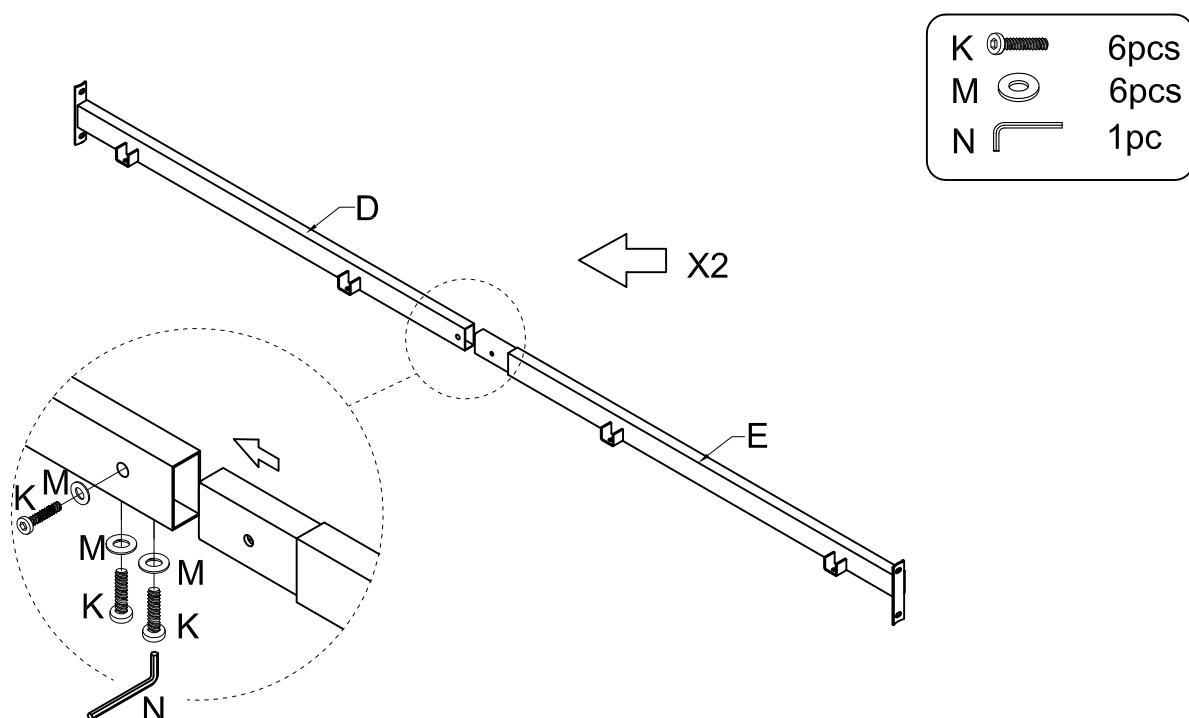
ASSEMBLY

Do not fully tighten all bolts until assembly is complete. This will help all parts to assemble properly.

- 1** Assemble the headboard (A) to the extension leg (C) with 4pcs bolts (K) and 4pcs flat washer (M), then fastened using allen wrench (N).

