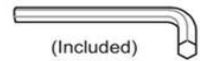

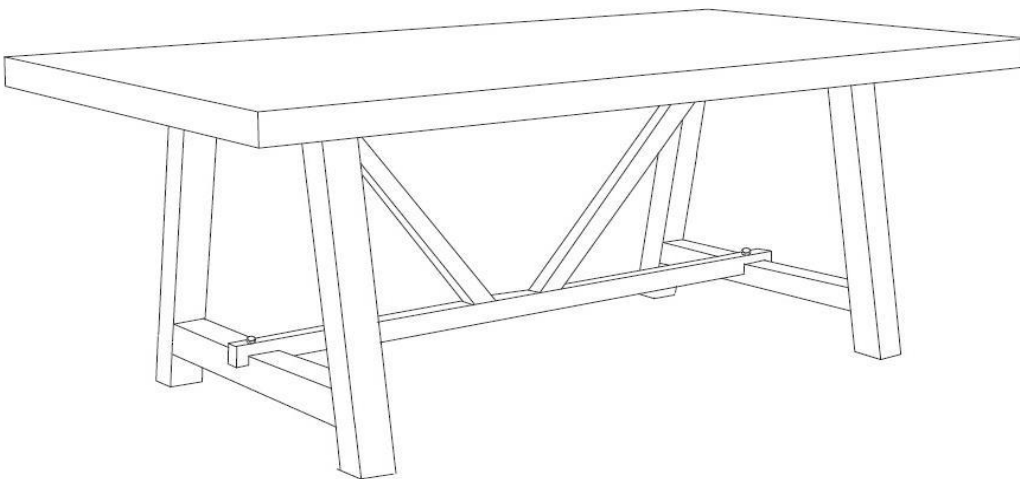

Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

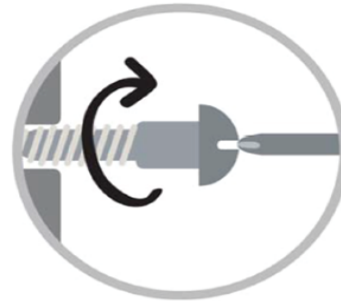

Save the instructions and store any supplied tools for later maintenance.



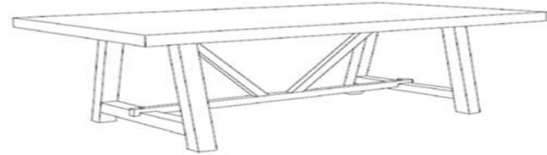
After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

STEP 1

Assemble both diagonal Stretchers (P5) into the Top bar (P3) by aligning Bolts (H1). Use Allen Key (H7) to tighten the bolts.

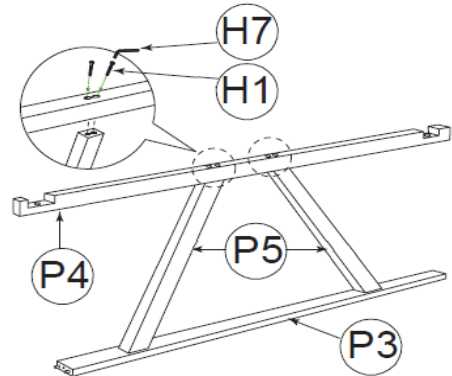
Make sure using 4 holes face (P3) to assembly



STEP 2

Assemble both Diagonal Stretchers (P5) into the Leg Stretcher (P4) by aligning Bolts (H1). Use Allen Key (H7) to tighten the bolts

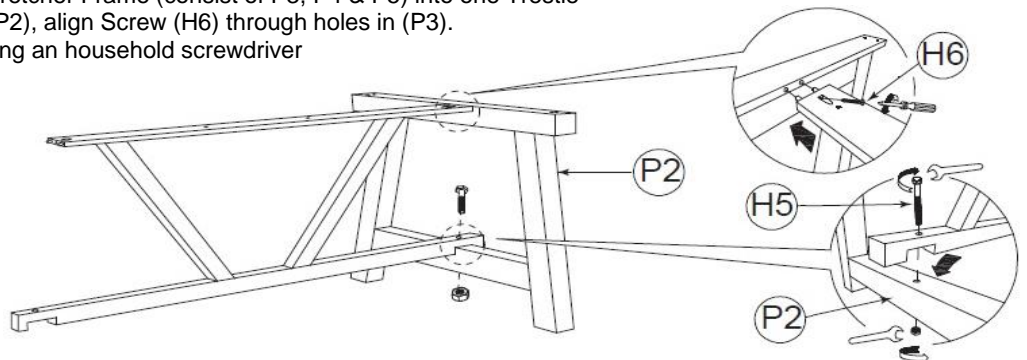


STEP 3

Attach the Stretcher Frame (consist of P3, P4 & P5) into one Trestle Leg Frame (P2), align Screw (H6) through holes in (P3). Tighten it using an household screwdriver

