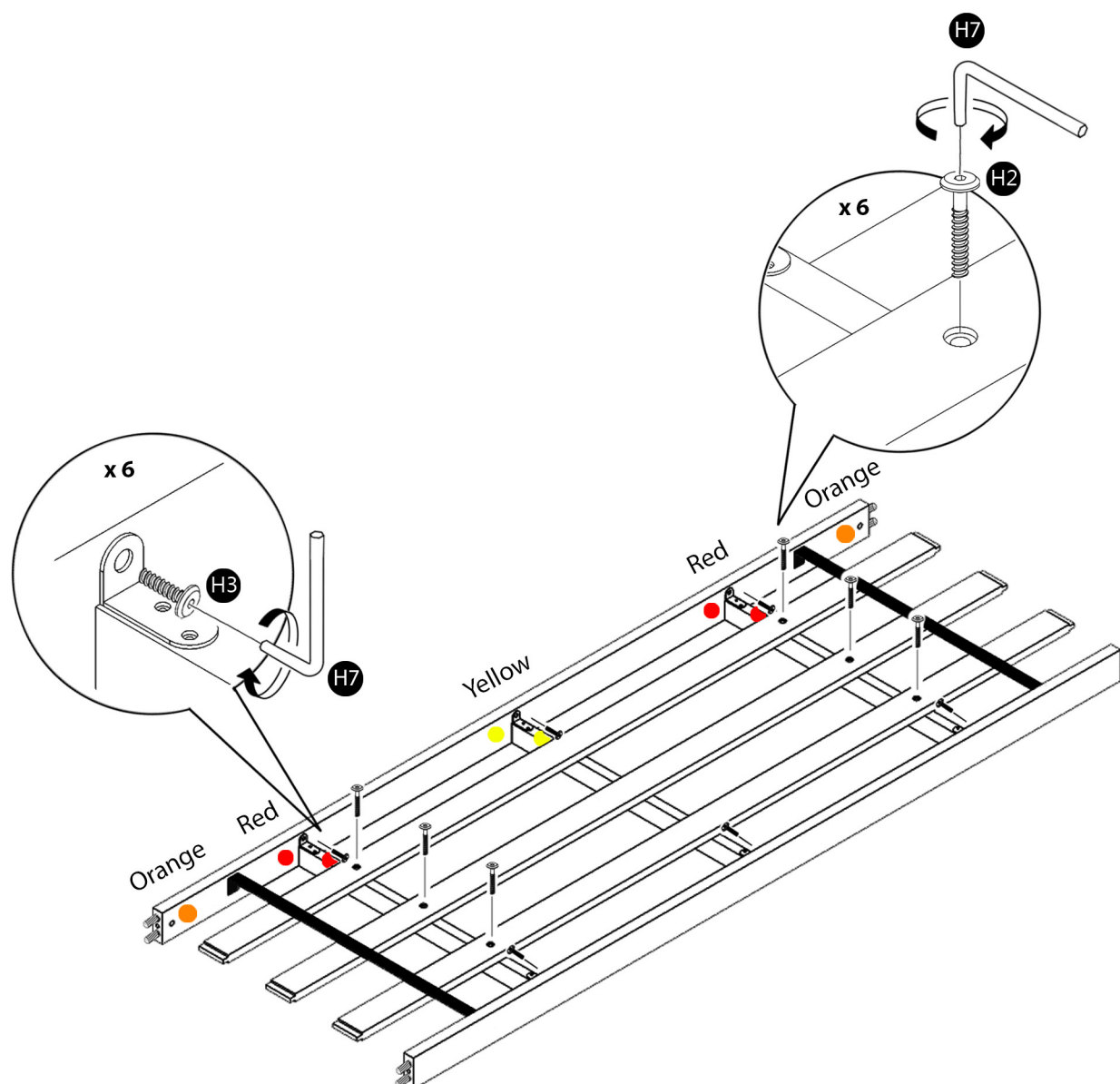


Step 1: Locate parts P2, P9(2), & P7

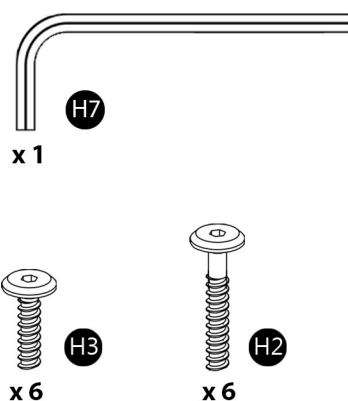
Use colored dots to align parts for connection.



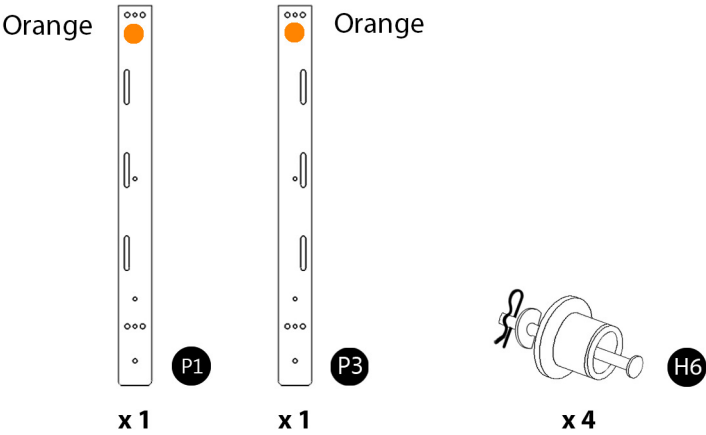
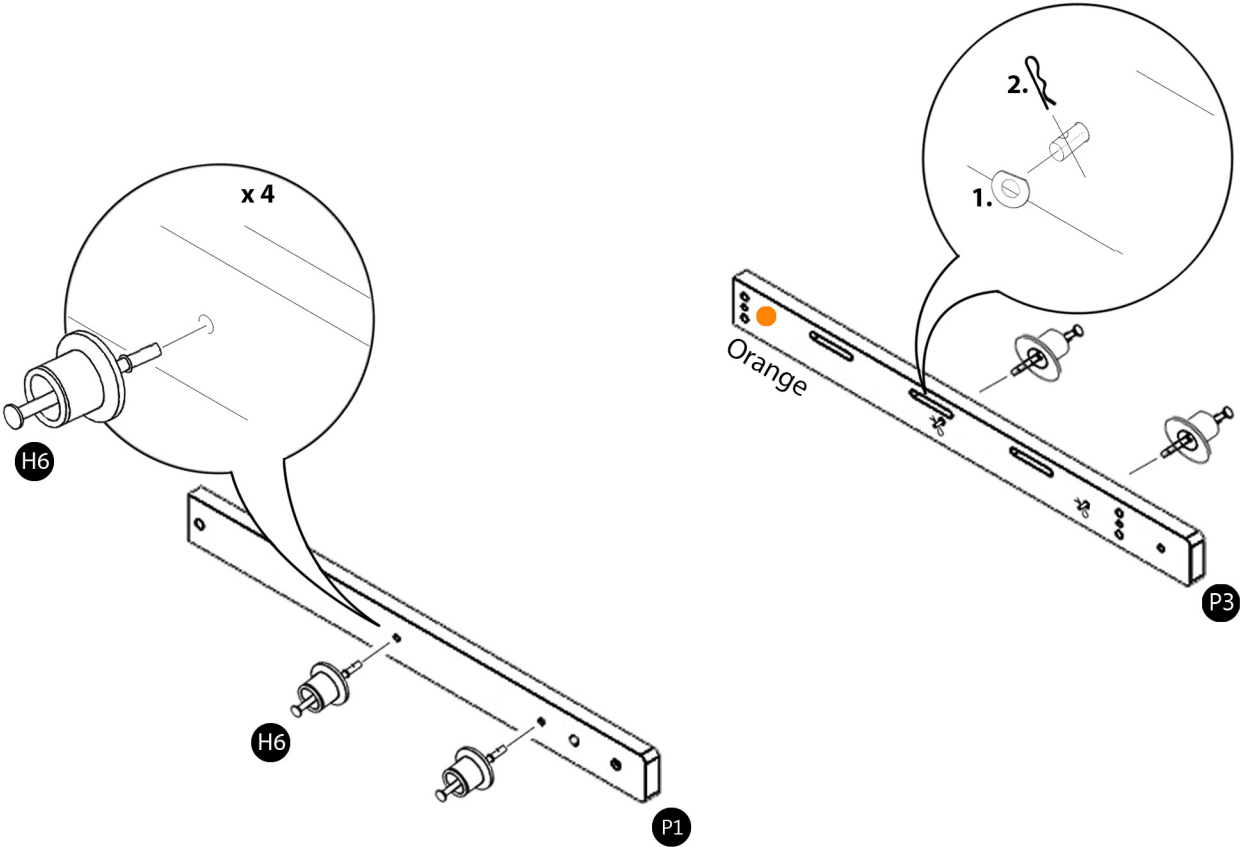
Step 2: Attach P7 and P9(2) to P2 with hardware as shown



