

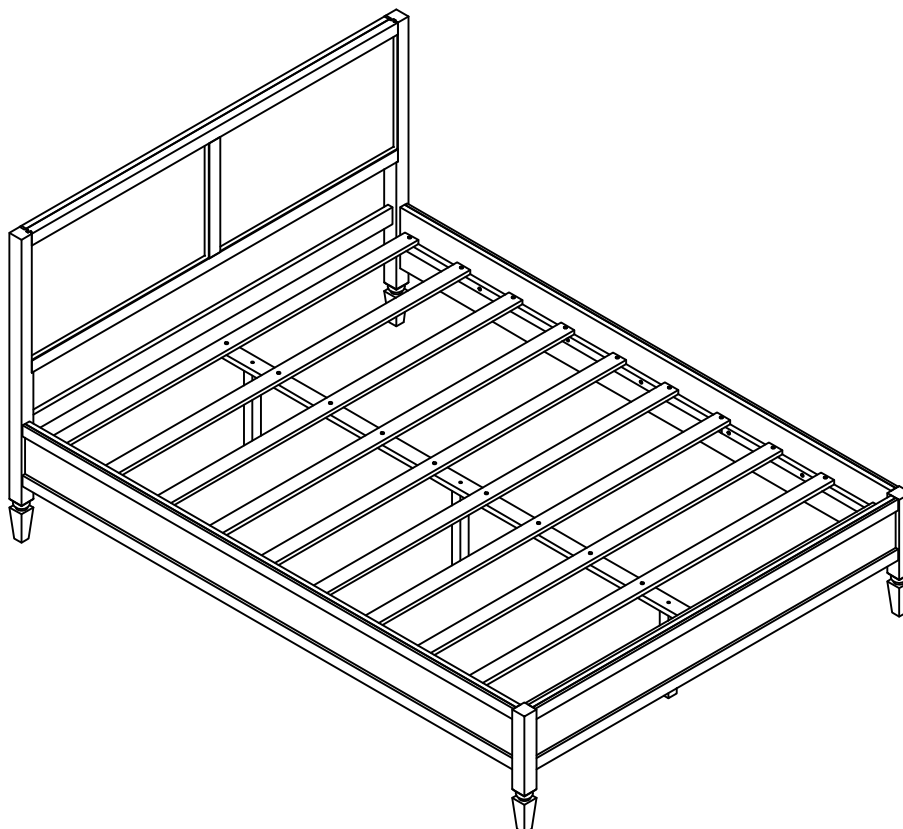
Assembly Instructions

Caution: You must read this before you proceed

Care & Maintenance

	• Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
	• Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
	• Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
	• Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.
	• Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.
	• Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
	• Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.
	• Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
	• Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
	• Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

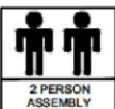
Wooden Bed - Queen Size

WARNING

STRANGULATION HAZARD.

WARNING!

Not intended for children under the age of six. INFANTS HAVE DIED FROM BECOMING ENTRAPPED IN BEDS. Openings in and between bed parts can entrap the neck and head of a small child. NEVER use bed for child under the age of six.

The mattress must be appropriately sized for the bed. If the mattress is undersized, dangerous gaps can exist and a person can become wedged or entangled in the frame and suffocate.

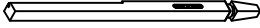
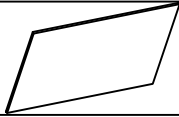
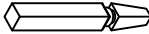
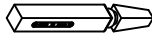

To prevent injury to yourself or damage to the product a minimum of two adults are required whenever moving or lifting it.

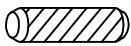
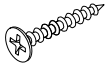
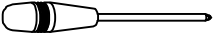

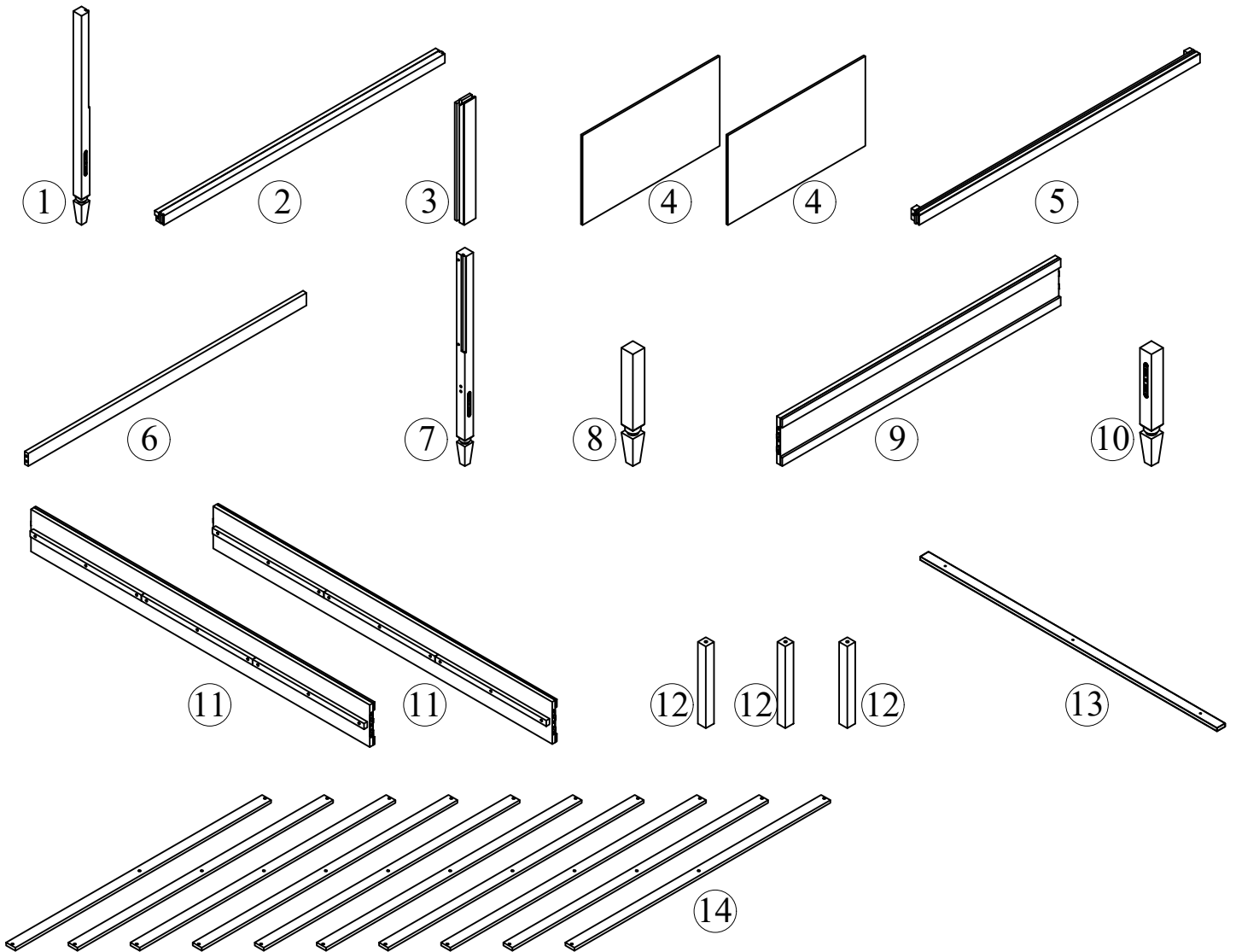
IMPORTANT ! KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE : READ CAREFULLY

