Assembly:

- 1- Connect Pole (B) to Head (C), making sure to pull excess wire out from the bottom of the pole so that it does not get clipped in the threading.
- 2- Connect assembled lamp body to Base (A), then plug power supply cord (D) into lamp first, then outlet, and power on.

Operation and Features:

Max watts- 14.5

The Libra Floor Lamp is controlled via a three step foot pedal switch located on the lamp cord. Simply tap the button to turn on and cycle through the dimmer settings. It can be turned on and off via a wall switch for convenience, but it cannot be dimmed except by the touch sensor on the lamp. When using the lamp with a wall switch, it will remember its settings: if you turn the switch off with the lamp set to a lower brightness level, it will stay on the same lower level when you turn the switch back on.