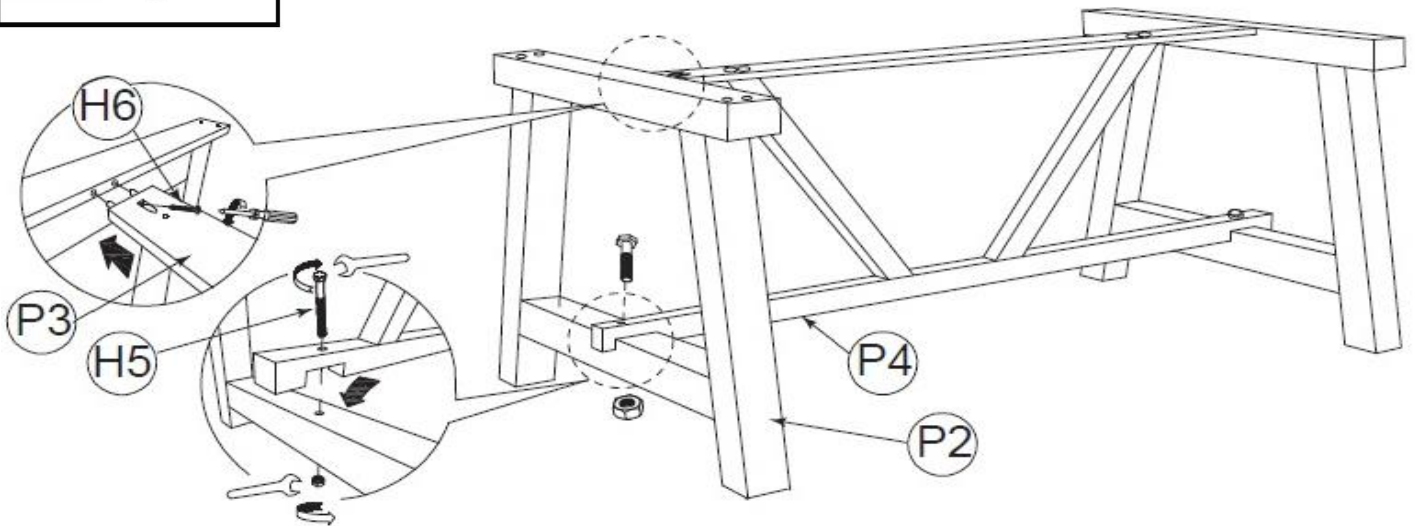
Then, align Bolt (H5) through a hole in (P4) into a hole in the Trestle Leg frame (P2) right to the Nut. Tighten it using a household Wrench.

Now repeat same process on the other side of the Trestle Leg Frame and Attach the Stretcher Frame (consist of P3, P4 & P5) to complete the base assembly step. Again, align Screw (H6) through holes in (P3). Tighten it using an household screwdriver.




Then, align Bolt (H5) through a hole in (P4) into a hole in the Trestle Leg frame (P2) right to the Nut. Tighten it using a household Wrench

