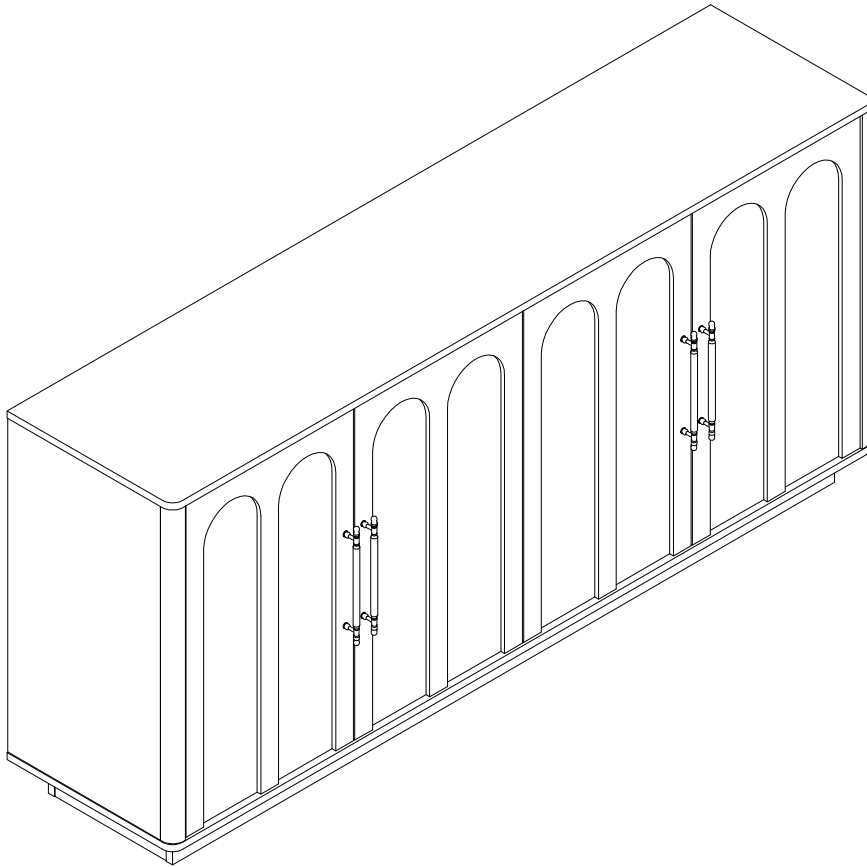

- This summary may not include every detail of all variations and considered steps. Please contact us when further information and help are needed.

