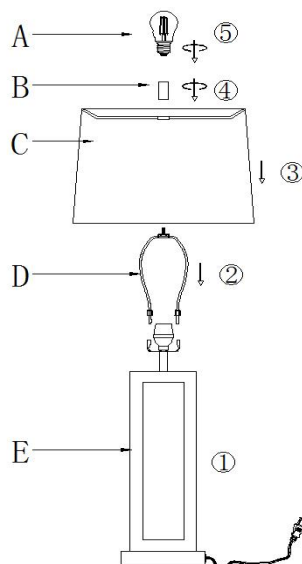

1. Illustration of assembly and wiring:

- I. D → E
- II. C B → D
- III. A → E



The mostly recommended bulb type is 6W LED Dimming bulb, 3000K (TYPE A19 Bulb)

2. Instructions for use:

This modern table lamp is not only featured with USB and Type-C charging function, but also with a two prong outlet. Just lightly tap on any metal part of the lamp body (Final included) to quickly change with three different brightness levels without delay. Compatible Bulb Type (2 Included)

- I. Open the box from top, take out all the components, parts bag and manual from the box carefully.
- II. Check all the components against the parts list. Make sure get each parts on list.

Lamp body and Holder	2	E

3. Refer to the illustration and follow the steps as below, Before assembly.

- I. Firstly, Pressing and Inserting the harp (D) into the lamp body holder (E).
- II. Secondly, screwing the bulb (A) onto the socket.
- III. Thirdly, putting the lampshade (C) on the top of the harp (D), and then screwing the final (B) into the top of the harp (D).

Tips: Pressing the top of harp (D) forward or backward to adjust the lampshade to a balanced position.
