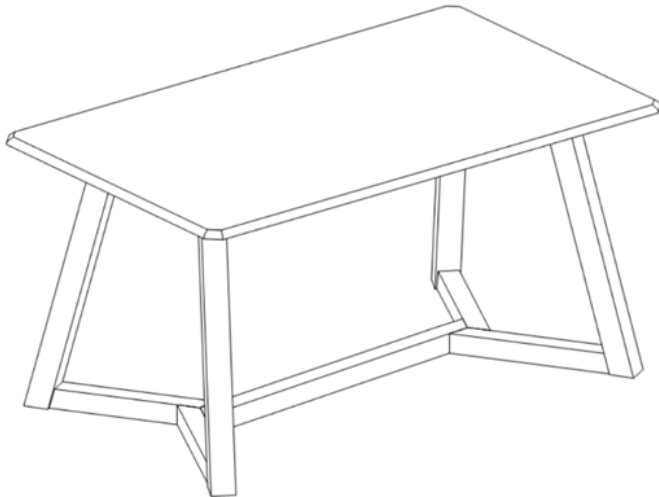


Dining Table

Assembly Guide



IMPORTANT: please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

NO POWER TOOLS

- Check you have all the components and tools listed
- Remove all fittings from their bags and separate into groups
- We do not recommend use of power tools - this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers and Allen keys
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could cause choking if swallowed
- Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (same room) as possible
- Do not over tighten the nuts to avoid damage to the threads
- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners
- Do not allow children to climb or play on this product
- From time to time, check there are no loose screws in this unit
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre
- Unless otherwise stated, this product is designed for domestic use and is not certified for commercial or contract settings.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Note: the quantities are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fixings may be supplied than are required.

Label	Hardware Description	Drawing	Size (mm)	Quantity
A	JCBB Bolt		M8x80	8
B	Spring Washer		5/16"	8
C	Flat Washer		M8	8
D	Allen Key		M5	1
E	Long Wood Screw		M4x38	4
F	Short Wood Screw		M4x32	6

Note:

- Use a clear, flat surface to avoid bumps or scratches before assembling.
- Insert all fixings loosely at first to allow for alignment; only tighten them once everything is properly positioned, as some adjustment may be required.
- Avoid over-tightening, as this may damage the parts.
- Seek assistance when moving large or heavy parts

STEP 1

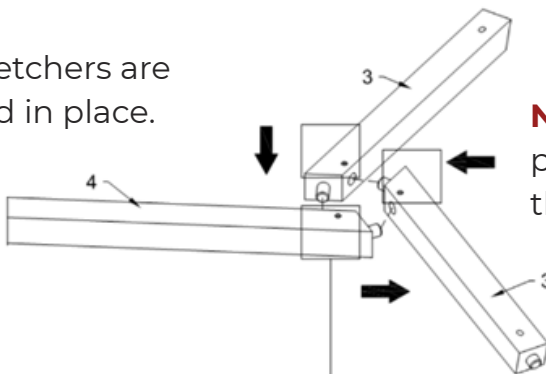
Position the 2x Short Bar [3] and 1x Long Bar [4] around the centre connector as shown.

Align the wooden dovetail on each bar with the slots in the centre connector.

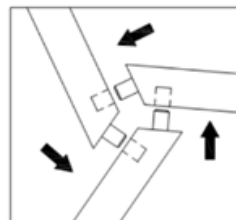
Slide each stretcher inward toward the connector, following the arrow directions, until the pins are fully inserted.

Ensure all stretchers are securely fitted in place.

NOTE: Do not force the parts, as this may damage the connector



NOTE: Ensure the pilot holes are all the same way up.

