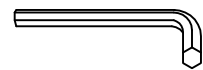


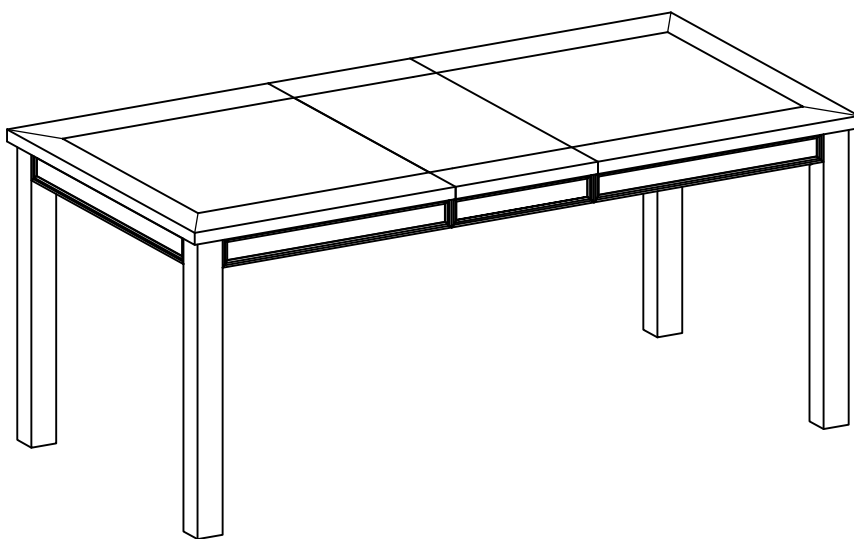

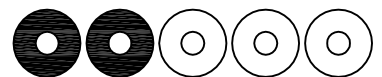

PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

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Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

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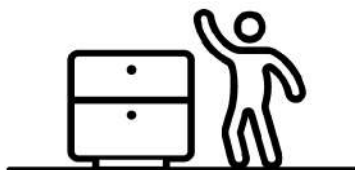
Sufficient Space

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

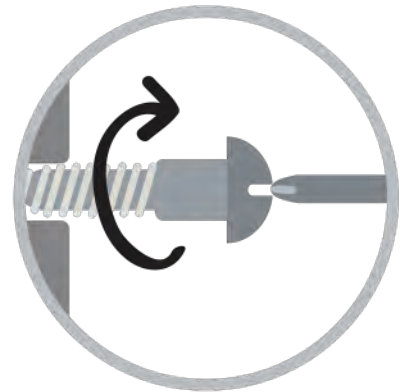
ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE

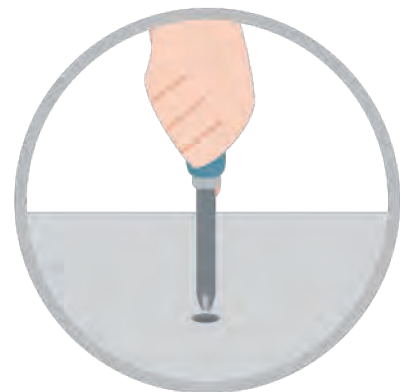

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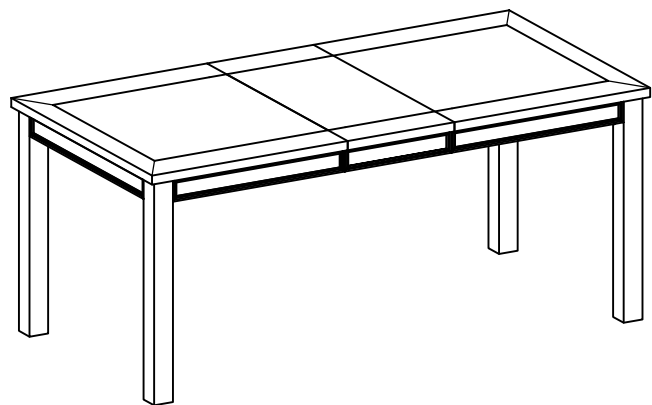
After two weeks, check and

Prepare 8 bolts assembly by inserting lock washer (#B), then flat washer (#A) onto bolts (#C). Align legs (#2) to the holes of the table top (#1). Secure with bolts (#C).

