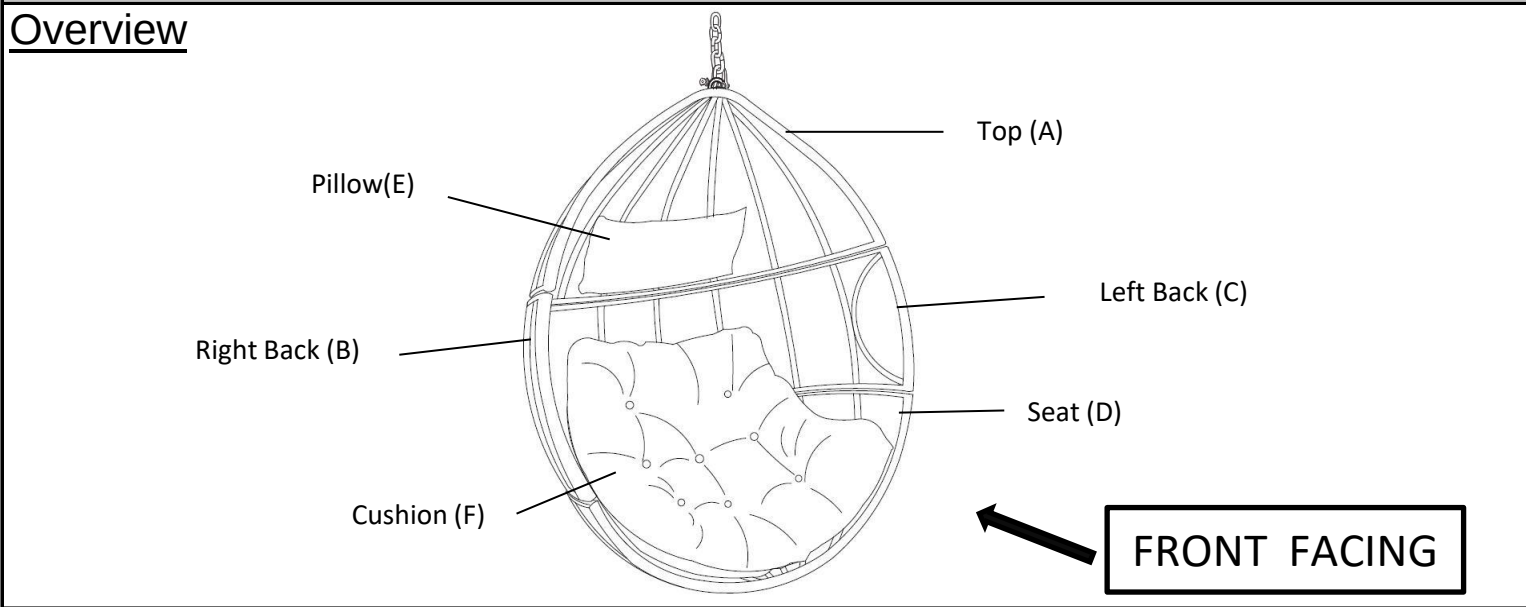
Assembly Steps

Overview

The diagram illustrates the components of a hanging egg-shaped chair. The labels and their corresponding parts are as follows:

