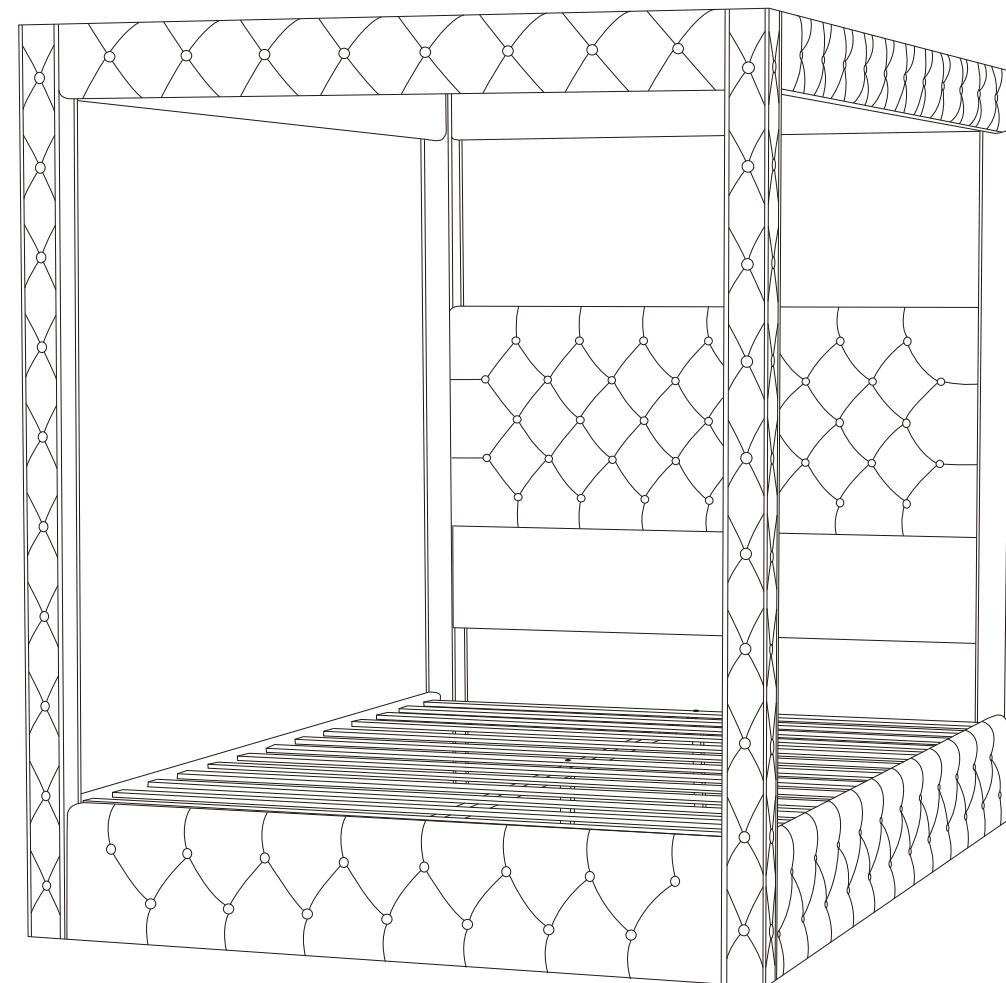

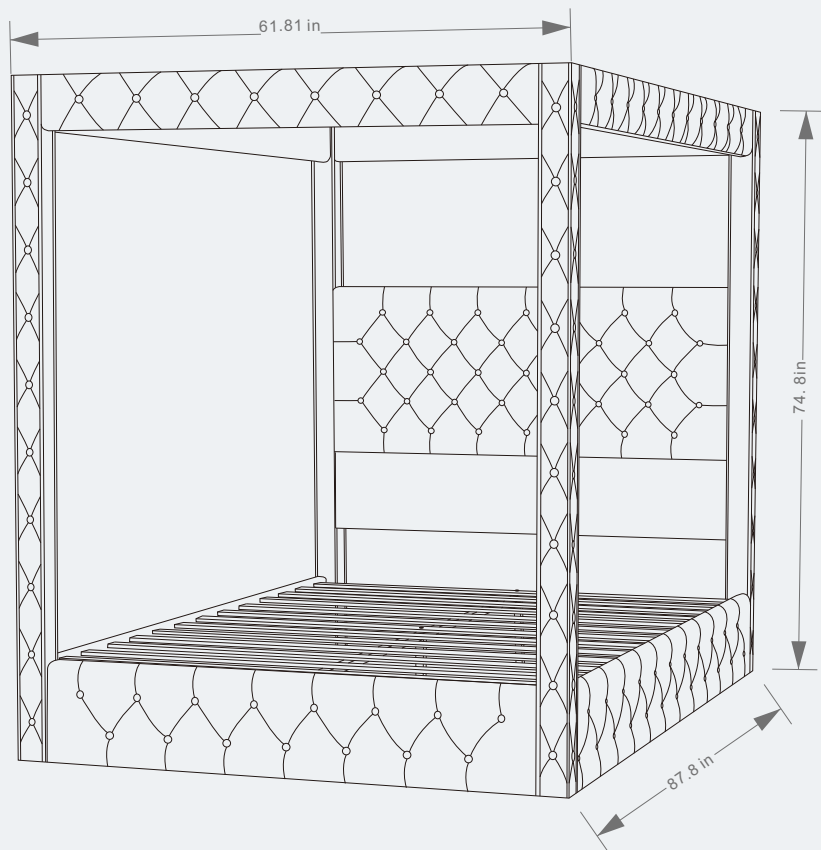

In each of the previous steps, tighten all screws to approximately 70% to stabilise the overall frame during assembly. Do not fully tighten any screws until the final step is completed.

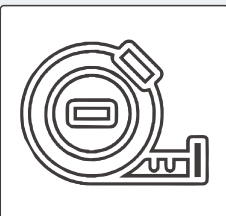

Note:

Step 1

Headboard Section

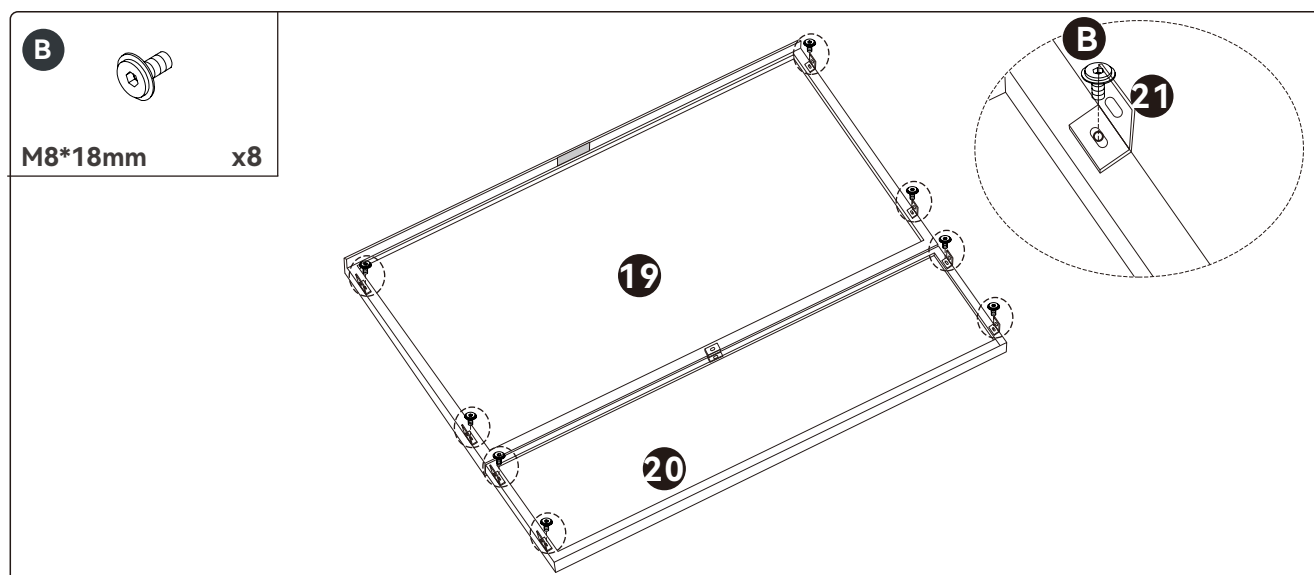


Headboard upper panel 19 and headboard lower panel 20 are connected with metal plate 6, and secured with bolt B.