Loosely attach H2 and H3 bolts.

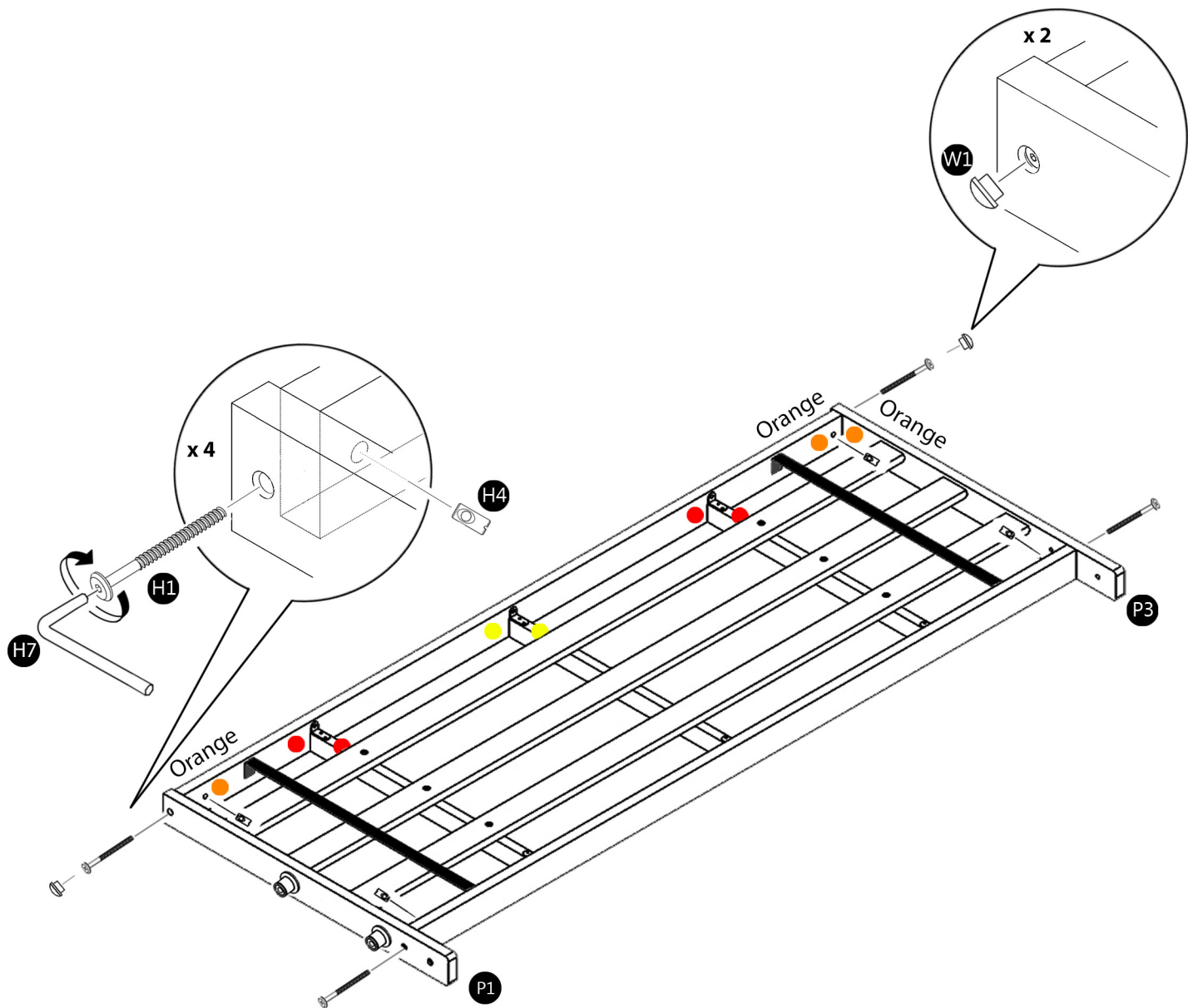


Step 3: Attach four nylon guides (H6) as shown

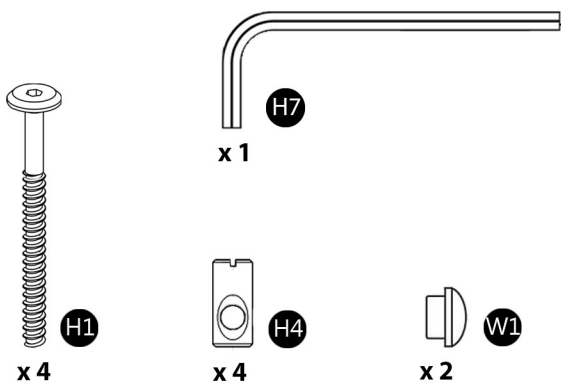


Step 4: Attach P1 & P3 to back deck P2

Use colored dots to align parts for connection.

