MAINTAINANCE AND WARNINGS



Before You Start

Please follow the steps below:




-  Un box the package and check if all parts and accessories are complete.
-  Place the parts of the chair on a flat surface.
-  Ensure the chair is placed on a stable, flat surface to prevent it from tilting.
-  Avoid placing sharp or heavy objects directly on the chair to prevent tears or deformation.
-  Clean the installation area in advance and ensure the ground is level and there is enough space to avoid damaging the furniture or making installation difficult.
-  Lay a protective mat on the ground to prevent scratching the floor during installation.

Precautions

-  This chair is for indoor use only. Do not expose it to outdoor elements or high-humidity environments.
-  Keep the product away from high heat or open flames to prevent fire hazards.

Safety Warnings

-  If you notice any loose or damaged parts, stop using the chair immediately and contact customer service.

Daily Maintenance

- Regularly clean the surface of the sofa with a chair cloth to prevent dust accumulation.
- For fabric chairs, it is recommended to vacuum weekly and clean the fabric as needed.
- For leather chairs, use a leather cleaner regularly to clean and maintain the material. Avoid direct sunlight to prevent leather aging.
- In case of spills, immediately blot the area with a clean, dry cloth

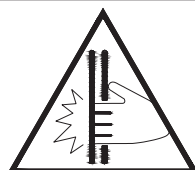

WARNING

The following guidelines are provided to ensure the safe of your power lift recliner.

- Care should be taken in the unpacking of this unit, so as not to cause injury to persons or damage to the unit. Dispose of all plastic bags and covers, as they can be a smothering hazard to small children.
- To operate this recliner properly, you must read and understand the intended use of the product, and overall operation of the recliner as misuse, or lack of proper training may lead to serious injury.



Do not allow children or pets near the recliner while the recliner is operating.



Do not allow children to play with or operate the recliner at any time.



Hand control should be unplugged and placed out of the reach of children when the recliner is not in use.


- Do not flop down into the recliner when getting into it, or while it is in its lift position. Flopping down into the recliner will damage it and could cause personal injury.
- Do not allow anyone to sit on your lap, or on the arm of the recliner, or on the footrest while in or operating the recliner, as it may cause tipping and could result in personal injury.





Do not place fingers or hands between the seat cushion and the inside arm of the recliner while sitting in the recliner or when the recliner is in operation or plugged into a power source.



WARNING


The following guidelines are provided to ensure the safe of your power lift recliner.


-  Do not retrieve fallen objects from inside or under the recliner while the recliner is plugged into a power source.


Use extreme care before operating your device to ensure electrical cables are not located near pinch points, such as in between the seat and arms near the recline mechanism.


-   Do not operate the recliner if there are any persons, pets or other obstructions under or in front of the footrest, under the recliner or behind the recline


-   Do not position yourself, child and/or pet too high on the recliner while the recliner back is reclined. This can cause a tip over hazard. Make sure you are properly fitted for the lift recliner prior to operating the recliner.

-  Do not smoke while operating, sitting or resting in the recliner.

-  To reduce the risk of electrical shock, avoid immersing electrical components in liquid or spilling liquids onto them. Do not attempt to open electrical components, as there are no serviceable parts inside.

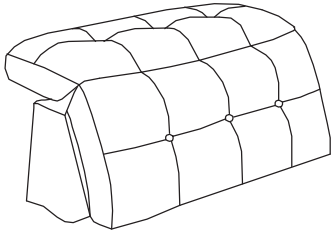
-  Warranty will be void if any of the electrical components are opened by other than a qualified service person.

-  Make sure the recliner is placed at the specified distance from a wall/corner. Failure to do so can damage the recliner and will void the warranty.

-  Not for commercial use, only for residential use

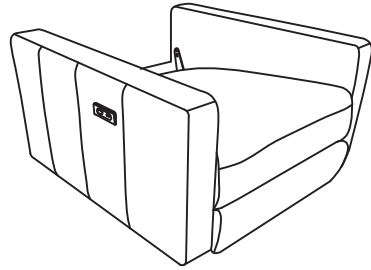

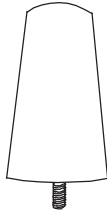
Backrest

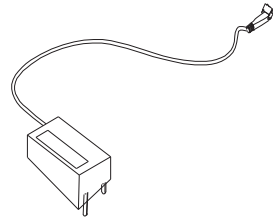
Seat frame
