

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, and/or injury including the following:

- 1. Read all instructions before using this heater.
- 2. This heater is hot when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. Keep combustible materials, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes, etc. and curtains at least 3 feet (0.9 m) from the front of the heater and keep them away from the sides and rear.
- 3. Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used by or near children or invalids and whenever the heater is left operating and unattended.
- 4. Do not operate any heater after it malfunctions. Disconnect power at service panel and have heater inspected by a reputable electrician before reusing.
- 5. Always unplug this appliance when not in use.
- 6. Do not operate any heater with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or if it has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- 7. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, it's service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 8. Any repairs to this fireplace should be carried out by a qualified service person.
- 9. Under no circumstances should this fireplace be modified. Parts having to be removed for servicing must be replaced prior to operating this fireplace again.
- 10. Do not use outdoors.
- 11. This heater is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry areas and similar indoor locations.

Never locate this appliance where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container.

- 12. Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners or the like. Arrange cord away from traffic areas and where it will not be tripped over.
- 13. To disconnect this appliance, turn controls to the off position, then remove plug from outlet.
- 14. Connect to properly grounded outlet only.
- 15. This appliance, when installed, must be electrically grounded in accordance with local codes or, in the absence of local codes, with the current CSA C22.1 Canadian Electrical Code or for USA installations, follow local codes and the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA NO.70.
- 16. There is a protective thermostat limiter inside the heater. When the inner temperature over heat, the thermostat limiter will shut off the power supply to avoid the risk of fire damage to the appliance.
- 17. The heaters must not be located immediately below a socket-outlet.
- 18. Do not insert or allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this may cause an electric shock or fire, or damage the appliance.

- 19. To prevent a possible fire, do not block air intakes or exhaust in any manner. Do not use on soft surfaces, like bed, where opening may become blocked.
- 20. This appliance has hot and arcing or sparking parts inside. Do not use where gasoline, paint, or flammable liquids are used or stored. This fireplace should not be used as a drying rack for clothing.

Christmas stockings or decorations should not be hung in area of it.

- 21. Use this appliance only as described in the manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock or injury to persons.
- 22. Always plug heaters directly into a wall outlet/receptacle. Never use with an extension cord or relocatable power tap (outlet/power strip).

PLANNING INSTALLATION

The unit comes standard with 6 feet (1.8M) three wire cord, exiting from the right of the fireplace.

Plan the installation to avoid the use of an extension cord. When choosing a final location, make sure you will have clear access to grounded electrical outlet.

Before you begin assembly, locate the instructions and hardware. Compare all parts with the


Hardware Included and Package Contents lists. Be sure you have all the parts and can identify

them. A helping hand is always good. Assemble your fireplace with an adult assistant if possible.

Some pieces are heavy and will need to be held by a helper. Assembly time will take approximately15-30 minutes.

Getting Started

- Remove the appliance from the box.
- Remove any packaging from the product.
- Place the packaging inside the box and cither store or dispose of safely.
- Carton contents are as follows.




Helpful Advice before Fitting

- Please retain all packaging until you have checked and counted all the parts and the contents of the hardware pack against the parts list.
- The hardware pack contains small items which should be kept away from children and babies.

- We suggest that you open the hardware pack and place all the contents into a container, therefore reducing the risk of losing any small pieces.
 Installation (see Fig1~Fig5)
- Do not connect the appliance until properly fixed to the wall and the instructions are fully read.
- The minimum distances must be observed in the diagrams.
- For installation of the appliance, care must be taken not to damage conccaled cables.
- Please be careful while drilling the holes.

