**ITEM# 7615 - How To Assemble Your Adirondack Chair**

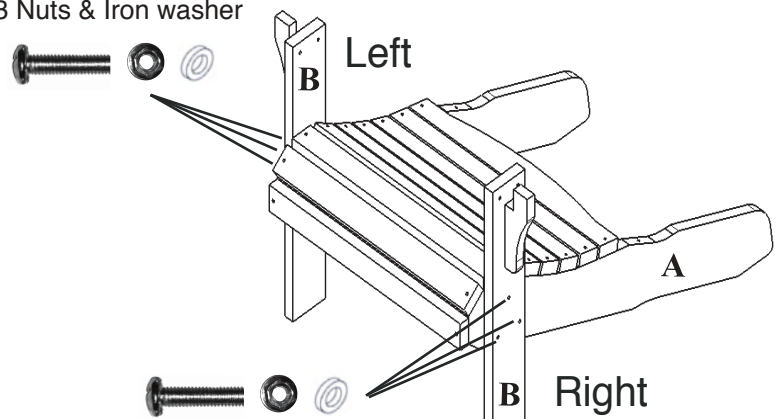
**Tools needed:** Philips screwdriver, power drill optional

**Caution:** When assembling chair, **DO NOT** completely tighten the bolts & nuts until all parts & holes are properly aligned.

**Step 1:**

Place **(A)** Seat on its side and screw **(B)** Front Leg with 3 Long Machine Thread (6 x 55 m/m), 3 Nuts & Iron washer.  
Repeat on the other side.

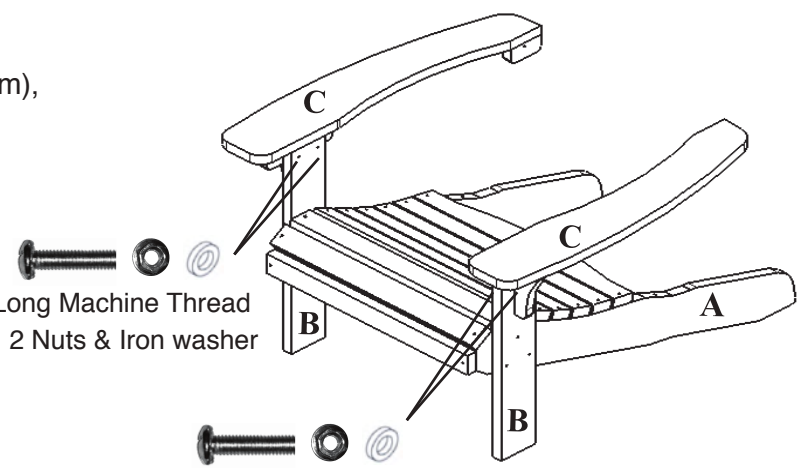