Note: The edges of the upper and lower panels must be aligned evenly on both sides.

Step 2

Headboard Section

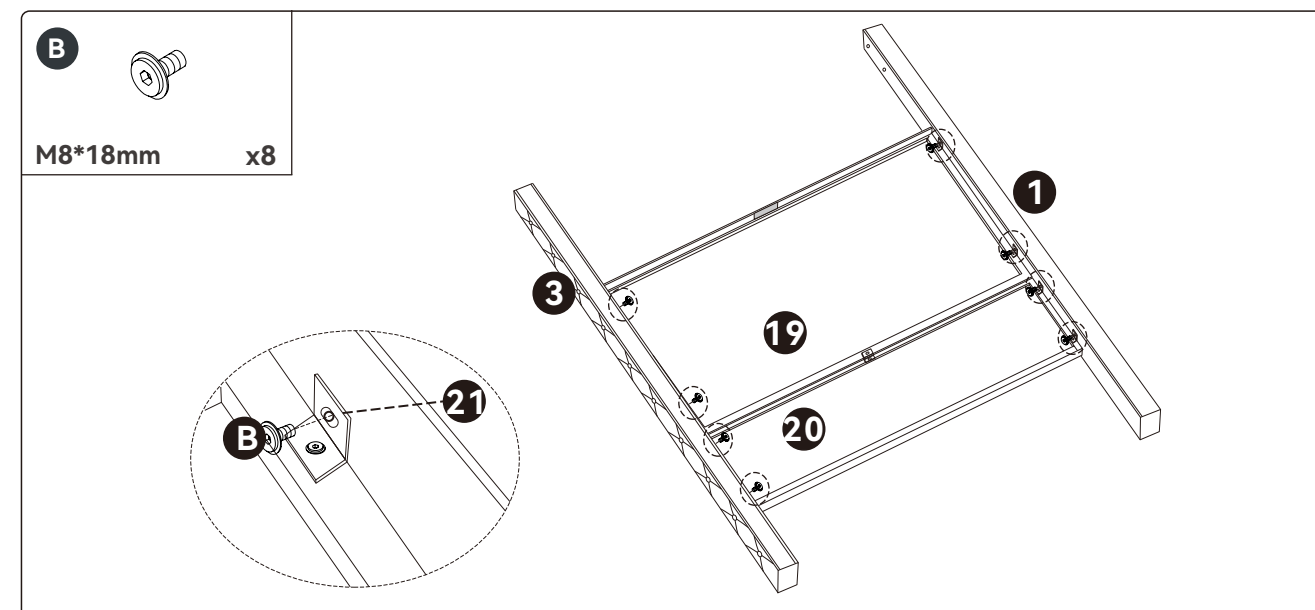


Angle iron 21 is installed at the corresponding hole positions on both sides of the headboard upper panel 19 and the headboard lower panel 20, and connected with bolt B.

Note: Tighten all bolts only to about 70%, not fully tight, to facilitate subsequent assembly.

Step 3

Headboard Section



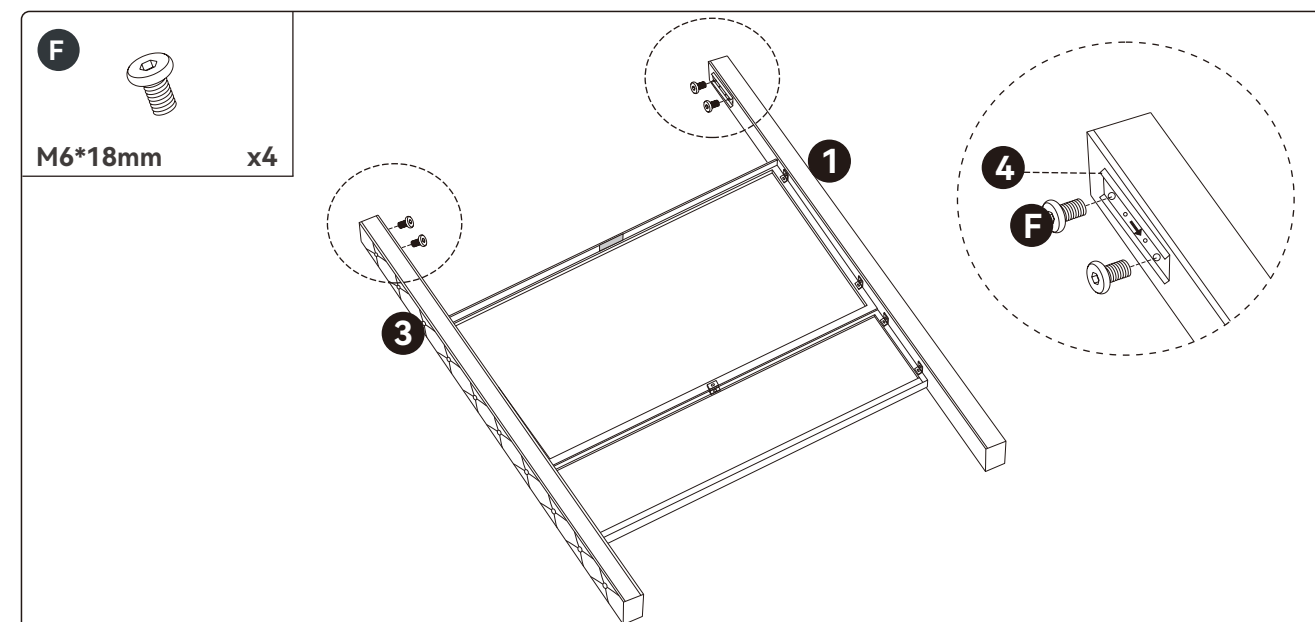
Place bed posts 1 and 3 according to the diagram, and use angle iron 21 to secure them to both sides of the headboard upper panel 19 and the headboard lower panel 20, connecting with bolt B.

Note:

1. Bed posts 1 and 3 have specific hole orientations. Do not mix them up.
2. First install all bolts, including those previously not fully tightened, and then tighten all bolts completely.

