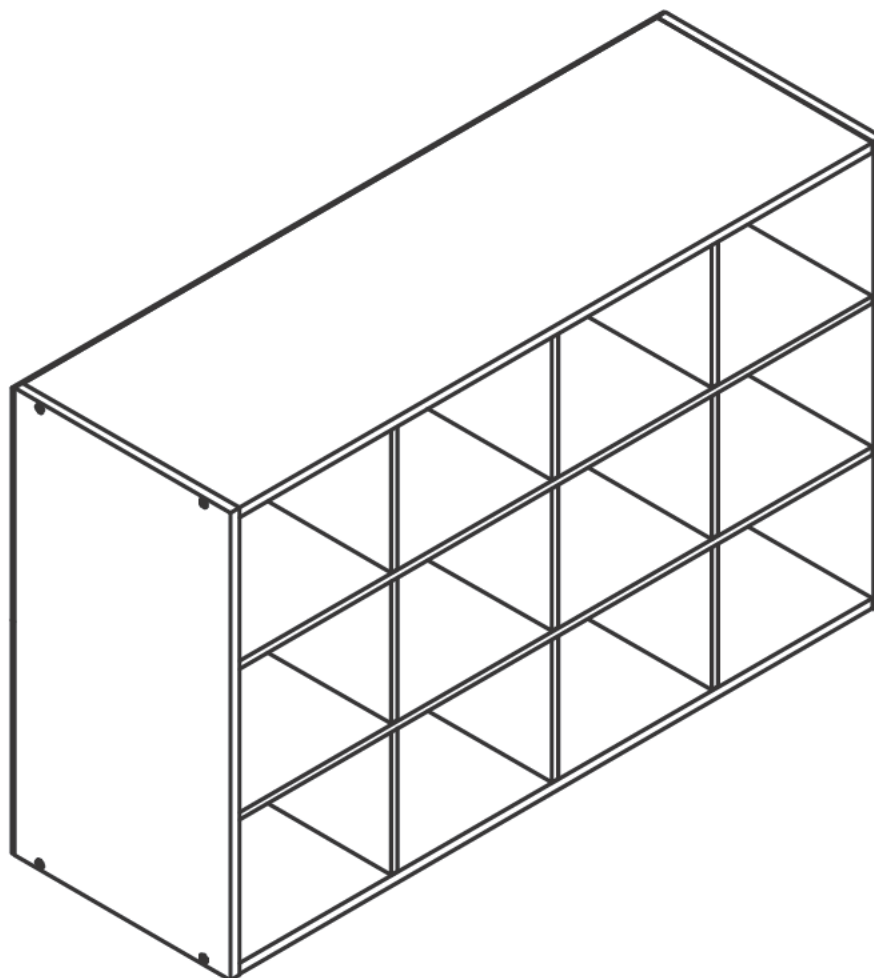


Assembly Instructions - Please keep for future reference

Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers **for inserting screws**, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Glue safety - Take care when using glue, please follow the advice below

Skin contact: Remove contamination by washing with soap and water. This procedure should also be followed prior to eating and drinking.

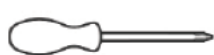
Eye contact: Rinse immediately with clean water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice.

If swallowed: Seek medical advice immediately.