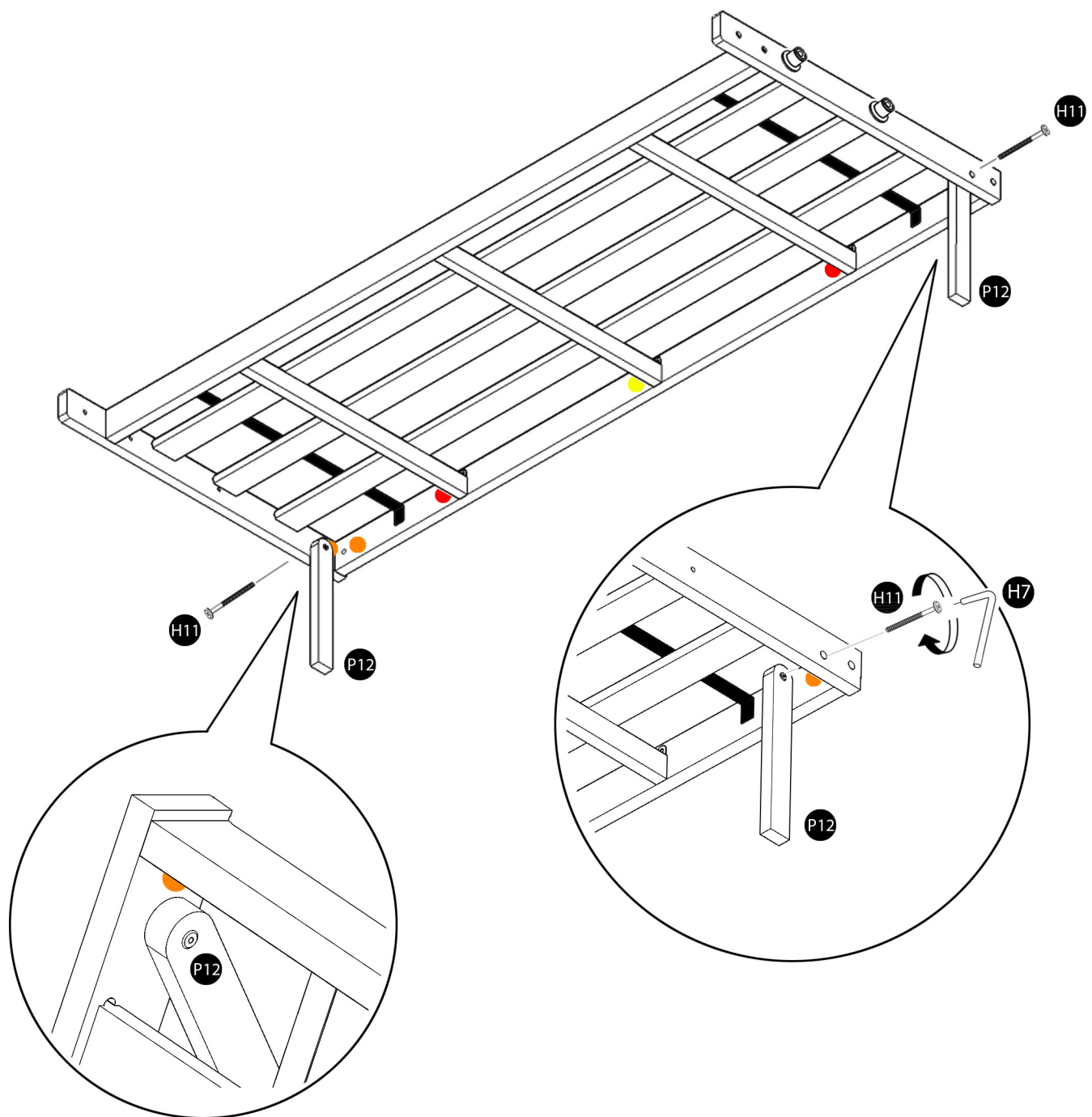


All bolts can be tightened at this point.

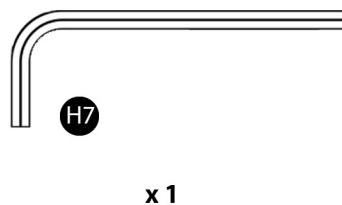
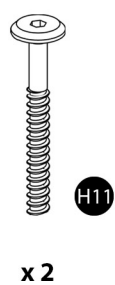
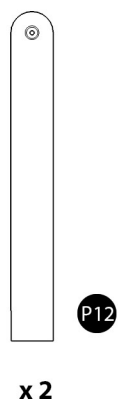


Queen Size Frames

If your frame is queen size, you will need to attach part P12(2)

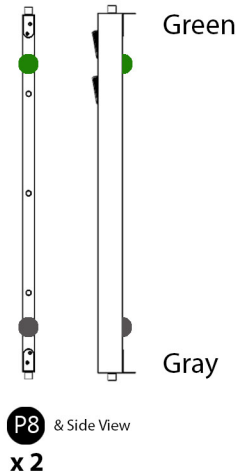
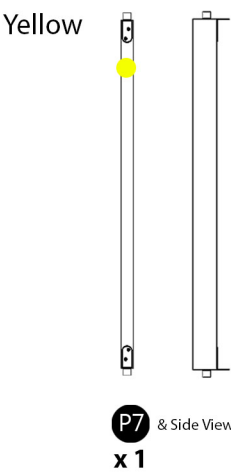
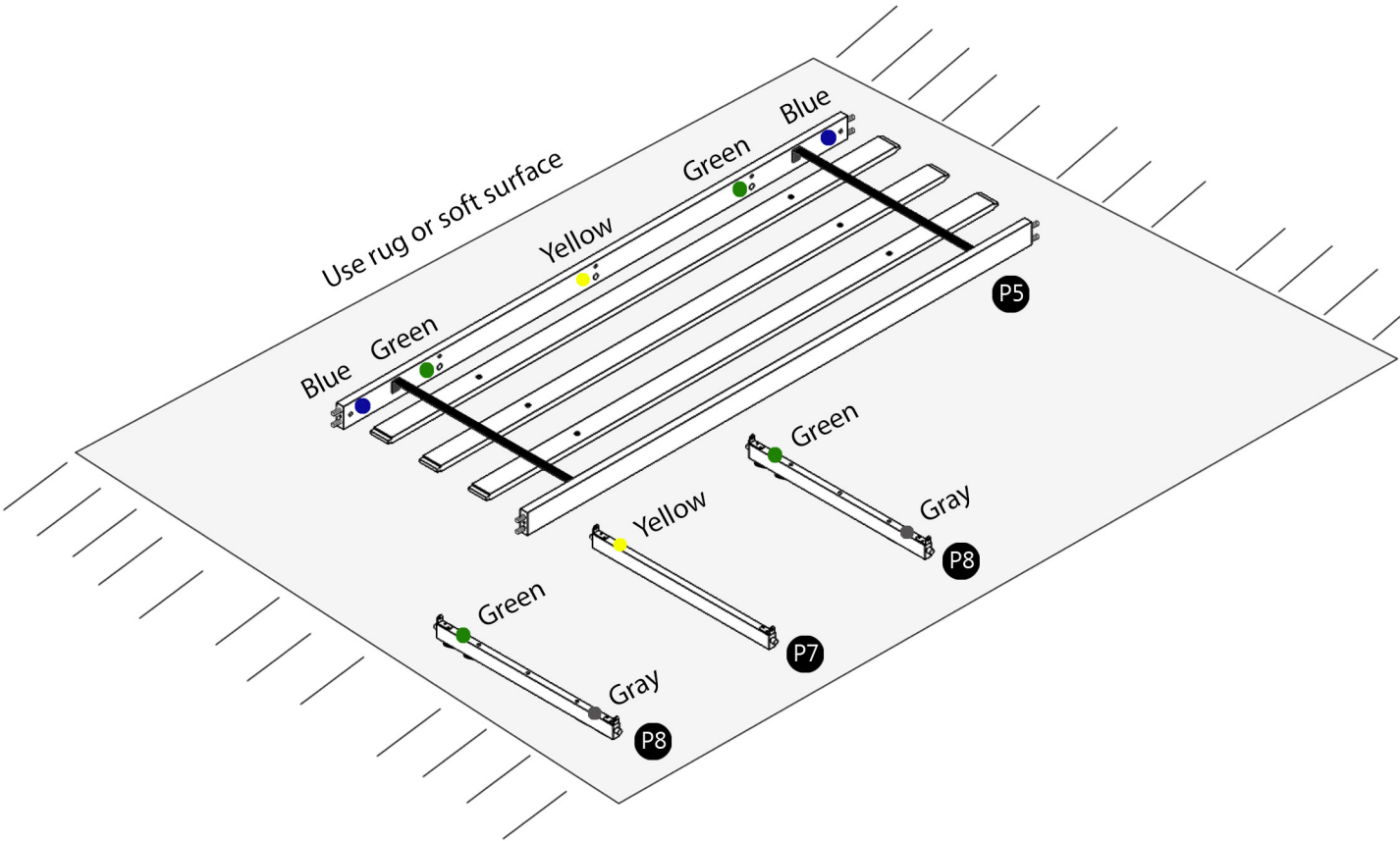