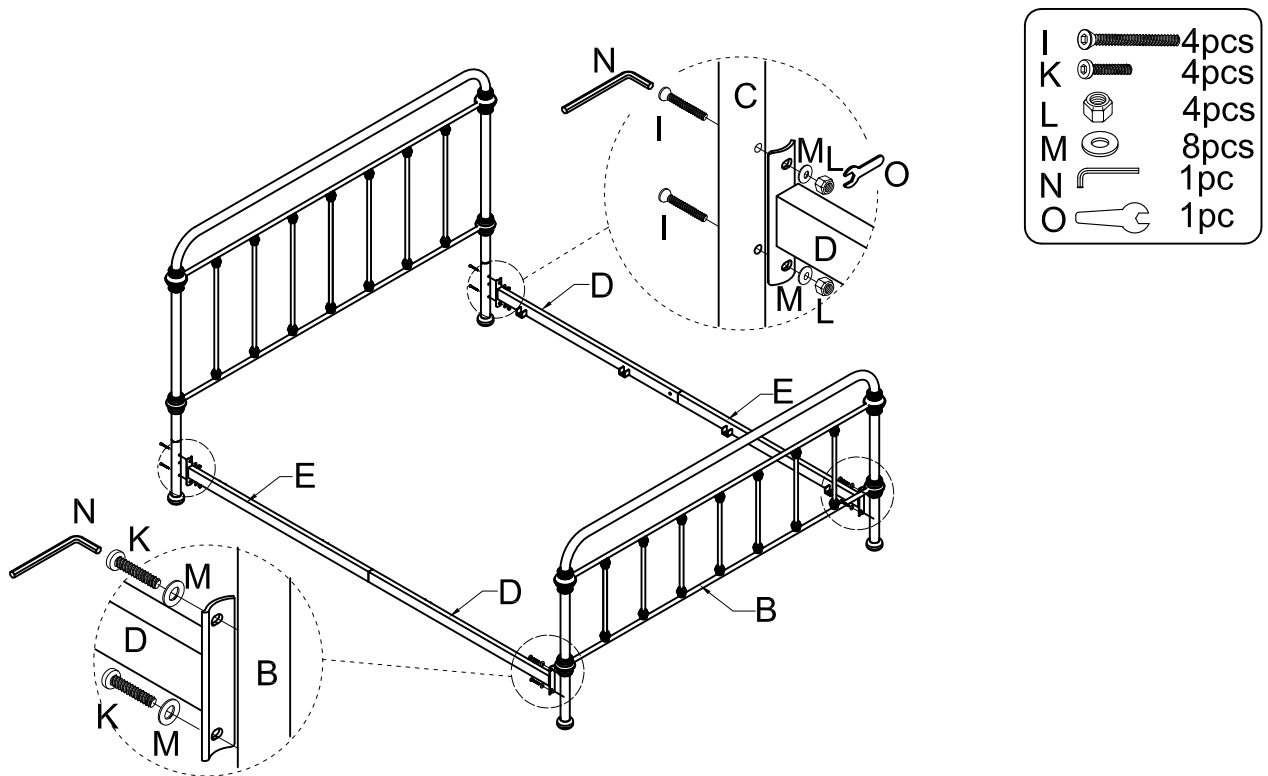


- 2** Assemble the side rail - front (D) to the side rail - rear (E) with 6pcs bolts (K) and 6pcs flat washer (M), then fastened using allen wrench (N).



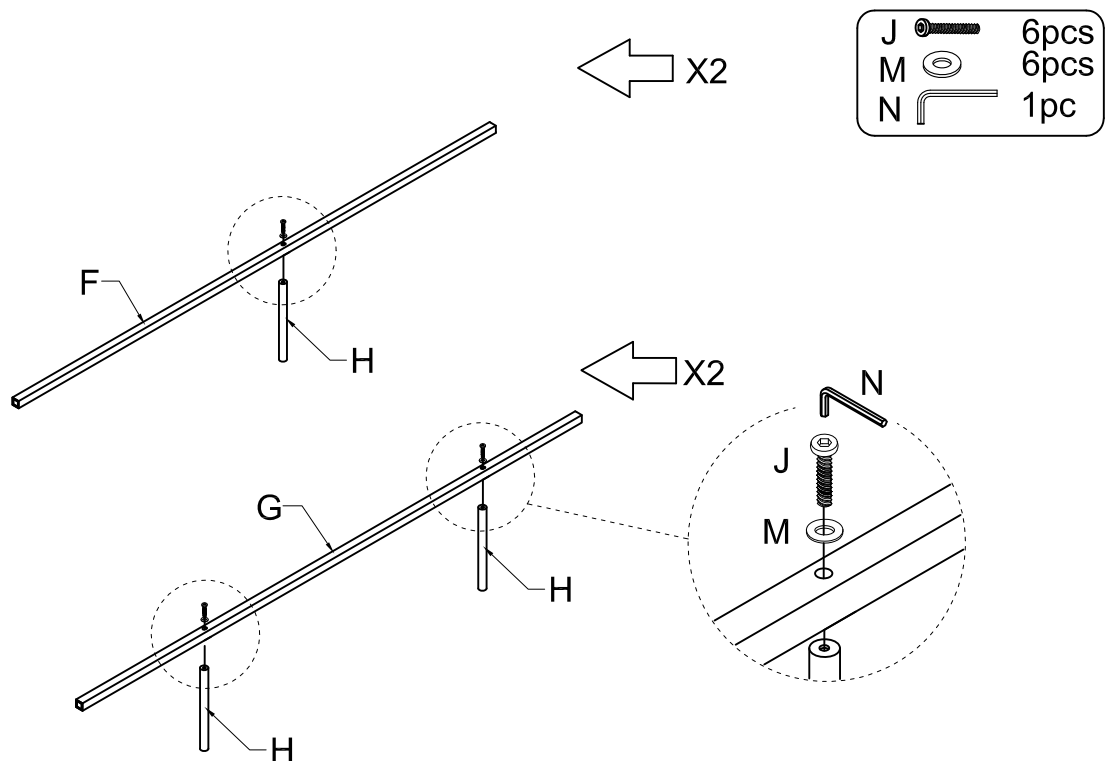

Assemble the side rail (D & E) to the extension leg (C) and the footboard (B) with 4pcs bolts (I), 4pcs bolts (K), 4pcs nuts (L), and 8pcs flat washer (M), then fastened using allen wrench (N) and wrench (O).