- WARNING ! Keep all screws, small parts and plastic bags out of the reach of children
- Properly identify all parts before assembling
- Never use your item if any of its parts are broken or missing

- Manufacturer's instructions shall be followed at all times
- Care: Clean with a soft, dry cloth. In case of larger stains, carefully rub with a slightly damp, non-abrasive sponge

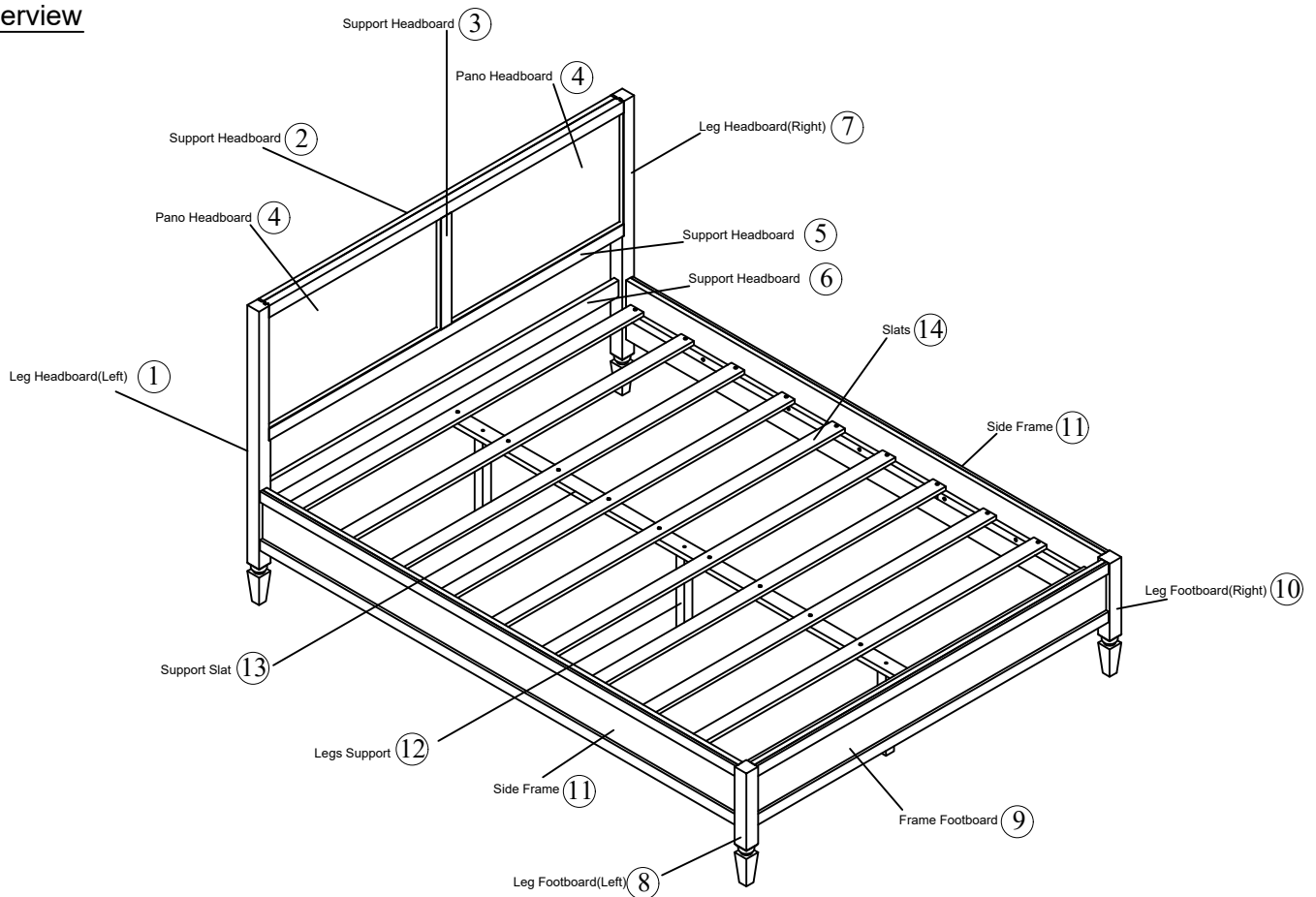
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam).



- Save all packaging until finished.