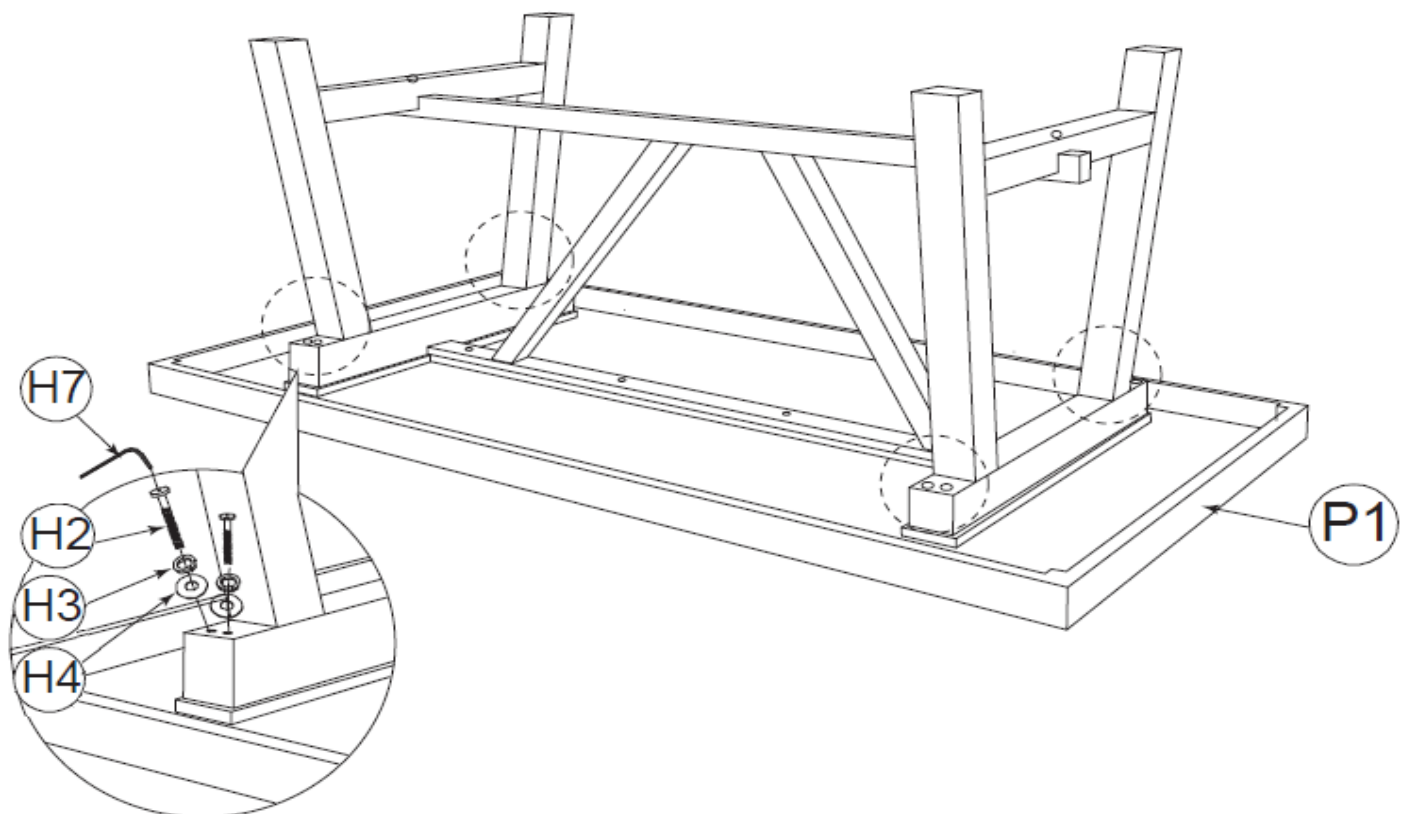




Prepare the Table top (P1) by placing it upside down on a soft clean surface (cardboard, blanket or carpet), to protect it from scratches.

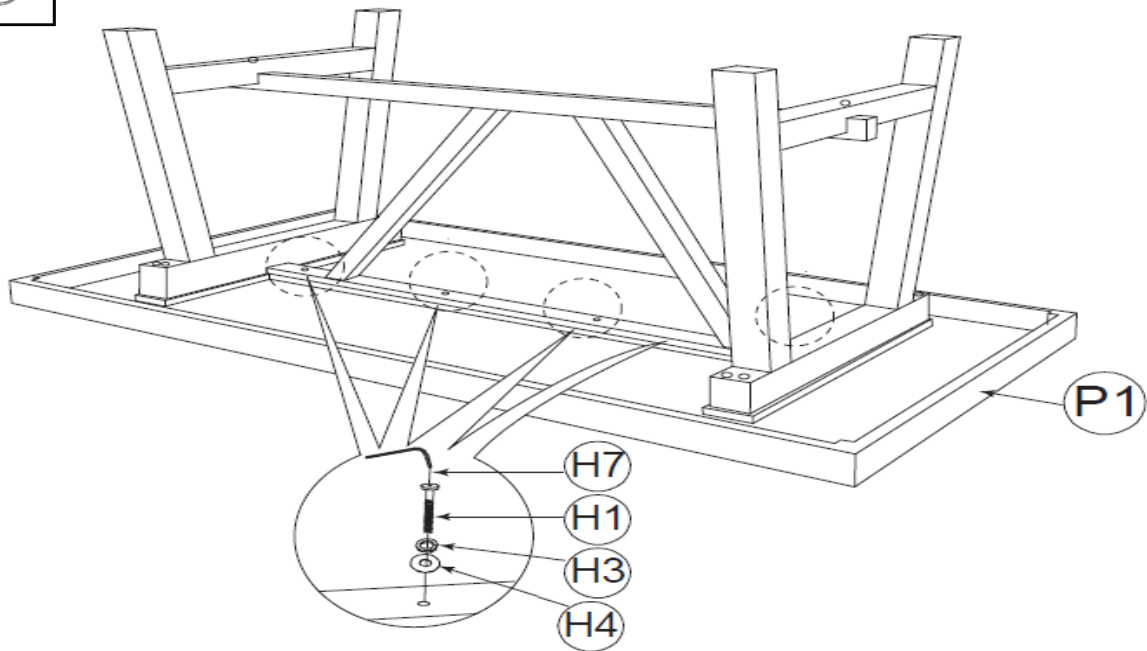
Turn the assemble leg upside down, then attach it onto the table top. Align Bolts (H2) together with Spring washer (H3) & Flat washer (H4) through the desired holes in the leg frame right into the holes in the Table top. Tighten the bolts using the Allen key (H7). Do not tighten completely until all 8 screws are in place . Do not over tighten the screws .

