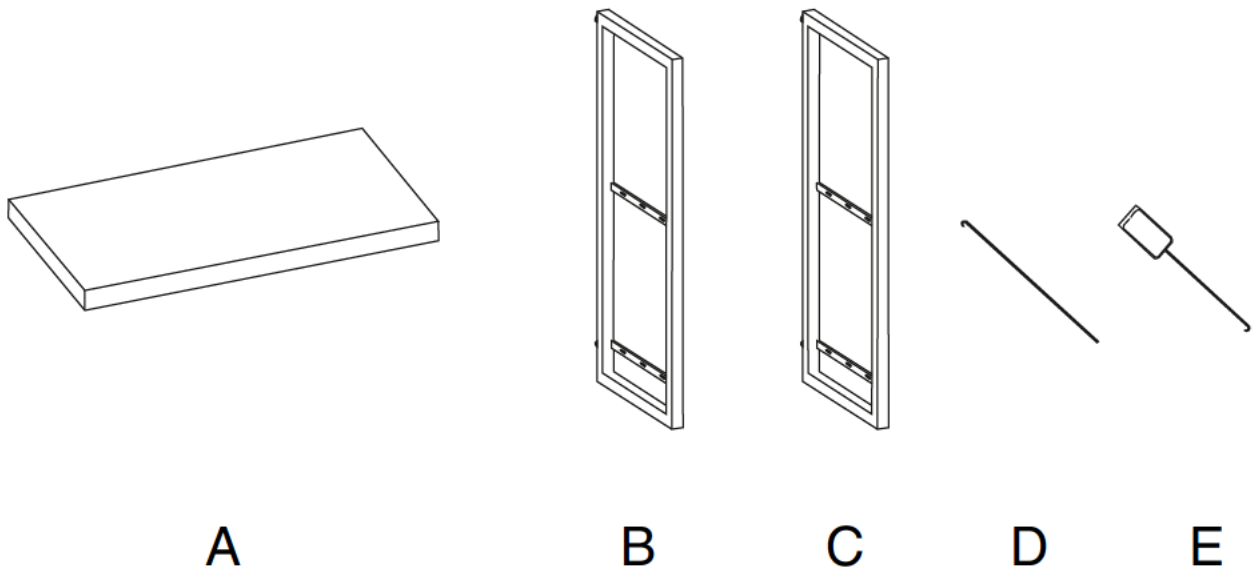
Assembly steps

Overview



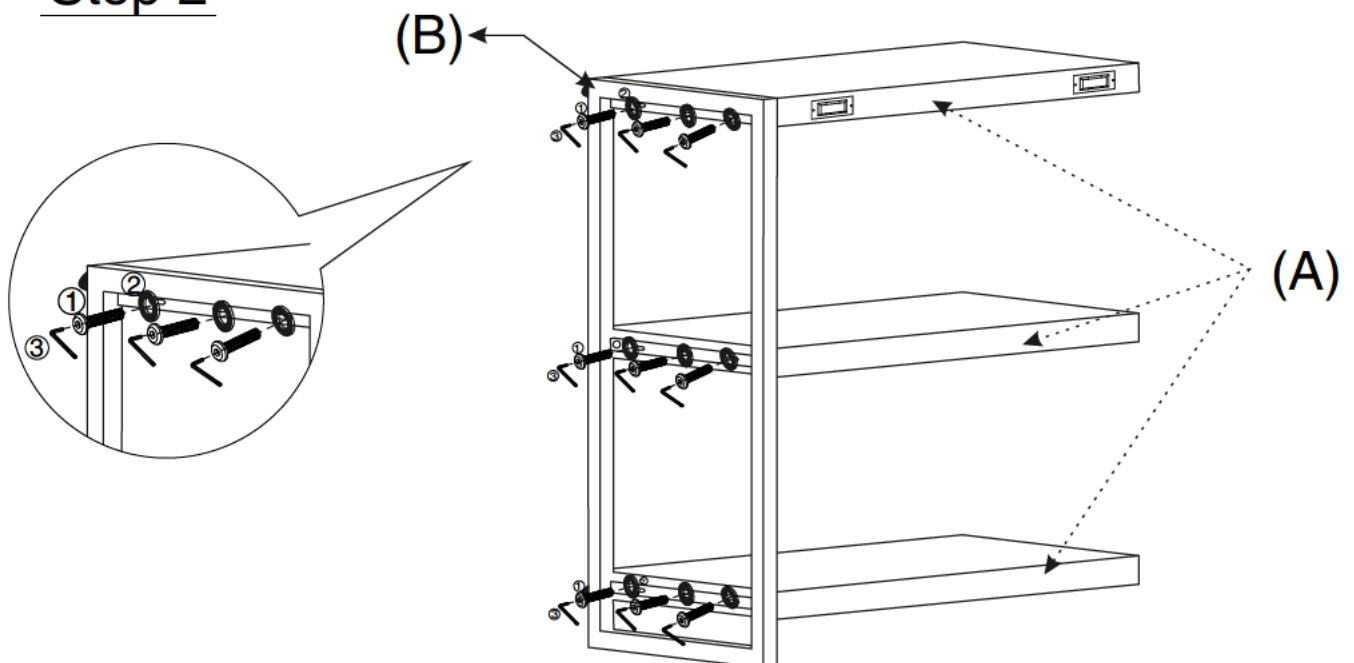
This Bookrack has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bookrack parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