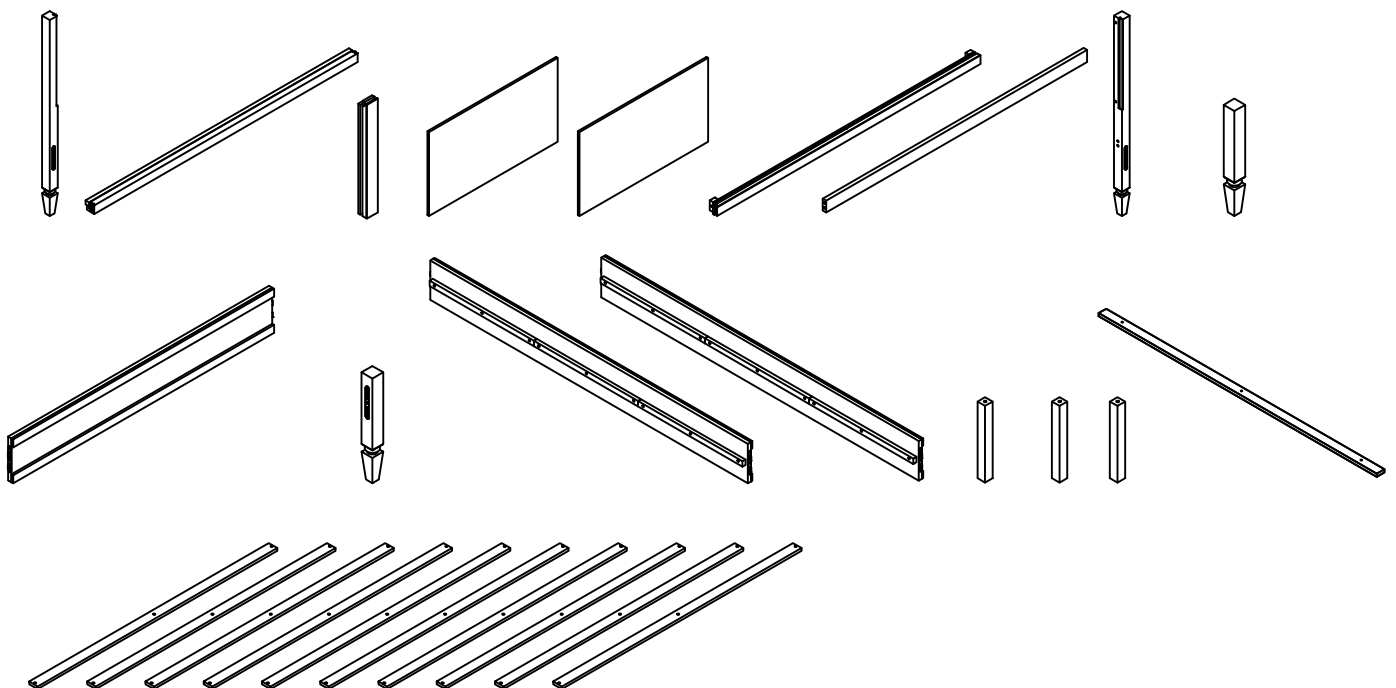
Assembly Steps

Overview



This Bed has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bed parts, the above picture is provided to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

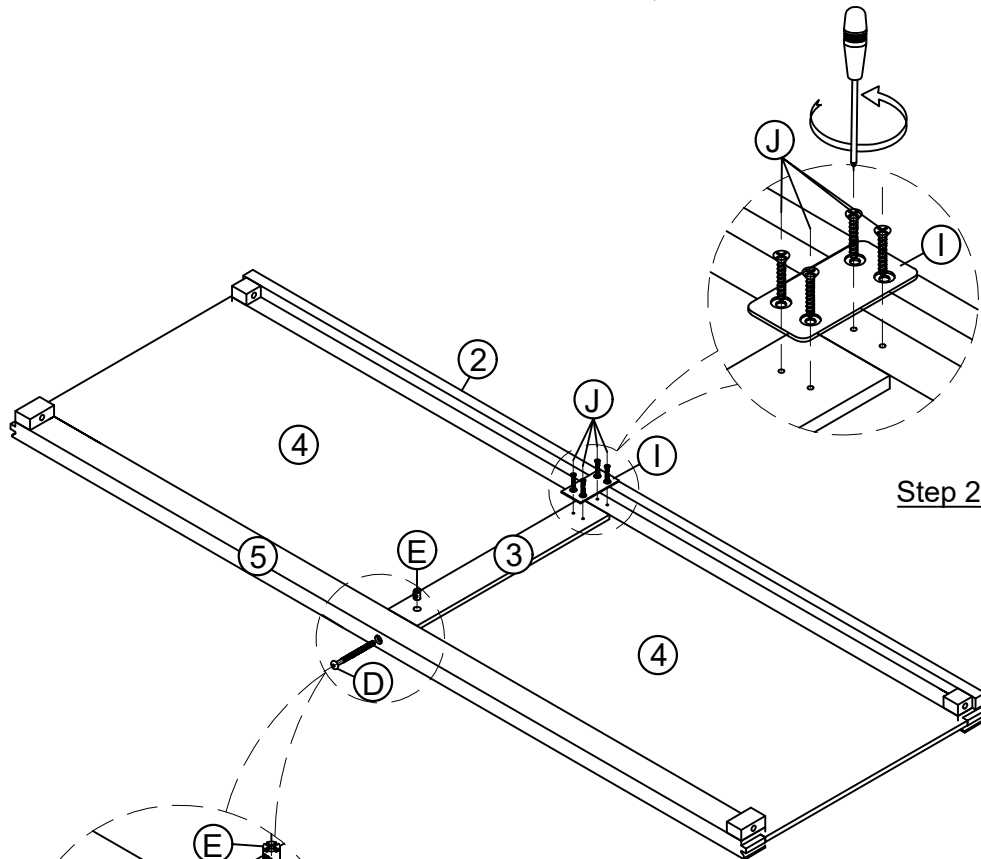
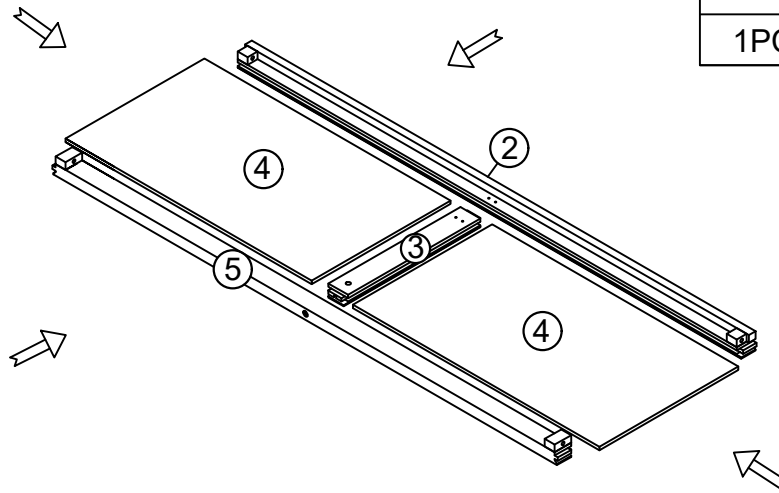
STEP 1:



Unpack and place all part on a clean, non-marring surface.