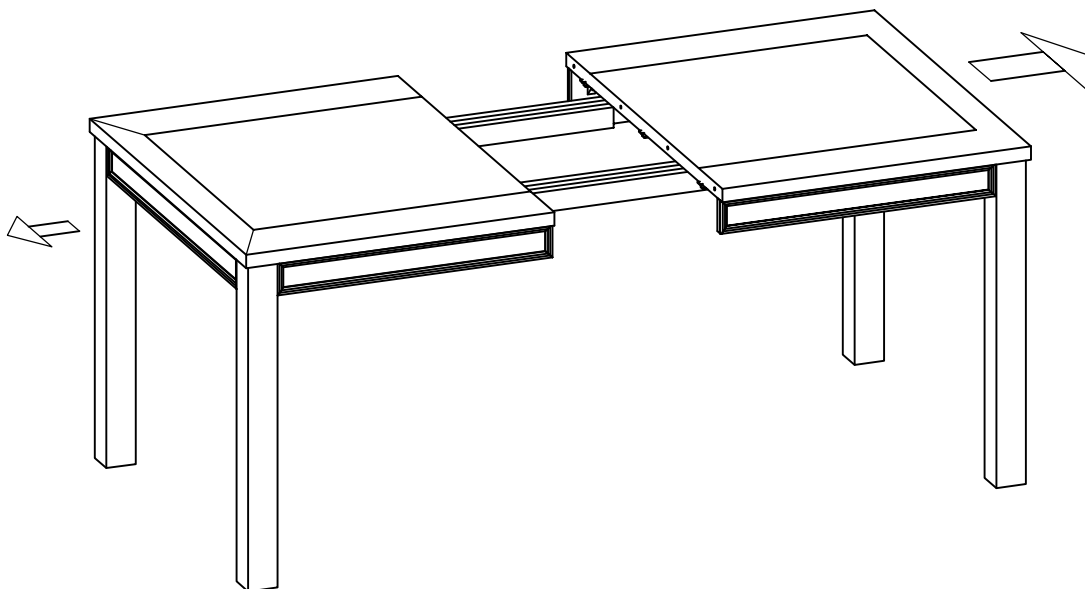
Flip the switch underneath the table to unlock and extend the table.

