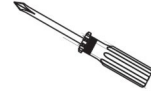


WSS-W – Storage Shelf

Information about your furniture:

Our furniture ranges have been carefully crafted from solid wood and natural wood veneers. Each piece of furniture has unique characteristics such as knots, variances and graining. These are part of the natural character of the furniture itself.

Caring for your furniture:

Extreme temperature can cause slight movements in the wood itself so please avoid placing your furniture close to radiators or other direct sources of heat. Humidity should also be avoided. Please avoid exposing your furniture to continued bright sunlight as it can affect the color. Any fluid should be removed as quickly as possible. Always lift your furniture when moving, as dragging can cause damage to your furniture or flooring. Extreme changes in temperature and humidity during transit may result in a powder residue forming so silica gel bags have been included to alleviate this natural occurrence. This residue is harmless and can easily be removed before assembly with a damp cloth and mild detergent.

After care:

Wipe the surfaces with a dry cloth and an occasional use of normal household polish. We also recommend you use household spray polish occasionally on the drawer grooves and runners as this will aid use. Please do not use detergents or chemicals on your furniture.

Before you start assembly.:

Please check that you have all the correct parts and fittings as detailed below. In the unlikely event of a part being damaged or missing please check the component or part number on the diagram below and contact your retailer for corrective action.

Note: It is easiest to lay this down on the side as we will be attaching all bars and shelves to the Left Panel first and then aligning and securing the Right Panel second.

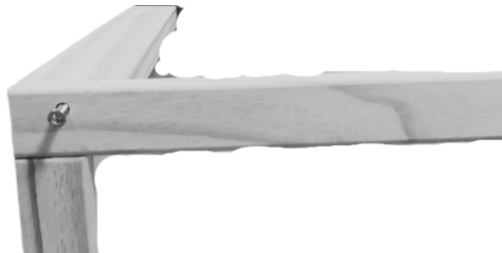
Step 1 - Take Front Bar (Part 6) and insert 2 dowels (A) in each end.



Step 2 - Set Left Panel on it's side and insert Front Bar and it's dowels (from Step 1) into the holes at the top of the frame. ****Note:** There should be 2 holes on the top side to receive the screws for the top piece. Align these holes to the top side for later use.



Step 3 - Secure this connection using Hex Socket Screw (B) into the middle hole on the Left Panel which secures the Front Bar to the Left Panel.



Step 4 - Repeat steps 1-3 now using the Back Bar (Part 7) so that both bars are now secured to the left panel.



Step 5 - Secure the Bottom Shelf (Part 5) using the dowels (A) and then the Hex Socket Screws (B) so that the Bottom Shelf is now secured firmly to the Left Panel.



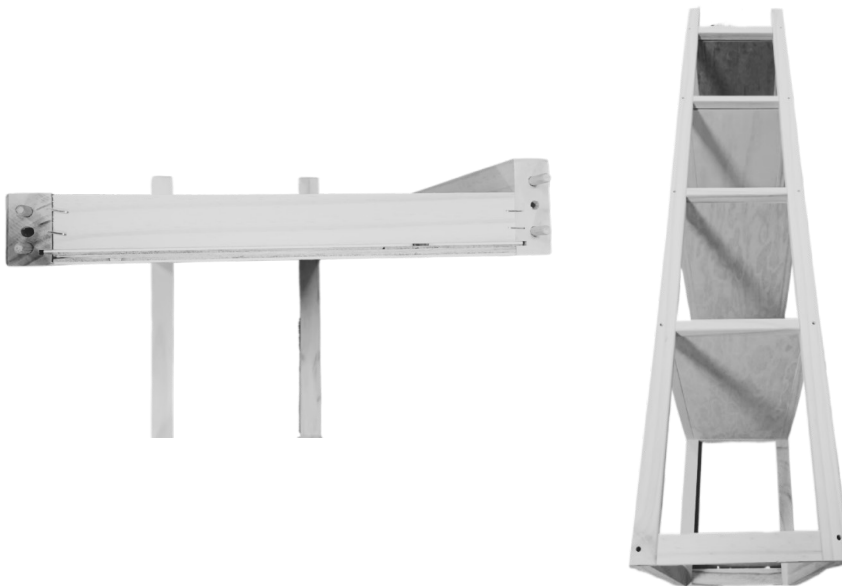
Step 6 - Repeat step 5 but now using each of the 3 Middle Shelves (Part 4).



Step 7 - Now that the left panel has all the shelves and cross bars in place, rotate the left panel onto its back so that all bars and shelves are now facing up. This will make it easy to place the Right Panel (Part 3) on top and secure with dowels and screws.



Step 8 - Place the Right Panel (Part 3) on top and secure with dowels and screws.



Step 9 - Place the Top (Part 1) onto the top of the assembled unit and secure using the 6 screws (C) provided.