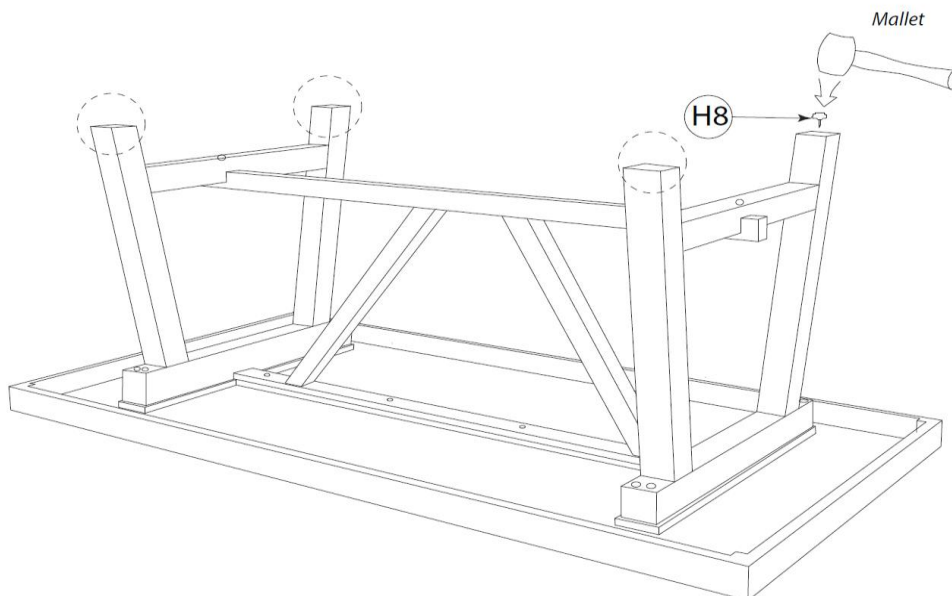
Then align Bolt (H1) together with Spring washer (H3) & Flat washer (H4) into holes in the top bar and tighten it using the Allen key (H7).
Do not tighten completely until all 4 screws are in place .
Do not over tighten the screws .

Tap the Nail leg (H8) to each table Leg .

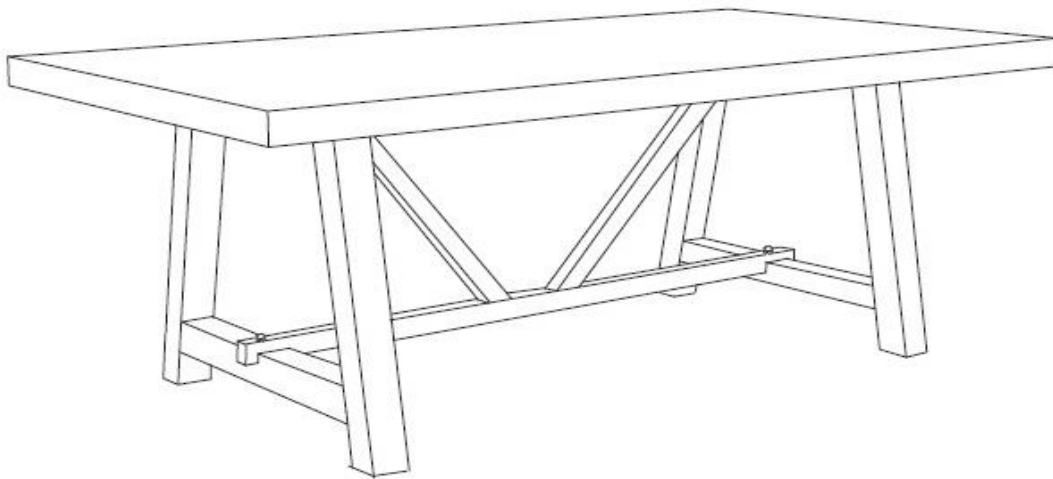

Carefully reposition the table upright. Remember to ALWAYS do this last step with at least two people (adults) to avoid injuries.

STEP 1

Prepare the Seat (P4) by inserting the Wooden dowel (H6) into the desired holes.





