

INSTRUCTIONS

⚠ DANGER!

Read these instructions carefully prior to installation.

- Check for electric, gas, and plumbing lines before drilling or consult a professional.
- **ALWAYS** cut **ALL** relevant power before installing a lighting fixture and do not restore power to the line until the lamp has been **FULLY** installed.
- **DO NOT** use with bulbs exceeding the recommended wattage.

ASSEMBLY

1. Prepare the wiring in your ceiling for the desired location of your new lamp. Prepare your junction box (not included).
2. Remove the canopy nuts (F) from the canopy bolts (C) and take the mounting bracket (B) off the canopy (E).
3. Connect the mounting bracket to your junction box using the mounting bolts (D).
4. Make electrical connections using the wire nuts (A).
5. Being careful that no wiring is left exposed, place the canopy against the mounting bracket and replace the canopy nuts.
6. Attach the Hooks (H) to the bottom frame (G) and hang the crystal rods on them as shown in the image.
7. Attach the metal plates (I) to the frame by using their two holes to hang them on the hooks on the side of the frame. Hang them in the same order as shown in the image (medium, large, medium, small).
8. Install your bulb into the socket. This fixture has been rated for one E26 bulb (not included) up to 60W.