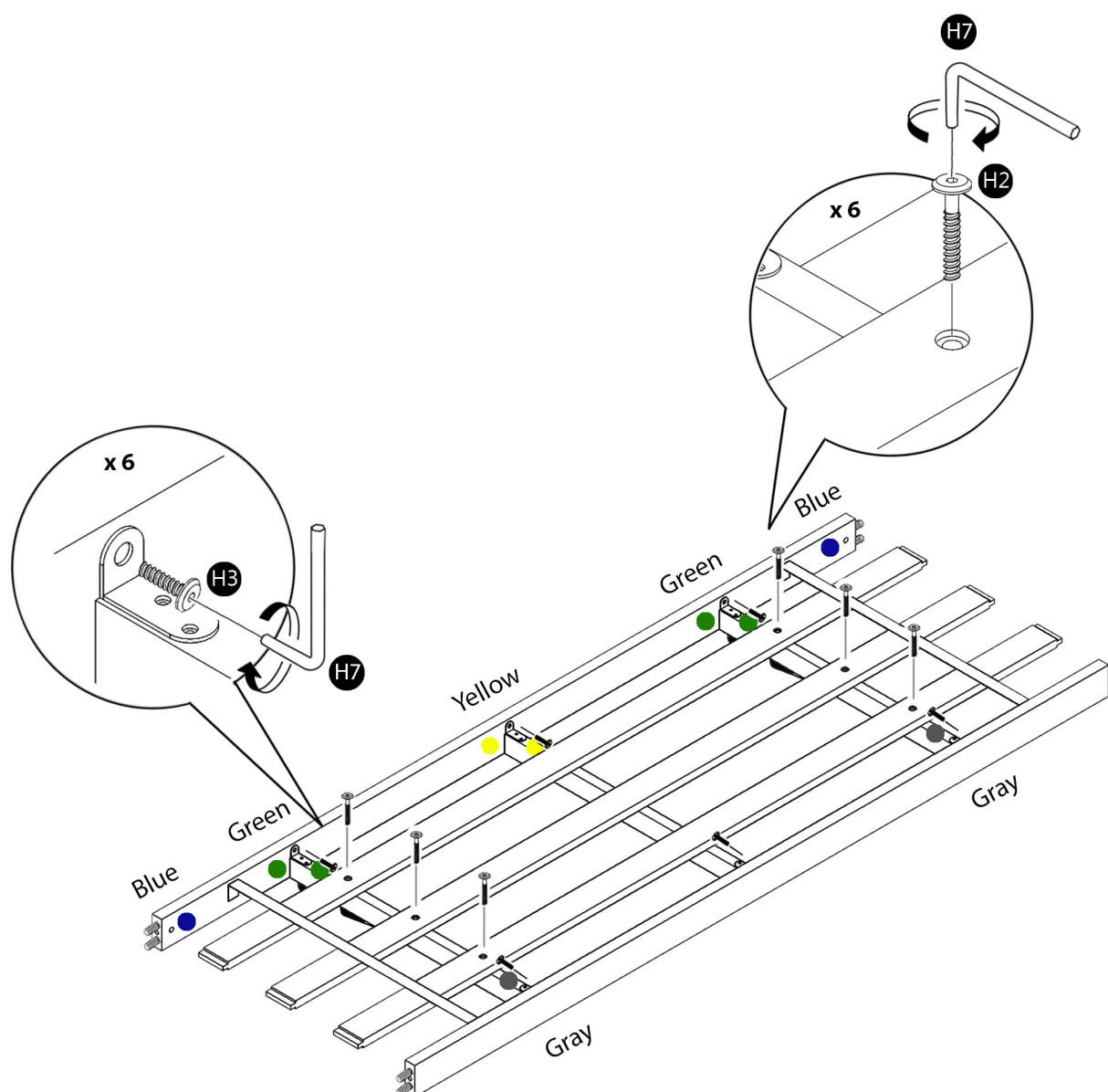


Step 5: Locate parts P5, P8(2), & P7

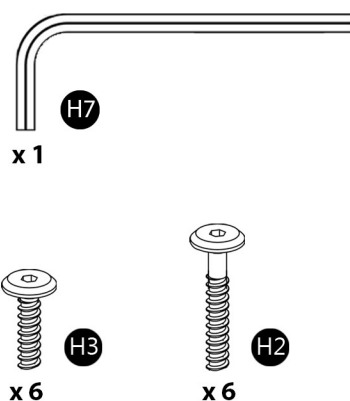
Use colored dots to align parts for connection.