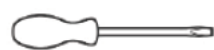
Care and maintenance

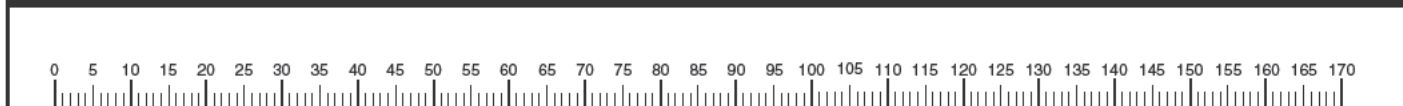

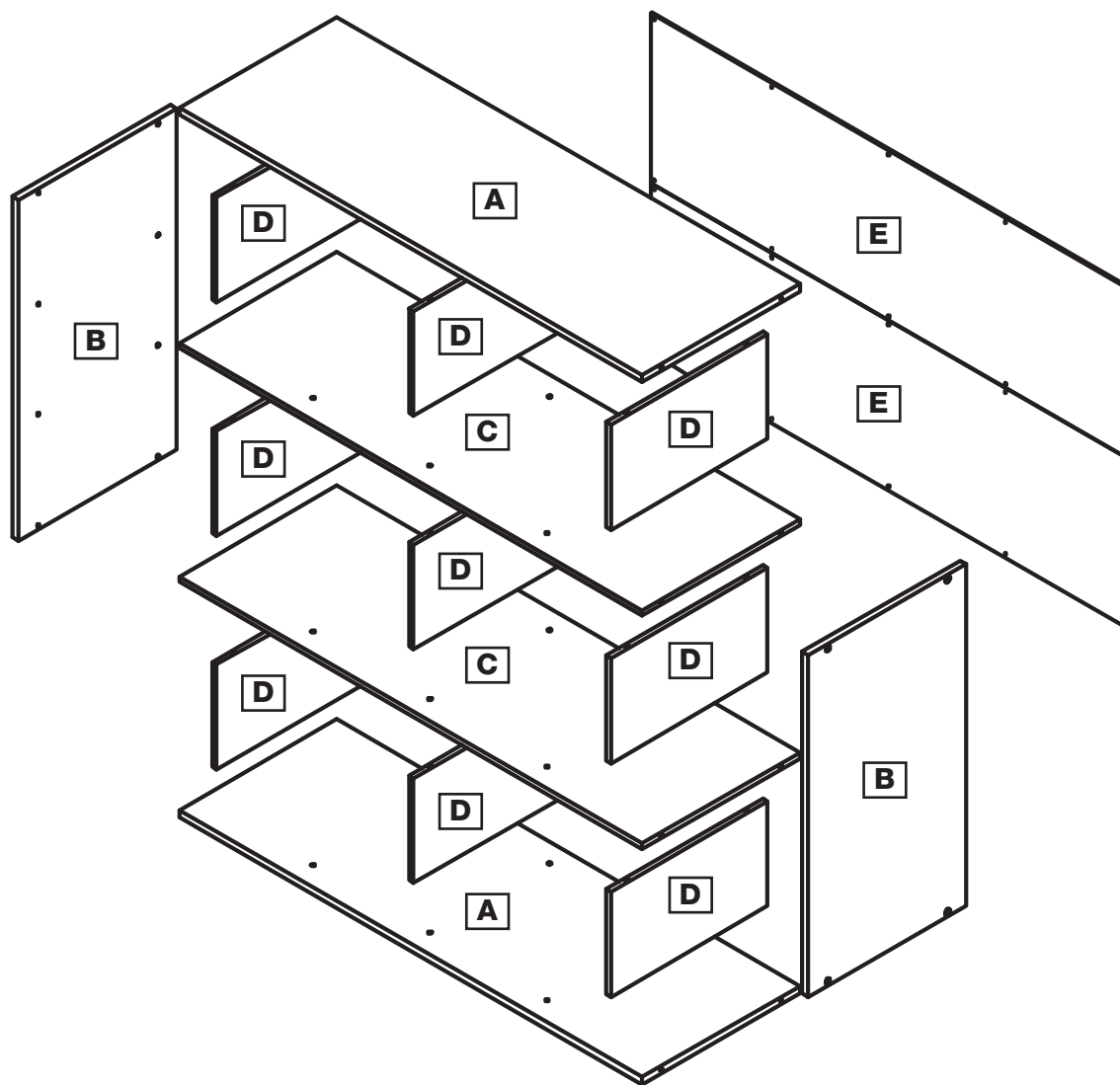
Ruler/tape

Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws









Components - Panels

Please check you have all the panels listed below



Note: The quantities below are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.

1  Screw x 8	2  20mm Wooden dowel x 20	3  30mm Wooden dowel x 12
4  Tack x 20	5  Glue x 1	6  Screw cover x 8

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Assembly

a: Insert 4 x 30mm wooden dowel **3** into shelf **D**.

Repeat for another 2 x shelf **D**.

b: Insert 2 x 20mm wooden dowel **2** into shelf **D**.