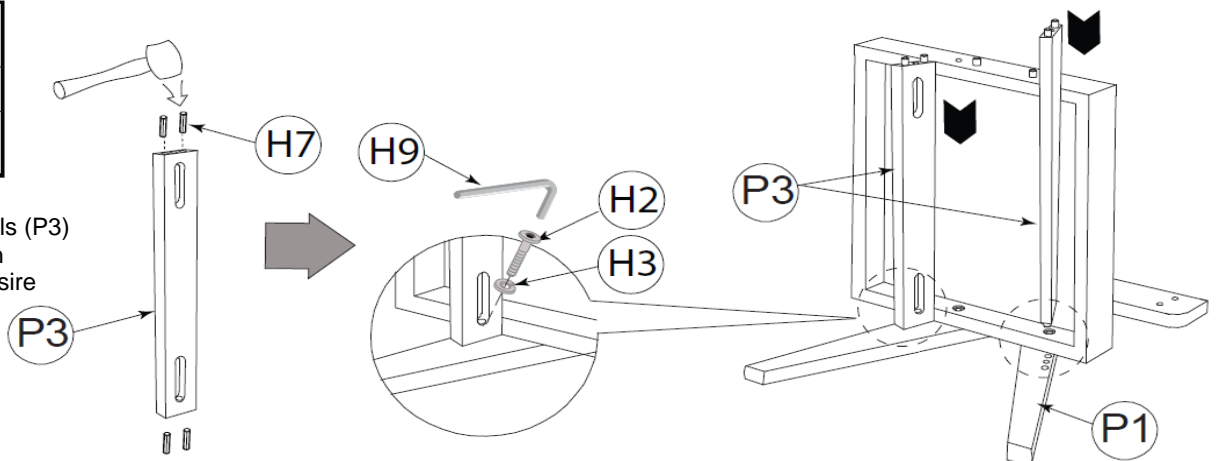
ARROW STICKERS AT SEAT MUST MEET ARROW STICKERS IN LEGS (P1) & (P2) RESPECTIVELY

Attach the Seat (P4) to the Leg frame by locating the dowels into the desired holes in the Leg (P1). Match the ARROW stickers to ensure the seat is in the correct position. Then, align Screw (H1) with Spring washer (H3) & Flat washer Big (H4) tighten it using Allen key (H9).

Prepare the Support rails (P3) by inserting the wooden dowels (H7) into the desired holes.



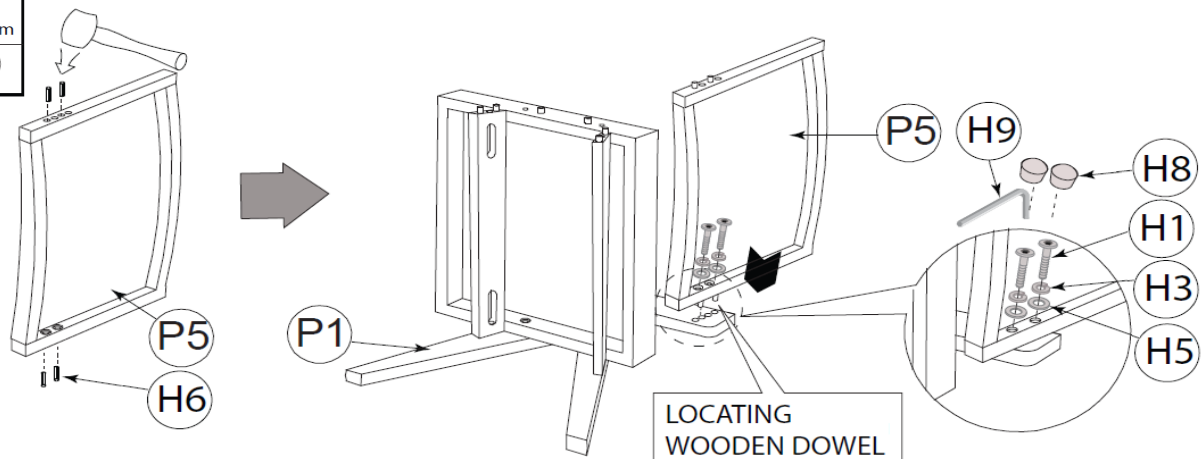
Assemble both Support rails (P3) into the desired holes in the Leg frame. Align Bolt (H2) with Spring Washer (H3) & tighten it using Allen key (H9).