Step 6: Attach P7 and P8(2) to P5 with hardware as shown

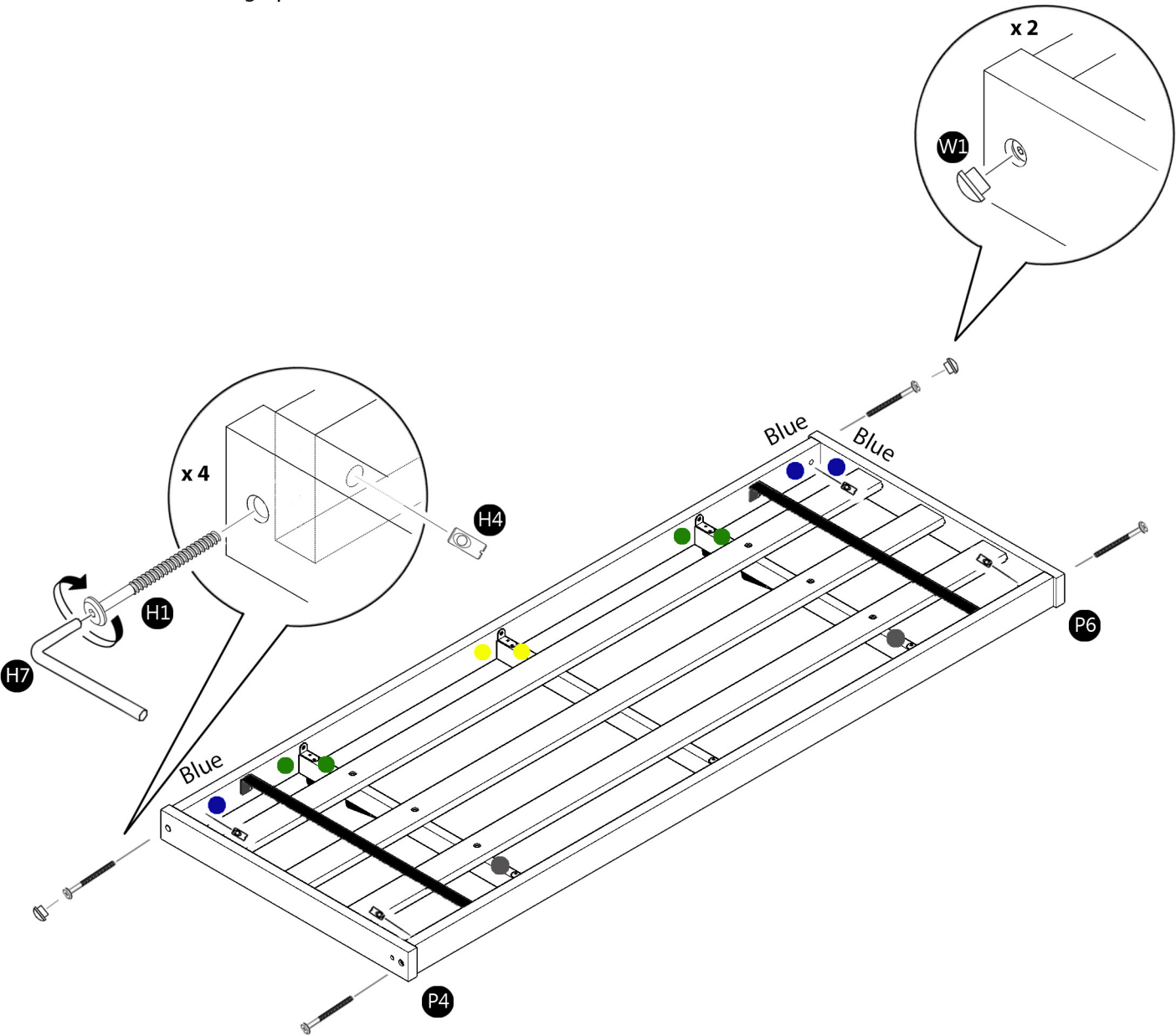


Loosely attach H2 and H3 bolts.

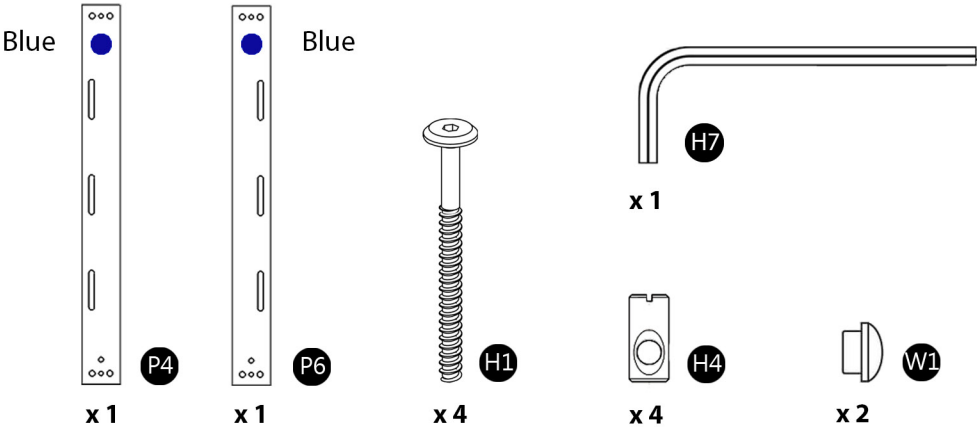


Step 7: Attach P4 & P6 to seat deck P5

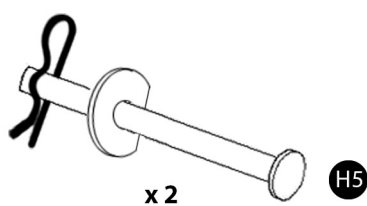
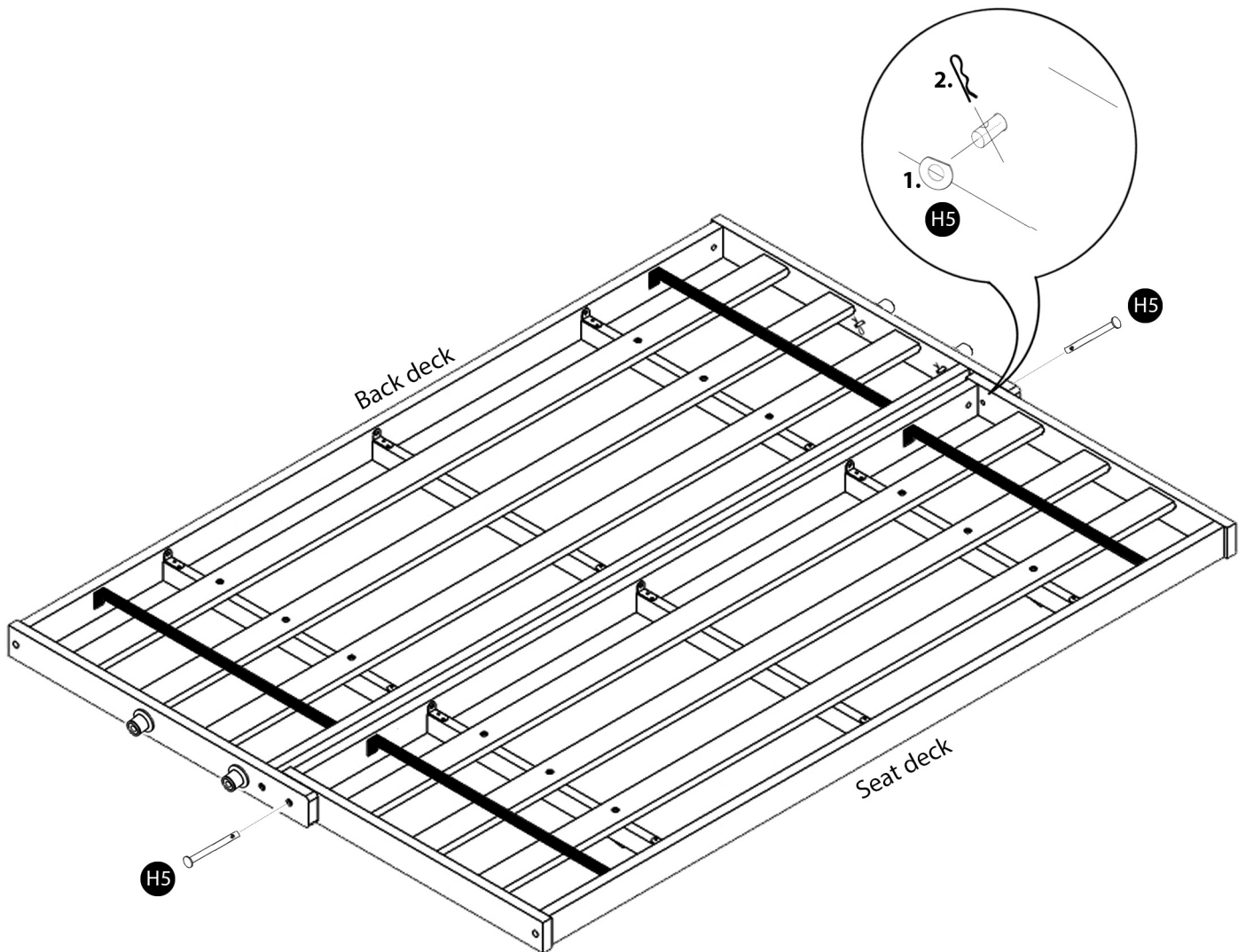
Use colored dots to align parts for connection.