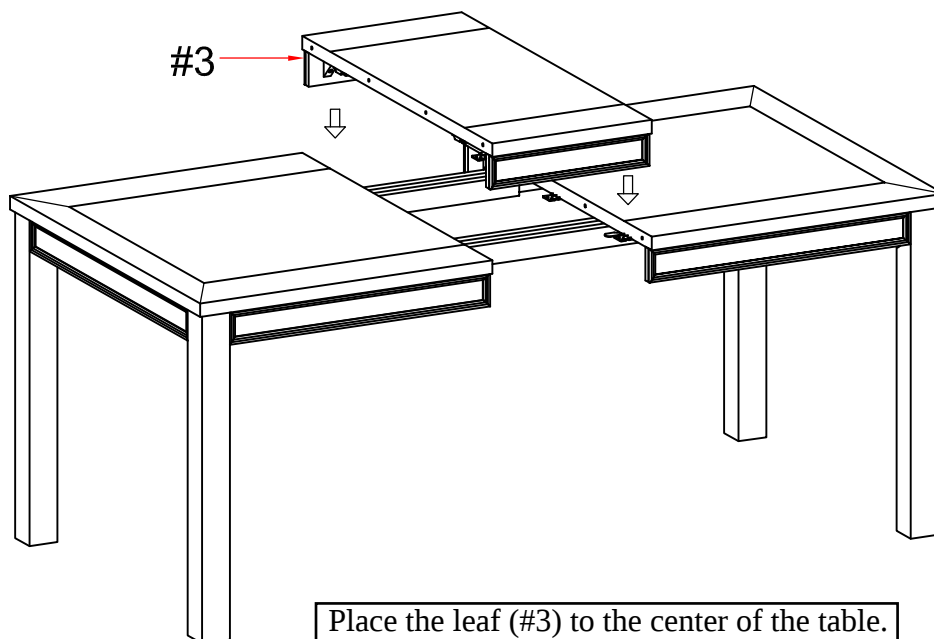

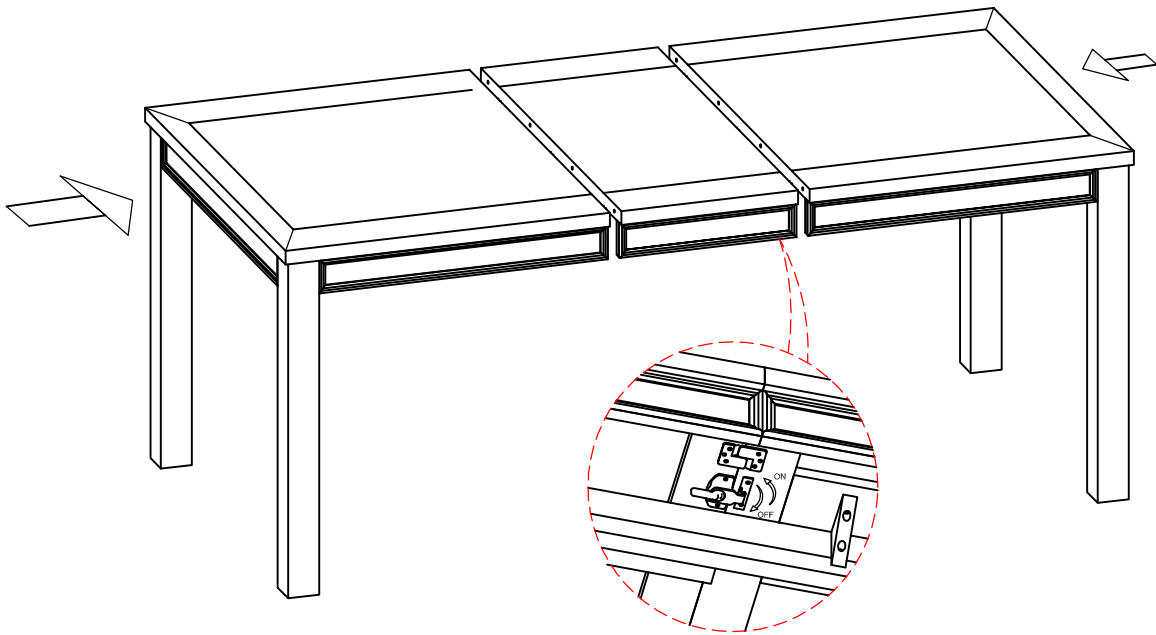


Place the leaf (#3) to the center of the table.

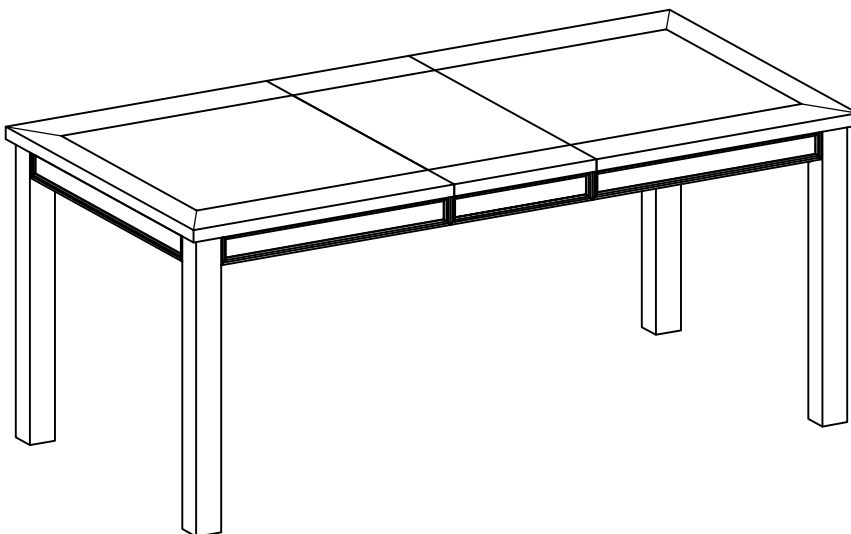
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS