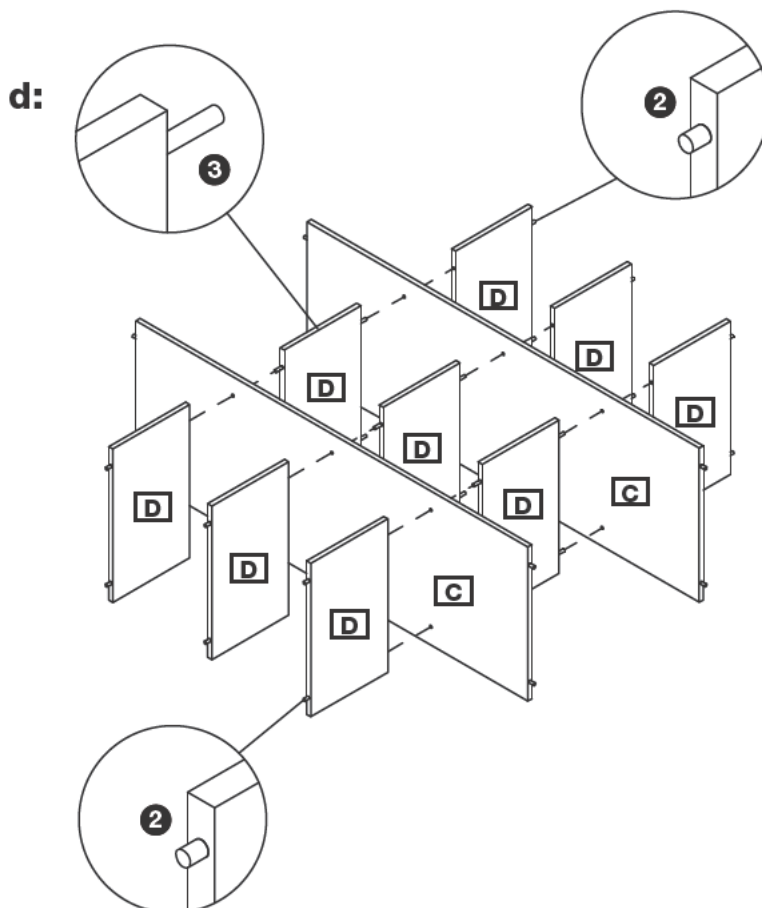
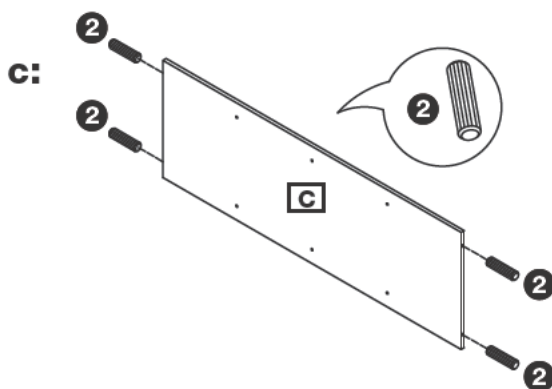
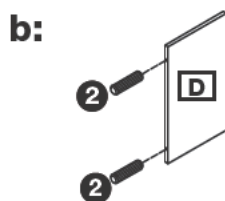
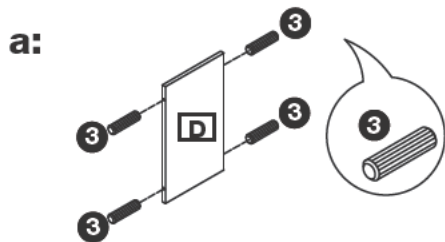
Repeat for another 5 x shelf **D**.

c: Insert 4 x 20mm wooden dowel **2** into upright **C**.

Repeat for second upright **C**.

d: Attach 2 x upright **C** to 9 x shelf **D** as shown.

The 3 x shelves **D** with the long 30mm dowel **3** in the centre and the 6 x shelves **D** with the shorter 20mm wooden dowel **2** on the left and right edges - ensure all "finished" edges are facing downwards.



