

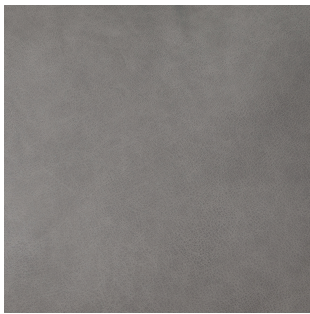
LEATHER CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Oyster



- Dust regularly with a soft, dry cloth.
- Blot spills immediately with a soft white cloth. If further cleaning is required, wipe with a damp cloth; for persistent stains, use a mild soap and warm water solution, testing it first on an inconspicuous area.
- Do not use polishes, preservers, conditioners or leather soaps.
- Surface scratches can be rubbed out with a finger or buffed with a soft chamois cloth.
- Avoid direct sunlight and direct heat exposure.
- If necessary, consult a professional leather cleaning specialist.

Gray