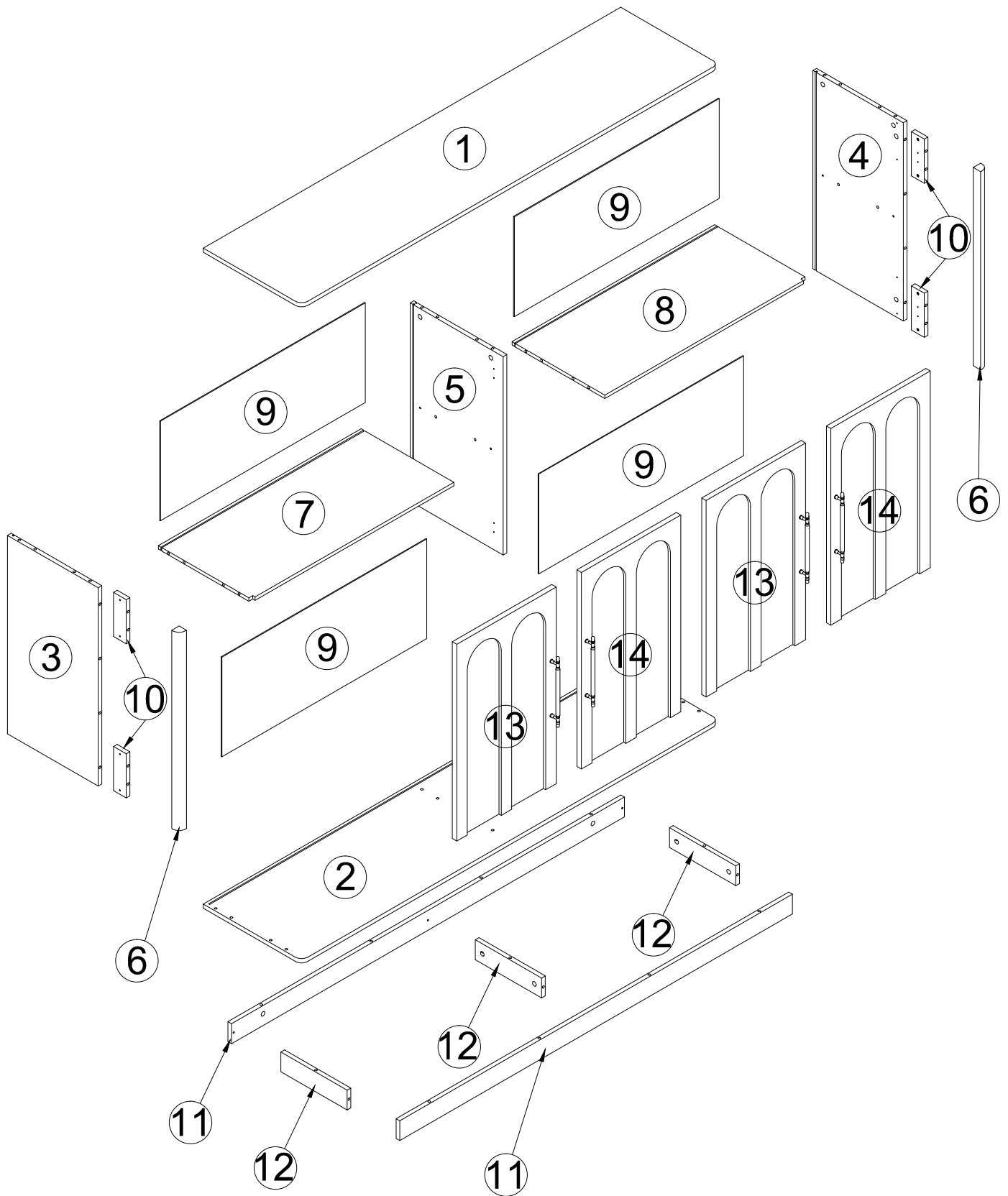
Notes

- Do not place any hot objects on the surface of the product.
- If there are any defective or missing parts after unpacking, please cease assembly immediately and contact us.
- Please assemble the item on a spacious surface and do not place the unwrapped product directly on the ground to avoid product damage.
- Please do not stand or sit on the wooden boards.
- Please wear gloves during the assembly and/or disassembly process to avoid scratches from any sharp edges.
- Please match the corresponding part and fitting based on the part number in the manual.
- If the part does not match with the fitting, please check the piece as specified in this manual.
- During assembly, first loosely align all screws with the corresponding pre-drilled holes and then tighten the screws one by one.
- Periodically inspect screw tightness while the product is in use. If necessary, retighten to ensure structural integrity.
- If you accidentally spill water or another liquid on the surface, immediately wipe clean with a dry towel.
- Please keep the product away from sharp, pointed objects and corrosive substances to prevent product damage.
- Please place this item on level, solid ground during use.

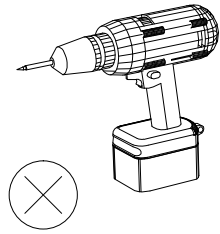
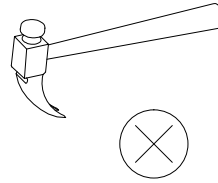
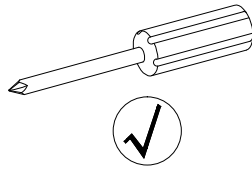
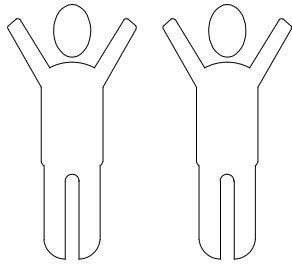
Warnings

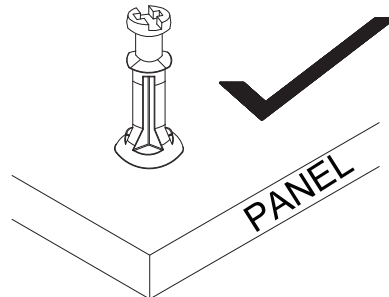
Tools Required



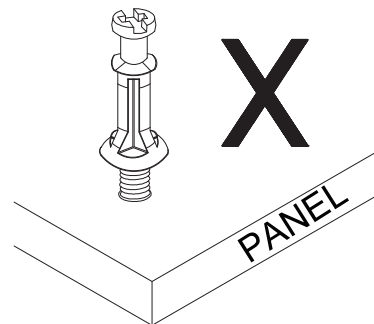
INSERTING AND TIGHTENING CAM-BOLT



Place Cam-bolt on pre-drilled hole and screw in vertically



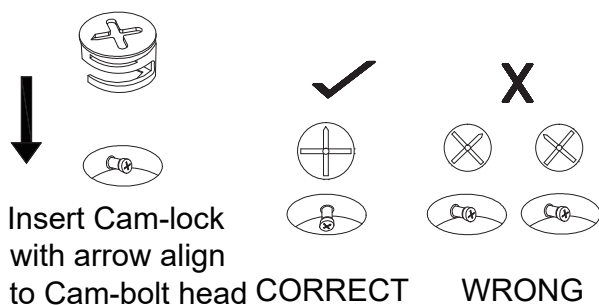
Shoulder is flushed (on the same level) with the panel.



Shoulder is above the panel.

Place Cam-bolt on the designated pre-drilled holes on the panel. Use a Phillips Screwdriver to screw-in Cam-bolt vertically until shoulder is flushed (on the same level) with panel.

