Why do you need to clean the lighting?

- Maintain the beauty of lighting and improve the quality of home life.
- Extend the life of lighting.
- Eliminate safety hazards and improve the safety of the home environment.

Notes on cleaning!

- Cut off the power supply before deaning the lamps to ensure safety.
- When deaning the lamp, do not turn the lamp body, especially the large-sized lamp.
- · Avoid using non-lamp deaners to dean indiscriminately.

How To Clean Light Fixtures

Crystal/Glass Light (Select one of three)

- 1. When deaning, you can choose to buy a professional deaner, and then spray the right amount of deaner towards the crystal lighting, the crystal ball or crystal piece of floating dust will be taken away with the evaporation of the liquid.
- 2. Use a damp soft doth to gently wipe the front and back of the crystal beads at the same time (do not pinch the beads and pull down when wiping, so as not to break the beads).
- Just wipe away the surface dust and dirt with an anti-static dry doth. To avoid leaving fingerprints on the crystal, wear white cotton gloves when deaning.

Metal Lamp

- 1. Wipe the brackets and accessories directly with a dry soft doth. The soft doth should not be dipped in water, especially alcohol, so as not to damage the protective film outside the electroplating layer and affect the surface gloss of the lamp holder.
- 2. Available professional plating parts deaning agent.
- Stainless steel can be directly wiped with a damp doth, should avoid the stainless steel surface is scratched, accelerating corrosion.

Resin Lamp

- It is necessary to prevent and reduce the exposure of strong light.
- 2. Resin products should be deaned regularly, and can be wiped with a feather rod or dry towel.
- 3. If the resin jewelry is stained, rub it with alcohol.

Rattan / Bamboo Weave Lamp

- 1. Use a duster or vacuum deaner to remove dust from the surface of the luminaire
- Bamboo woven lamps and lanterns stain, use light salt water wipe.

Wooden Lamp

- Use a moistened dean soft cotton doth, because wet cotton doth can reduce friction and avoid scratches, and also help reduce static electricity on dust adsorption, which is conducive to removing dust from the surface. But should avoid moisture residue on the surface of the lamps, it is recommended that it is best to use a dry cotton doth to wipe again.
- Do not use sponges or tableware cleaning utensils to wipe your lamps.

Ceramic Lamp

If there is dust, stains on the ceramic lamps, to use a soft cloth to gently wipe, and do not use too hard cloth or other items to force the stain, so as not to scratch the porcelain glaze.

Mirror Lamp

- 1. Dust regularly with a clean soft cloth or furniture duster.
- 2. To clean mirrors, use a soft cloth and a mild solution of distilled white vinegar and warm water.
- Do not use window cleaners containing ammonia to clean mirror lighting fixtures.

Fabric Lamp/Fabric Lampshade

First use a small vacuum cleaner to suck away the surface dust, then pour some detergent or furniture-specific detergent on the rag and replace the position of the rag while wiping. If the inside of the lampshade is made of paper, you should avoid using detergent directly to prevent breakage.

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Outdoor Lights

- 1. Routinely wipe the exterior surface of outdoor lighting fixtures with a soft clean cloth.
- Use glass cleaner to keep the glass clean and clear.