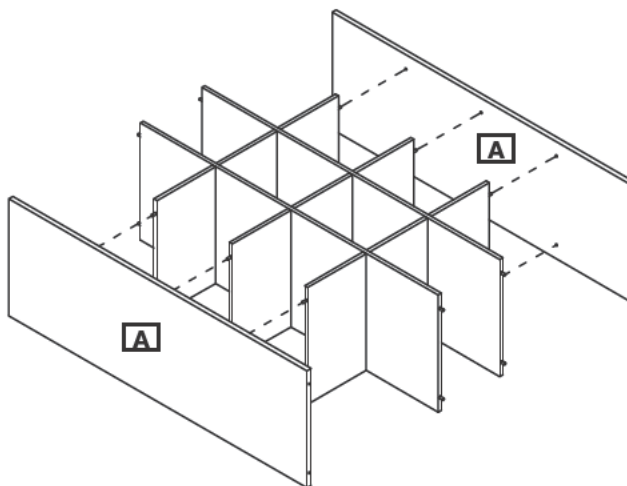

Assembly

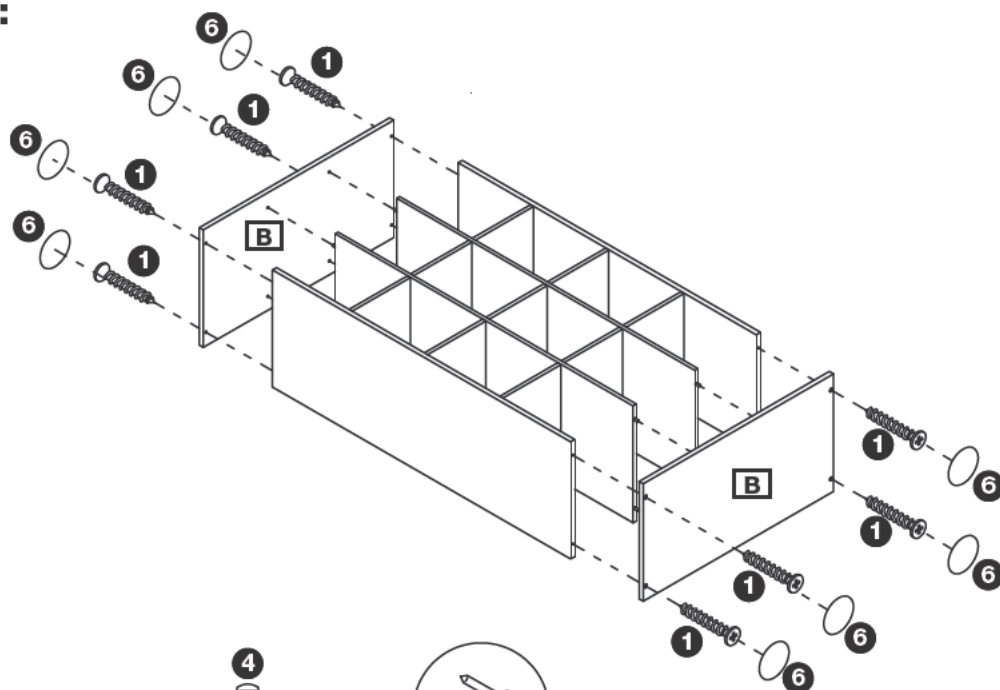
e: Slot left and right side panels - 2 x **A** onto assembled frame ensuring all “finished” edges are facing downwards.

f: Add 2 x base / top panels **B** to the frame. Fix through holes using 4 x screw **1** and complete with 4 x screw covers **6** for each panel

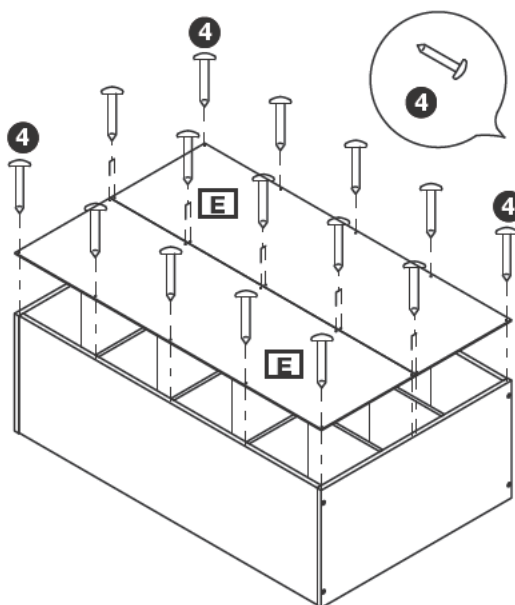

g: Add 2 x backboard **E** to the frame ensuring that the frame is square and corners are 90 degrees.

Fix through holes shown using 20 x tack **4**.
