

# Furniture Cleaning, Care, and Assembly Note



Many of our furniture pieces are lightly sealed or waxed to highlight the wood's natural characteristics. Following these recommendations will help ensure the long life of your furniture.

To minimize normal wear on your vintage or reclaimed wood furniture, we recommend using felt pads under all articles to prevent discoloration or softening of the finish. Plastic and rubber bases on items can also discolor wood.

Furniture should be placed away from direct sunlight, outdoor settings, or high-humidity environments.

Wipe up any liquid spills immediately, lightly sand, and wax if the stains on the wood appear. Avoid common household cleaners such as detergents, harsh solvents, and abrasives. Clean with a soft, lint-free cotton cloth dampened with water or furniture polish wax.

On high-traffic surfaces, we recommend applying high-quality paste wax, which should be used regularly to provide additional protection from everyday wear and tear. For optimal security, we recommend applying wax once a year.

Each piece of this furniture is handmade. Every leg is crafted to fit its matching top, and each plate is designed to align with its specific hole. Parts are **not interchangeable**. Please verify the marked numbers and ensure that each part is placed in its original location during assembly.