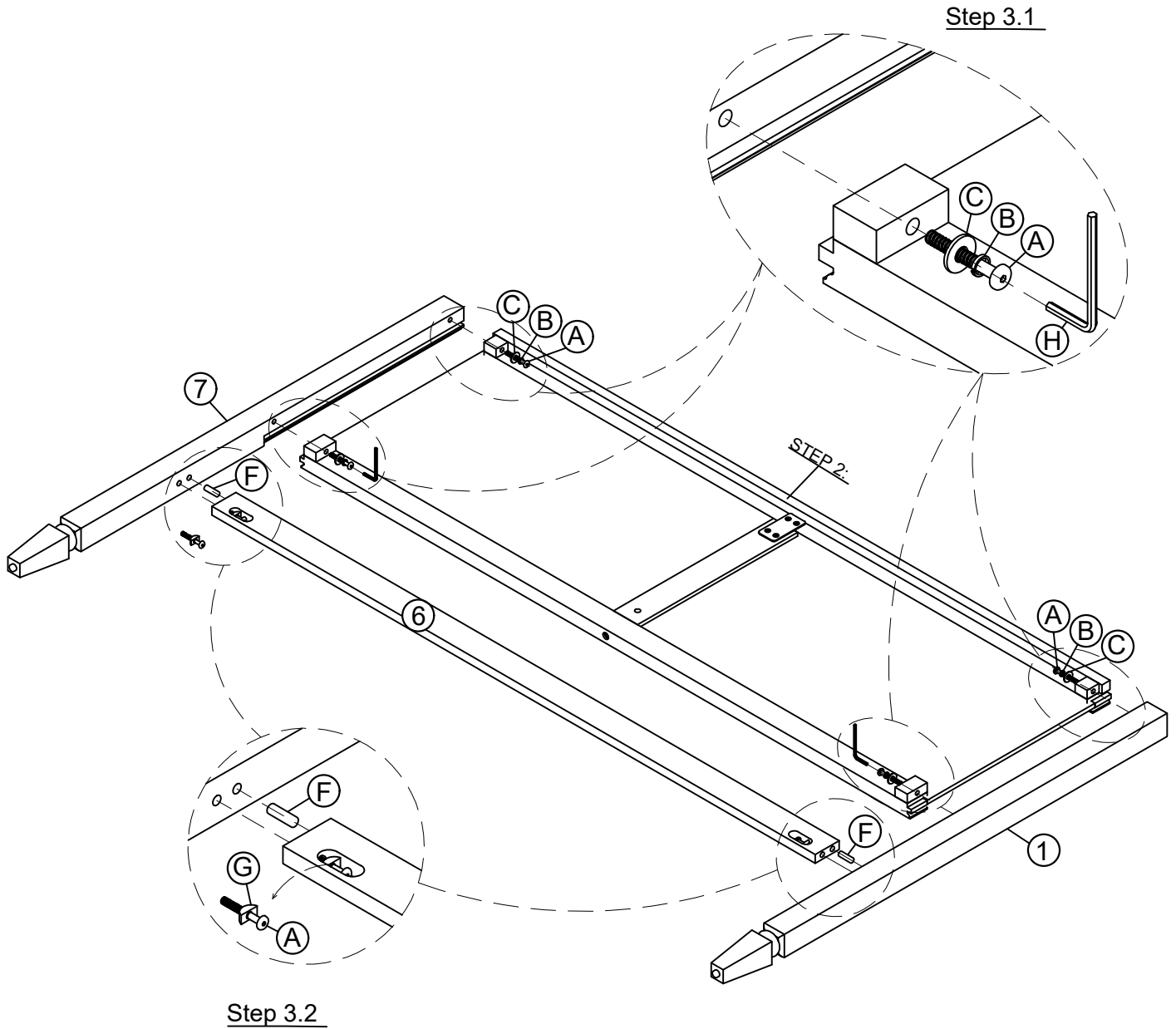
2.1: Attach Support headboard (3) to the Support headboard (5) by using Hex-Head bolt (D) and Hole bolts (E) With allen key (H), as shown above.

2.2: Attach Support headboard (2) and Pano Headboard (2) to the Support headboard (3) and (5) by using Sheet metal (I) and Screws (J) and Screwdriver (Not Provided), as shown above.

DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS AND SCREWS.

