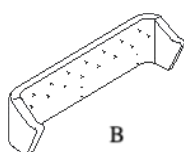
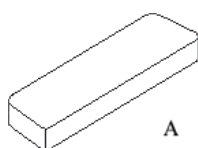

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



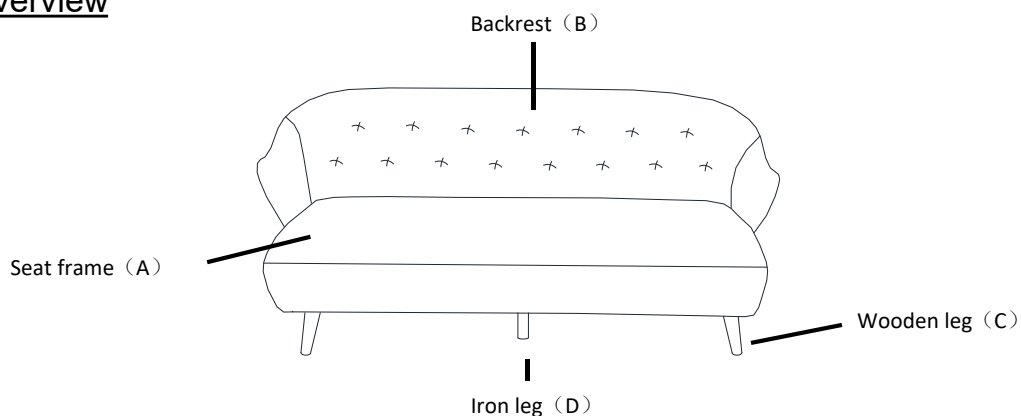
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

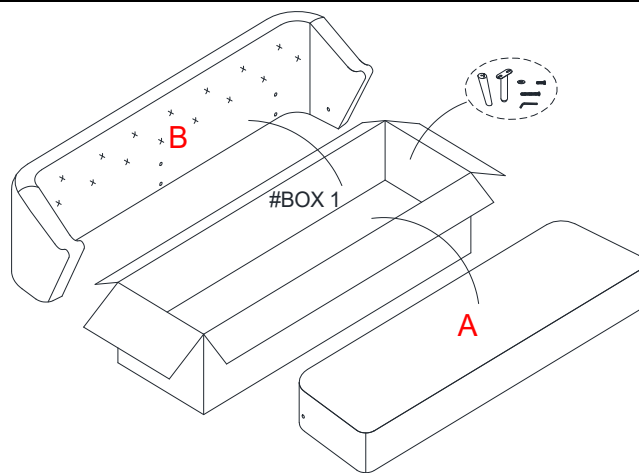
Assembly Steps

Overview



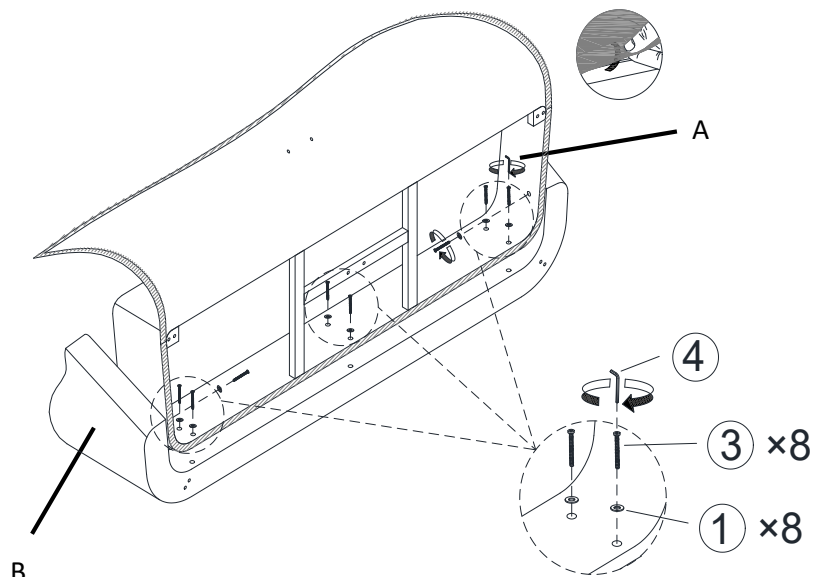
This Sofa has multiple parts and may require up to some 20 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Sofa parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Take out Part A (Backrest), Part B (Seat frame), and all hardware from Box.

Step 2



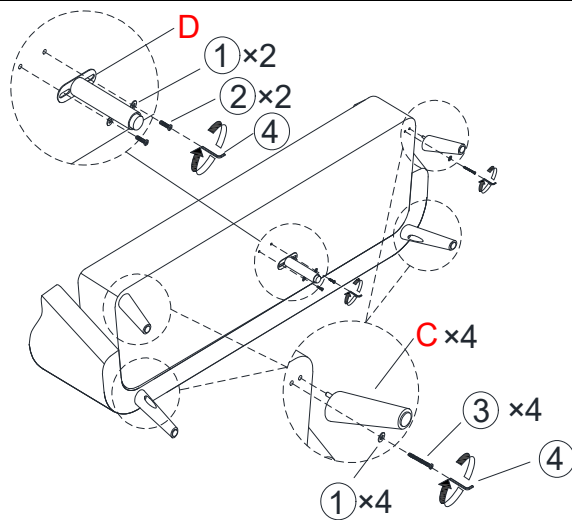
Lay Part A (Backrest) flat on the floor, open the bottom of Part B (Seat frame), and align its holes with those on the sofa backrest.

Put a washer (①) onto each Bolt (③).

Insert the screws through the aligned holes.

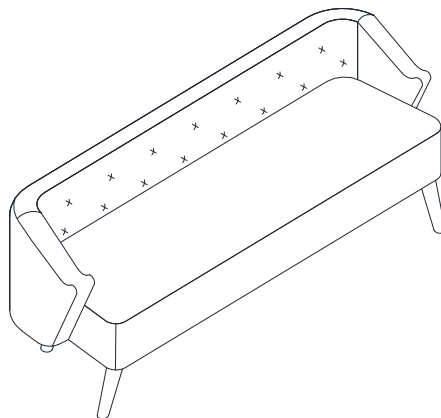
Use the Allen Wrench (④) to tighten all screws clockwise until the backrest is firmly fixed to the seat base.

Step 3



Prepare Part C(Wooden leg),Part D(Iron leg), 4 Bolt (③), 4 washers (①), and Allen Wrench(④).
For each leg: Slide a washer (①) onto a Bolt (③), insert through the leg into the frame, then tighten with theAllen Wrench (④).
Repeat for all legs.

Step 4



Your Sofa is ready for use.
This Sofa can only be used on a flat, level surface.