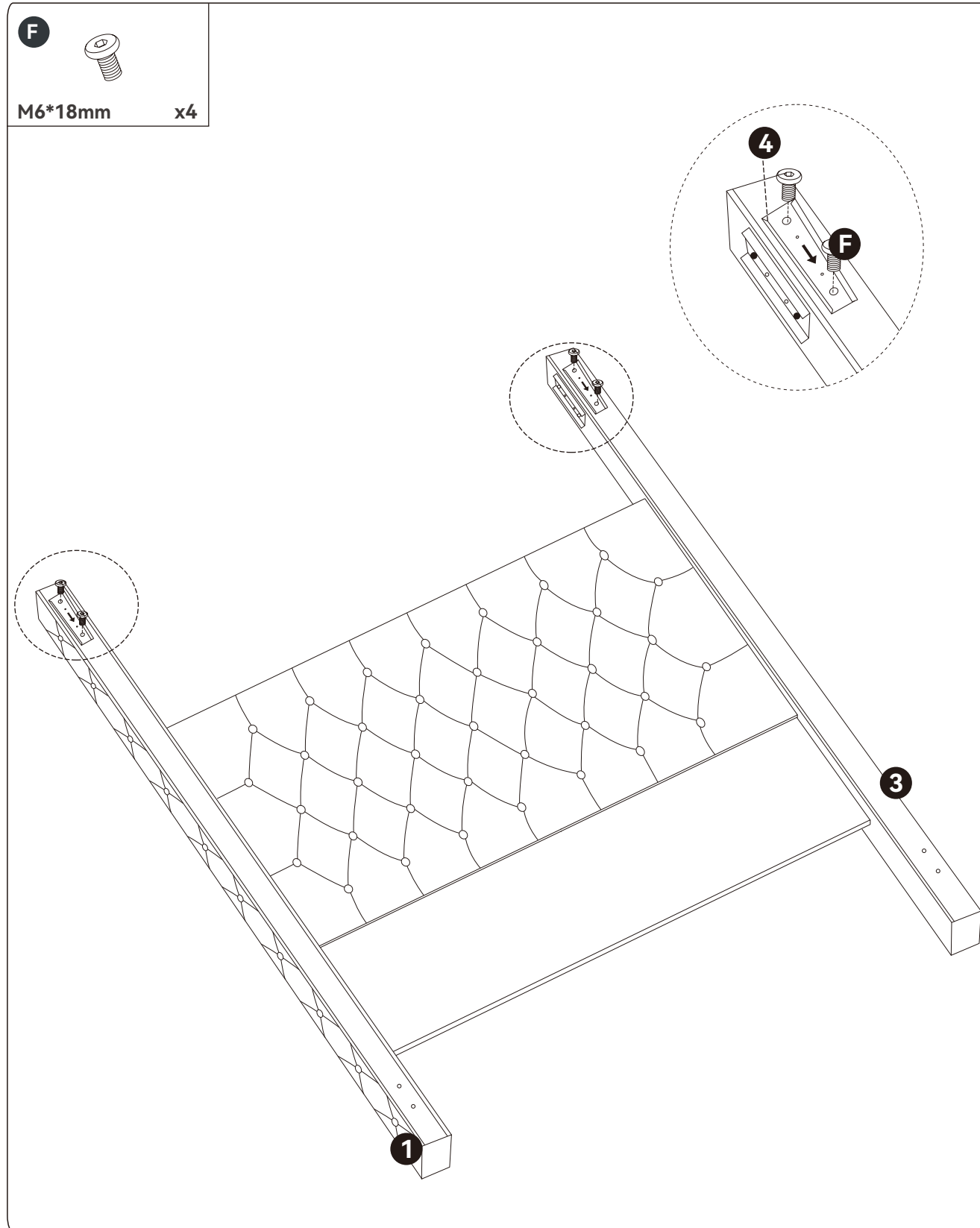


Install insert piece 4 on the upper side of bed posts 1 and 3, and secure it with bolt F.

Note: Pay attention to the arrow direction on insert piece 4.

Step 5

Headboard Section

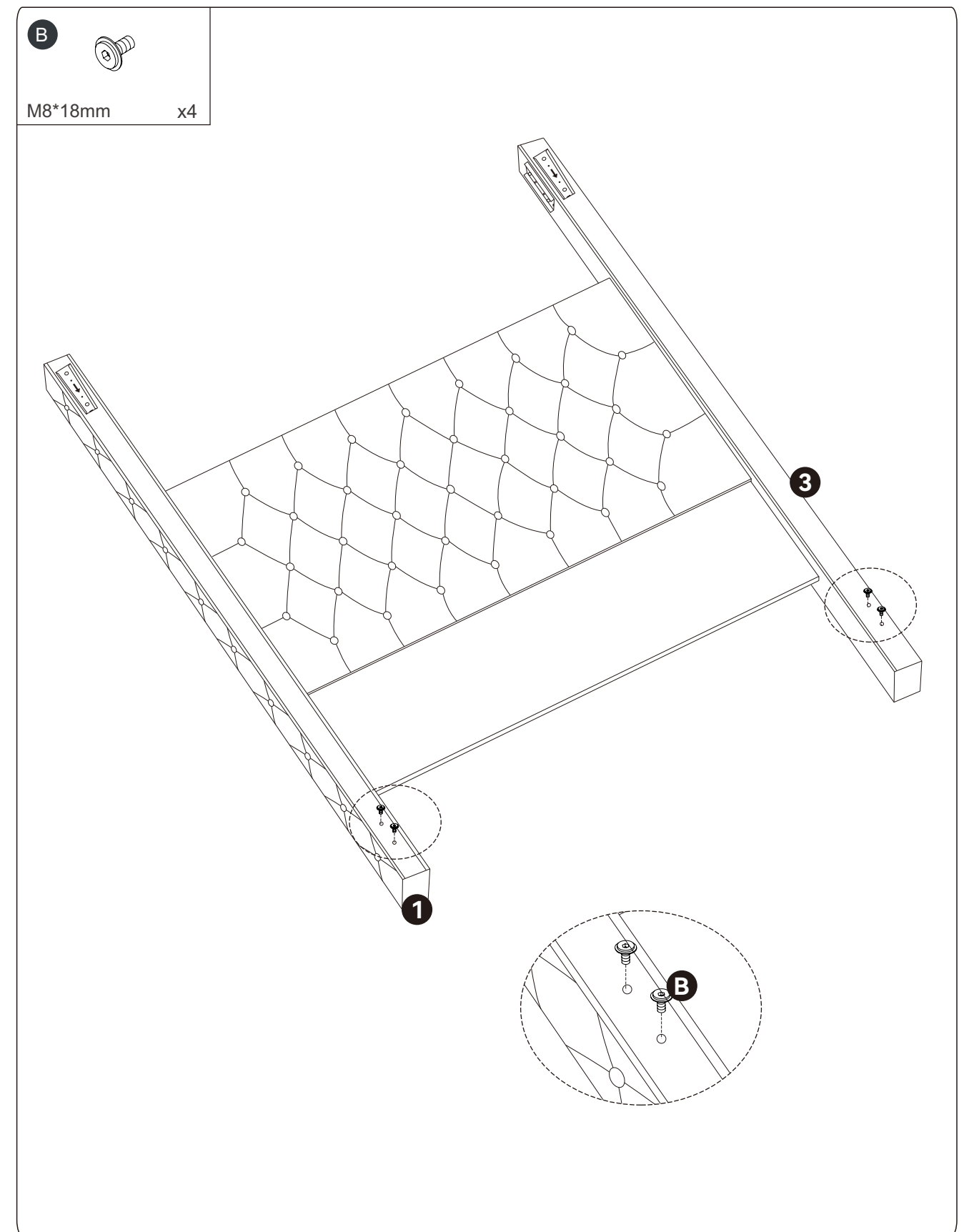


Turn the headboard over to the front side, then install insert piece 4 on the upper side of bed posts 1 and 3, and secure it with bolt F.

Note: Pay attention to the arrow direction on insert piece 4.

