

Assembly Instructions

WARNING CAUTION

ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED CHOKING HAZARD

- This product includes small parts, sharp points and sharp edges in its unassembled state. Keep unassembled parts away from children under 3 years of age, and animals.

STRANGULATION HAZARD

- Never attach or hang items to any part of the bookcase that is not designed for use with the bookcase; for example, but not limited to hooks, belts, and jump ropes.

SAFETY WARNINGS

- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the loft bed end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.
- Do not allow children under 3 years of age to use the bookcase.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.

FURNITURE TIP-OVER HAZARD

Children have died from furniture tip-over.

To reduce the risk of furniture tip-over:

- ALWAYS install tip-over restraint especially if used by a wall or in the open.
- NEVER put a TV on this product
- NEVER allow children to stand, climb or hang on drawers, doors, or shelves.
- NEVER open more than one drawer at a time.
- ALWAYS place heaviest items in lowest drawers.



PARENTAL SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED

- This Kids product is intended for child use age 3+.
- Parents or Guardians should supervise use under the intended age specifically regarding children that may have access to it and climb on the unit.
- Do not allow horseplay on, under, or behind the unit and prohibit jumping on the bookcase.
- If used improperly, your bookcase may be pulled over or fall, creating risk of injury or damage. Children should not be permitted to climb or pull on the bookcase.

USE, MAINTENANCE & ASSEMBLY

- Periodically check and ensure that the components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Use on level surfaces only. Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damage to unit or floor.
- Do not use this item if any components are missing or damaged.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Only clean using damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- Check you have all components and tools listed on page 4
- Do not stand or put weight on this product during assembly, this could cause damage.
- Remove all hardware from the plastic bags and separate them into groups.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Certain assembly steps may be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- We do not recommend power screwdrivers. Only use hand screwdrivers to prevent damage to unit.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.


Para limitar el riesgo de vuelco de los muebles:

Due to the number of parts involved assembly can take a few hours so set aside between 30 minutes and 1 hour to assemble this without rushing.





COMPONENT PARTS

- 1. Table Top Panel x1
- 2. Middle Panel x1
- 3. Bottom Panel x1
- 4. Left Shelf x1
- 5. Right Shelf x1
- 6. Drawer Front Support x1
- 7. Drawer Left Side x1
- 8. Drawer Right Side x1
- 9. Drawer Rear Support x1
- 10. Drawer Bottom x1
- 11. Table Back Support x1




ASSEMBLY HARDWARE



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



Select 7,8,9,10 and A x8.
Align groove in 7, and 8 to
groove of 9. Fasten 7 to 9
with A x2. Repeat and fasten
8 to 9 with A x2. Slide drawer
bottom 10 into groove of 7, 8
and ensure snug into 9.


Select 6, Ax4, Cx1, Dx1.
Align groove of 6 to 7 and 8.
slide 10 into groove of 6.
Insert Ax2 into holes at end of
7 and fasten 6 to 7. Repeat Ax2
into holes at end of 8 and fasten
8 to 6. Insert D bolt inside 6 and
fasten to C drawer pull.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



Select 2, 3, 4, 5, 11, A x4, B x6. Position 3 in the bottom, position 2 in the middle with groove facing up toward top of unit. Insert B x2 into center holes of 3. Insert B x4 into holes in 2. Align 4 to the left and 5 to the right of the center shelves. Insert dowels from 2 and 3 into holes of 4 and 5. Fasten 3 to 4 and 5 with A x4. Loosely tighten the A screws to allow adjustment at top. Align 11 into groove of 2, 4 and 5. Tighten A screws in 3.



Select 2, 3, 4, 5, 11, A x4.
Insert the A x2 into the top of the 4 into the 1. Repeat for the 5 and 1.