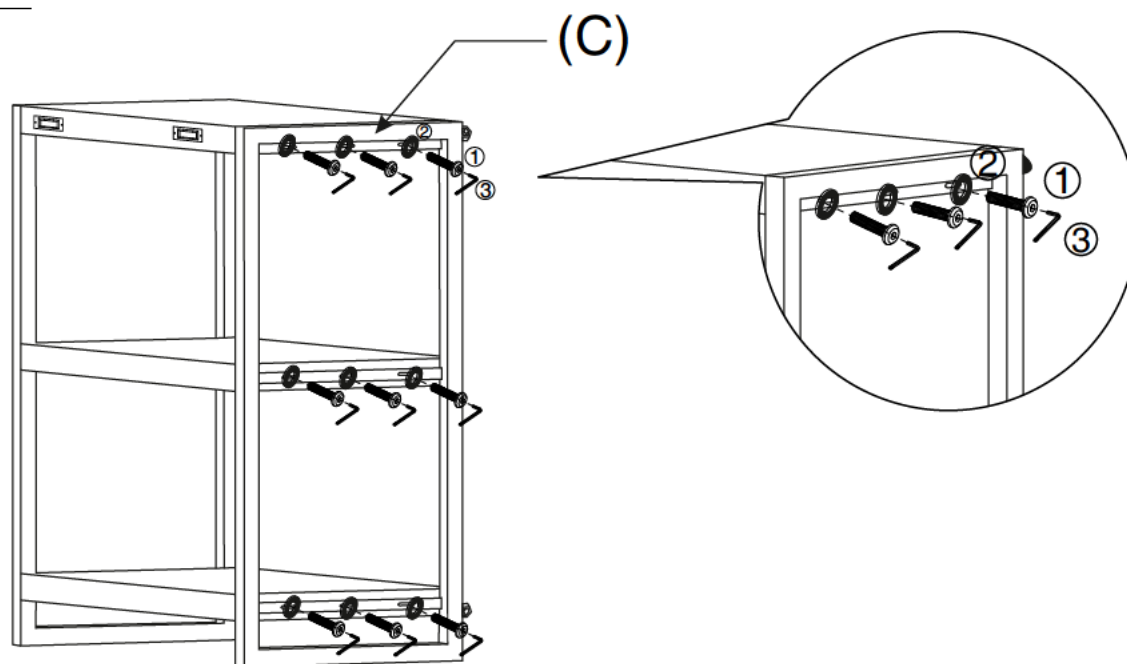
Unpack all parts and place them on a clean and non-marring floor to avoid scratches.

Step 2



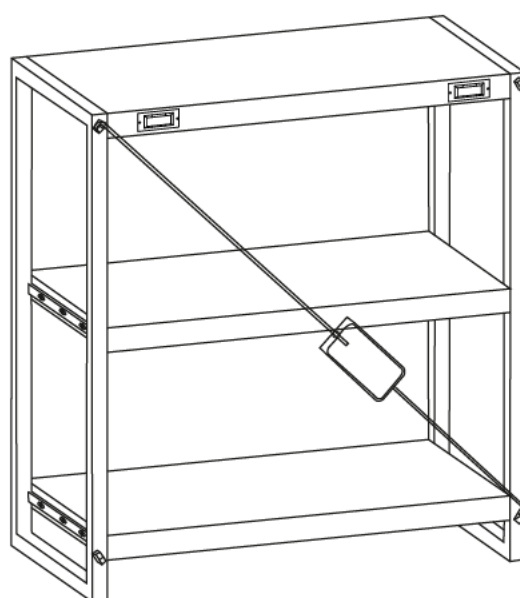
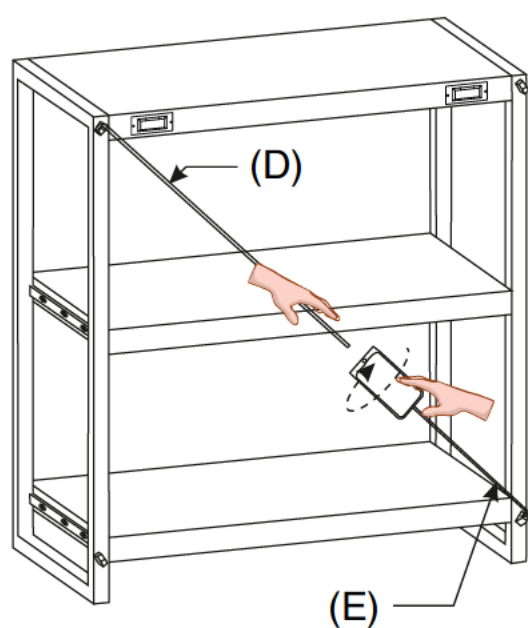
Align the Right Leg Frame (B) to the right side of Bookrack with the help of hand and attach using Washer (②) and using Bolt (①) with the help of Allen key (③) as shown in the picture above.

Step 3



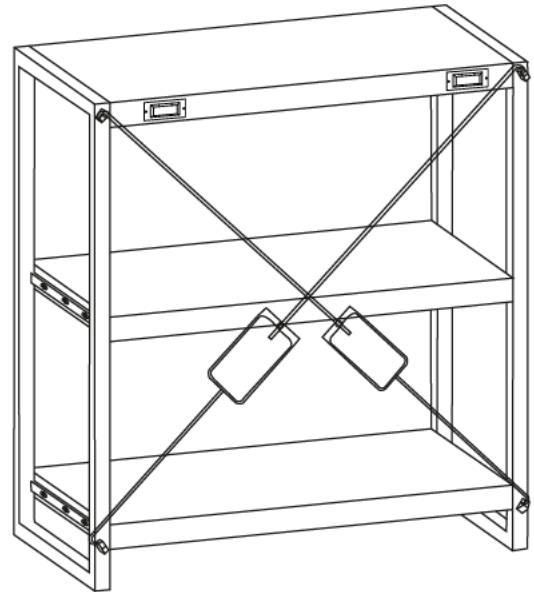
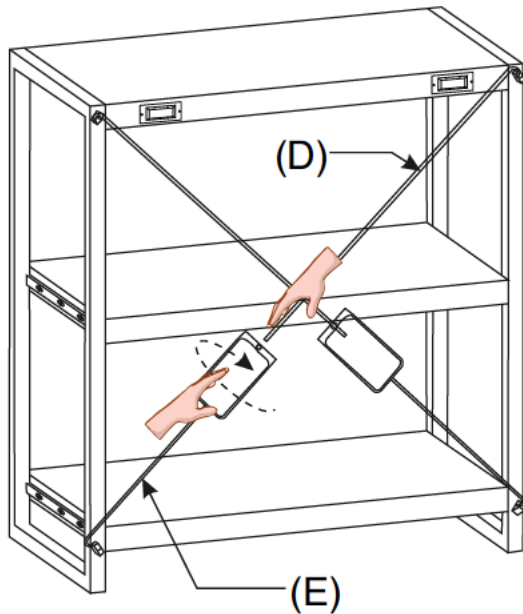
Align the Left Leg Frame (C) to the Left side of Bookrack with the help of hand and attach using Washer (2) and using Bolt (1) with the help of Allen key (3) as shown in the picture above.

Step 4



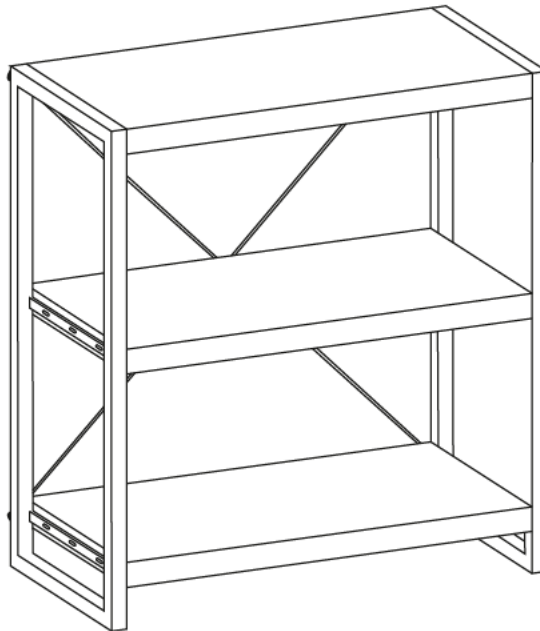
Attach the Back support Part 1 (D) to the top left Nut and the Back support Part 2 (E) to the right bottom Nut and rotate the rectangle part to tighten both the parts with the help of hand as shown in the picture above.

Step 5



Attach the Back support Part 1 (D) to the top Right Nut and the Back support Part 2 (E) to the Left bottom Nut and rotate the rectangle part to tighten both the parts with the help of hand as shown in the picture above.

Step 6



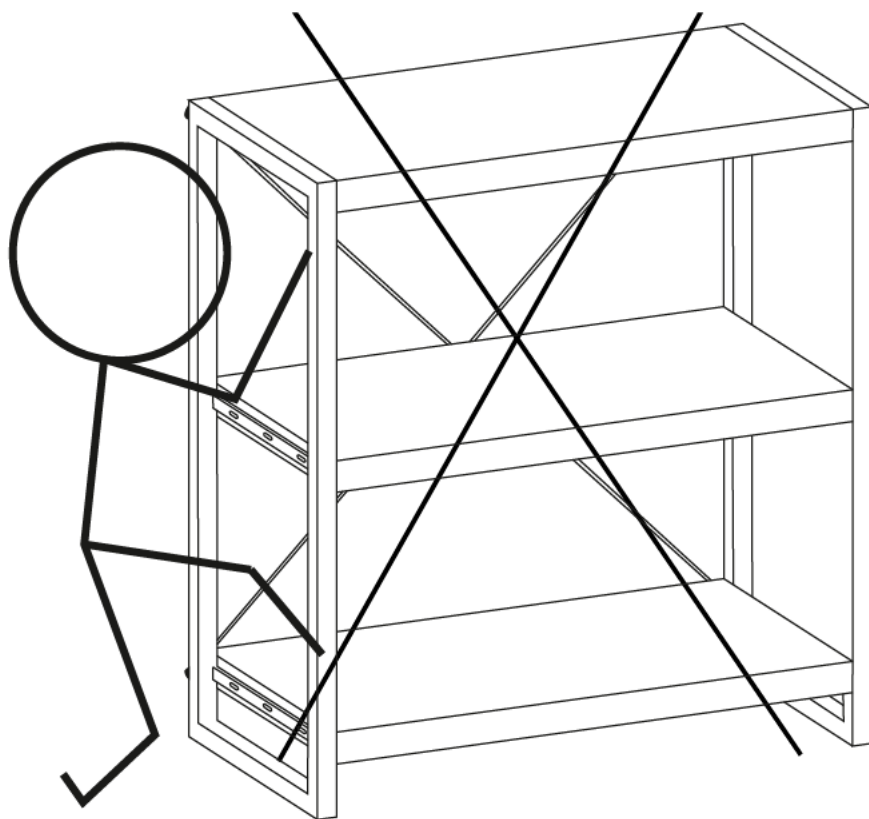
Place the Bookrack on a **LEVEL SURFACE**. Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Tipover Restraint Device Installation Instructions



WARNING

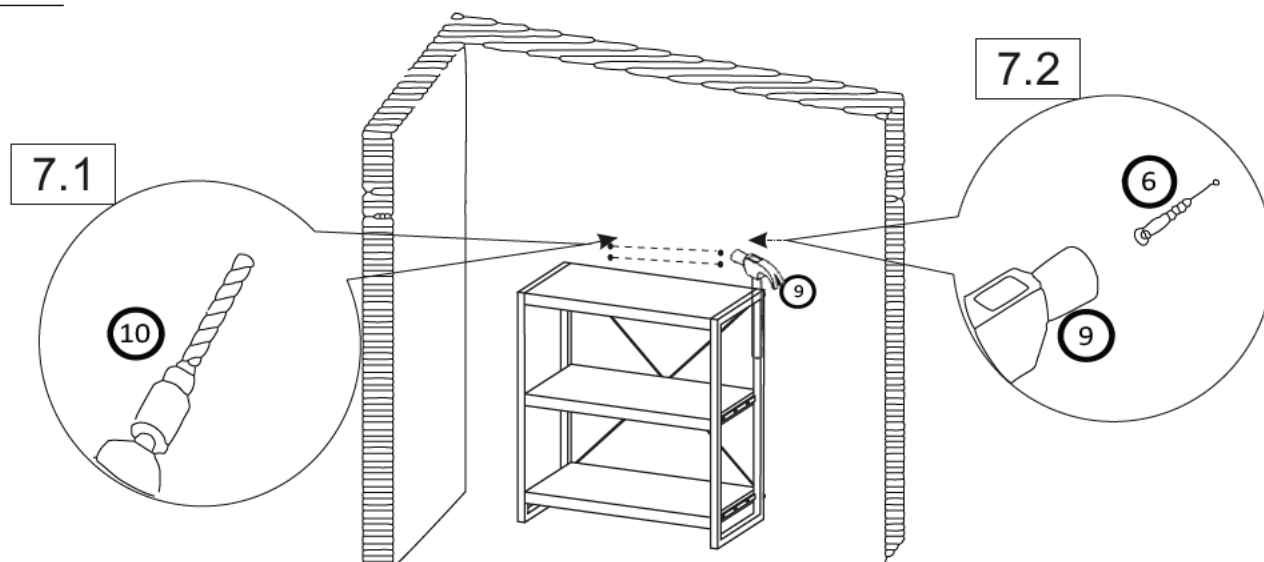
Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from tipping furniture. To help prevent tip-over: ALWAYS secure this furniture to the wall using Tipover Restraint Device. See product instructions for more ways to help prevent furniture tip-over.



Usage For Tipover Restraint Device:

To secure Bookrack against wall, attach Brackets (7) on wall and product, use Tipover Restraint Strap (4) to connect the Brackets (7).

Step 7



7.1) Drill two holes on wall at same height as Brackets (⑦) on Bookrack with Power Drill (⑩).

You can mark these points in two ways as below:

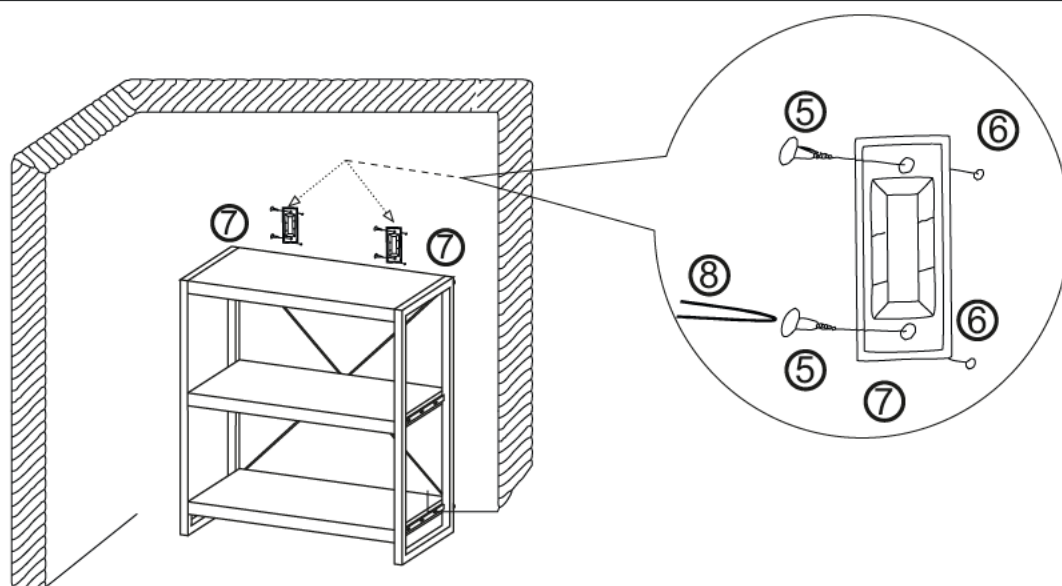
1) Move the Bookrack back to the wall. Mark two points same height as Bookrack on the wall.

Note: The Brackets need to be secured to solid, load bearing surface. Please use a Stud Finder(not supplied) if needed to locate the Wall Frame.

2) Measure the height of the Brackets (⑦) with ruler/measuring tape and mark on wall to keep them accurate and same height.

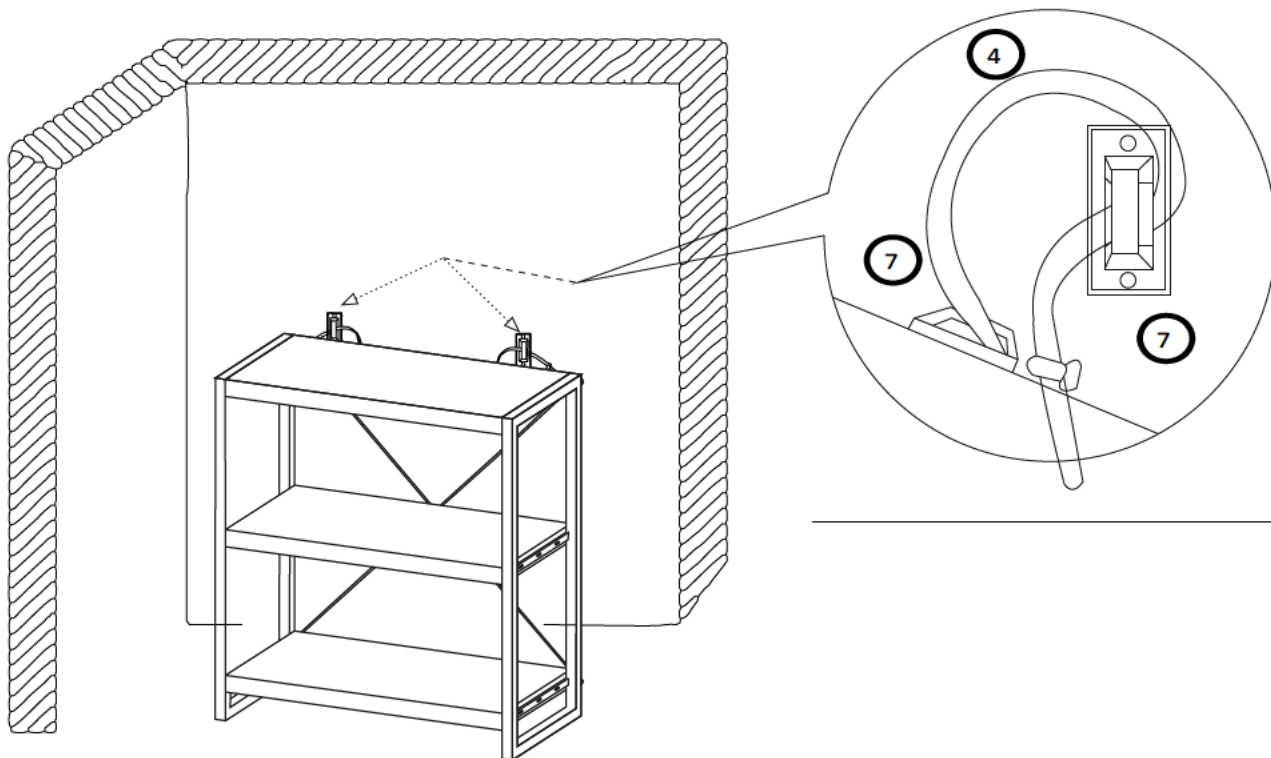
7.2) Insert Wall Plugs (⑥) into drilled holes on wall with Hammer (⑨).

Step 8



Attach Brackets (⑦) to Wall Plugs (⑥) using Wall Plug Screws (⑤) with Screwdriver (⑧).

Step 9



Move the Bookrack to the wall.

Pull the Tipover Restraint Straps (④) through the Brackets (⑦) on the wall and Bookrack table one by one, and pull the Tipover Restraint Straps (④) tight.

This Bookrack is now ready to use.

Caution: This Bookrack can only be used on flat, level surface.

Care & Maintenance

- ✓  • Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ⊘  • Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.
- ⊘  • Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a passed barner to protect the surface.
- ⊘  • Do not place furniture outside. for indoor use only.
- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. for residential use only.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ✓  • Dust and pick - up shills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
