- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



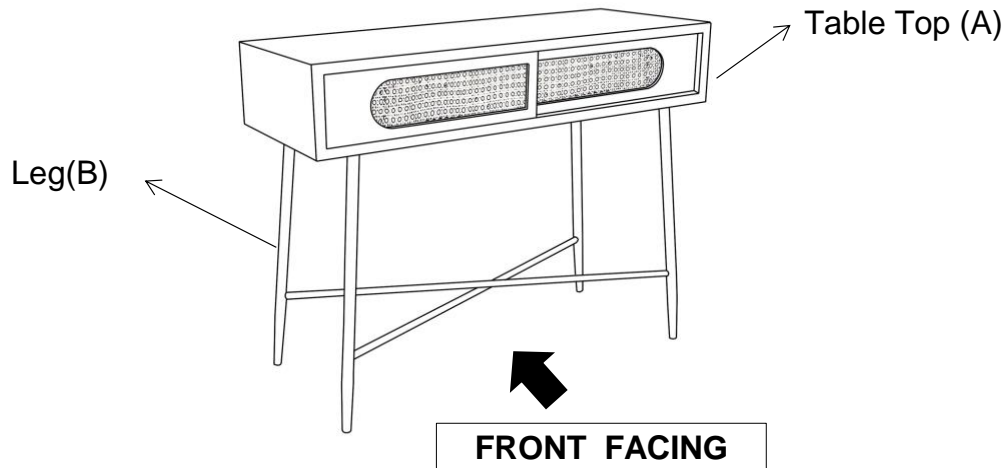
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

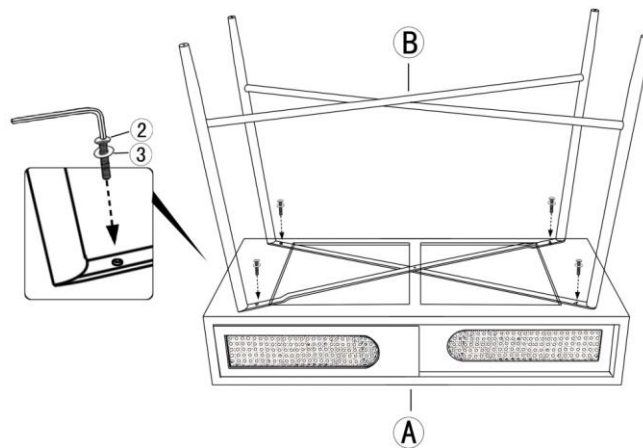
Assembly Steps

Overview



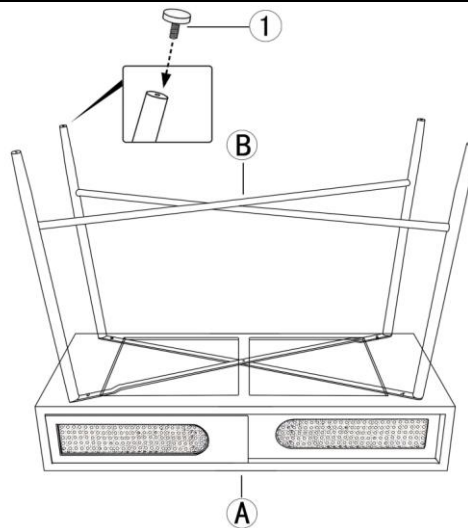
This Table has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



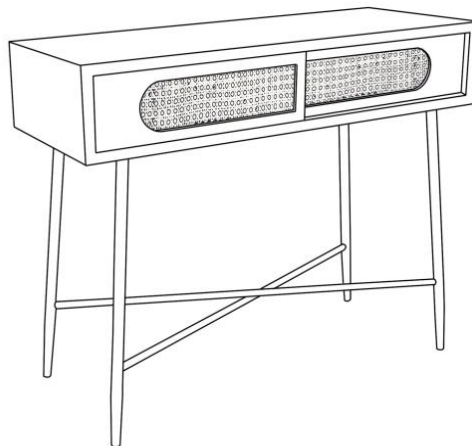
Attach Legs(B) to Table Top(A) using Bolts(②) and Flat Washers(③)with the Allen Key(④)

Step 2



Attach the Adjustable Levellers(①) to the Legs(B) by hand.

Step 3



Turn the Table right side up.
Your Table is ready for use.