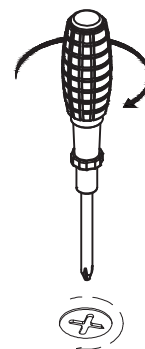
INSERTING CAM-LOCK



Insert Cam-lock with arrow align to Cam-bolt head **CORRECT** **WRONG**

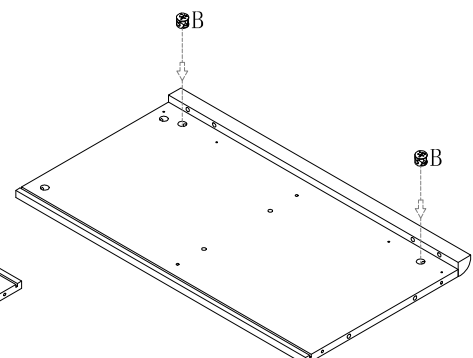
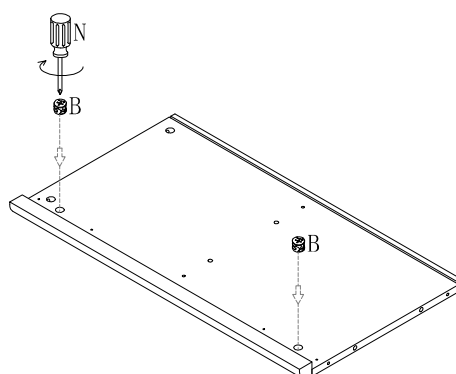
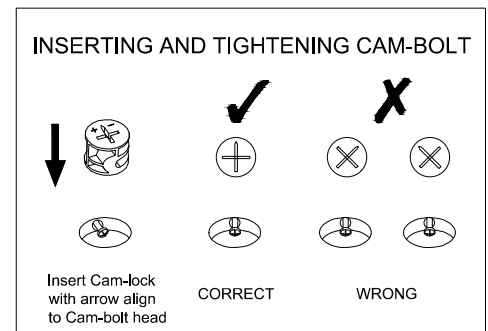
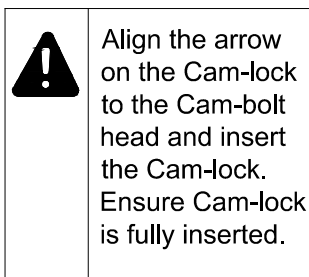
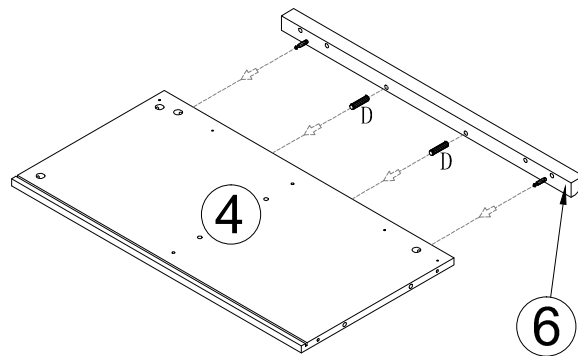
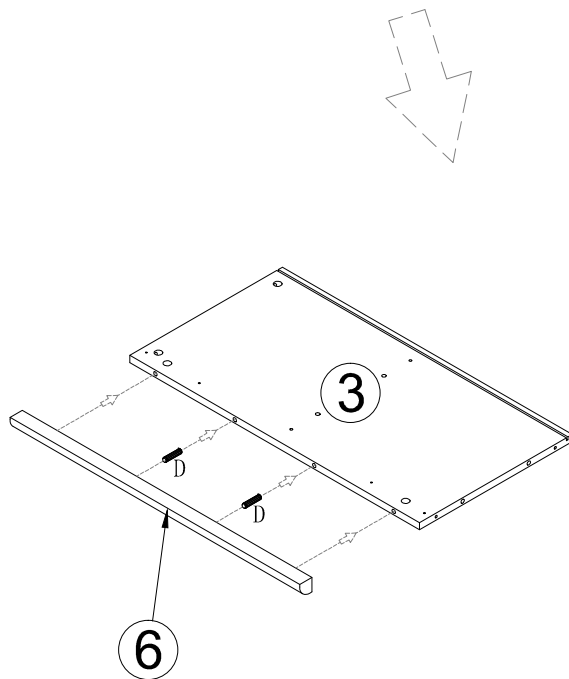
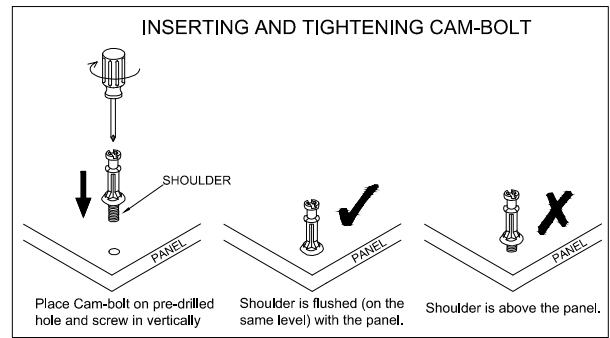
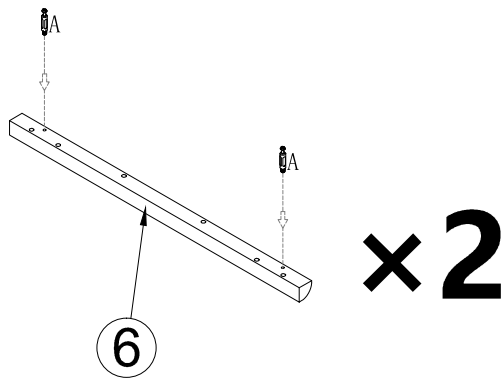
Align the arrow on the Cam-lock to the Cam-bolt head and insert the Cam-lock. Ensure Cam-lock is fully inserted.

