

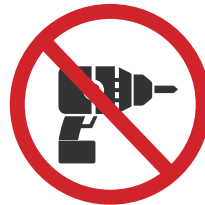

SAFETY AND CARE ADVICE

- Check you have all the components and tools listed.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- We do not recommend the use of power drills/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers and Allen keys.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could cause choking if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Do not overtighten the nuts to avoid causing damage to the threads.
- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre

A	 $\varnothing 8 \times 25 \text{mm}$ X6PCS
B	 $\varnothing 8 \times 40 \text{mm}$ X8PCS
C	 $\varnothing 10 \times 60 \text{mm}$ X1PCS
D	 8x22mm X14PCS
E	 5mm X1PCS
F	 8mm X1PCS
G	 $\varnothing 10 \text{mm}$ X1PCS

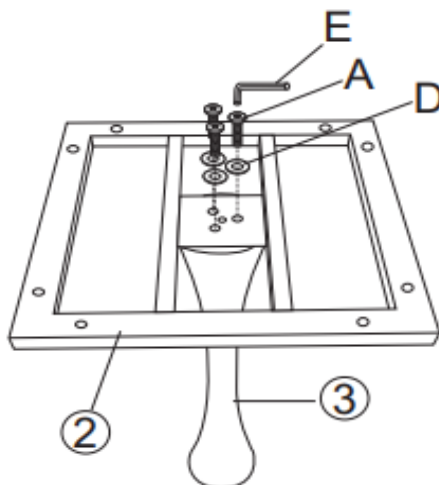
NOTE: Parts 2, 4 and 5 will arrive attached for delivery, please use tool G to unfasten all pieces before assembly.

NOTE: The quantities above are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.

STEP 1

Use a clean, flat, soft surface to avoid any bumps or scratches.

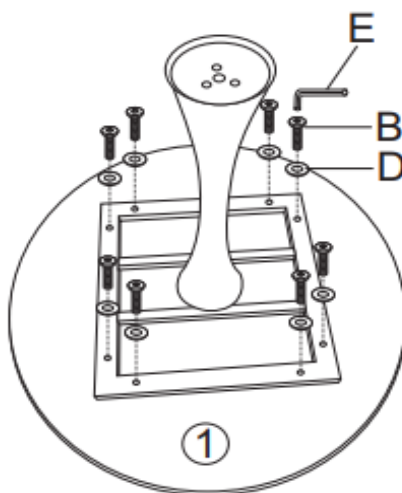
Attach the frame [2] to the leg [3]. The leg can be attached either way round. Use 1x washer [D] followed by 1x bolts [A] for each hole - 3 in total. Tighten with allen key [E].



STEP 2

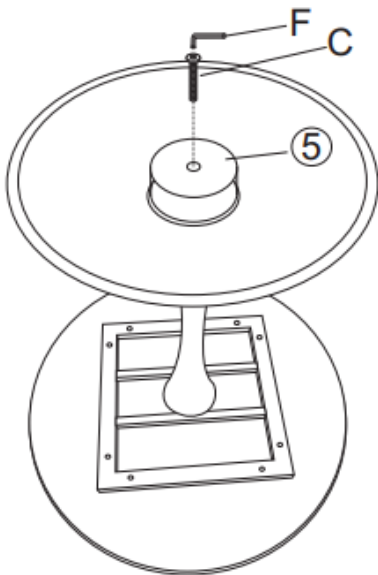
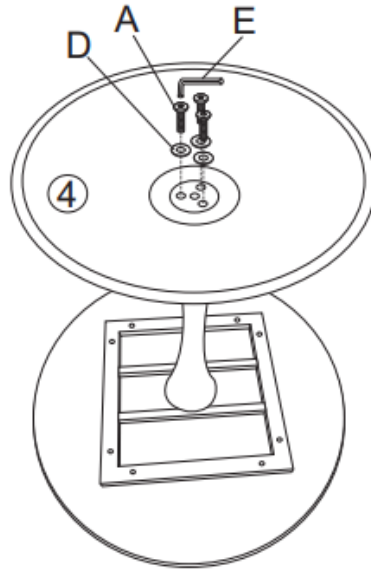
Place tabletop [1] upside down on your flat, soft surface. Carefully, and with help, flip the leg and frame upside down.

Attach the extending frame [2] to the the tabletop using 1x washer [D] followed by 1x bolt [B] for each hole - 8 in total. Tighten with Allen key [E].



STEP 3

Attach the table base [4] to the table leg using 1x washer [D] followed by 1x bolt [A] for each hole - 3 in total. Tighten with Allen key [E].



STEP 4

Attach the weight [5] to the bottom of the table base [4] using 1 x long bolt [C]. Tighten with Allen key [F]. **Make sure you ensure this weight is securely tightened, as it's crucial for the stability of the table.**

STEP 5

Carefully and with help, flip your table upright onto its base. Check for stability. Your new table is now ready to use.
