IMPORTANT INFO

- · Clean installation surface and brace of all dirt and dust with a clean cloth or dry sponge.
- It is highly recommended that you paint/finish our braces before installation.
- Once installed, you can apply any necessary touch-up paint/finish.
- · You can use standard woodworking tools to cut or drill.
- · Hot-dipped galvanized or stainless steel nails/screws are best for Signature Urethane trim.
- · Fill fastener holes in with Signature Urethane acrylic caulk.
- · Glue joints and miters together with PL Premium.
- Use 100% acrylic paint before installing, finish with final coat to cover caulk holes.

INSTALL INSTRUCTIONS:

Mitering Corners

- Place moulding in the miter box with the wall side against the side of the miter box opposite you and the ceiling touching side against the bottom of the box.
- 2. Cut miters and butt joins prior to installation.

Moulding Installation

- Apply a continuous 1/2" bead of PL Premium adhesive along the top and back of moulding lengths. Press moulding into place. (Diagram A)
- 2. Secure the moulding in place with finishing nails (Diagram B)
- 3. Apply caulk in remaining gaps and smooth with finger.
- 4. Lightly sand any touch-up areas and paint as needed.