TIGHTENING CAM-LOCK



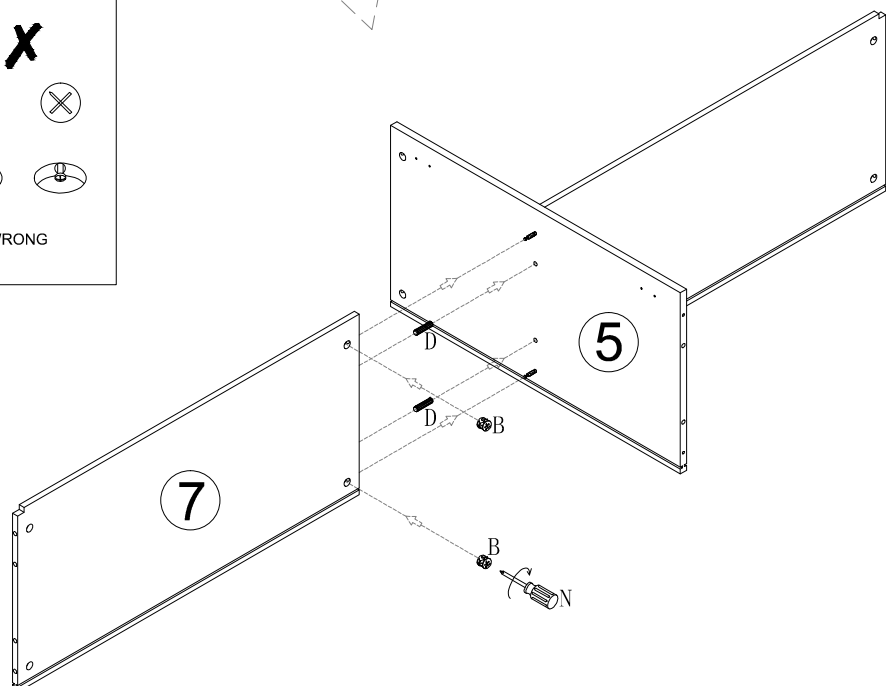
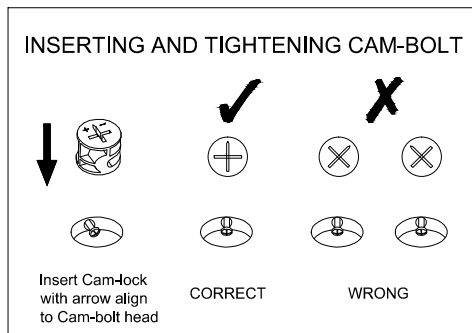
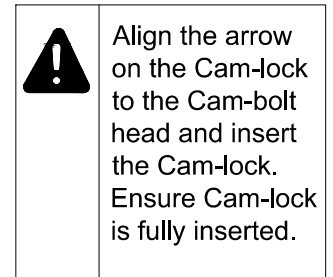
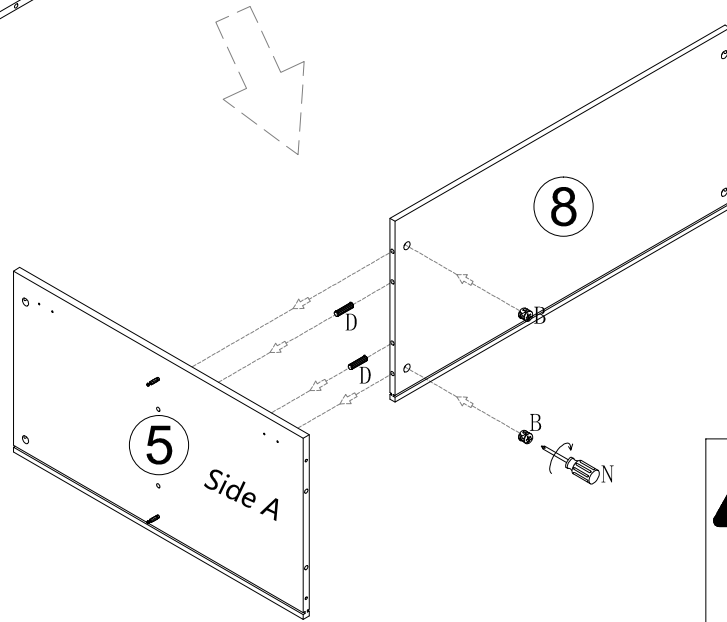
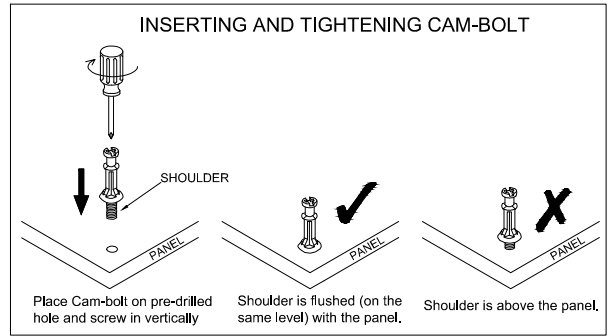
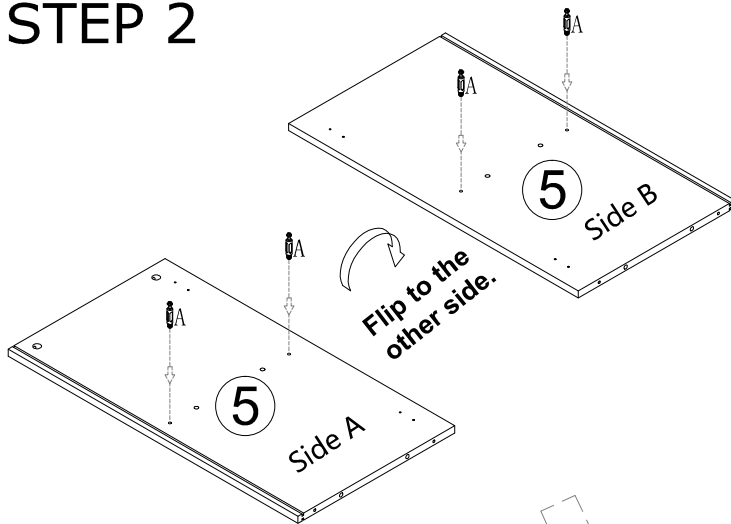
Use a Flat-head Screwdriver to turn Camlock clockwise so it locks onto the head of the Cam-bolt. Turn until it is snug (about 3/4ths of a turn) -- over-tightening could damage Cam-lock or/and Cam-bolt.

Description: Insert the thinner end of the reinforcement into the gap in this back panel, then tighten the screws. This will make the cabinet more stable.



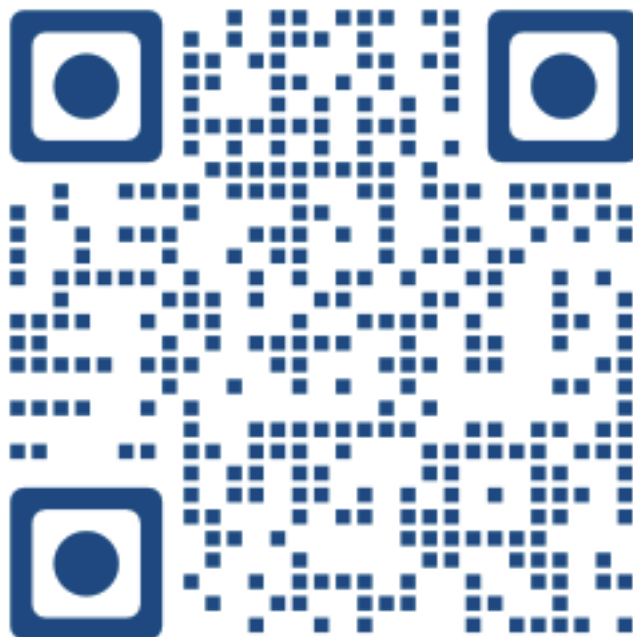


Hinge Adjustment (Door Alignment)