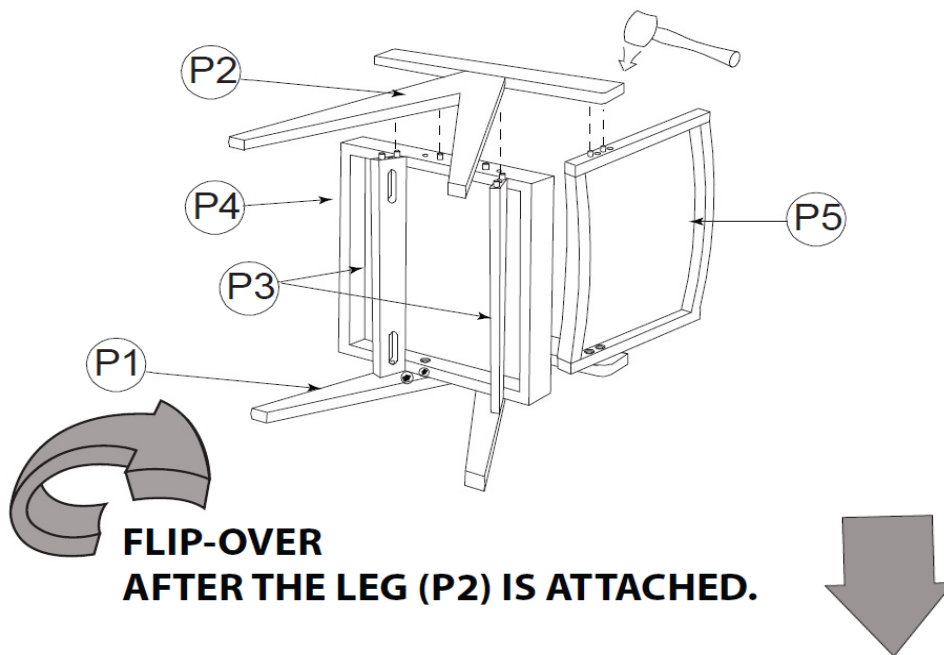
Prepare the Backrest (P5) by inserting the Wood dowel (H6) into the desired holes at the backrest. Then, attach the Backrest (P5) by locating the wood dowel at the backrest into the desired holes at the armrest. Align Bolt (H1) together with the Spring washer (H3) & Flat washer Small (H5). Tighten it using Allen key (H9).

Tap the Wood button (H8) to cover the holes.






STEP 4

Prepare the other side of the leg: the Leg frame-Left (P2). Attach it to the parts of (Seat P4), Support rail (P3) & Backrest (P5), by locating the wood dowel at those parts to the desired holes in the Leg (P2). Use a rubber mallet to tap the leg frame until all the parts are snug to the leg frame. Then, carefully flip the chair to the other side to secure remaining holes with corresponding bolts.

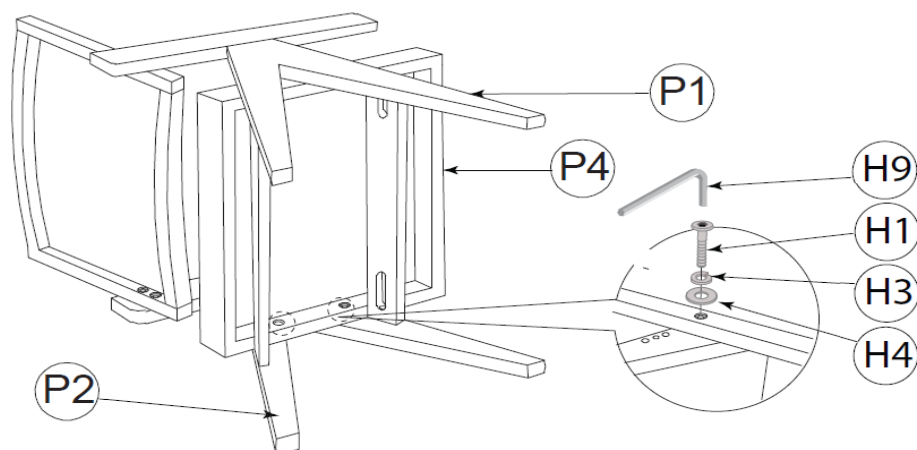

FITTING TO THE SEAT

Start with fitting the leg to the seat by aligning Screw (H1) with Spring washer (H3) & Flat washer Big (H4). Tighten it using Allen key (H9).