Step 8: Connect the fully assembled seat and back decks using hardware H5 (x2) as shown below

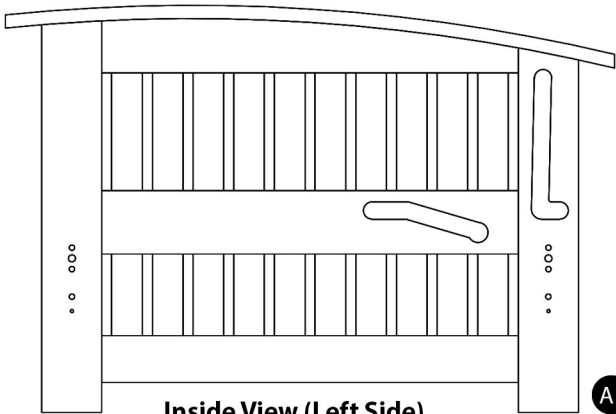

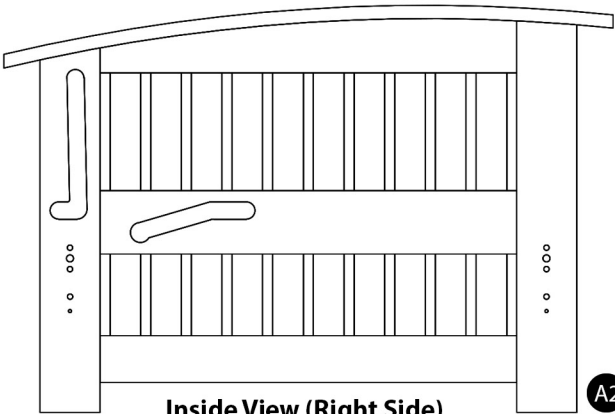

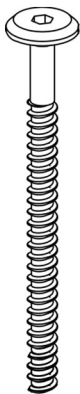


Inside View (Left Side)

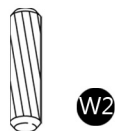
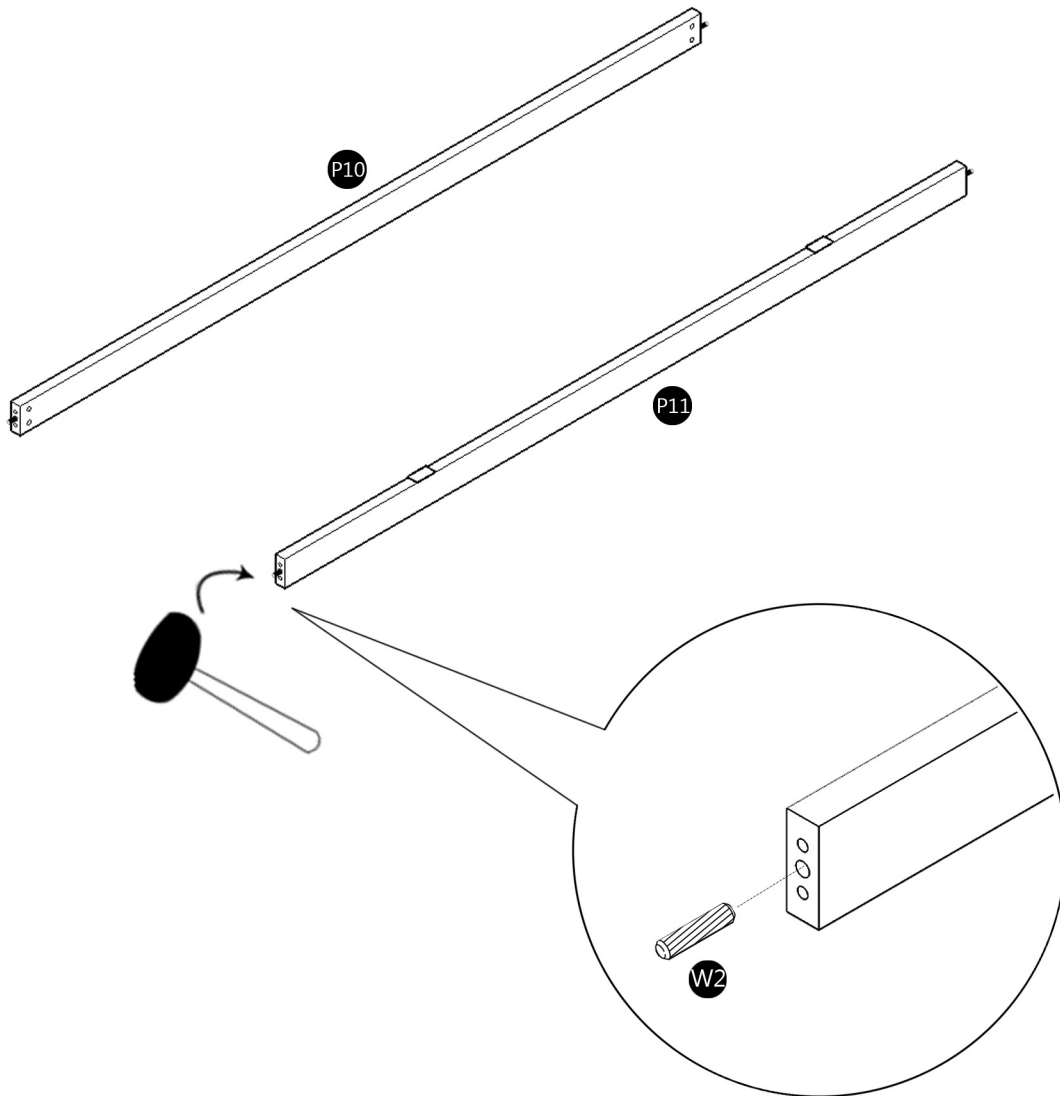
Step 9: Locate 4 legs, parts A1 & A2



Do not tighten the bolts before finishing all steps.