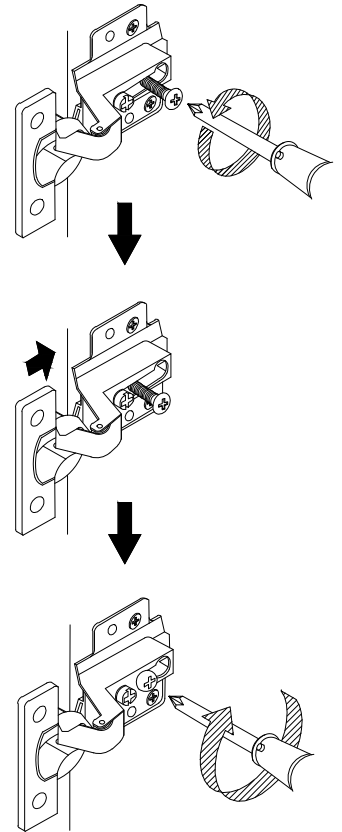
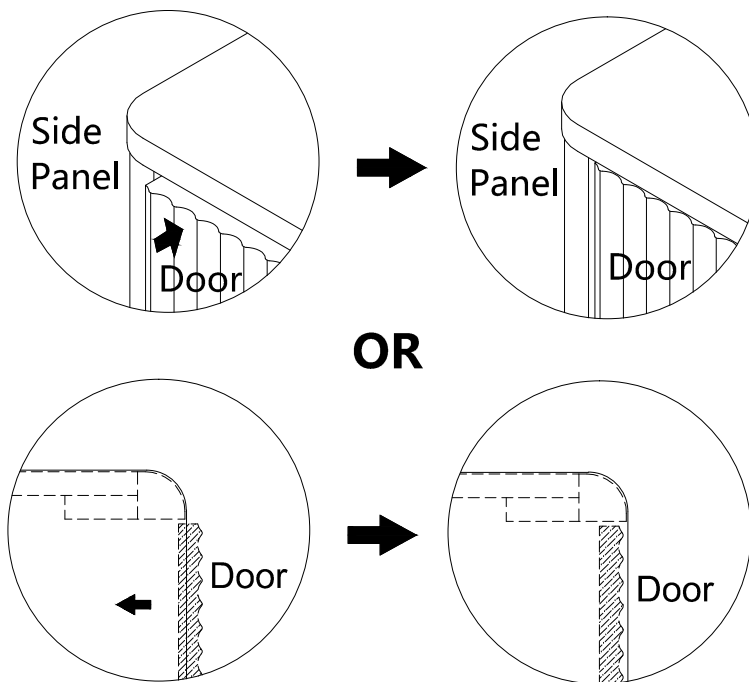
Scan the QR code to watch the hinge adjustment video.
If you notice any of the issues below, follow these steps:

Front screw: Adjusts the gap between the door and the side panel (left/right).

Rear screw: Adjusts the door position front-to-back (in/out)

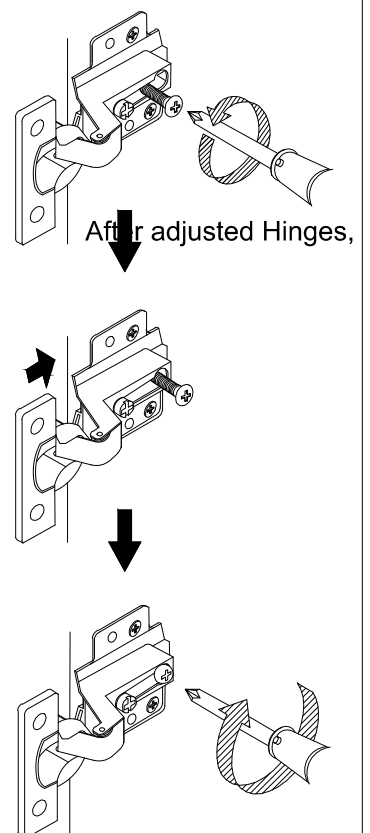
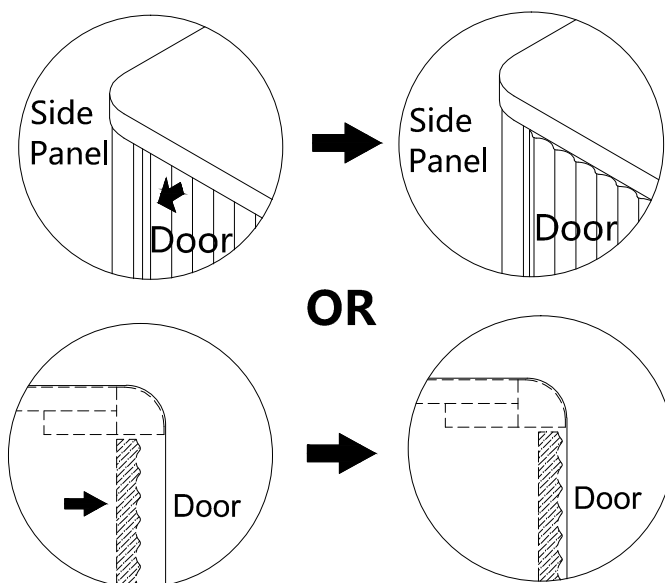


11-A. When the door panel is higher than the side panel.



