

PU Leather Care Instructions

Our massage table surface is constructed from high-quality PU leather. Appropriate maintenance can prolong service life and maintain a smooth, tidy appearance.

Daily Cleaning

1. **Ordinary dust and light stains:** Wipe the surface gently with a dry soft microfiber cloth.
2. **Minor dirt:** Moisten a soft cloth with room-temperature clean water or mild neutral soapy water, gently wipe the stained area. Immediately absorb residual moisture with a dry cloth after cleaning, then place the table in a ventilated area for natural air-drying.

⚠ Do not soak, scrub vigorously or flush the table directly with water. Excessive moisture may cause PU leather delamination, mildew, peeling and deformation.

Regular Maintenance

Every 1 – 2 months, after thoroughly cleaning and drying the tabletop, apply a thin layer of special synthetic leather care lotion and polish softly with cloth. This prevents the leather from drying, whitening and cracking while retaining soft gloss.

⚠ Do NOT use shoe polish or thick genuine leather care cream; these products may cause stickiness, discoloration and dust buildup.

Usage & Storage Tips

1. Keep the table away from direct sunlight, heating equipment and air-conditioner outlets. High temperature and ultraviolet rays accelerate material aging, hardening, fading and cracking.
2. Prevent sharp objects such as jewelry, nails and scissors from scratching the leather surface.
3. Stay away from alcohol, disinfectants, cosmetics, detergent and other chemical liquids. These corrosive agents will destroy the surface coating and lead to peeling and discoloration.
4. Wipe off sweat and water stains right away and ventilate to dry. Do not store in damp enclosed spaces to avoid mildew.
5. Avoid long-term heavy compression to prevent permanent creases.

Prohibited Operations

- ✗ Do not rinse or soak the whole massage table.
 - ✗ Do not use alcohol, bleach, gasoline, acidic or alkaline cleaners.
 - ✗ Do not expose to direct sunlight or high-temperature baking.
 - ✗ Do not rub violently or scratch with hard sharp items
- Emergency Treatment.

Emergency Treatment

- Light dust: Wipe with dry cloth.
- Mild stains: Partial cleaning with neutral soapy water, air dry naturally.
- Mildew spots: Erase mildew with dry soft cloth, air dry in shade, then apply care lotion.

- Stubborn stains: Adopt dedicated PU leather cleaner and wipe gently.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q1: Is PU leather genuine leather? How durable is it?

A: PU leather is premium synthetic leather, not animal genuine leather. It features soft touch, stable shape and high cost performance. It can be used for a long time under proper maintenance. Improper operation will accelerate aging and wear.

Q2: Can I wash the massage table directly with water?

A: Whole-table washing and soaking are forbidden. Only partial wiping is allowed. Soaking will cause leather delamination, peeling and mildew.

Q3: Why does the PU surface become dry and pale after a period of use?

A: It is a normal characteristic of PU material. Long-term friction and light exposure will reduce surface gloss. Regular use of leather care lotion can restore shine. Avoid prolonged sunlight exposure to slow down this condition.

Q4: Will the PU leather peel or crack?

A: It will not peel or crack easily with gentle use and proper care. Long-term sun exposure, chemical corrosion, persistent damp storage or sharp scratches will trigger aging damage, which counts as wear caused by improper use.

Q5: Can I use alcohol or disinfectant to disinfect the table?

A: Not recommended. Alcohol and disinfectants corrode PU coating and cause whitening, peeling, hardening and discoloration. Please use mild soapy water for daily cleaning.

Q6: Mildew grows on the tabletop, how should I handle it?

A: First wipe mildew away with dry soft cloth, then place the table in a shaded ventilated place for full air-drying. Apply leather care lotion afterward. Never dry it under direct sunlight or high heat. Always store in dry surroundings.

Q7: Creases appear on the leather, can they be removed?

A: Shallow creases can be relieved by care lotion and gentle massage. Deep creases formed by long-time pressure are mostly irreversible. Avoid sustained heavy compression.

Q8: The massage table contacts sweat and body oil every day. Will it damage the leather?

A: Short-time contact with sweat will not cause immediate damage. Wipe clean after each use to stop long-term sweat residue, which may erode the surface gradually and cause stickiness or discoloration.

Q9: How often should I maintain the leather surface?

A: Daily simple wiping meets basic demands. For frequent commercial use, maintenance with care lotion every 1 to 2 months is recommended.
