- Avoid exposing furniture directly to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets. Sunlight and/or exposure to heating and air conditioning outlets will fade/damage Chenille.
- Do not place your Chenille furniture too close to windows, radiators, or vents.
- Vacuum or wipe with a soft brush to remove dust.
- Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connection are tight, Re-tighten if necessary.



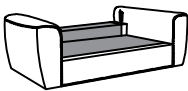
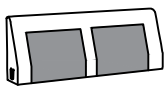
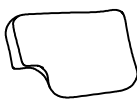