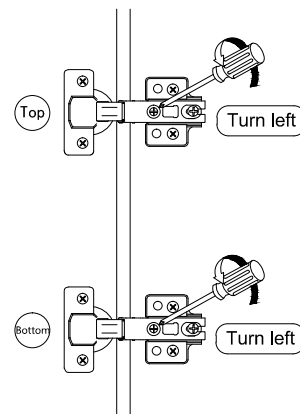
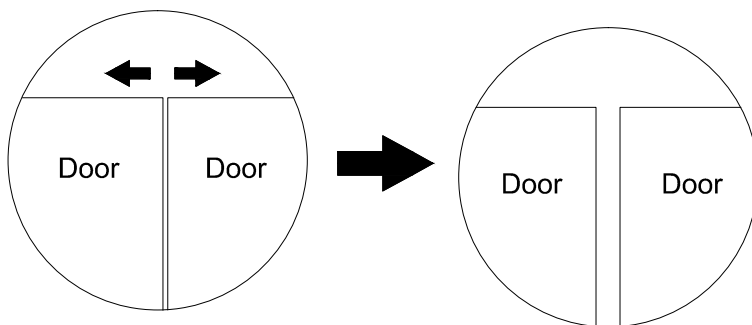
If the gap is too big between side panel and door or the door is over the edge of side panel, loosen the back screw as shown, then move in the door with hinge and tighten the back screw as shown when the gap is just well.

11-B. When the door panel is lower than the side panel, an indentation occurs.



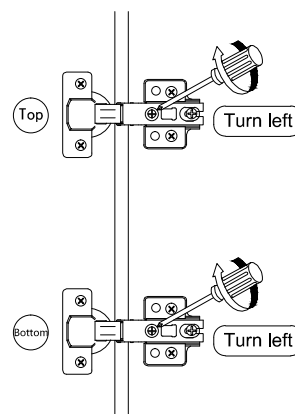
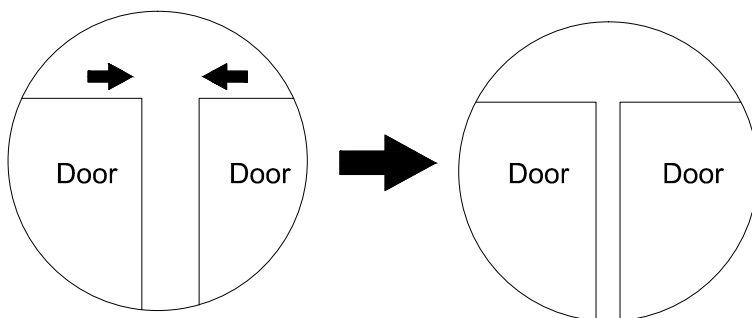
If the gap is too small between side panel and door or the door sank in side panel, loose the back screw as shown, then move out the door with hinge and tighten the back screw as shown when the gap is just well.

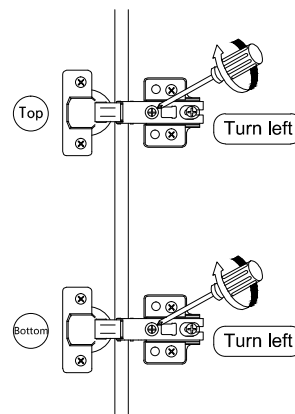
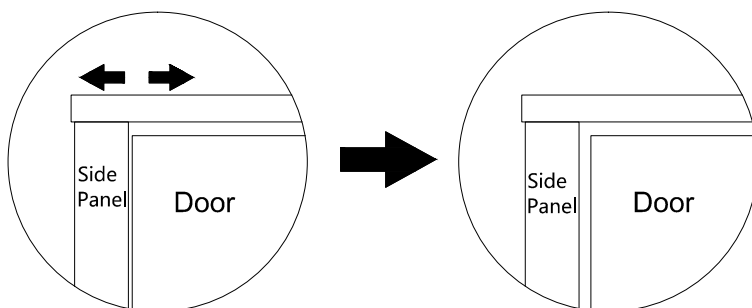
If the gap between the two doors is too small, follow the diagram.

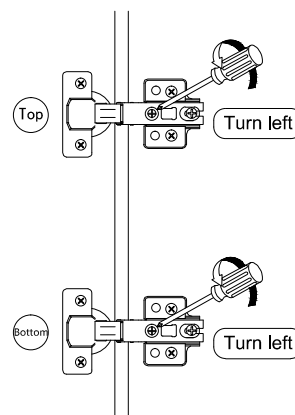
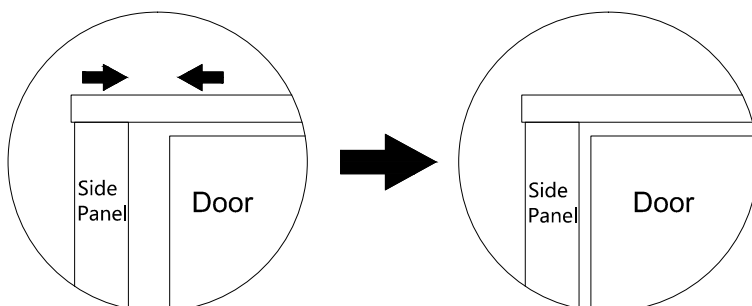
If the gap between the two doors is too large, follow the diagram.