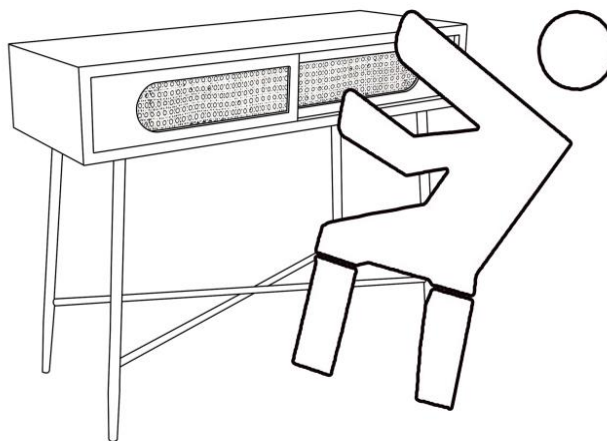
Caution: This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Tipover Restraint Device Installation Instruction



Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from tipping furniture.

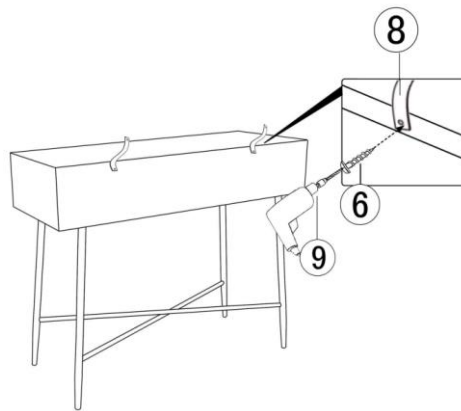
To help prevent tip-over: ALWAYS secure this furniture to the wall using the Restraint Device.
See product instructions for more ways to help prevent furniture tip-over.



Usage For Table Restraint Device:

To secure the Table against wall, attach one end of the Restraint Strap(⑧) to the wall and the other end of the Restraint Strap(⑧) to the product.

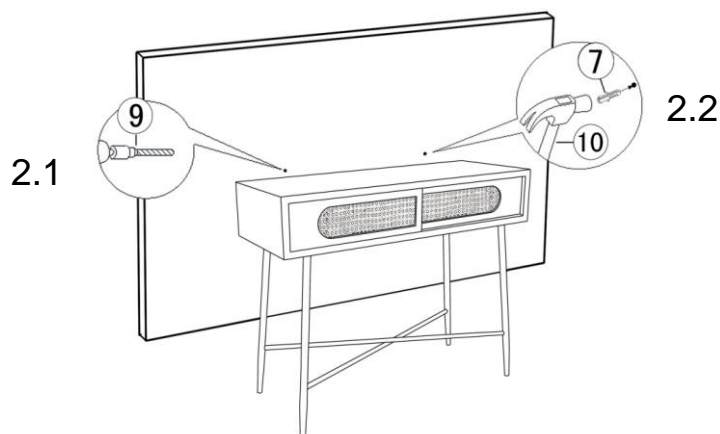
Step 1



Turn the Table so the back faces you.

Attach two Restraint Straps(8) to the back of the Table Top(A) where labeled, using a Bracket Screw(6) and a Power Drill(9).

Step 2



2.1) Drill two holes on the wall at the same height as the Restraint Straps(8) on the Table using a Power Drill(9).

You can mark this point in two ways as below:

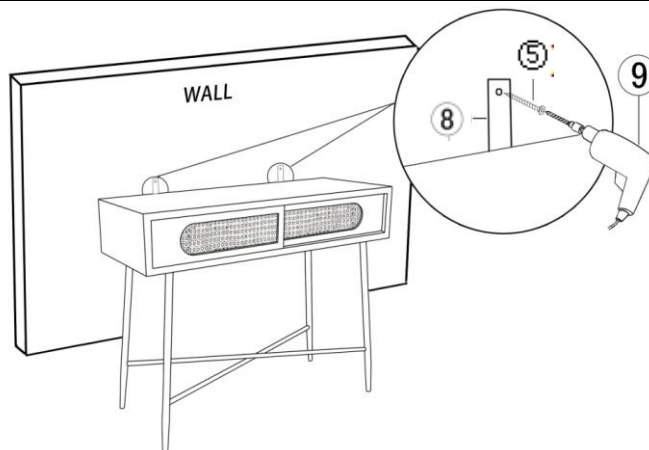
1) Move the Table back to the wall. Mark two points the same height as the Table on the wall.

Note: The Restraint Strap needs to be secured to a solid, load bearing surface. Please use a Stud Finder(not supplied) if needed to locate the Wall Frame.

2) Measure the height of the Restraint Strap(8) with a ruler/measuring tape and mark on the wall to keep them accurate and at the same height.

2.2) Attach a Wall Anchor (7) to the hole on the wall using a Hammer(10).

Step 3



Attach the Restraint Strap(8) to the Wall Anchor (7) using a Screw(5) and the Power Drill(9)
Your Table is ready for use.

Caution: This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Care & Maintenance



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