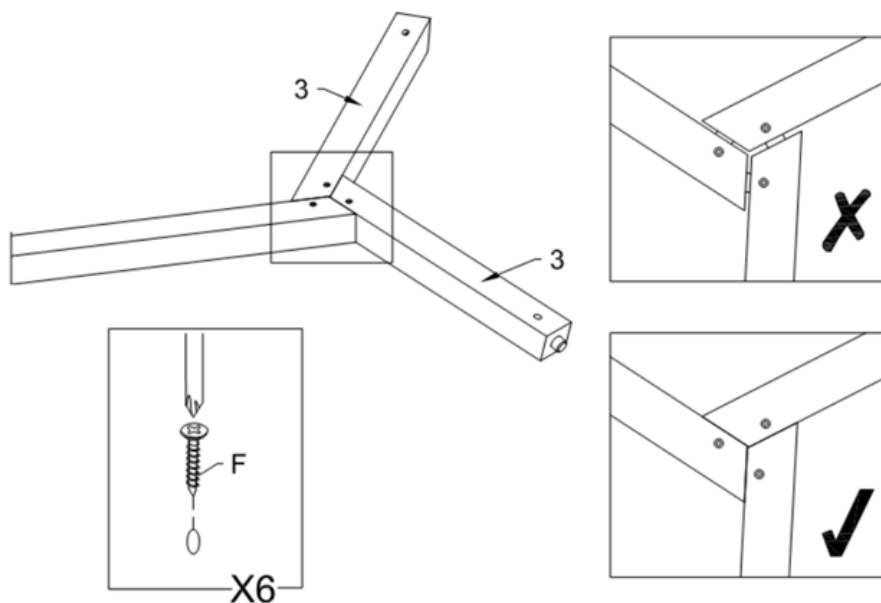


STEP 2

Repeat Step 1 with the remaining 2x Short bars [3] at the other end of the Long Bar [4]

STEP 3

After ensuring all bars [3+4] are securely in place, tighten them with 6x short wood screws [F].

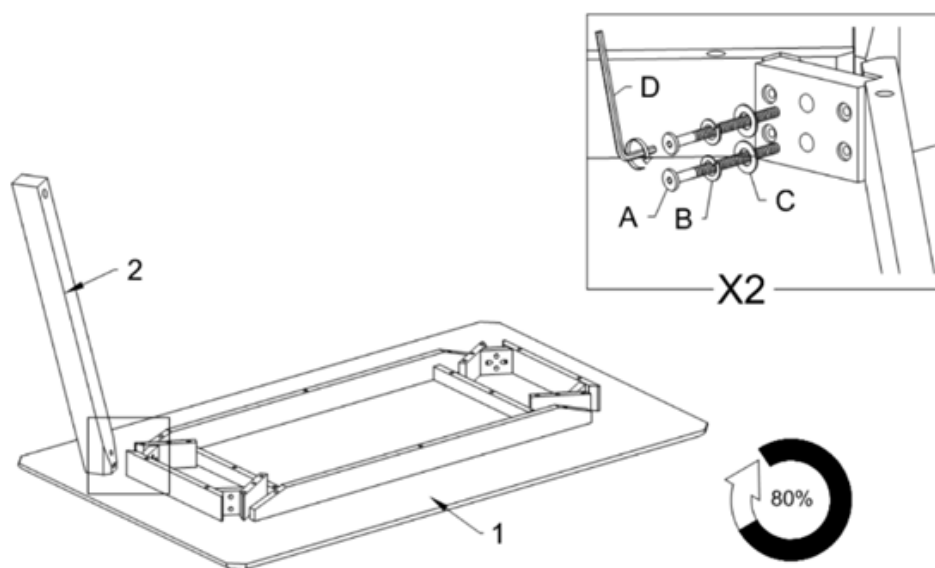


STEP 4

Align 1x Leg [2] with the pre drilled holes on the table top[1] and secure using 2x washer [C], 2x spring washer [B] and 2x Bolt [A].

Partially tighten with Allen Key [D]

To allow for alignment, only partially tighten the fixings.



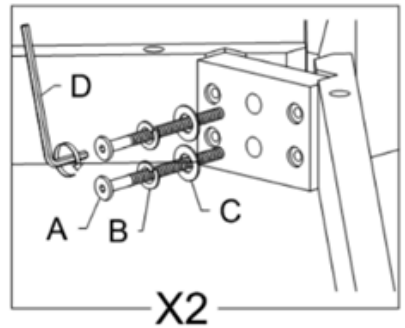
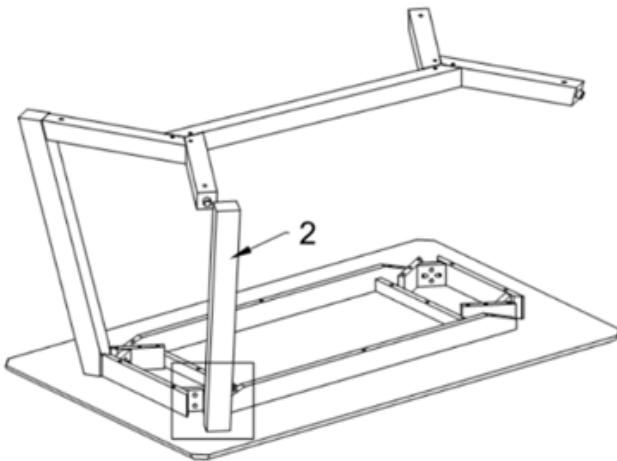
NOTE: Do not overtighten fixings as this will cause damage to the wood.

STEP 5

Align the second table Leg [2] with the pre drilled holes on the table top [1] and secure the leg using 2x washer [C], 2x spring washer [B] and 2x Bolt [A].

