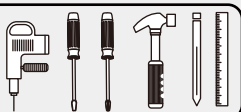

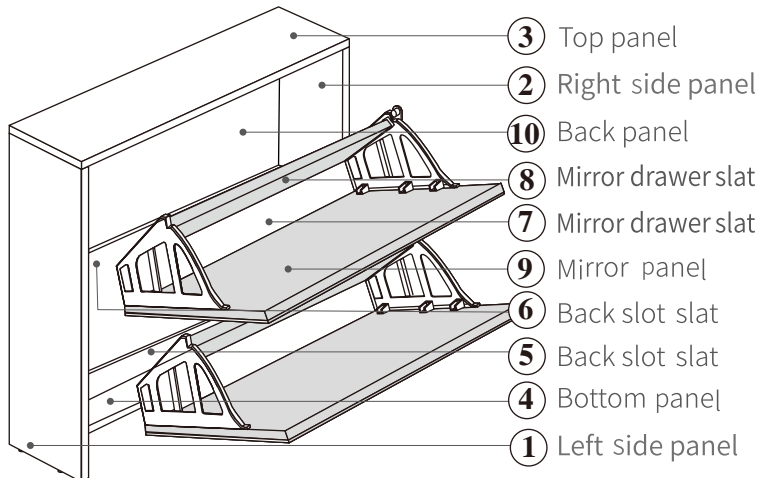
TIPS AND WARNINGS:

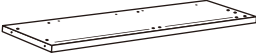
Cleaning with a dry cloth.

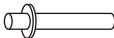
Far away from water or wet shoes.

INSTALLATION STEPS

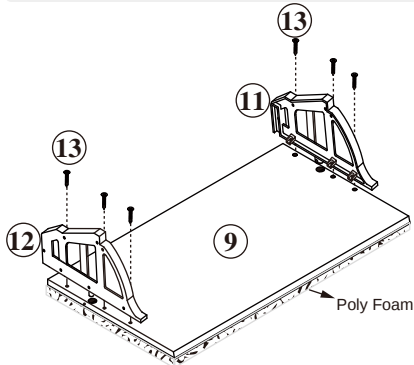
Please read the instructions carefully before assembling the cabinet.

Two adults are required for assembly of this product on a clean, flat surface instead of a rough surface.