INSTALL THE ELECTRIC FIREPLACE INTO THE WOOD MANTEL

Remove four silver screws from the sides of the heater, two screws on each side.
 Remove two screws from the front of the heater. Remove the tempered glass by lifting it from the lugs on the sides. see (Fig. 1)





• With the help of an adult assistant, lift the fireplace and gently slide it into the opening in the mantel. Make sure the fireplace is centered left and right in the opening. Be careful when placing fireplace and adjusting, bottom of fireplace could scratch the finish of the base/hearth of your wood mantel.(Fig.2)



• For best viewing, mark the left and right screws (where the mantel is fixed according to the hole in the fireplace).(Fig.3)



- Place decorative crystals inside the fireplace.
- Place the front glass surround over the front of the fire aligning the slots in the bracket at each side of the glass panel with the lugs on the sides of the fire; See (Fig.4)
- Again, two people will be required for this operation.



• Connect the LED lights with the power cables.(Fig.5)



Instructions for Use


• The appliance can be operated either by the switches located on the top right hand side of the fire or by supplied remote control.

TO ACCESS CONTROL PANEL



• The standby switch located at the center right hand side of the fire must be first switch on.

Infrared Remote control





	ON:Enables control panel functions and remote control.Turn on flame effect OFF:Disables control panel functions and remote control.Turn off flame effect

FLAME	COLOR button:Makes the color flame effect changing. 1.Press once.Flame color effect gets changing. Press again until desired setting is reached. 2.Keep press 3 seconds Makes flame effect dimmer and brighter.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

The battery compartment is located on the back end of the remote control.

- 1. Press and slide the battery cover open.
- 2. Insert two 1.5V (AAA) batteries ensuring they are installed correctly with regard to the polarities (+ and -) marked on the inside of the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the battery cover.

NOTE: The batteries should be removed if the product is to be left unused for a long time



DO NOT mix old and new batteries.

DO NOT use rechargeable silver oxide cell batteries with remote control unit.

DO NOT mix alkaline.Standard (Carbon-zine).Or rechargeable(Nickle -Cadmium)

batteries.

DO NOT dispose of batteries in fie Improper disposal may cause batteries to leak or explode.

Important Safety Instructions

When using this electrical appliance, basic precautions should be followed to reduce the risk of fire, clectric shock, and injury to person, including the following:

- This heater must be used on an AC supply only and the voltage marked on the heater must correspond to the supply voltage.
- Do not switch the appliance on until it properly installed and described in this manual.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended during use.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended whilst connected to the mains supply.
- Keep out of reach of children and do not allow them to operate this appliance.
- From time to time, check the cord for damage Never use the appliance if the cord orany part of the appliance shows signs of damage.
- Do not operate this appliance with a damaged plug or cord,after a malfunction or after being dropped or damaged in any way.

LED Bulb Replacement

Note: The flame effect on this electric fireplace insert is created by LED Bulbs. The life of these LED bulbs will be 100,000hours. The users are not recommended to Replace the LED Bulbs. For any reason should the bulbs stop working properly, contact a Qualified technician.

Cleaning:

- Turn heater OFF and unplug from electrical outlet before any cleaning or maintenance is performed. Wait at least 10minutes to allow all components to cool properly.
- Use a vacuum or duster to keep heater and vent area clean from dust and dirt.
- The exterior of the fireplace should be cleaned with a damp cloth or duster.
 Do not use abrasive cleaners or liquid sprays.



Safety Cut-Off

• This appliance is fitted with a safety cut-off which will operate if the fire overheats (e.g.due to blocked air vents). For safety reasons, the fire will NOT automatically reset.

AWARNING: This heater has a voltage rating of 120 volts. The cord has a three-blade, grounding-type plug. An adapter is available for connecting three-blade grounding-type plugs to two-slot receptacles. The grounding plug extending from the adapter must be connected to a permanent ground such as a properly grounded outlet box. The adapter should not be used if a three-slot grounded receptacle is available.

DO NOT DEFEAT TH SAFETY PURPOSE OF THE GROUNDED PLUG.



• To reset the appliance, disconnect the appliance from the mains supply for at least 15 minutes. Reconnect the supply to the mains and switch on the appliance.

Troubleshooting

Symptom	Solution
No operation/no fan	Check fuse by replacement, Check for safety cut-off operation,
No fire effect light	Check the LED light with technician.



Meaning of crossed -out wheeled dustbin:
