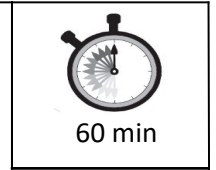
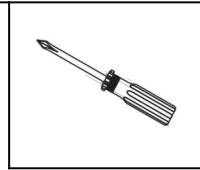
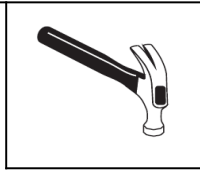


BS-WM – Book Shelf

Information about your furniture:

Our furniture ranges have been carefully crafted from solid wood and natural wood veneers. Each piece of furniture has unique characteristics such as knots, variances and graining. These are part of the natural character of the furniture itself.

Caring for your furniture:

Extreme temperature can cause slight movements in the wood itself so please avoid placing your furniture close to radiators or other direct sources of heat. Humidity should also be avoided. Please avoid exposing your furniture to continued bright sunlight as it can affect the color. Any fluid should be removed as quickly as possible. Always lift your furniture when moving, as dragging can cause damage to your furniture or flooring. Extreme changes in temperature and humidity during transit may result in a powder residue forming so silica gel bags have been included to alleviate this natural occurrence. This residue is harmless and can easily be removed before assembly with a damp cloth and mild detergent.

After care:

Wipe the surfaces with a dry cloth and an occasional use of normal household polish. We also recommend you use household spray polish occasionally on the drawer grooves and runners as this will aid use. Please do not use detergents or chemicals on your furniture.

Please check that you have all the correct parts and fittings as detailed below. In the unlikely event of a part being damaged or missing please check the component or part number on the diagram below and contact your retailer for corrective action.

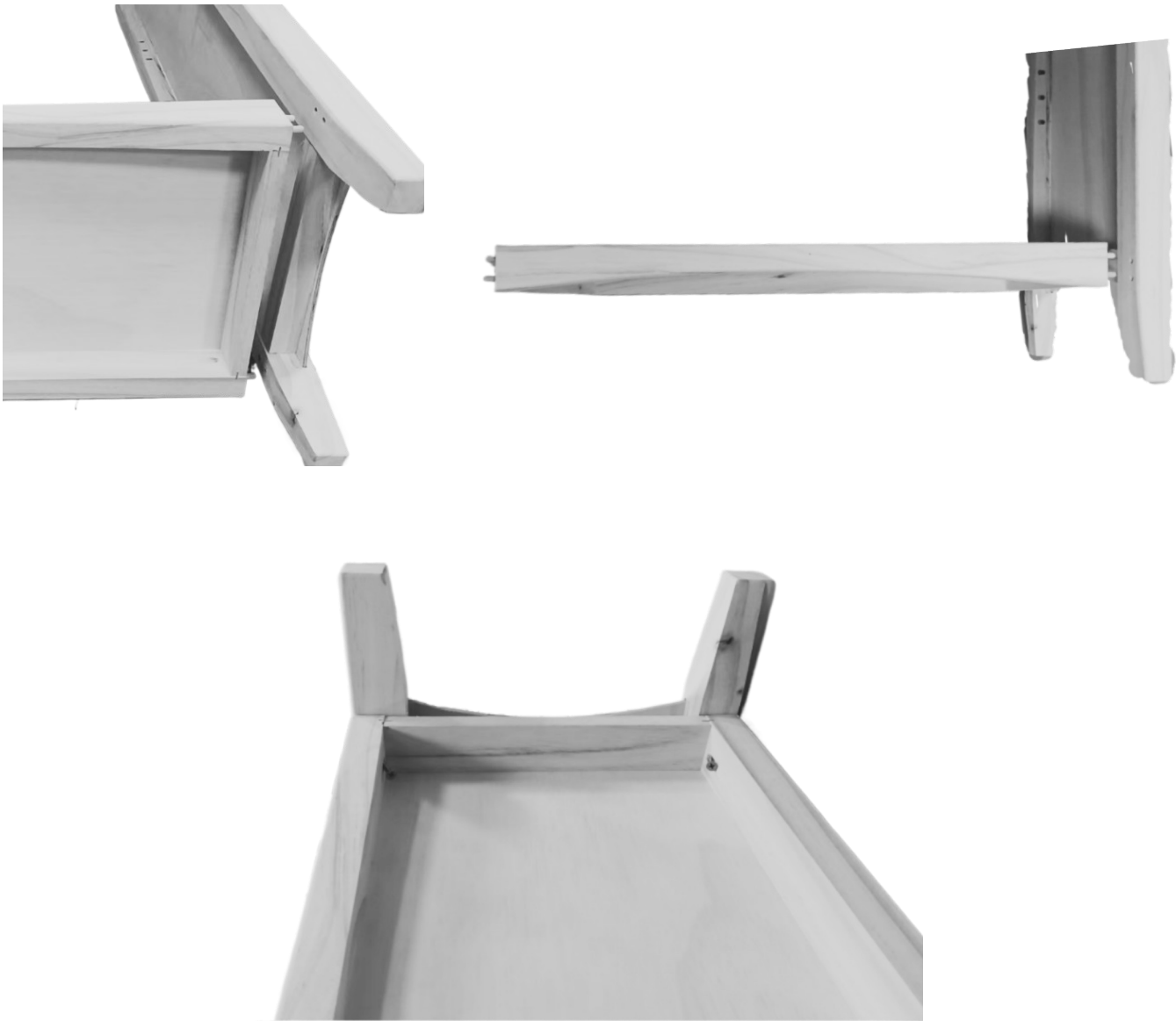

Note: It is easiest to lay this down on the side as we will be attaching all bars and shelves to the Right Panel first and then aligning and securing the Left Panel second.

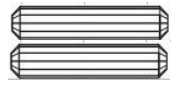
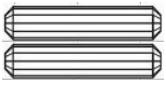
Step 1 - Take Bottom Shelf (Part 5) and insert dowels (A) in the holes on each end.



Step 2 - Set Right Panel (Part 3) on it's side and align Bottom Shelf (Part 5) and it's dowels (from Step 1) into the holes at the bottom of the frame. Secure underneath using the screws (D) provided.



Step 3 - Take the top bar (Part 6) and insert 2 dowels (A) on each end. Align and insert into the appropriate holes on the top of the Right Panel. Secure on the back side of the top bar using screw (D).



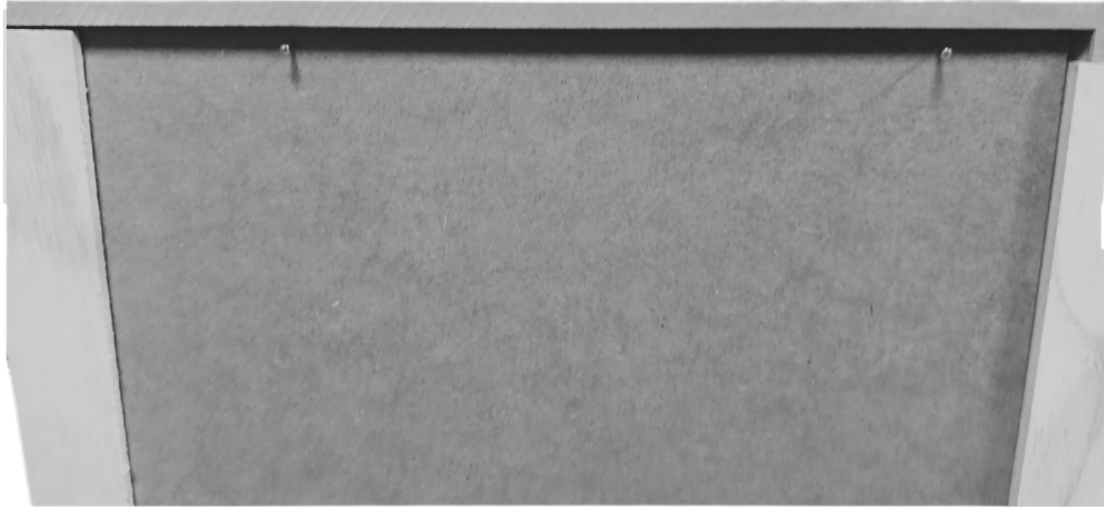
Step 4 - Now that the right panel has all the bottom shelf and top bar in place, rotate the panel to its back so that the top bar and bottom shelf are now facing up. This will make it easy to just place the Left Panel (Part 2) on top and secure with dowels and screws as in steps 2-3.



Step 5 - Place top (Part 1) on top and secure with screws (D) from below. Ensure the groove for the back panel brace is facing the back.



Step 6 - Lay unit flat down on it's front side so that you can easily apply the back panel (Part 7 - 2 pc) with it's back panel brace (Part 8). Use the copper nails provided (C) to secure the back panel to the frame.



Step 7 - Set shelf upright and place metal shelf pins (B) in place to hold the shelves (Part 4 - 3 pc).



Step 8 - Insert the 3 shelf pieces and adjust the pin placements to your desired shelf heights.