Align the previously built bar frame [3+4] with the slots on each table leg - You will need someone to help hold the bar frame.

Partially tighten with Allen Key [D]



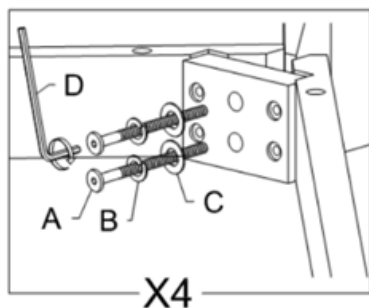
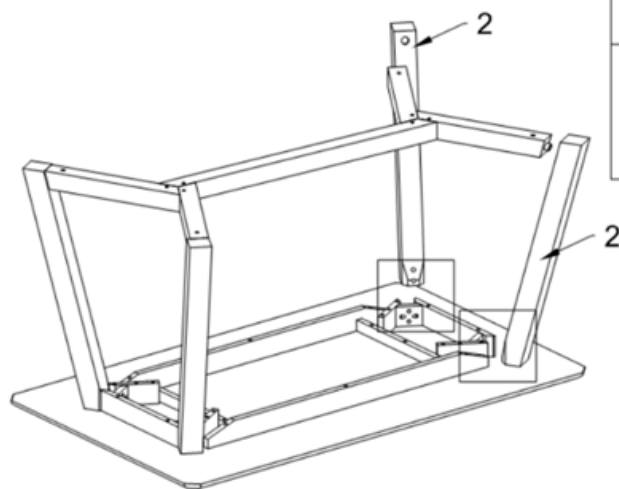
NOTE: Do not overtighten fixings as this will cause damage to the wood.

STEP 6

Align the 2x remaining table legs [2] with the table top [1] and the bar frame [3+4]

Secure the 2x legs [2] using 4x washer [C], 4x spring washer [B] and 4x Bolt [A].

Partially tighten with Allen Key [D]

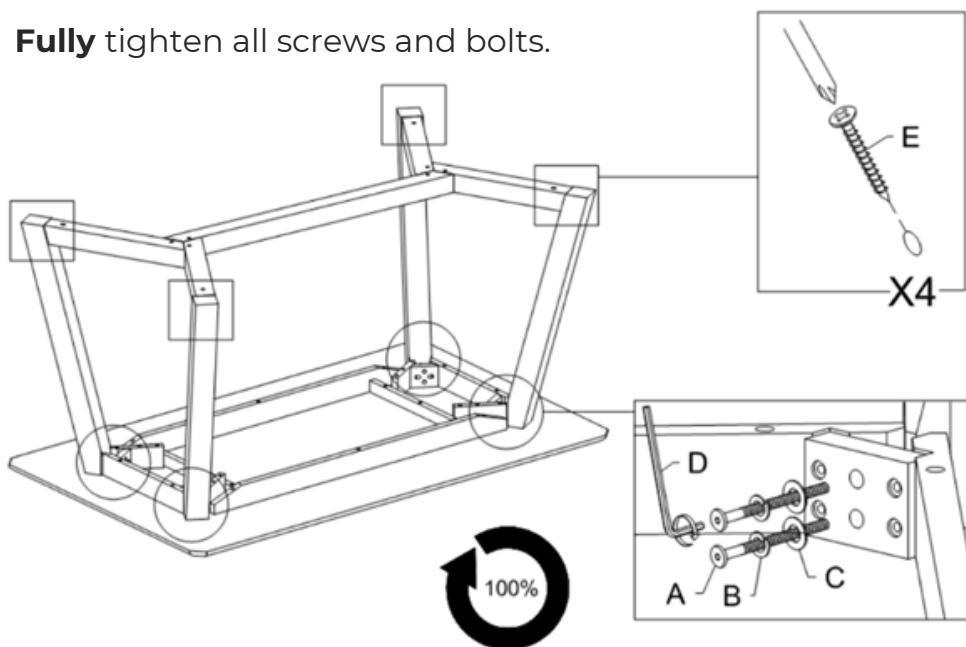


NOTE: Do not overtighten fixings as this will cause damage to the wood.

STEP 7

Secure the bar frame [3+4] to the 4x table legs [2] using 4x long wood screws [E]

Fully tighten all screws and bolts.

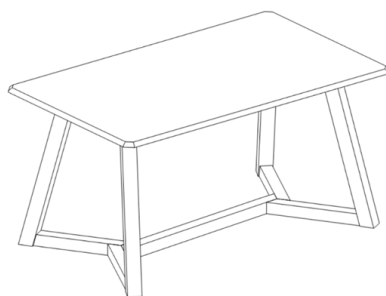


STEP 8

Carefully, and with help, turn the table over to stand on the legs.

Check stability.

Your table is now ready to use!
