


KITCHEN BASKET




INSTALLATION

Step 1

Drill holes in the correct positions of the side boards after taking all necessary measurements at the site. Then install the two guide rails (B) and (C) respectively onto the side boards of your cabinet with screws (D1).


Caution: If you want to use the screw holes in the second and third rows, pull the rails out completely before the installation.



Step 2


Place the basket (A) onto the guide rails (B) and (C). Make sure that the basket can be pulled out smoothly.

Caution: After attaching the basket, check if the hooks of the guide rails securely snap into the corresponding position of the basket (as shown in the figure).



Step 3:

According to the measurements you have taken, drill holes in the corresponding position of the front board of the cabinet. Now attach the fixing clamps (E) to the front framework of the basket and then fix the clamps (E) securely onto the front board of your cabinet with screws (D2). After that, check again to make sure that the basket can be pulled out smoothly.



CLEANING & CARE