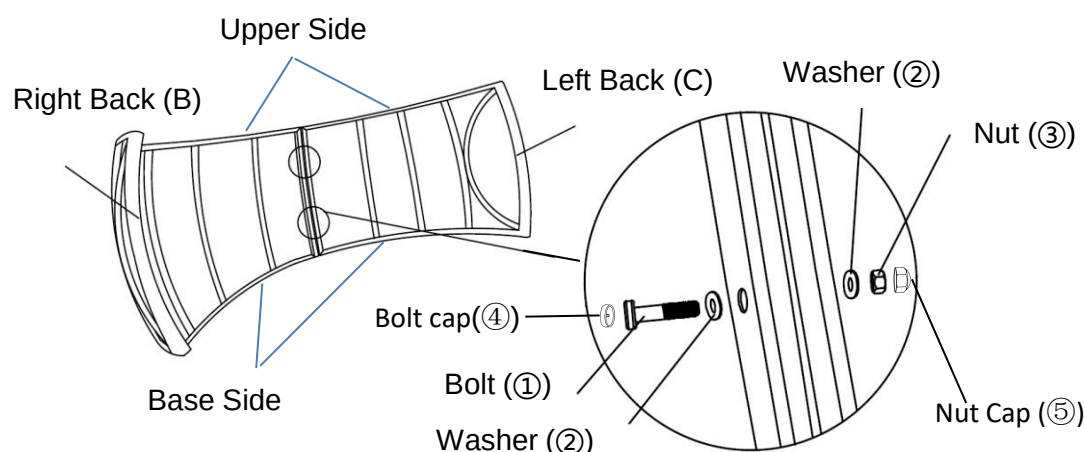
- Top (A)**: The uppermost part of the chair's frame.
- Left Back (C)**: The curved backrest on the left side.
- Right Back (B)**: The curved backrest on the right side.
- Seat (D)**: The central seating area.
- Pillow (E)**: A rectangular cushion placed against the backrest.
- Cushion (F)**: A tufted, diamond-shaped cushion placed on the seat.

This Basket has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Basket parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



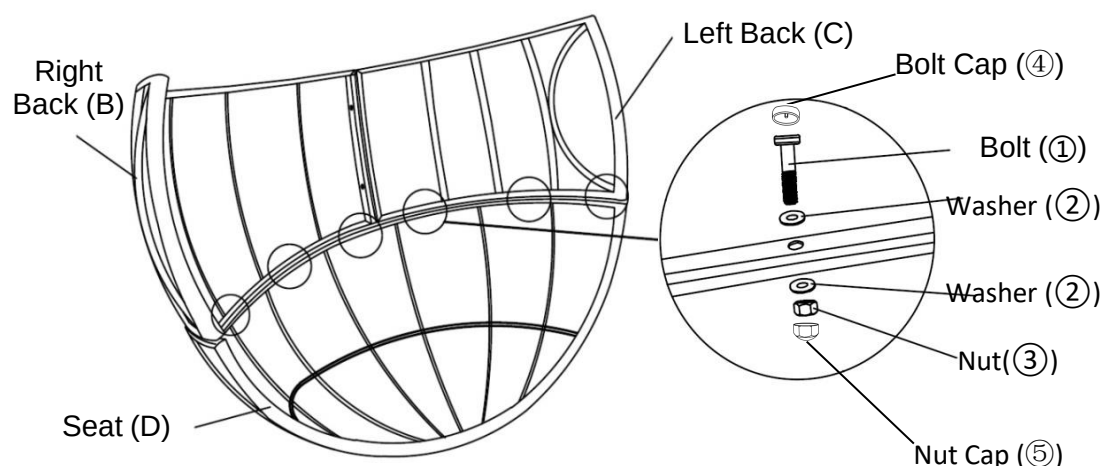
Place the Right Back(B) and Left Back(C) on a clean, non-marring surface.

Note: Find the sticker with the words "upper side" on them, and keep all the upper sides upwards.

Attach Right Back(B) to Left Back(C) using Bolts(①), and Washers(②) and Bolt Cap(④) on one side and Washers(②) and Nuts(③) and Nut Cap (⑤) on the other side, with Allen Key(⑦) and Spanner(⑥).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 2