Headboard Section

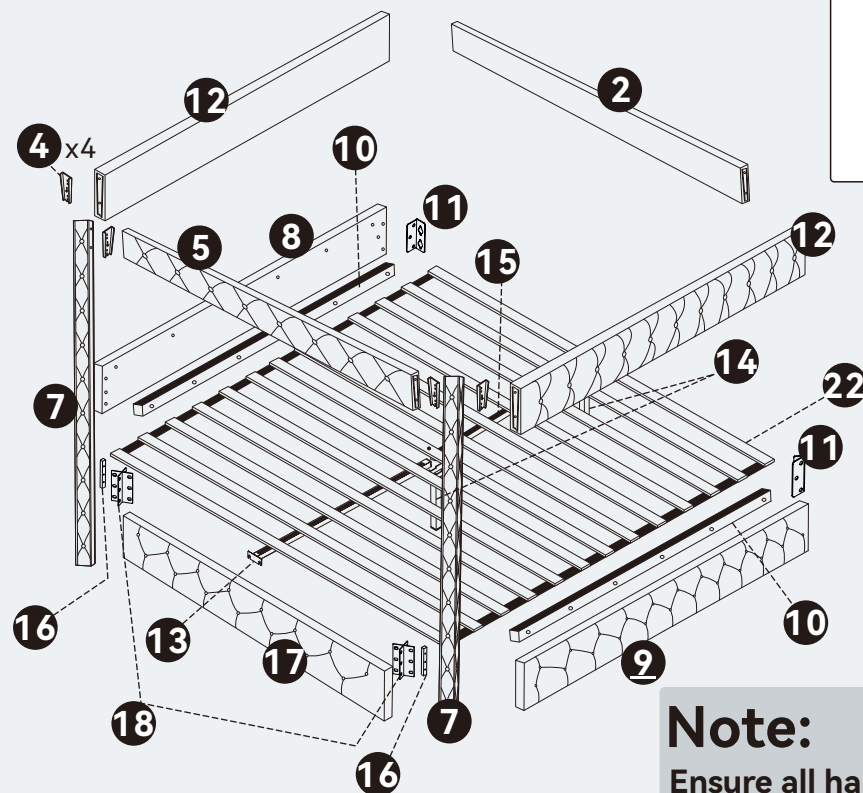


Pre-install bolt B at the corresponding hole positions on the lower side of bed posts 1 and 3, tightening it to 70% to facilitate later installation.

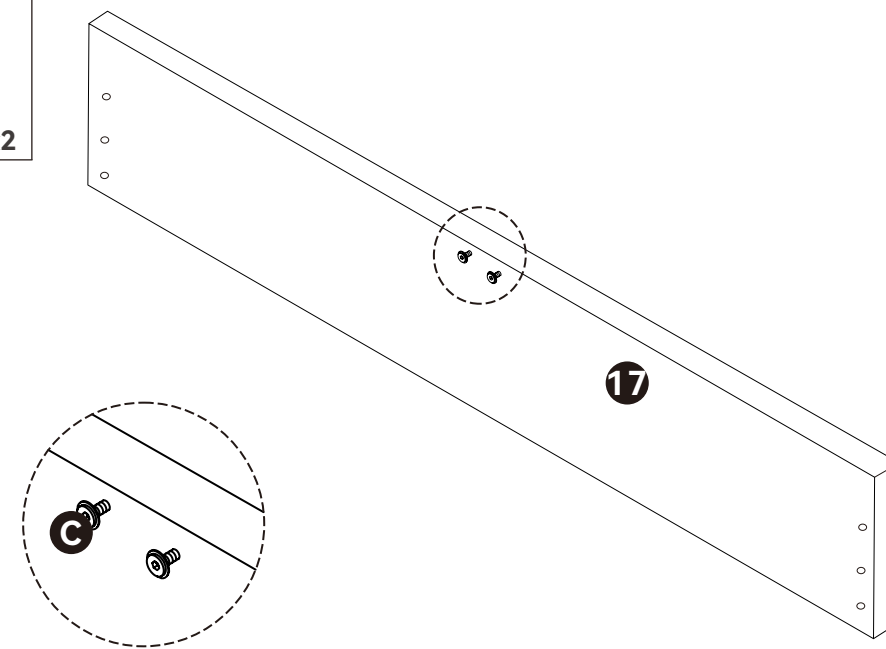

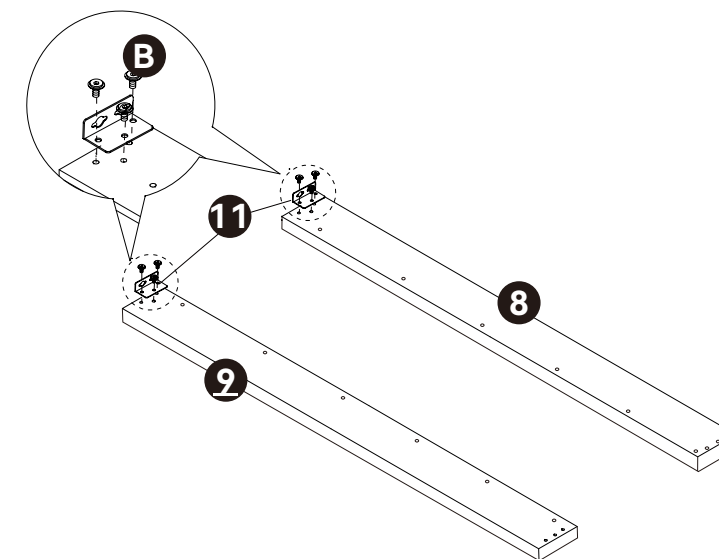
Pre-install bolt B on the footboard panel 17, tightening it to 70% to facilitate later installation.

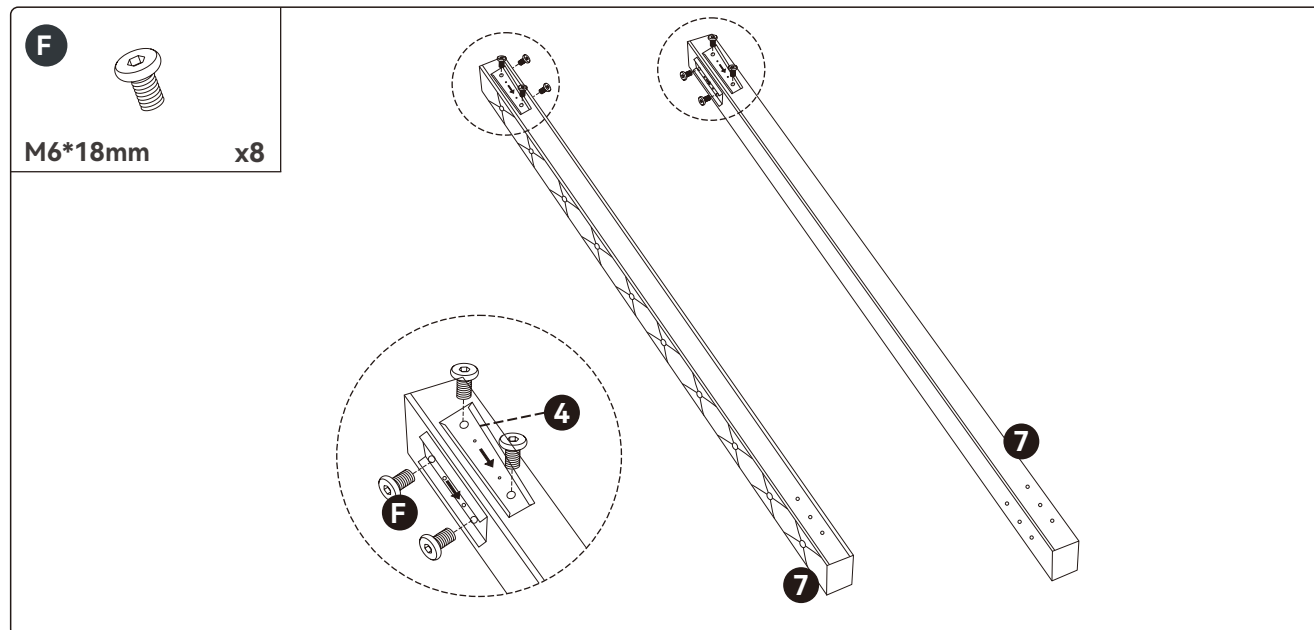
Install bracket 11 into the triangular holes on bed side panels 8 and 9, and secure it with screw bolt B.

