

Coming this spring to a garden near you!

Perfect no matter what size of garden you have. From balcony to back yard, patio to allotment patch, the [Hood Mini 90°](#) will fit the bill.

The wall mounted [Hood Mini 90°](#) is a spacious cloche style growing system. At around approx. 87 cm high at its peak, 135 cm wide and 87 cm long there's plenty of room for your seedlings and young plants. Fix it against your wall or shed and start planting. Much easier than a cold frame and simple to fold up and put away when you don't need it. Start your plants off in here or protect them from the cold weather later in the year



Next we have the free standing [Hood Mini 180°](#). This is literally twice the size of the [Hood Mini 90°](#). Dimensions are approx. 87 cm high, 135 cm wide and 174 cm long. It has elasticated loops around the edge to peg it down and full access is easy with the simple lift up/drop down action.

Place it over your smaller raised beds or on open ground for all-year-round growing. Use it to bring on your young plants or protect your tender plants during the winter.

It's lightweight and easy to fold away when you don't need it and quick to assemble. Compact, practical and great value.



The wall mounted [Horti Hood 180°](#) is a large, lift-up, walk in greenhouse. Big enough to put your staging in, several grow bags, tubs and trays.

It's 167 cm high, 167 cm deep and 250 cm wide. Extend your growing season by using it for seedlings in the spring, salads and vegetables in the summer and plant protection during the winter.



Last but not least we have the cavernous freestanding

If you ever fancied starting your own 'Eden Project'... you can now with the Horti Hood 180°!

The huge [Horti Hood 180°](#) is approx. 334cm x 250cm x 167cm high and is made from high quality UV stabilised PVC.

As with the [Horti Hood 180°](#) this is a product you can use all year round, or fold it up and put it away. The generous dimensions of the [Horti Hood 180°](#) allow it to be used over raised beds, on your allotment and in your garden as a greenhouse. You will be impressed by the quantity and variety of plants that will fit into this futuristic looking dome design. Tall plants/climbers can be grown in the centre with smaller plants in front. You can even put greenhouse staging in to germinate more of your seedlings and bring on smaller plants.

The easy lift up drop/down access from both sides means that you can reach the tallest and furthest plants and when you don't need access you can peg it down using the elasticated loops around the edges. It's even got air vents built in.

A large, quick and simple to erect greenhouse that won't break the bank... and the kids can't break the glass!