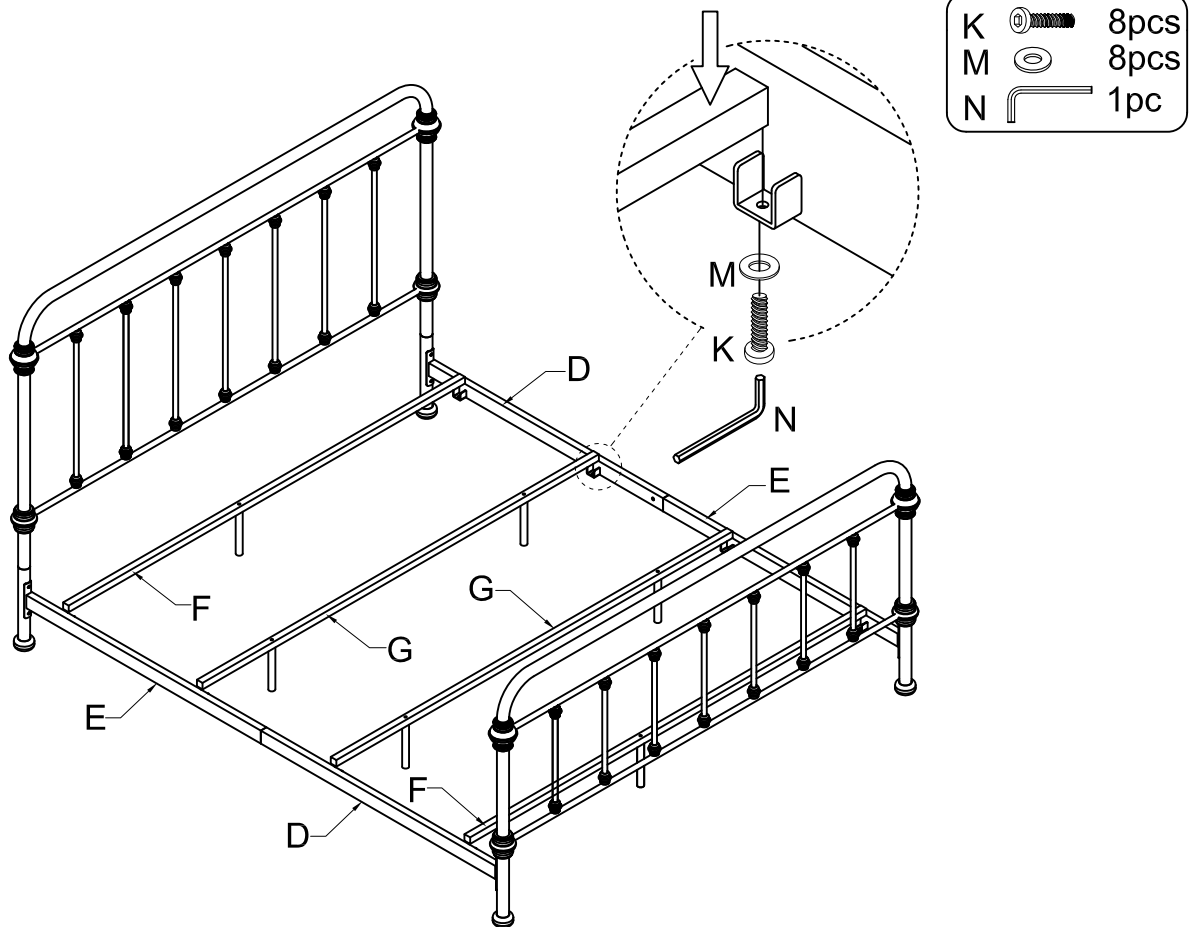

Assemble the slats - front / rear (F) and slats - center (G) to the support leg (H) with 1pc bolt (J) and 1pc flat washer (M) for each support leg (H), then fastened using allen wrench (N).

Assemble the slats - front / rear (F) and slats - center (G) to the side rail (D & E) with 1pc bolt (K), 1pc flat washer (M) for each end of slats - front / rear (F) and slats - center (G), then fastened using allen wrench (N).



WARNINGS:

- Do not remove warning label from bed.
- Use only mattress which is 79"-80" long and 59"-60" wide.
- Do not allow horseplay or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
- Periodically check and ensure that all the components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Do not use substitute parts, contact the store for replacement part.
- Maximum total weight is not to exceed 600 lbs.

Cleaning & Care

Treat surface with care. Surface is resistant to scratches but is not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.