Note:

- 1.First screw in all the screw bolts, then tighten them completely.
- 2.Pay attention to the orientation of the holes when positioning the bed side panels.

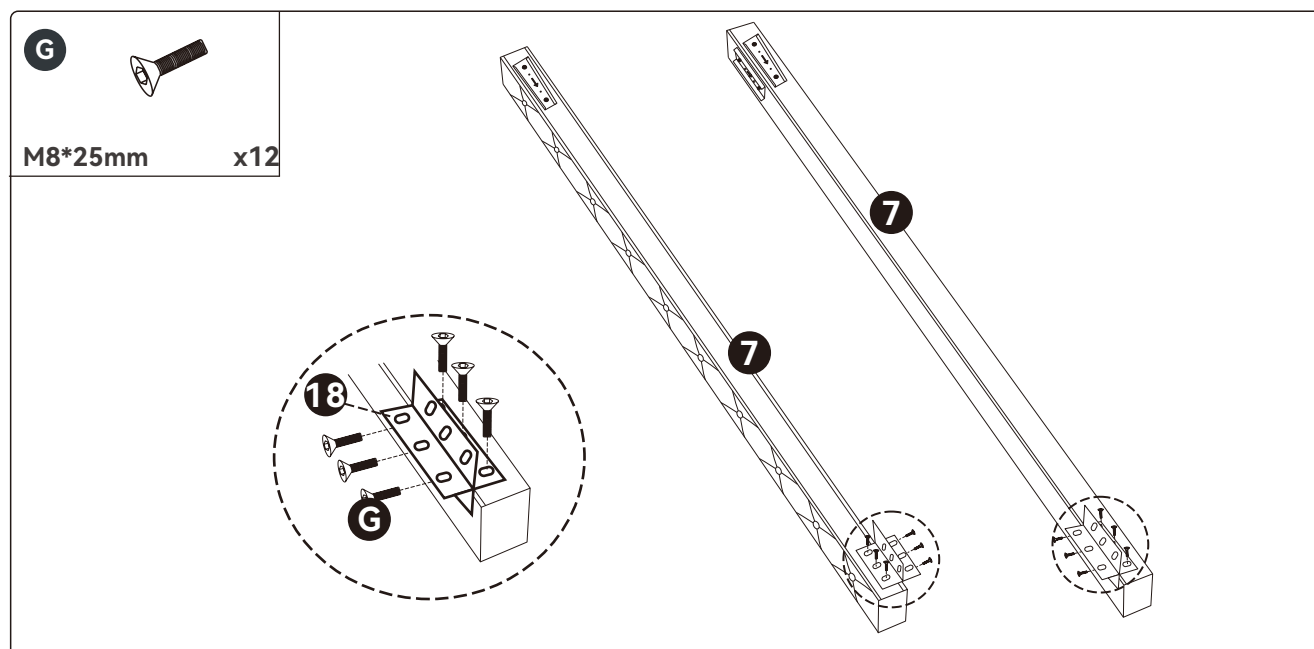
Install insert piece 4 on the top of bed post 7 as shown in the diagram, and secure it with screw bolt F.

Note:

1. Bed post 7 has specific hole orientations—do not install it in the wrong direction.
2. Pay attention to the arrow direction on insert piece 4.

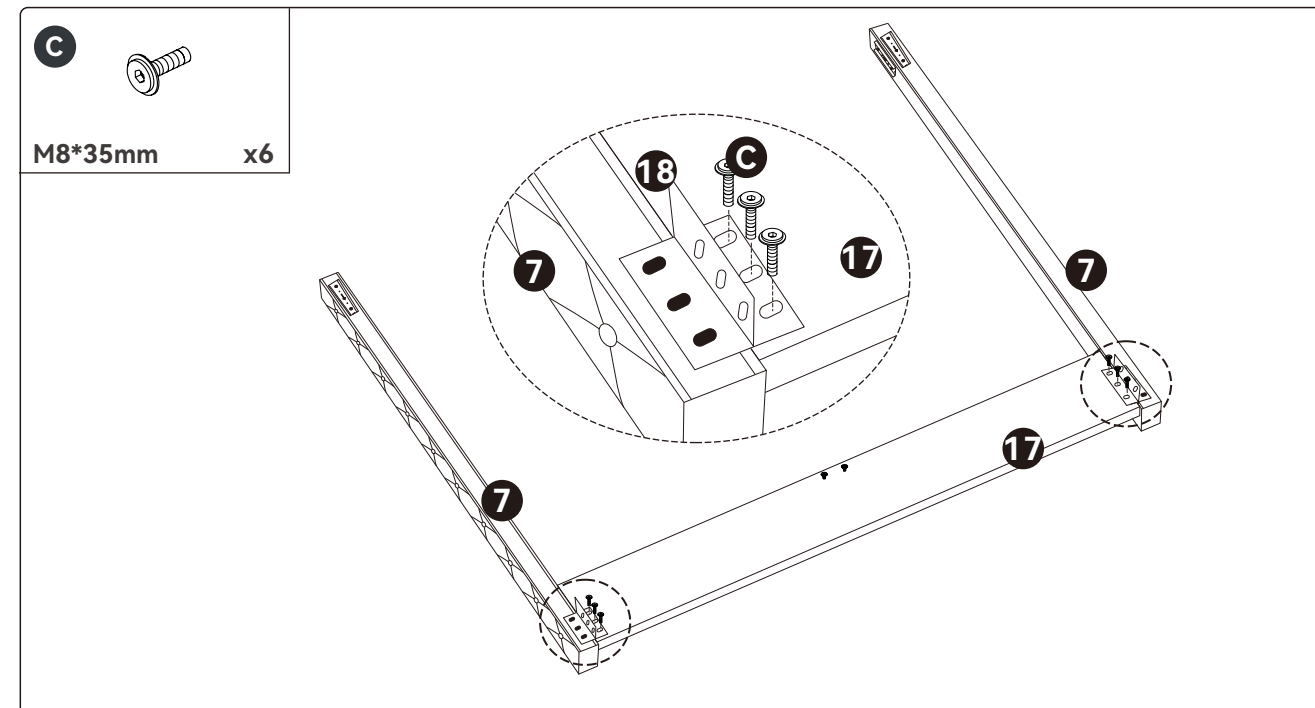
Install cross bracket 18 on the lower part of bed post 7, and secure it with screw bolt G.

Note:

1. Pay attention to the assembly orientation of bracket 18.
2. First screw in all the screw bolts, then tighten them completely.