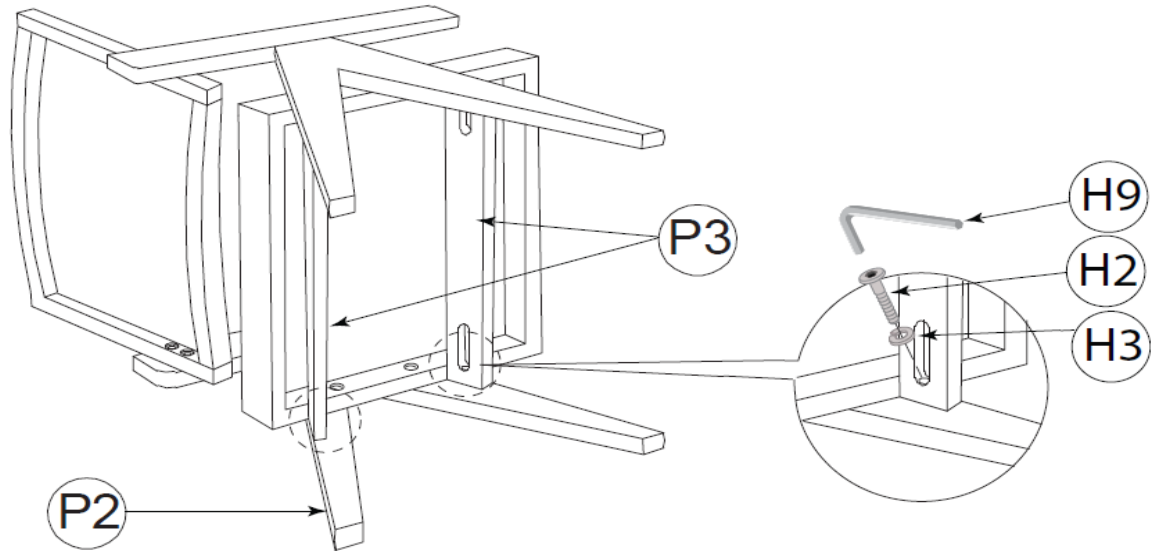

Continue with fitting to the Support rails (P3), by Aligning Bolt (H2) with Spring Washer (H3) & tighten it using Allen key (H9).

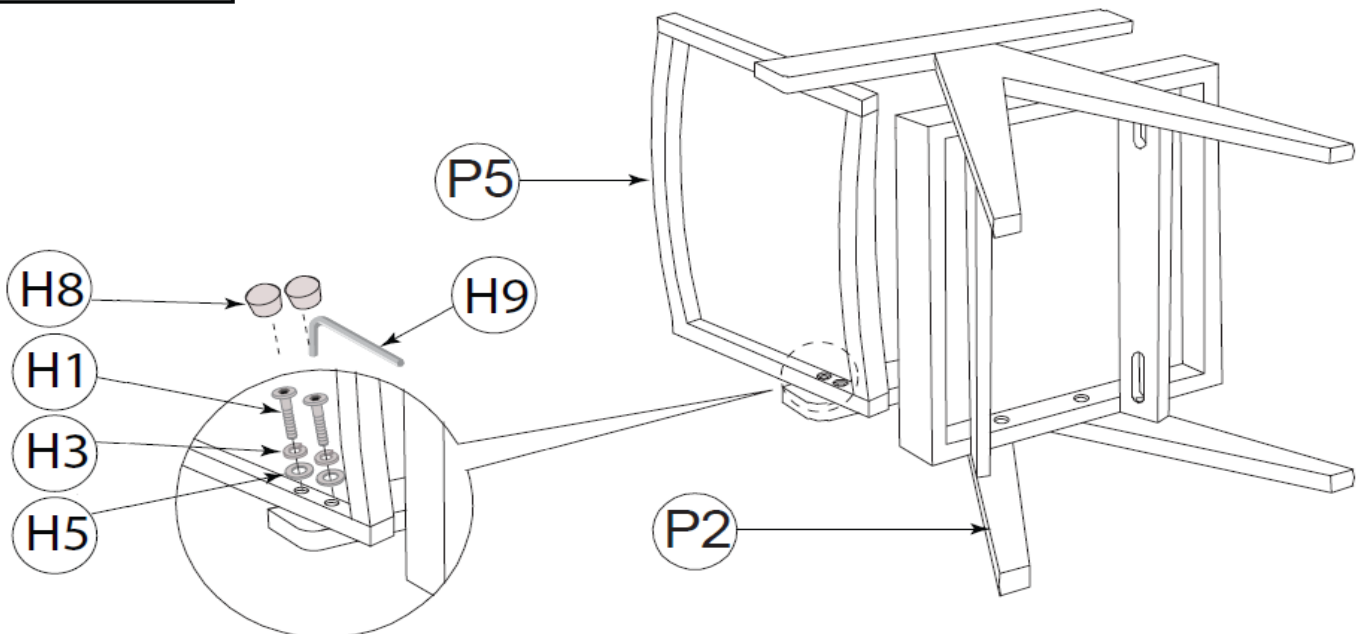

FITTING TO THE BACKREST

Lastly, fit the armrest to the backrest by Aligning Bolt (H1) together with the Spring washer (H3) & Flat washer Small (H5). Tighten it using Allen Key (H9). Tap the Wood button (H8) to cover the holes.