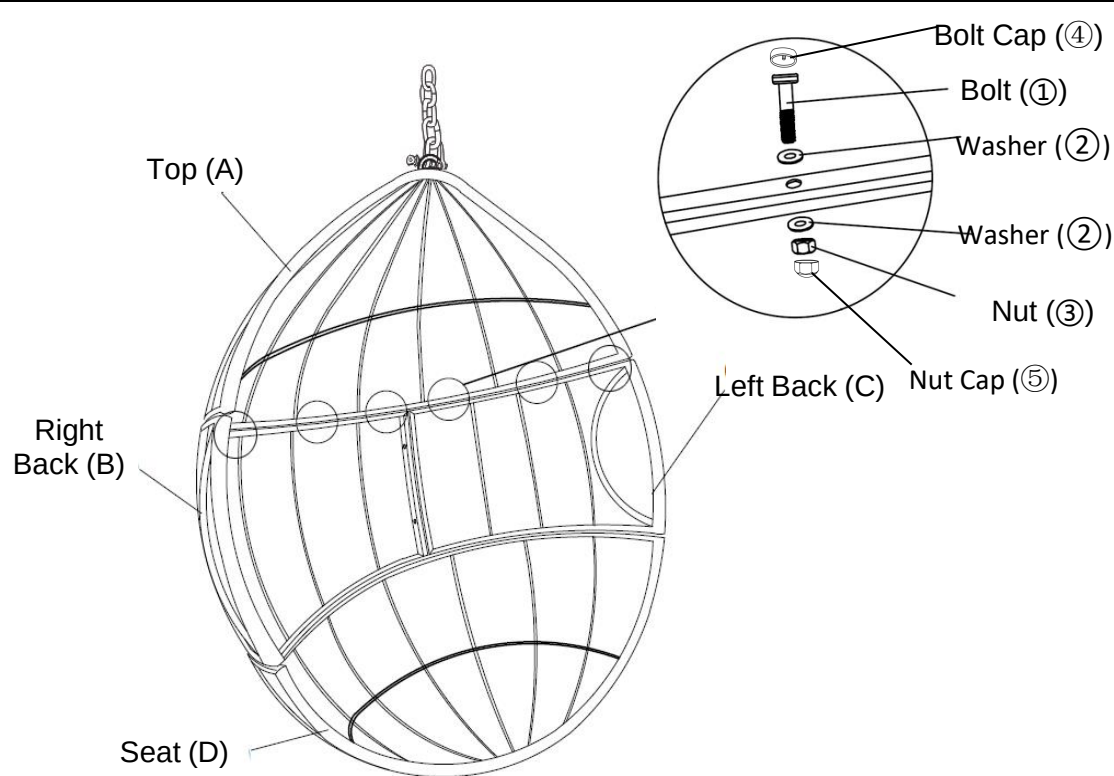


Align Right Back(B), Left Back(C) and Seat(D).

Attach Right Back(B) and Left Back(C) to Seat(D) using Bolts(①), and Washers(②) and Bolt Cap (④) on the upper side and Washers(②) and Nuts(③) and Nut Cap (⑤) on the lower side, with Allen Key(⑦) and Spanner(⑥).

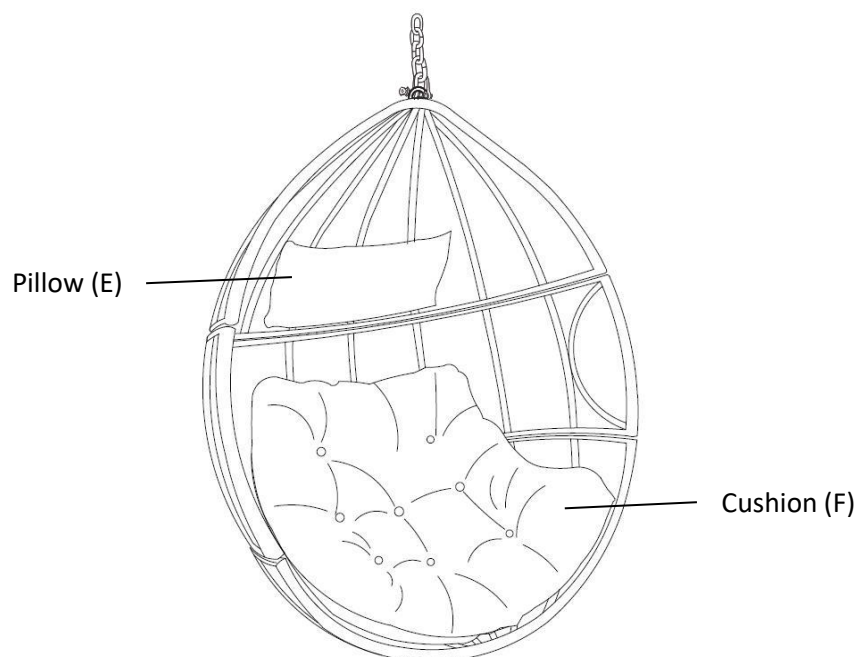
Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 3