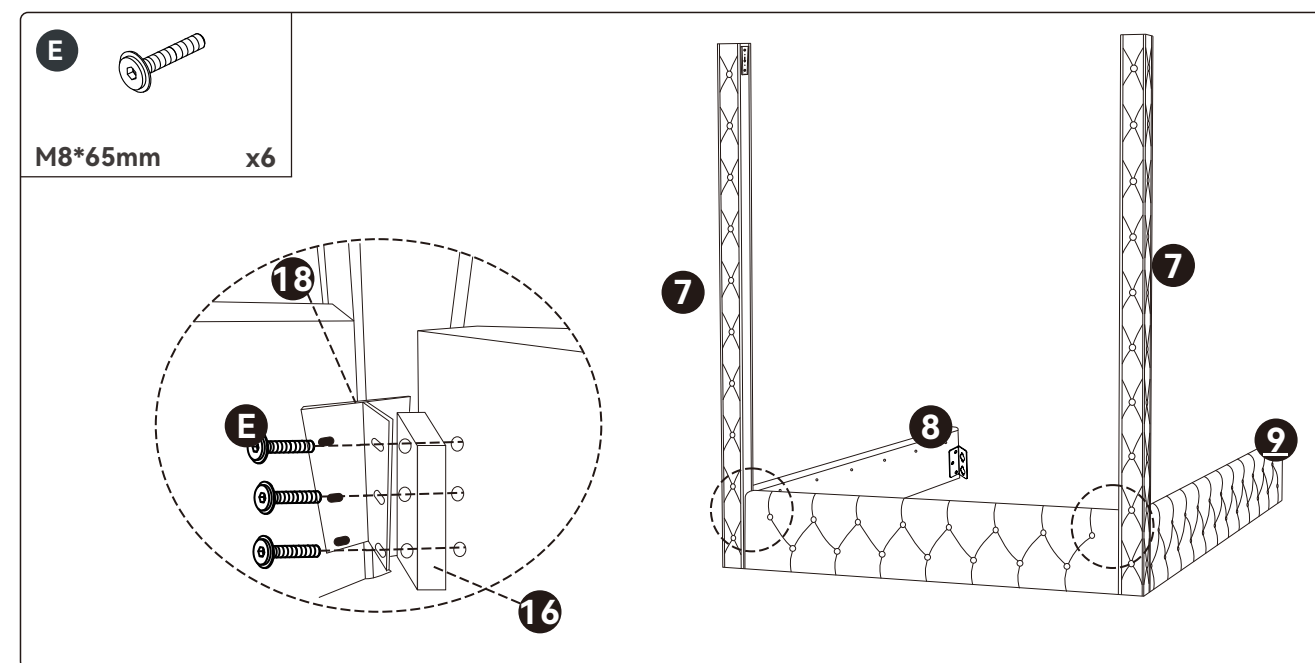


Install bed posts 7 on both sides of bed footboard 17, connect them using cross bracket 18, and secure with screw bolt C.

Note: First screw in all the screw bolts, then tighten them completely.

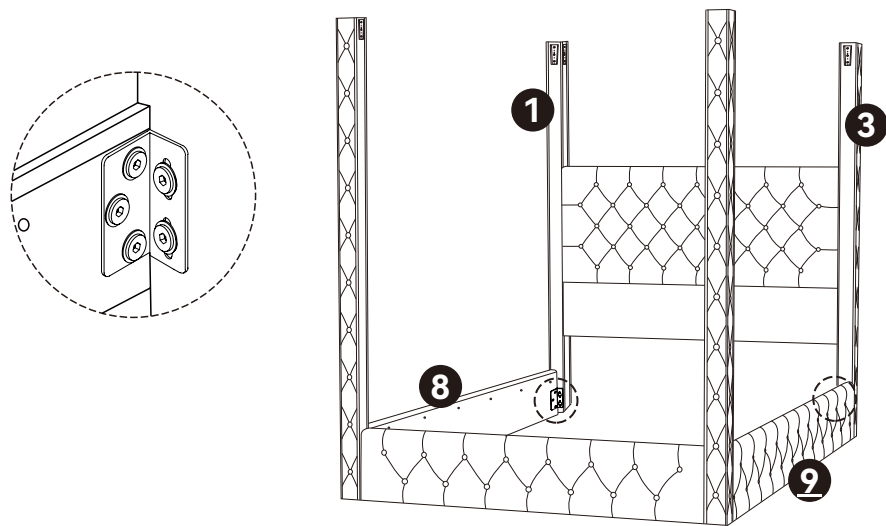


Place bed side panels 8 and 9 as shown in the diagram. Use screw bolt E to secure cross bracket 18 and wood block 16 onto side panels 8 and 9.

Note: First screw in all the screw bolts, then tighten them completely.

Connect the brackets on bed side panels 8 and 9 to the pre-assembled, untightened screw bolts on bed posts 1 and 3, then tighten the screw bolts.

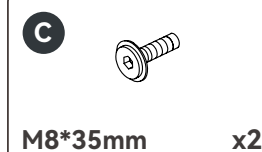
Install wood rail 10 at the corresponding holes on bed side panels 8 and 9, and secure it with screw bolt D.

Note:

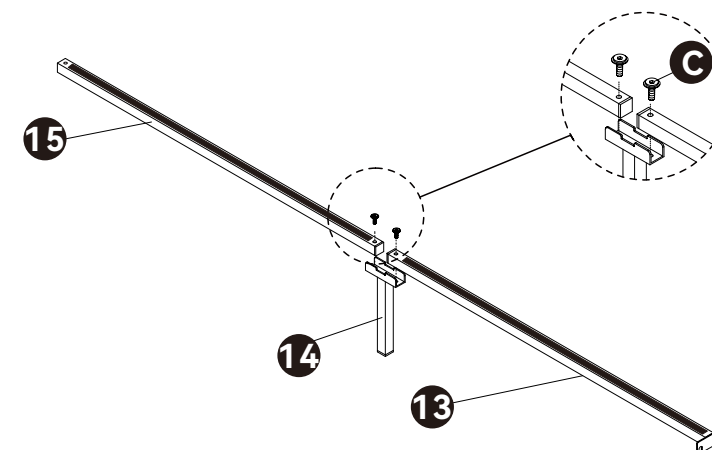
1. The black Velcro should face upward.
2. First screw in all the screw bolts, then tighten them completely.

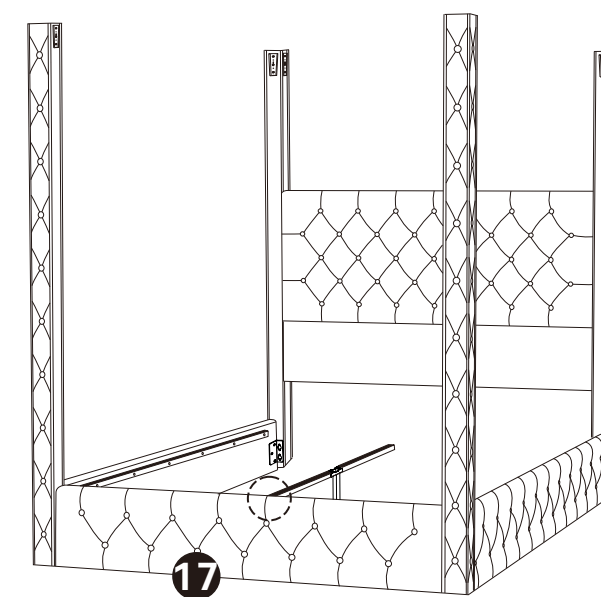
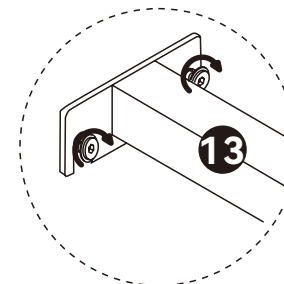


Use middle leg 14 to connect metal tubes 13 and 15, and secure them with screw bolt C.

Note: The black silent foam should face upward.