STEP 1 | Assemble mirror drawer

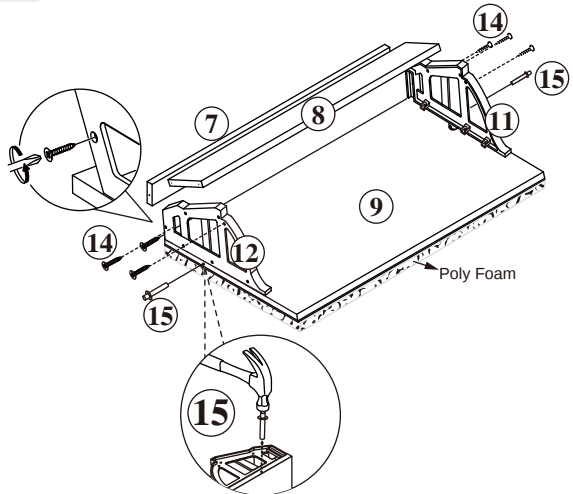

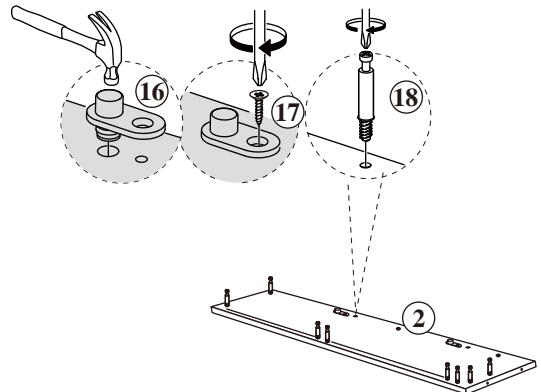
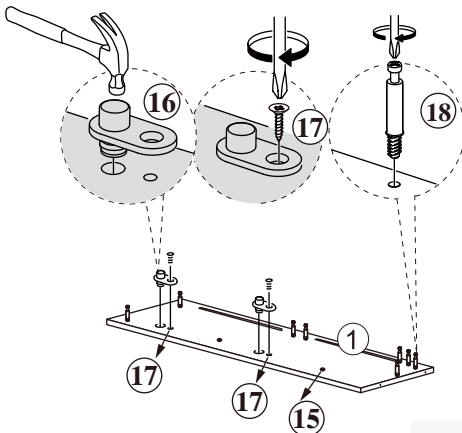
Put ⑦ ⑧ board into slot.

STEP 2 | Screw on the side panels



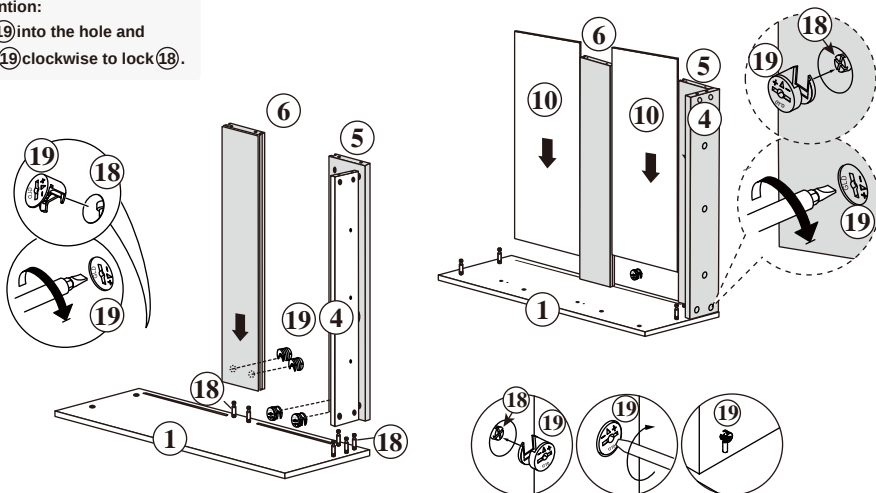

STEP 3 | Assemble the back slats and back panels

Attention:

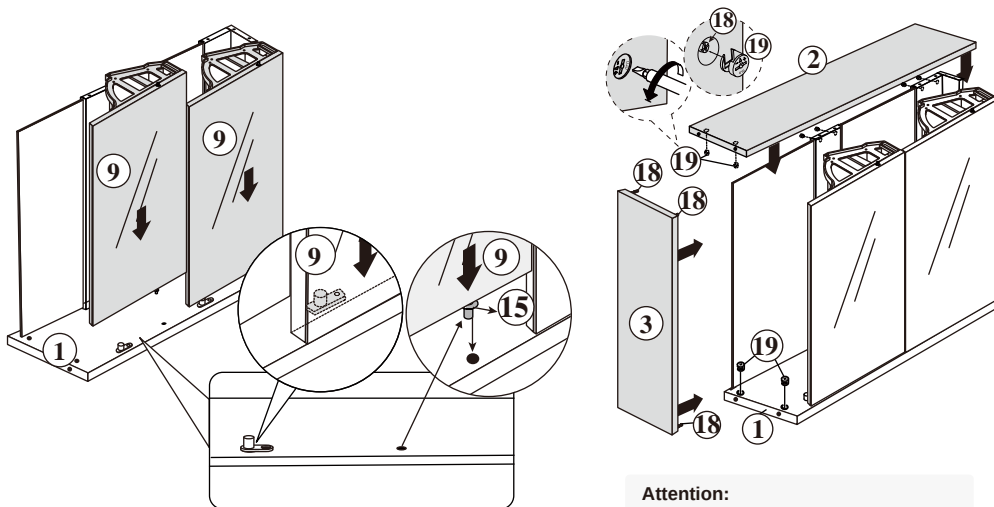
Put **19** into the hole and turn **19** clockwise to lock **18**.



Attention:

Make sure side panel fall into slots, if the side panel is not fully fit, please tap the side panel tightly to adjust.

STEP 4 | Insert the mirror drawer and locked with screws



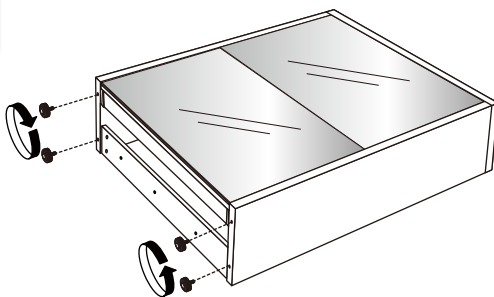
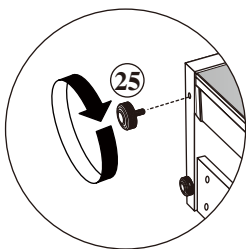
Attention:

Make sure all screws locked tightly.

STEP 5 | Install the foot pads

Attention:

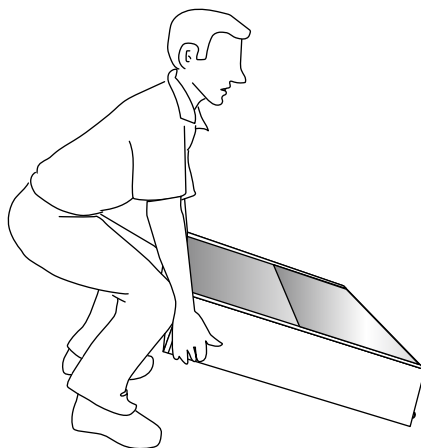
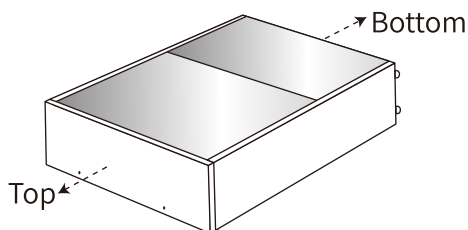
If you bought a 2+3 combination shoe cabinet, please do not install foot pads.



STEP 6 | Lift the shoe cabinet and straighten it

ATTENTION

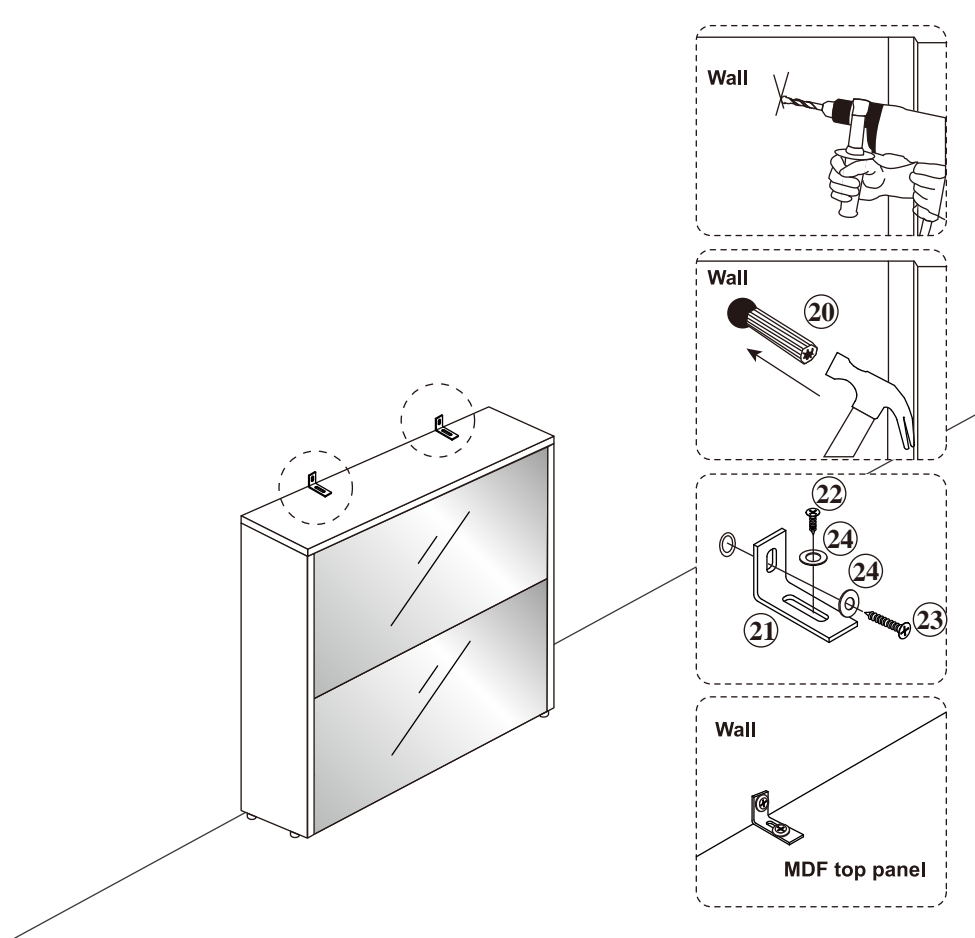
Place the installed shoe cabinet flat on the ground then raise it up using two people. **Mirror** must on the top when you raise it up. Do not let the moveable door panel fall off.



STEP 7 | Insert the anti-falling screws.

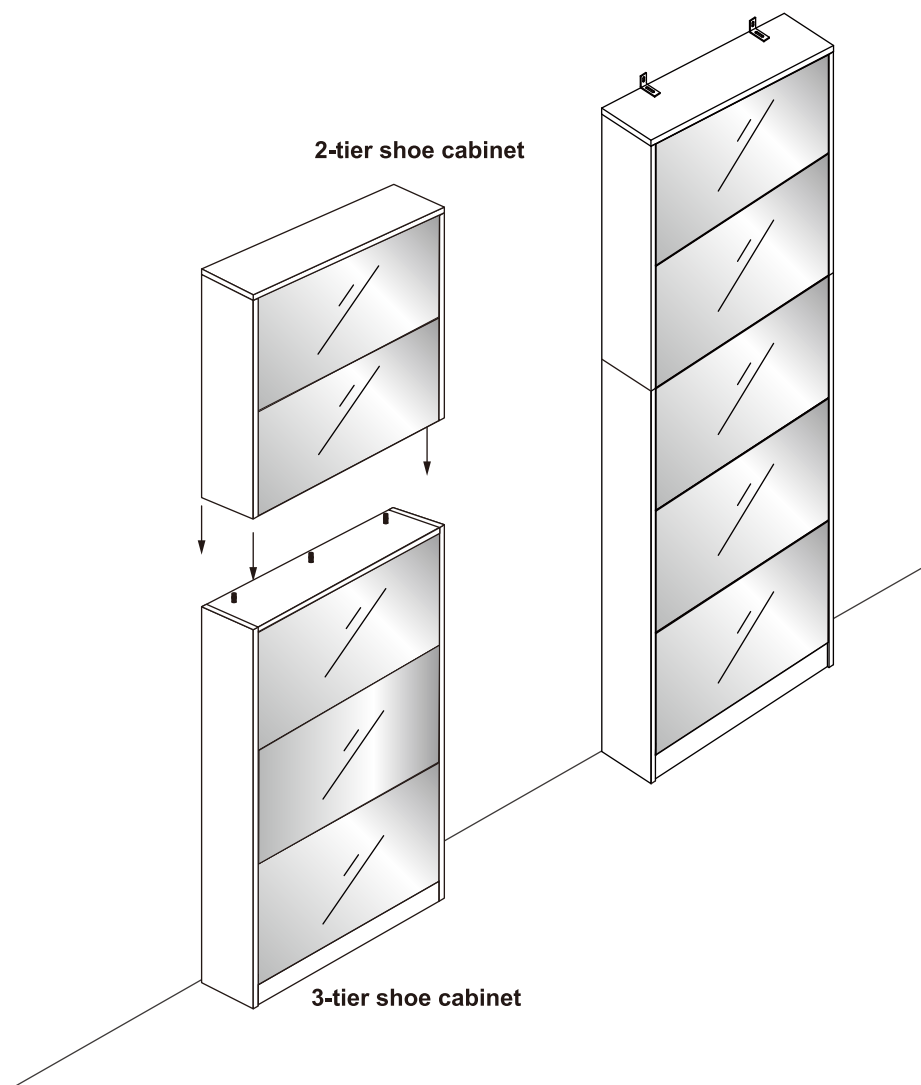

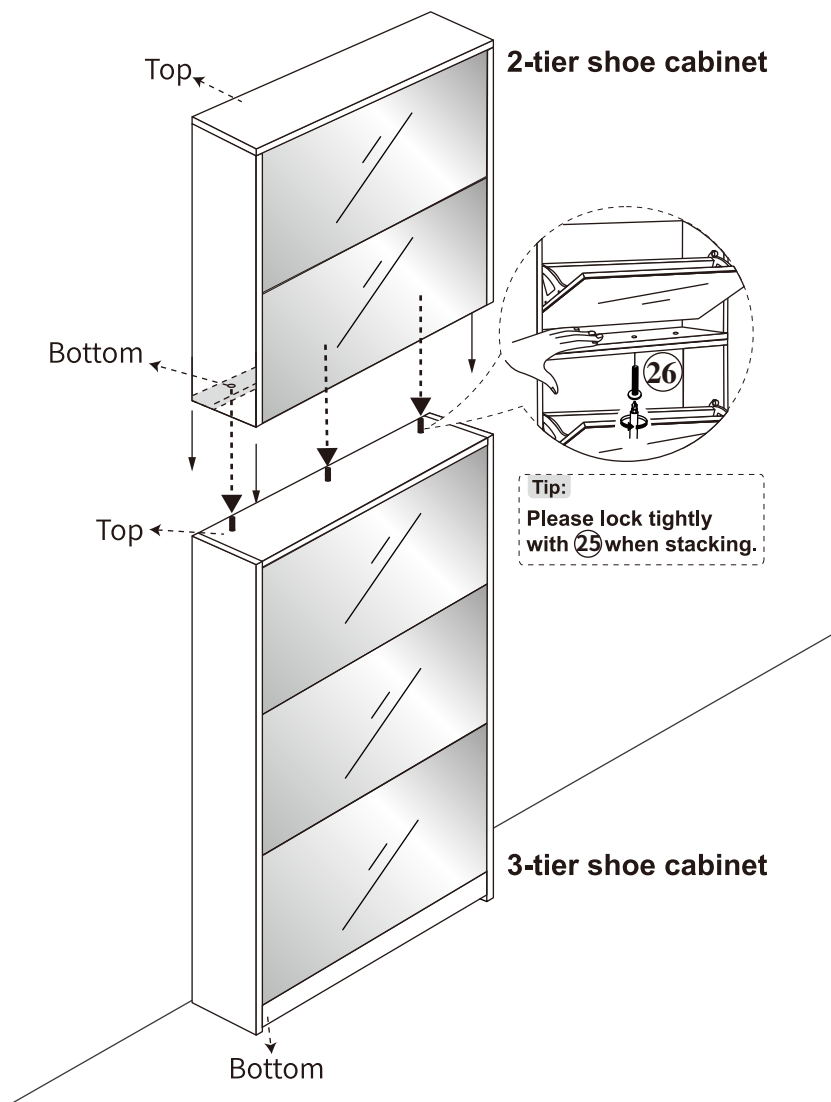
If you have bought the 2-Tier and 3-Tier shoe cabinets and want to assemble them together, follow the steps below to assemble them.