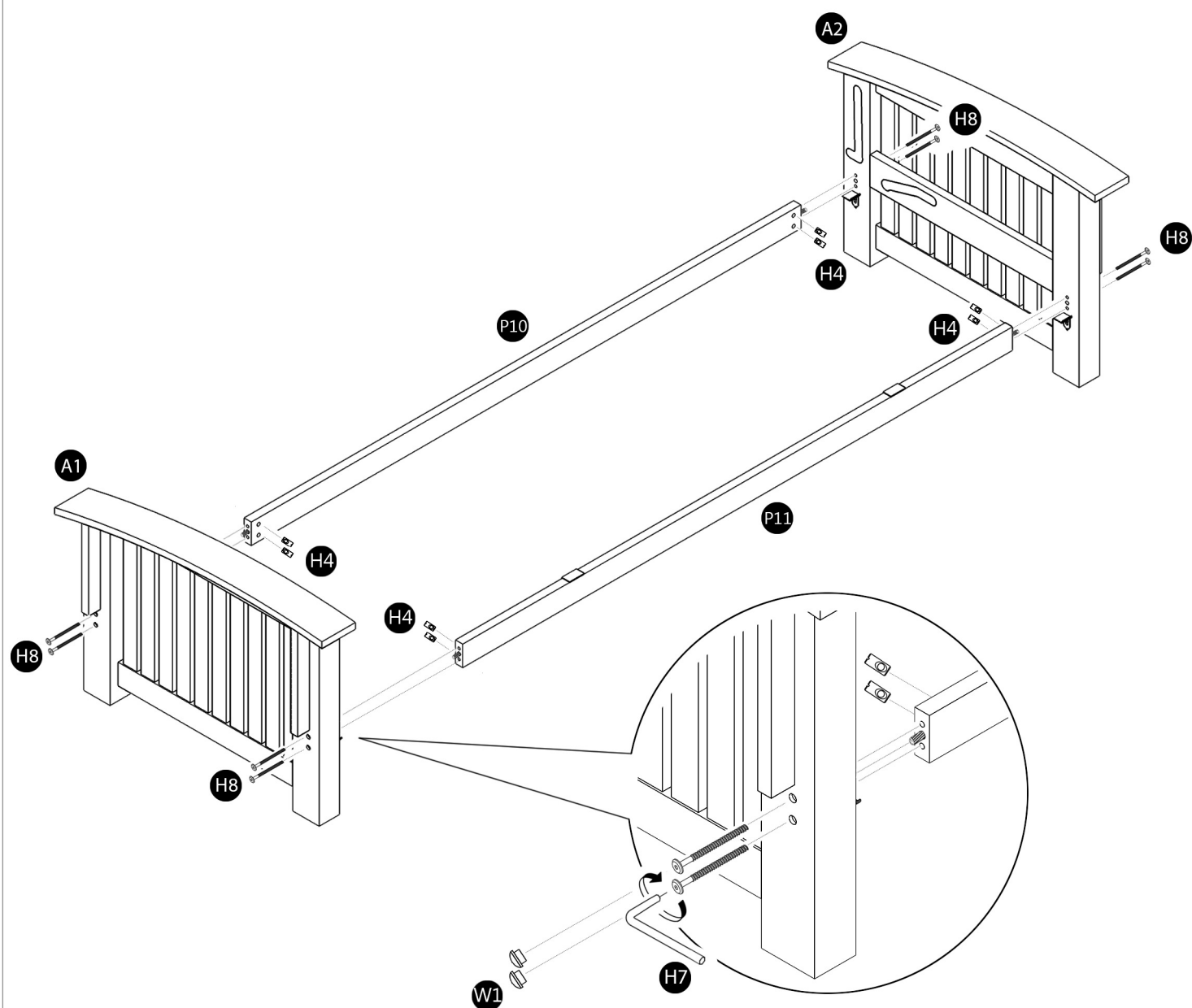


Step 10: Insert wood dowels (W2) into stretchers (P10) and (P11) as shown

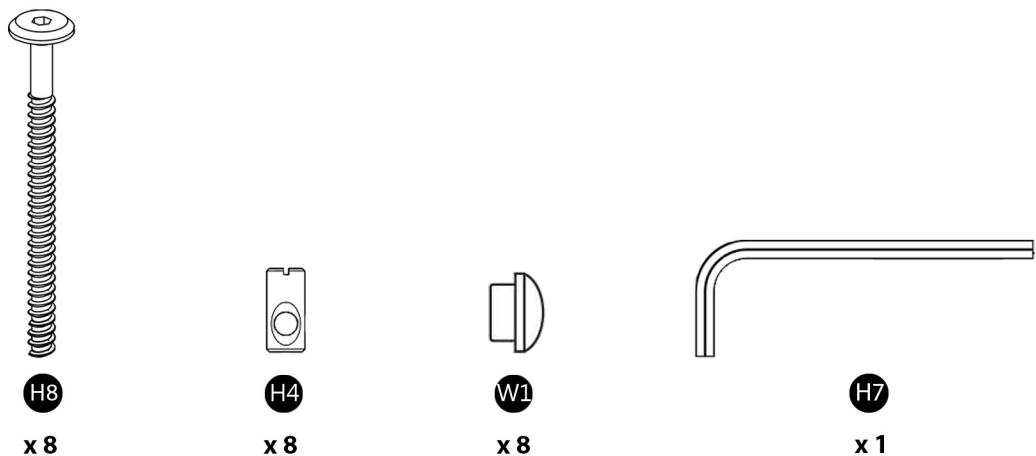

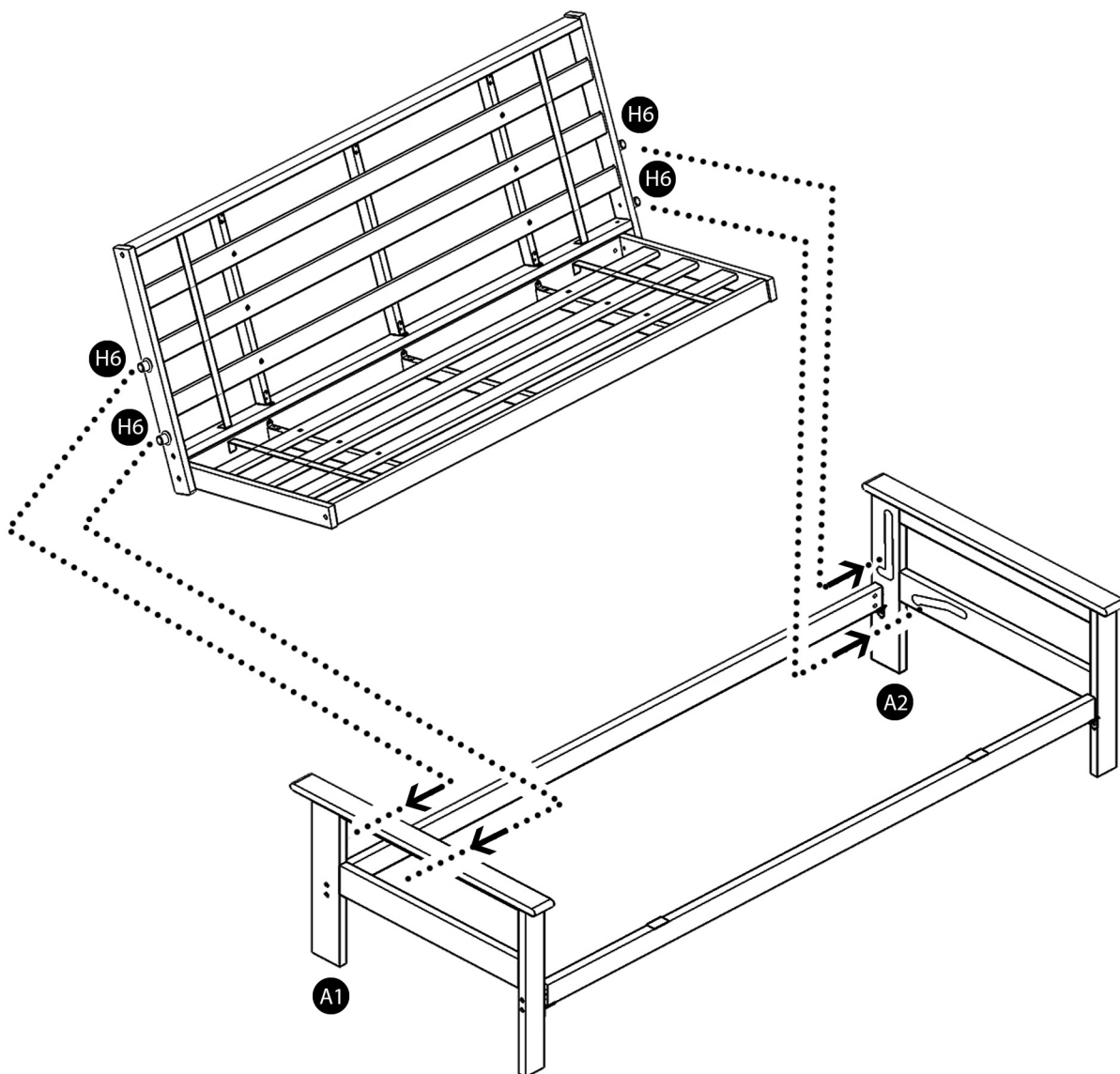
Step 11: Attach P10 & P11 to A1 & A2 with hardware as shown



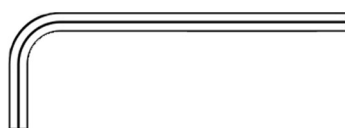
The bolts need to be very loosely attached at this point. Your arm may vary.