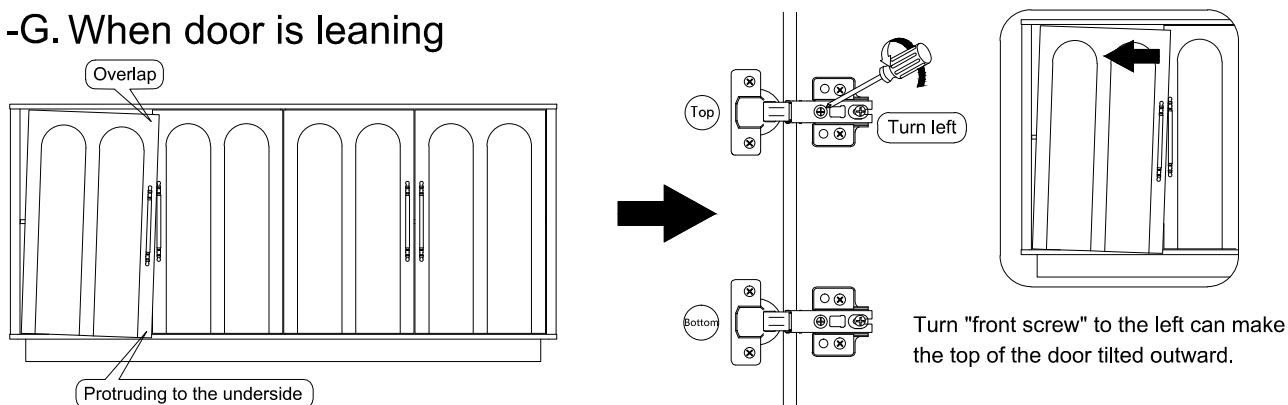
If the gap between the door and the side panel is too small, loose the front screw as shown.

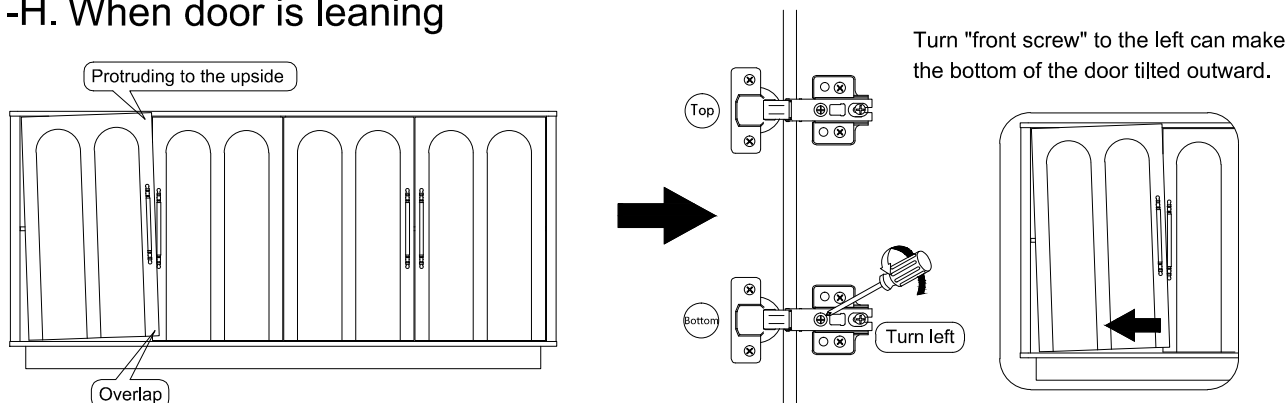


If the gap between the door and the side panel is too large, tighten the front screw as shown.