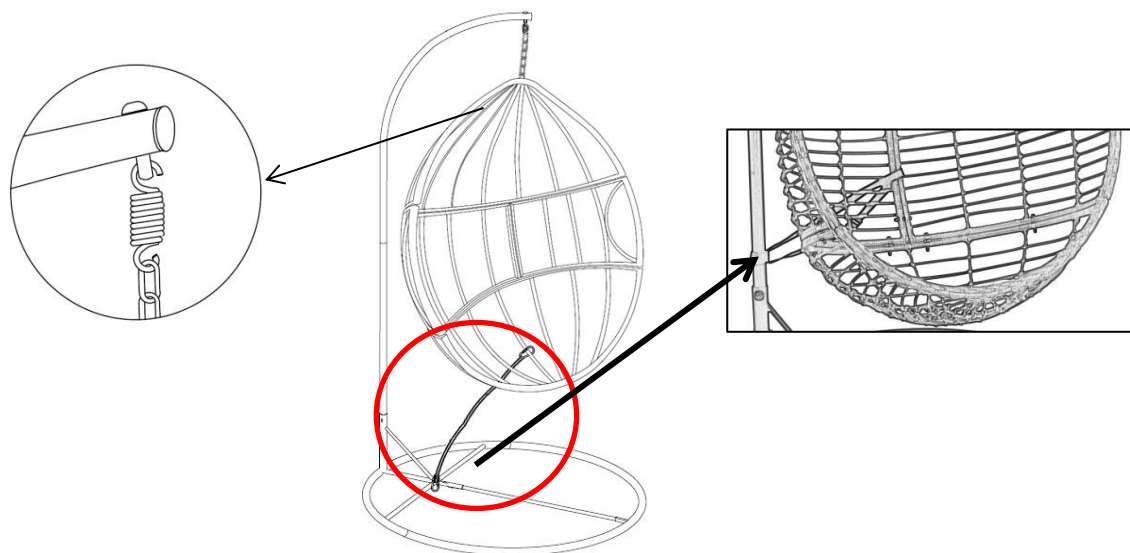
Align Right Back(B), Left Back(C) and Top(A).
Attach Right Back(B) and Left Back(C) to Top(A) using Bolts(①), and Washers(②) and Bolt Cap (④) on the upper side and Washers(②) and Nuts(③) and Nut Cap (⑤) on the lower side, with Allen Key(⑦) and Spanner(⑥).
Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 4



Now, tighten all Bolts and Nuts at all joints sequential manner.
Place Bolt Caps(④) on Bolts(①) and Nut Caps(⑤) on Nuts(③).
Tie the Pillow(E) to the Basket as pictured above.
Place the Cushion(F) on the Basket.
Your Basket is ready for use.

Step 5



Lift the Basket and hang the first iron chain on the Spring of the Stand.

Use the fasten Safety Rope to lock on the middle rattan warp at the bottom of the basket as shown above, screwed up the carabiner to keep the warp never come out from it.

Note: This step should be completed with 2 adults.

Care & Maintenance

-   • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface
 -   • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
 -   • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
 -   • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
 -   • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
 -   • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
 -   • Not for commercial use. For residential use only .
 -   • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
 -   • Keep away from sources of ignition.
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-   • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth .