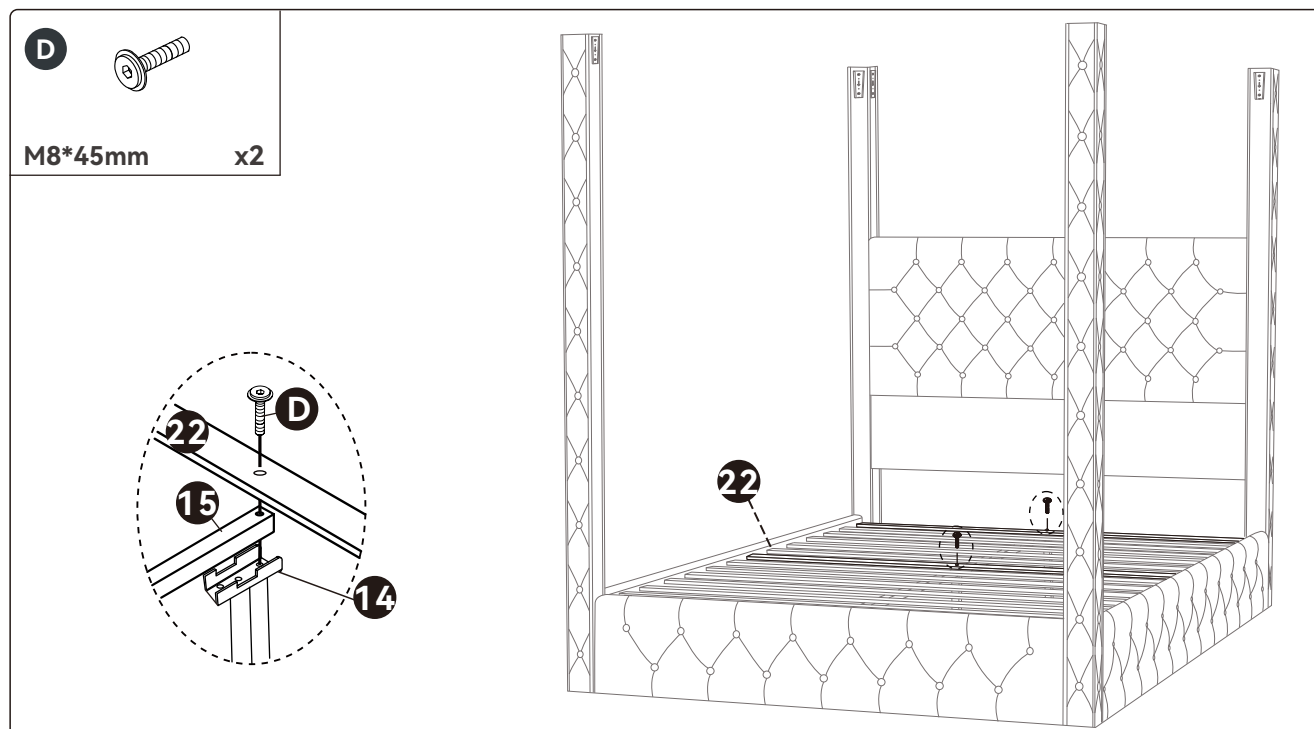

Hang metal tube 13 onto the pre-assembled screw bolts on bed footboard 17, and then tighten the screw bolts.