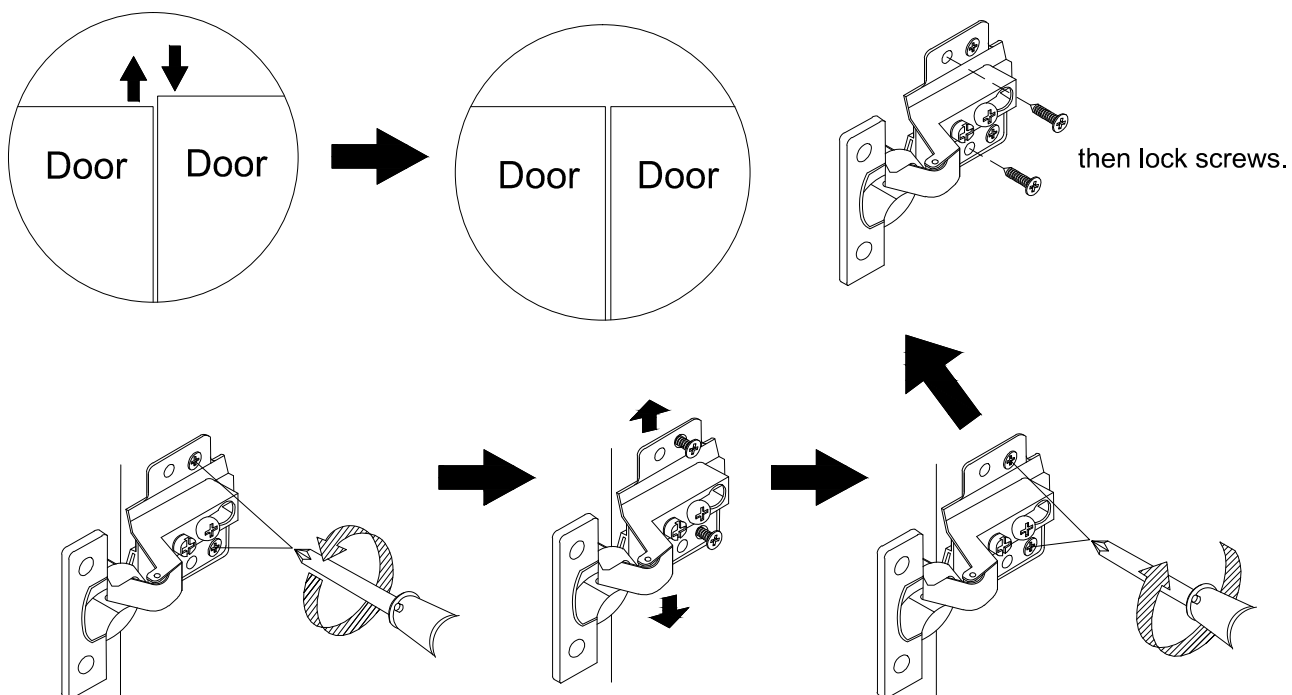

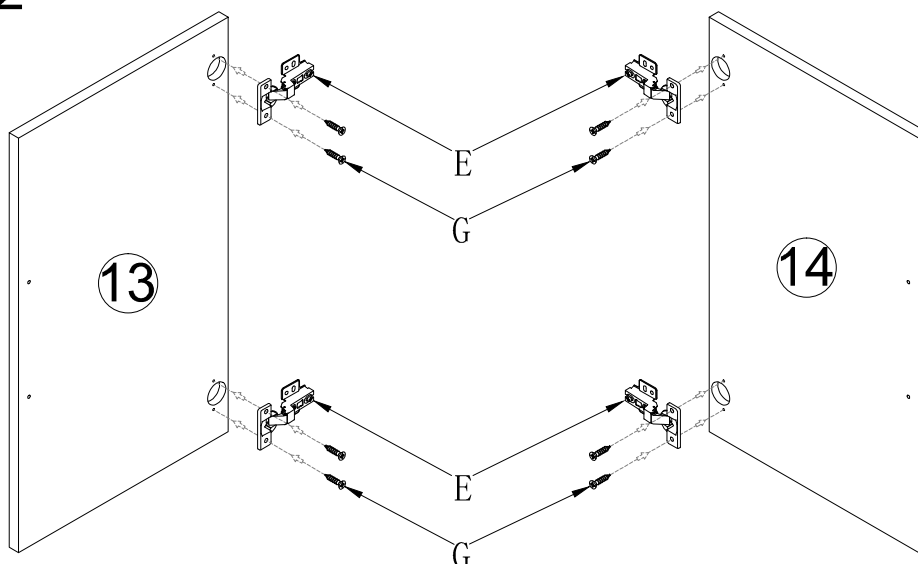

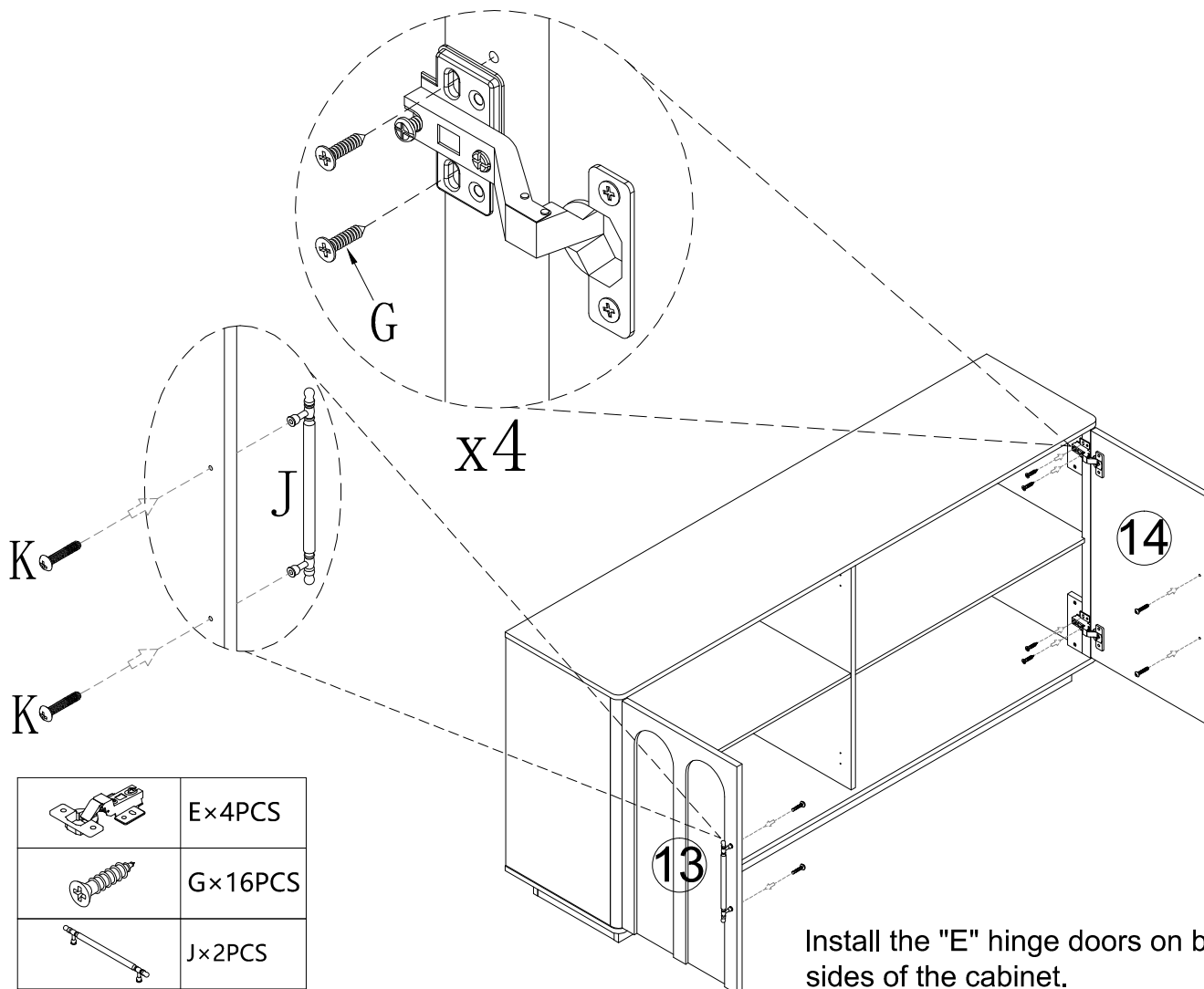


If the doors are not at the same level, loosen the rear screws on the hinge, adjust the door up or down, and then tighten the screws once both doors are aligned. Tighten the two front screws after everything is in place.