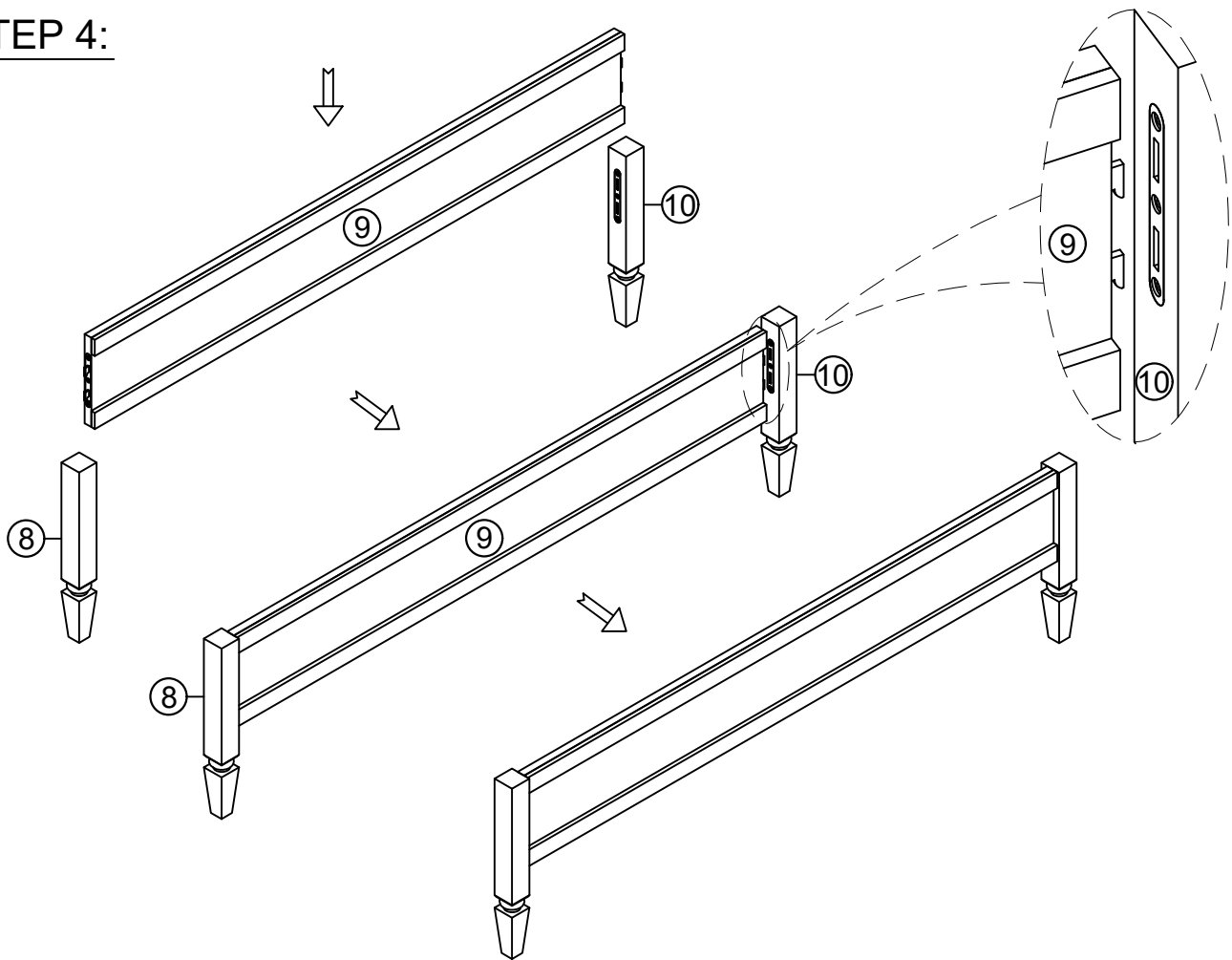


3.1: Attach Step 2 to the Leg headboard (left) ① and the Leg headboard (right) ⑦ by using Hex-Head bolt (A) and Washer (B)(C) With allen key (H) , as shown above.

3.2: Attach Support headboard ⑥ to the Leg headboard (left) ① and the Leg headboard (right) ⑦ by using Hex-Head bolt (A) and Wood Dowel (F) and Washer (G) With allen key (H) , as shown above.

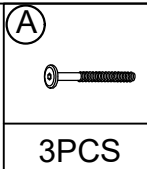
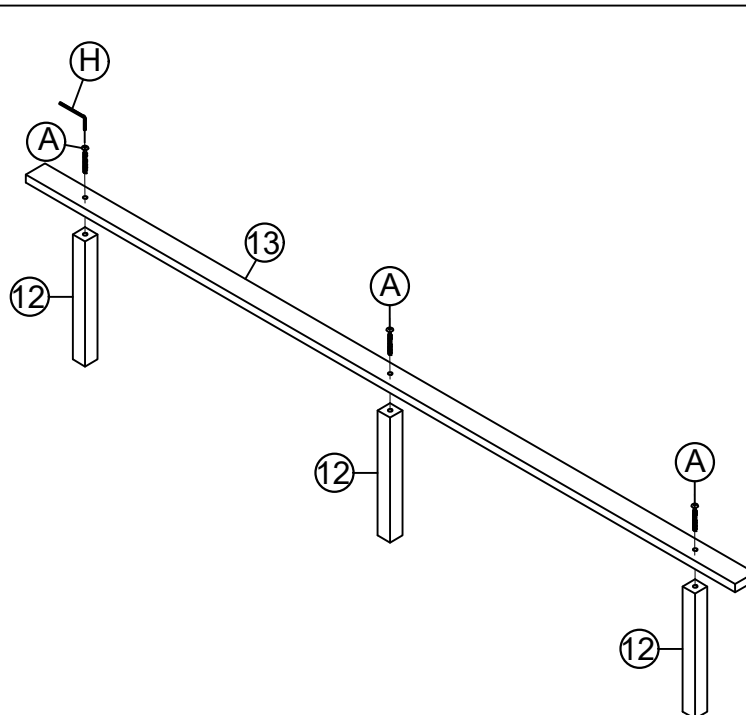
DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS.

STEP 4:



Attach Frame Footboard ⑨ to the Leg Footboard (left) ⑧ and the Leg Footboard (right) ⑩, as shown above.