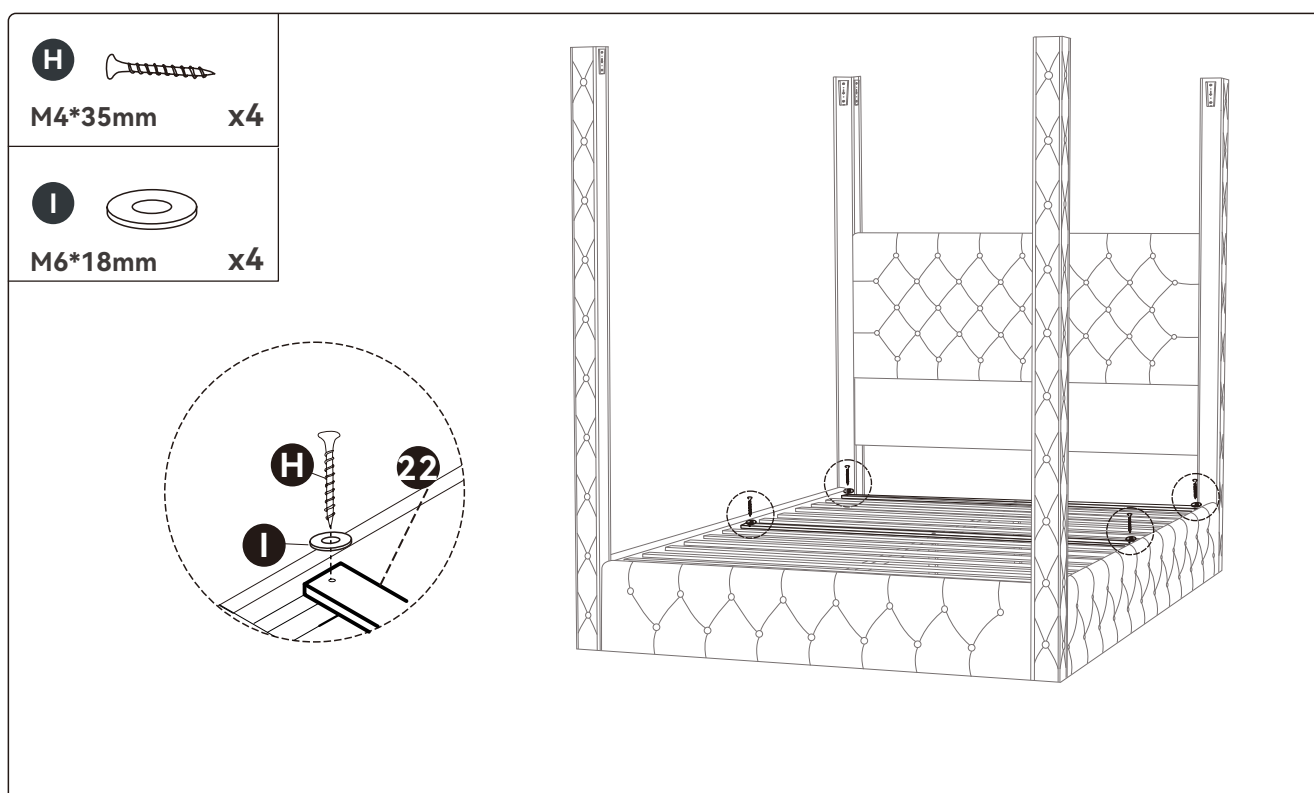

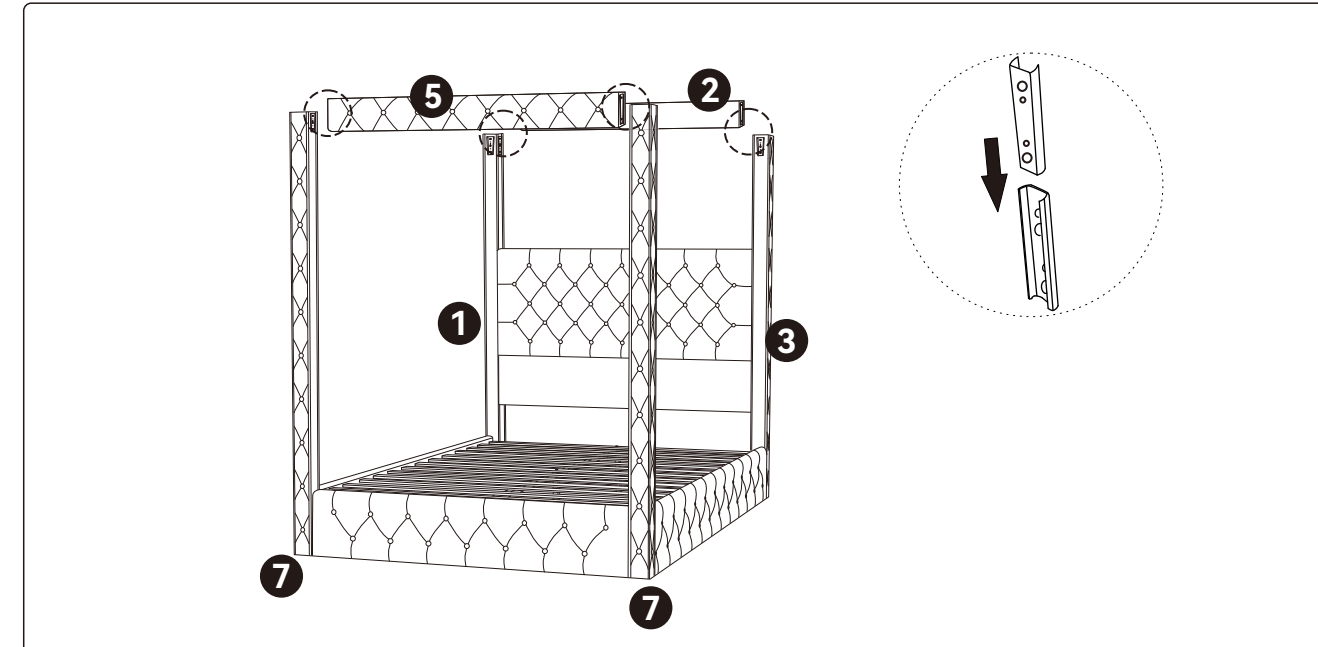

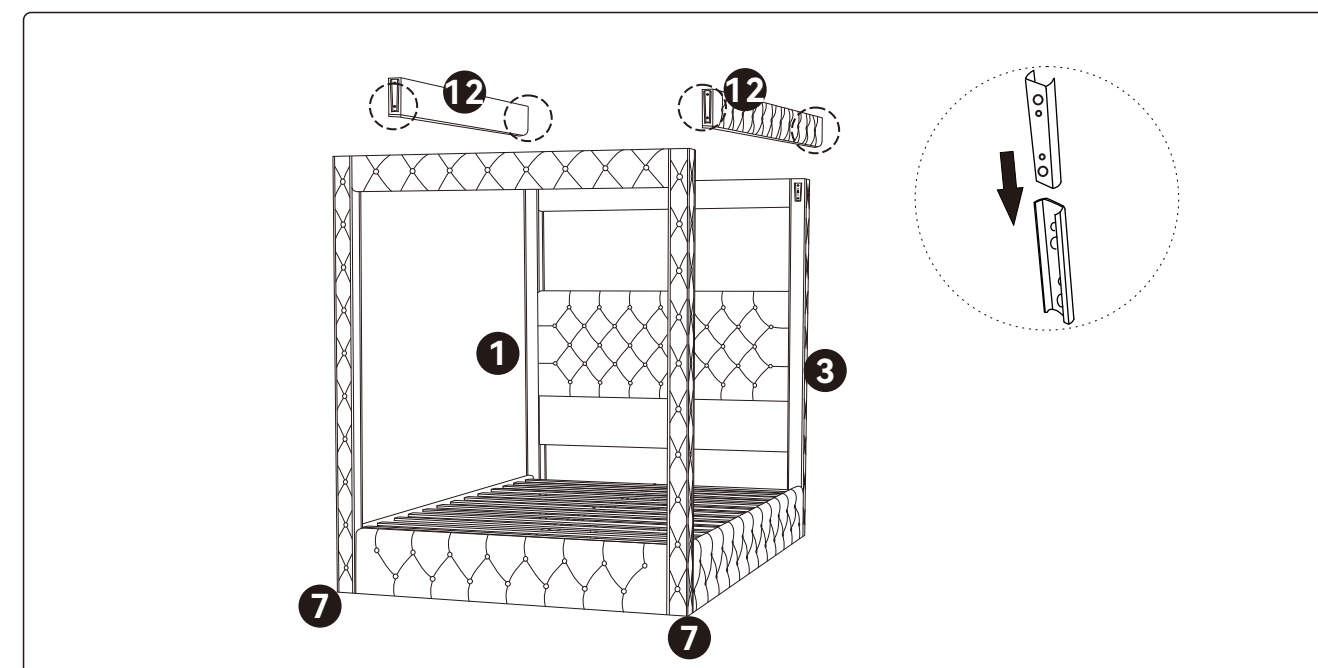

Beam 2 has a front and back orientation. The metal brackets on both sides must be inserted horizontally all the way to the bottom.

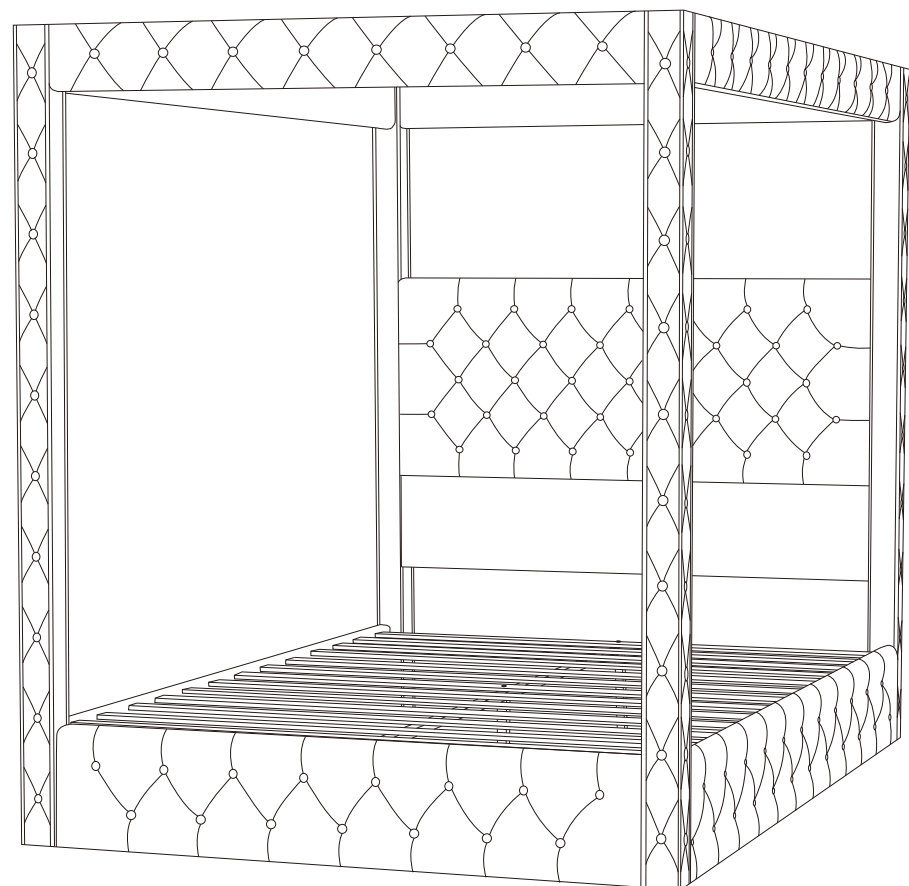