Step 12: Align H6(4) into grooved out slots on A1 & A2.



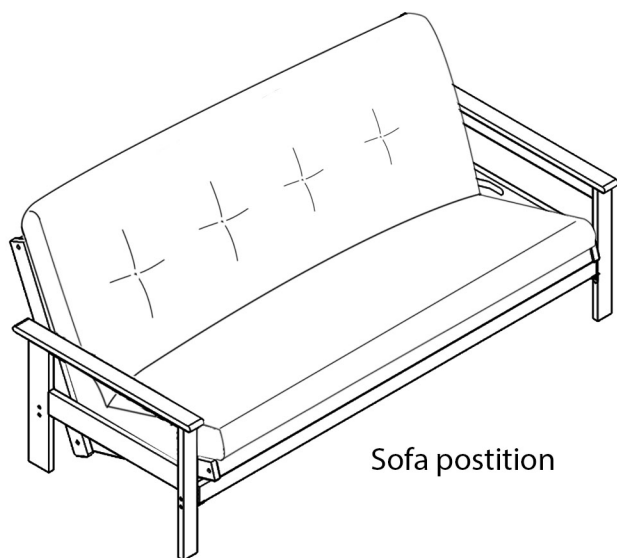
The bolts need to be very loosely attached at this point. Tighten all bolts after everything is in place.



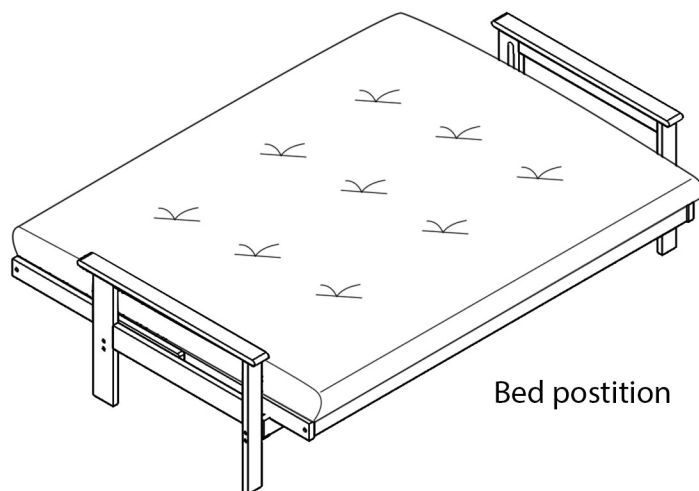

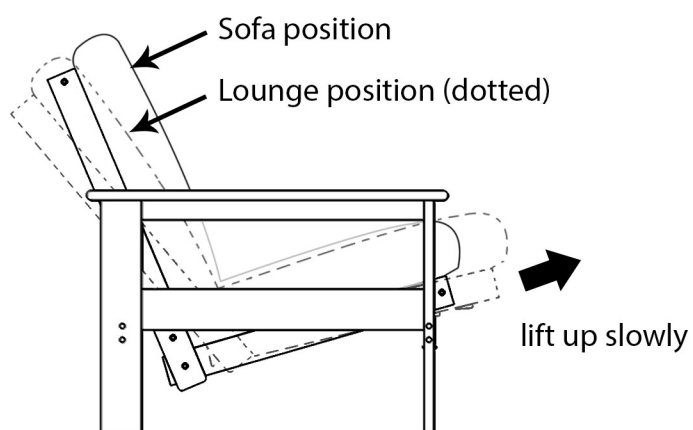

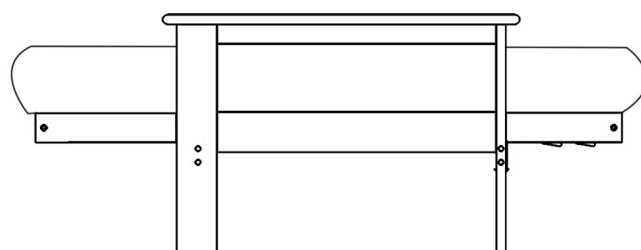
Sofa position
