Installation Guide

Metal Frame Mirror



Important Safety Information

Please read these instructions carefully before installation or use.

Glass Fragility: The mirror is made of glass, which can break under impact. Handle the mirror with care during installation and cleaning.

Proper Mounting: Ensure the mirror is securely mounted to prevent accidental falls. Always use appropriate wall anchors or screws for the wall type.

Choose the mirror direction



Do not remove safety film until after installation. This film helps protect the mirror from damage during transport.

Step 1 Choose a Location:

Select a location on the wall where the mirror will be installed. Ensure the space is free from excessive moisture or water splashes.

Step 2 Mark Mounting Points:

Measure distance between brackets and mark the drill position, based on vertical or horizontal mounting.

Using a level to ensure the marks are even.

Step 3 Drill Holes:

Drill the holes according to the size of the provided wall plugs and screws.

Note: For drywall, use wall plugs; for concrete or brick walls, use appropriate masonry screws and anchors.



Step 4 Mount the Mirror:

Install screws and carefully hang the mirror. Ensure the mirror is securely attached.



Step 5 Adjust the Position

Once the mirror is on the wall, use a level to check that it is perfectly straight.

Make any necessary adjustments by slightly shifting the mirror or repositioning the screws if needed.



Step 6 Final Check

Ensure the mirror is firmly mounted and does not shift or wobble.

Step back and assess the position to confirm the mirror is where you want it.



Maintenance & Cleaning

For regular cleaning: Use a soft, lint-free cloth to wipe down the surface. A microfiber cloth works best.

For streak-free shine: Use a glass cleaner or a mixture of water and a few drops of dish soap. Spray the cleaner onto the cloth, not directly onto the mirror.

Avoid using abrasive materials: Never use rough or abrasive sponges that could scratch the mirror surface.
