Insert the four hooks into the slots, push them forward, and they will lock onto the metal parts.

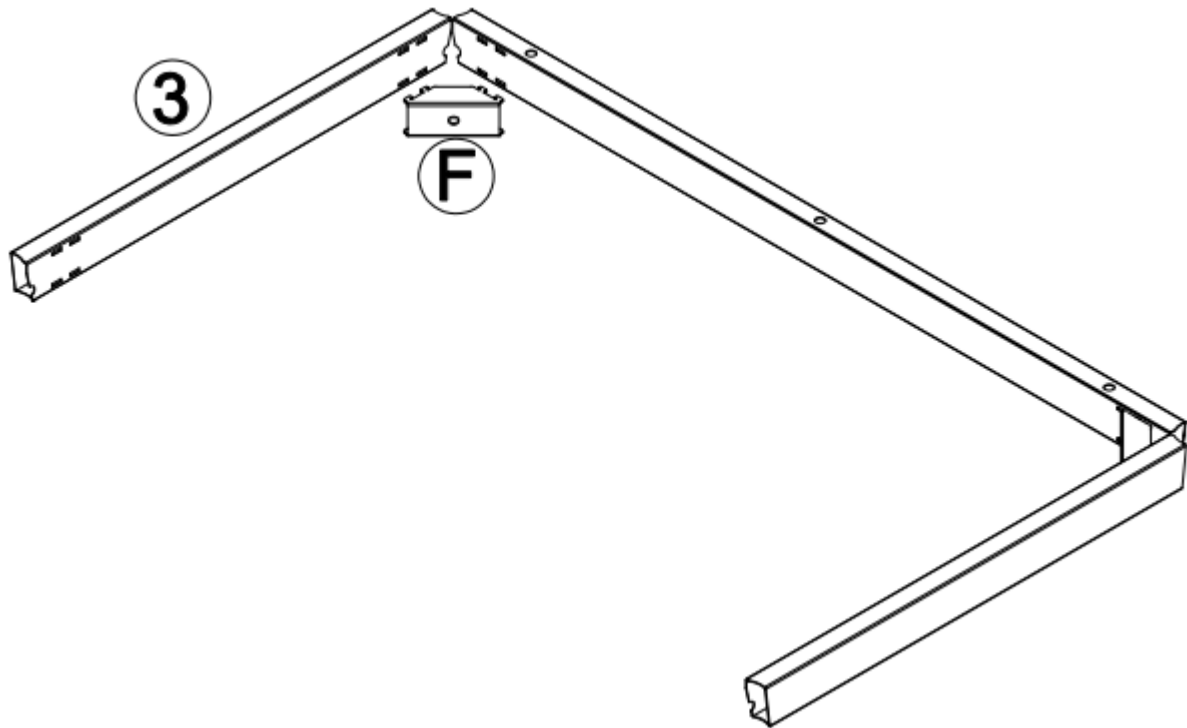