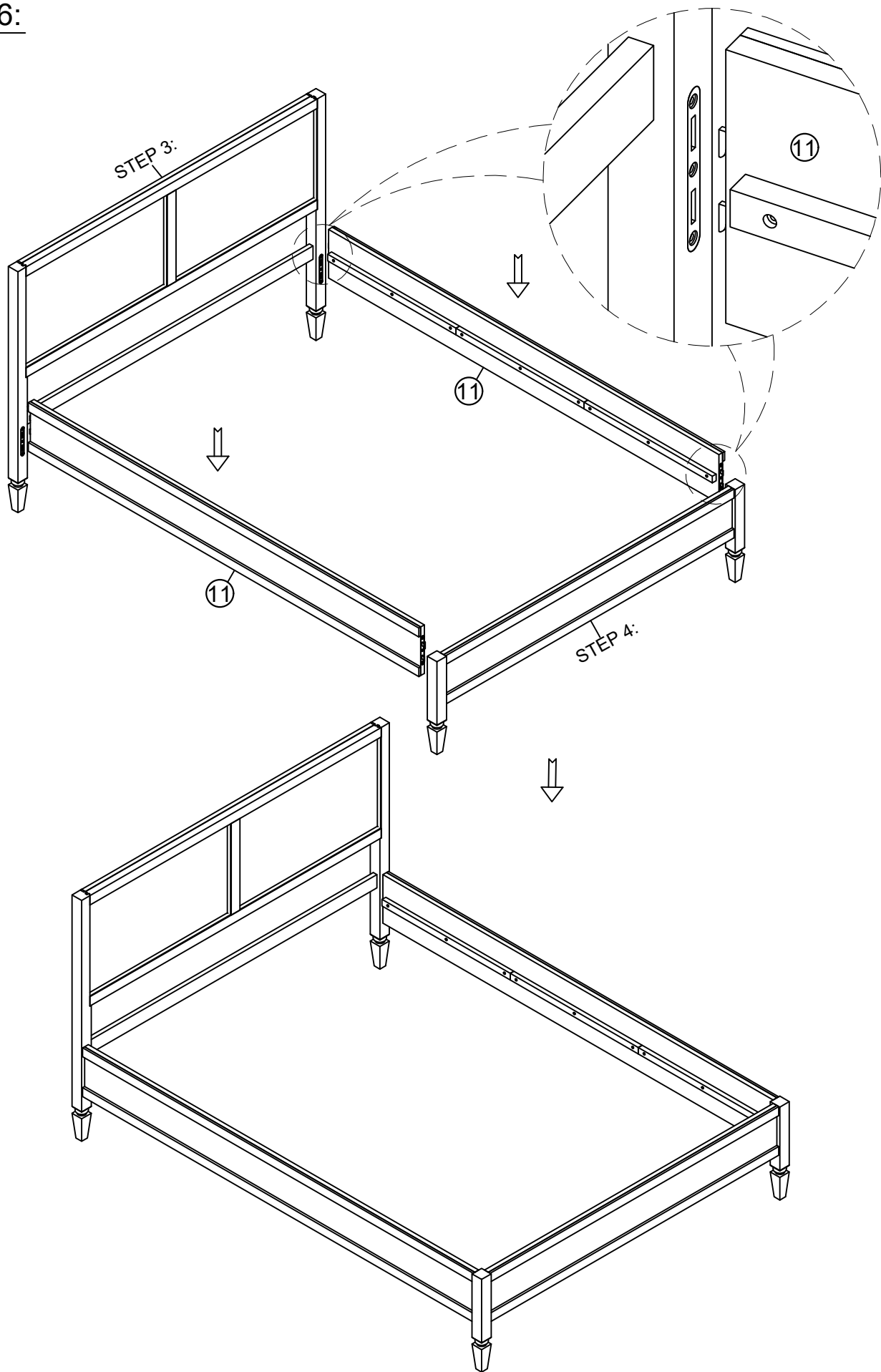
STEP 5:



Attach Legs Support ⑫ to the Support Slat ⑬ by using Hex-Head bolt ① A With allen key ① H, as shown above.

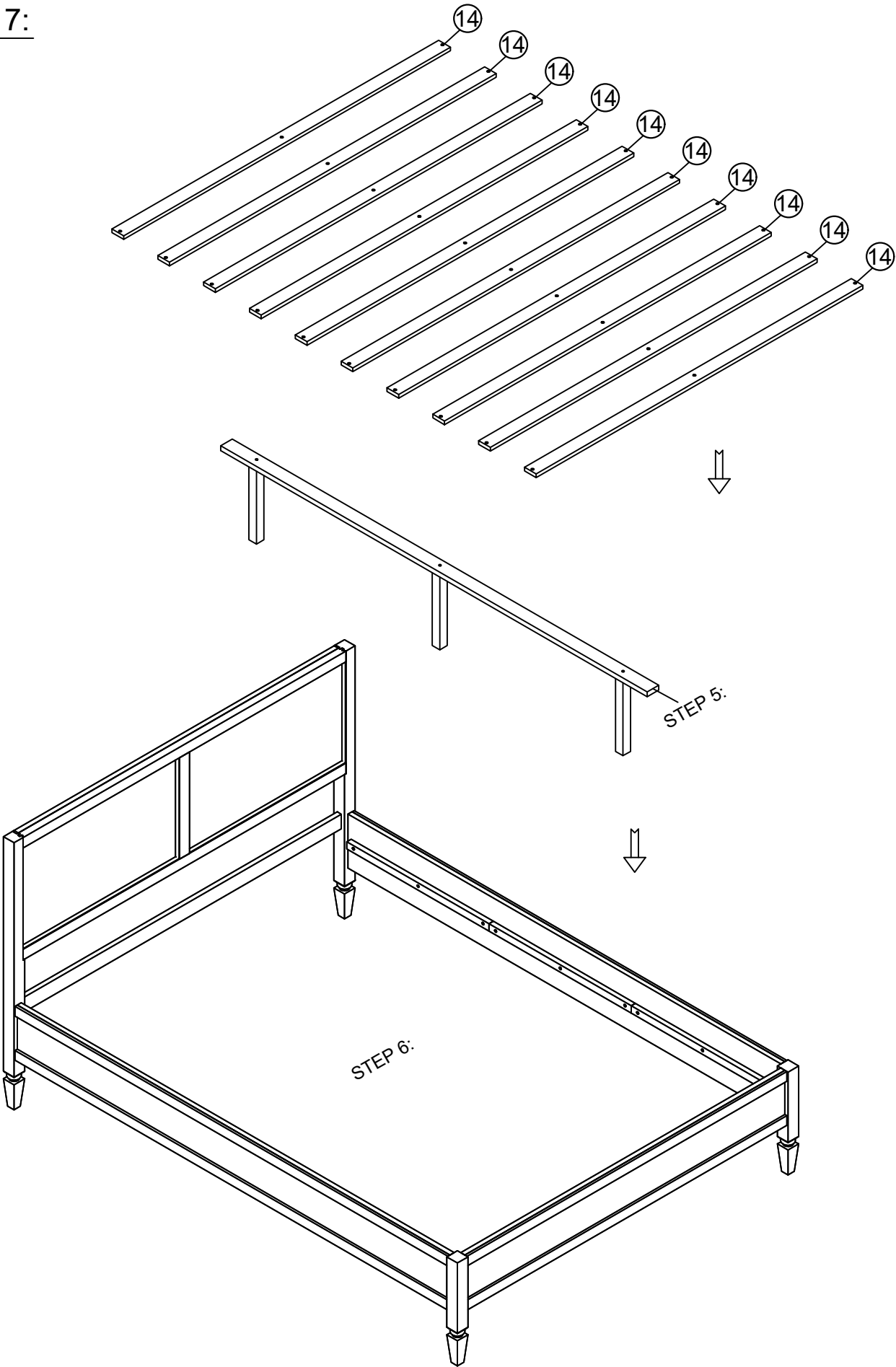
DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS.