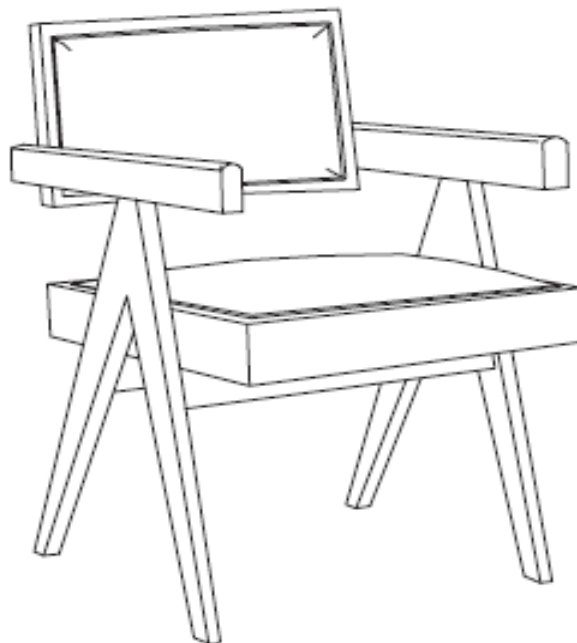
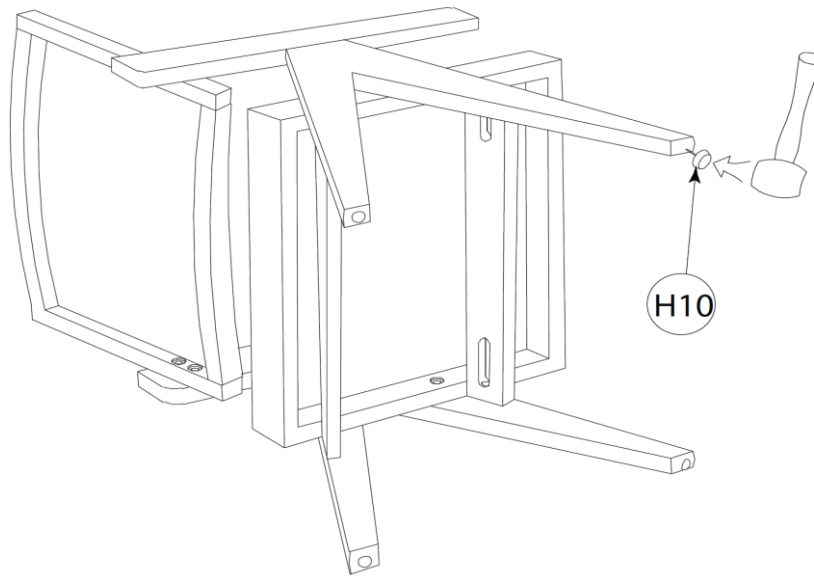

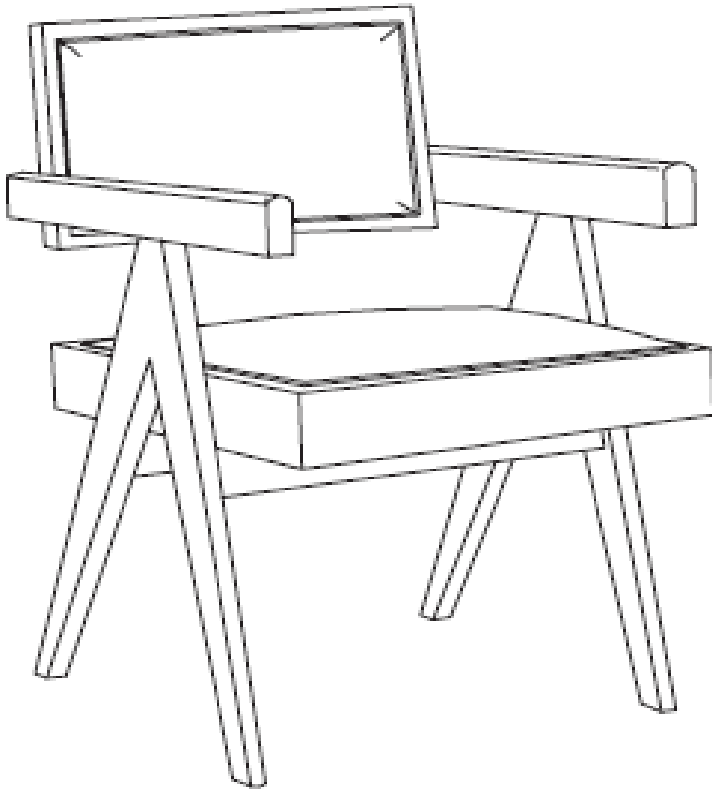