STEP 6:



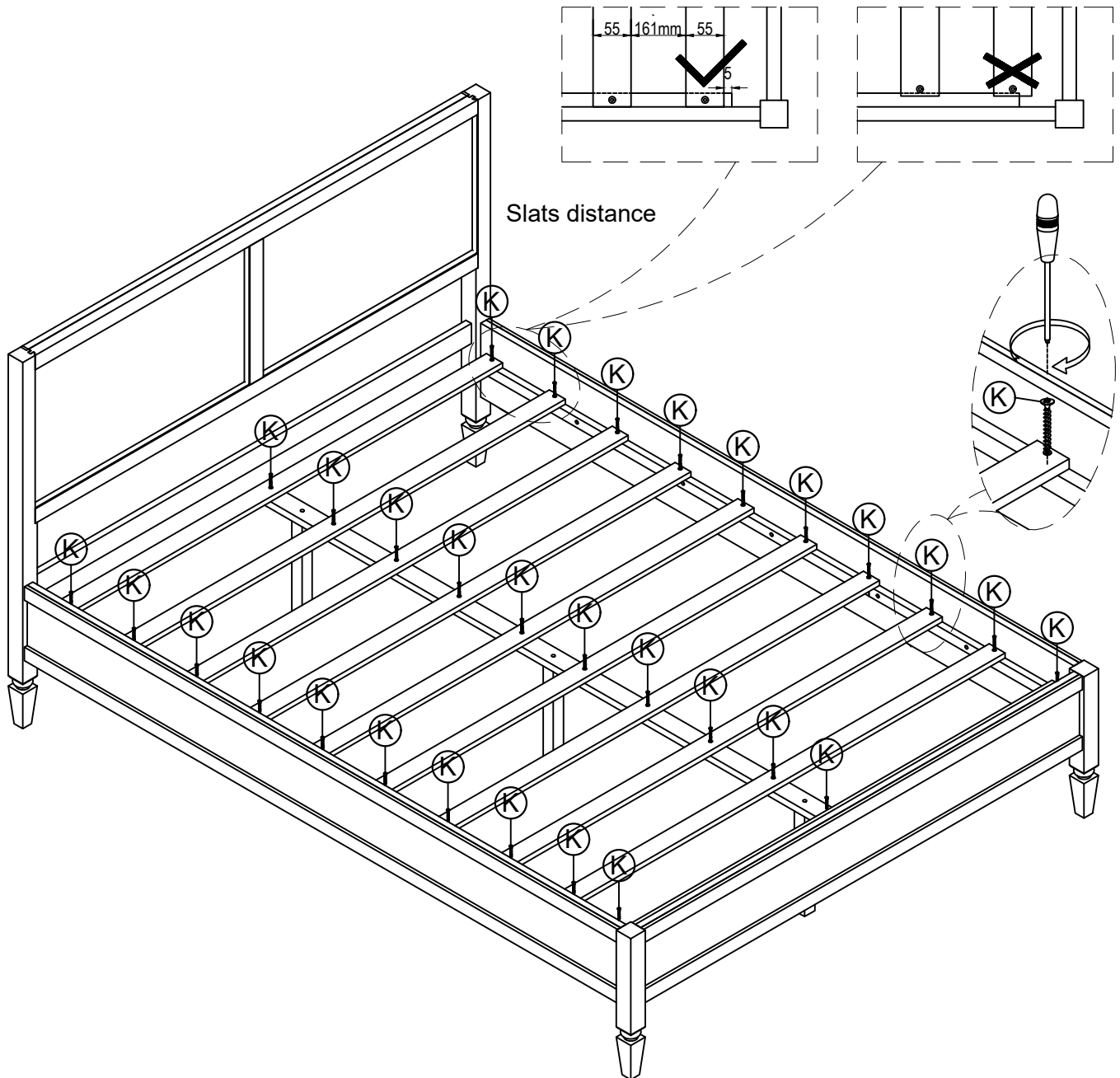
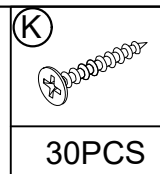
Attach Side Frame ⑪ to the Step 3 and the Step 4, as shown above.

STEP 7:



Move Step 5 and Slats ⑭ to the Step 6 , as shown above.

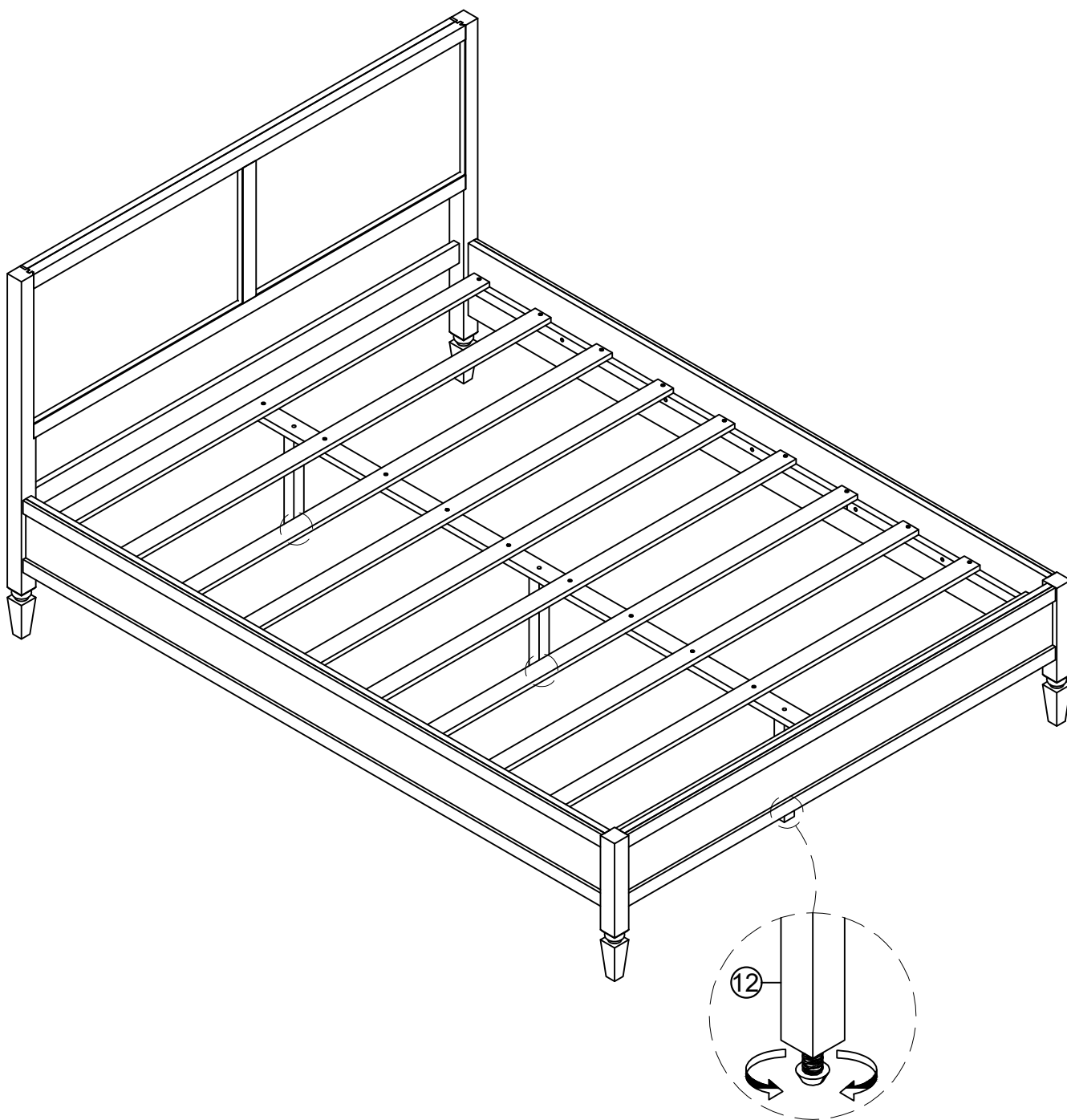
STEP 8:



Attach Slats (14) to the Side Frame (11) and Center rails support slat (13) by using Screws (K) and Screwdriver (Not Provided), as shown above.

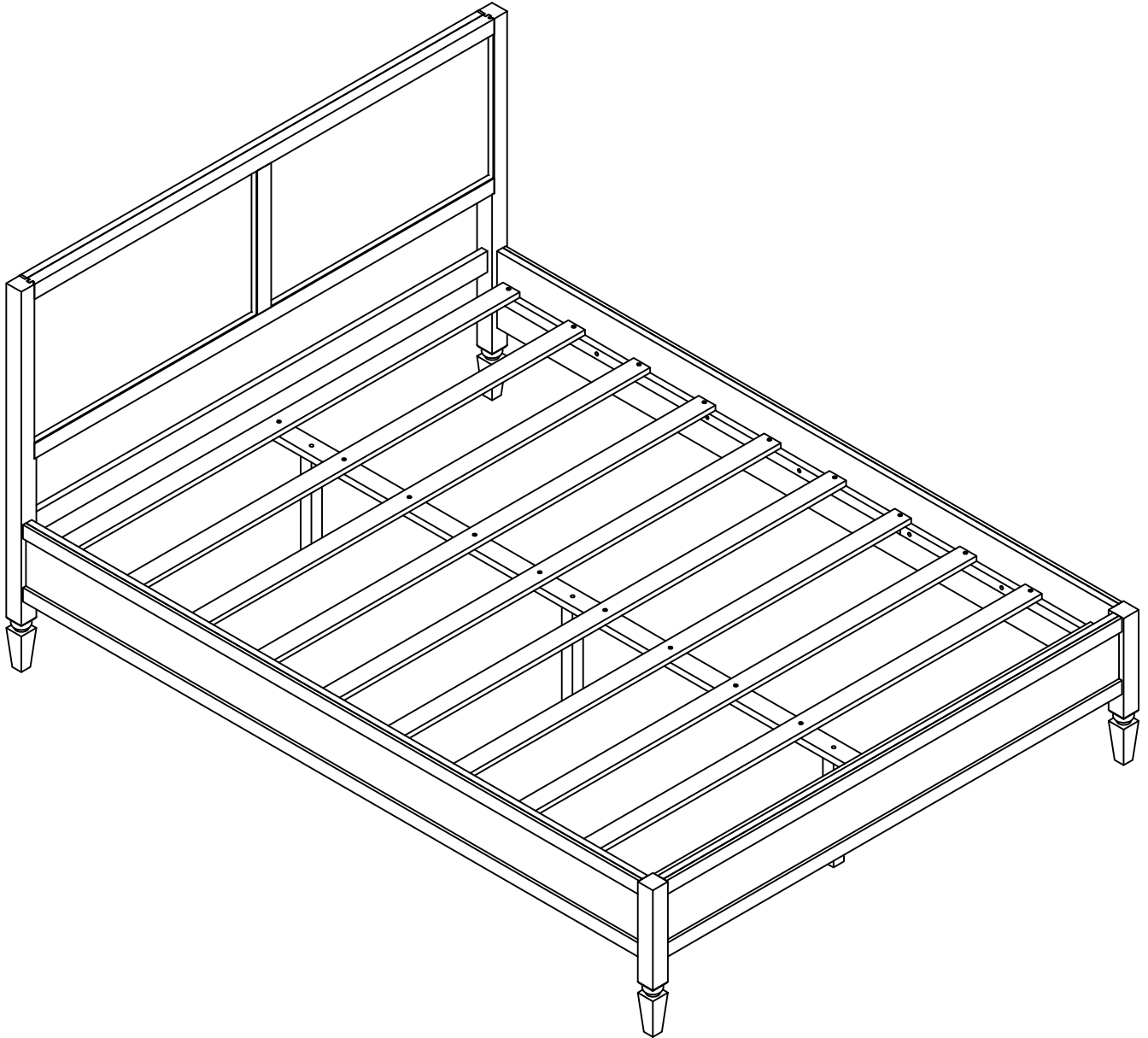
DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN SCREWS.

STEP 9:



Rotate counterclockwise to increase the length of Floor Leveler, and raise that corner. Rotate clockwise to lower that corner.

STEP 10:



Place the Bed on a LEVEL SURFACE.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Don't push too hard, shake on the bed.

This would help to align all the parts at all the joint areas.

CAUTION 1: When tightening these screws, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one.

This would cause the frame to warp.

If there is still wobbles, loosen the screws and execute this same process. DO NOT tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one.

WARNING!! IF BED IS NOT STABLE , IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Ensure all screws are fully locked into position.

The bed is ready to be used.

Caution 2: This bed can only be used on a flat, level surface.
